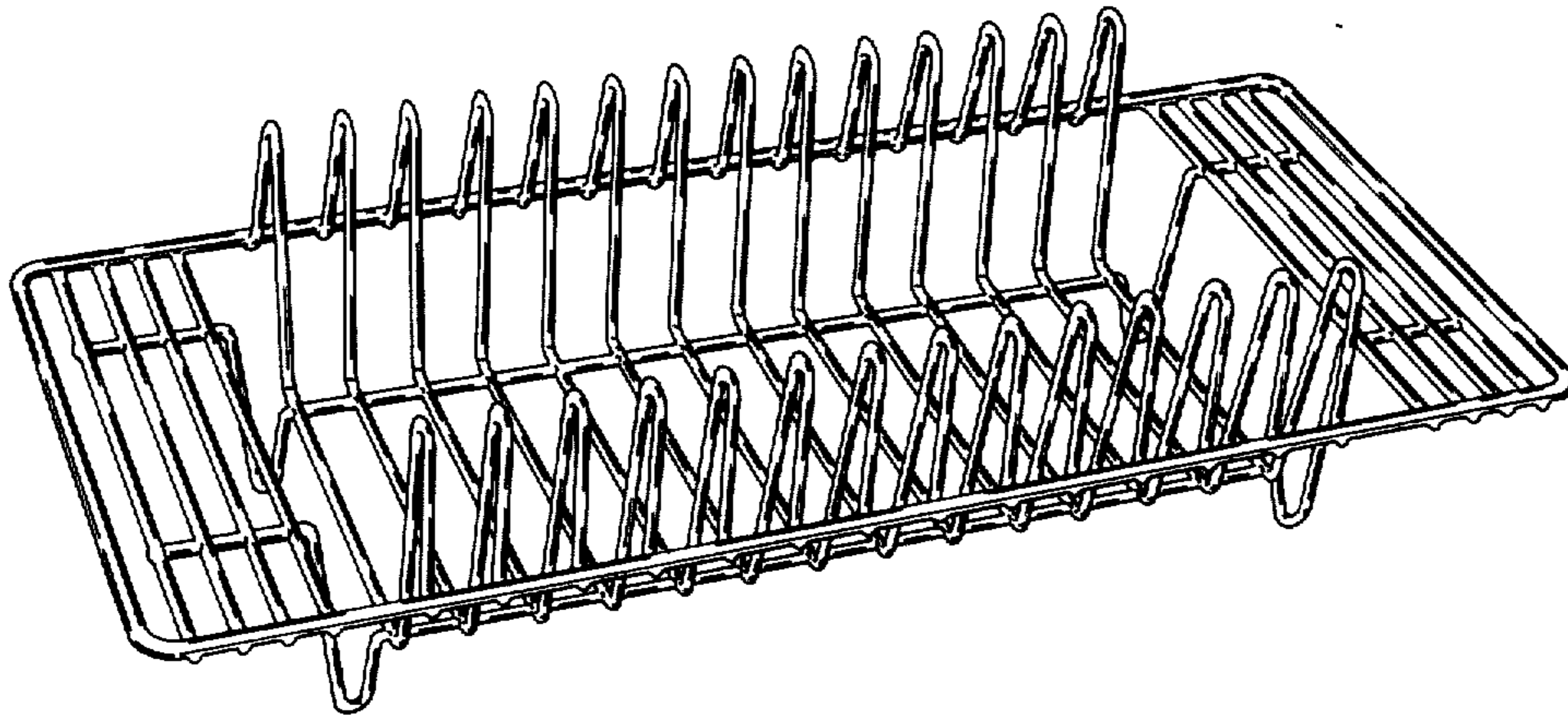

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an over-sink dish drainer embodying my new design.  
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof.  
FIG. 3 is an end elevation thereof.  
The side opposite to that shown in FIG. 2 is a mirror image thereof and the end opposite to that shown in FIG. 3 is a mirror image thereof.



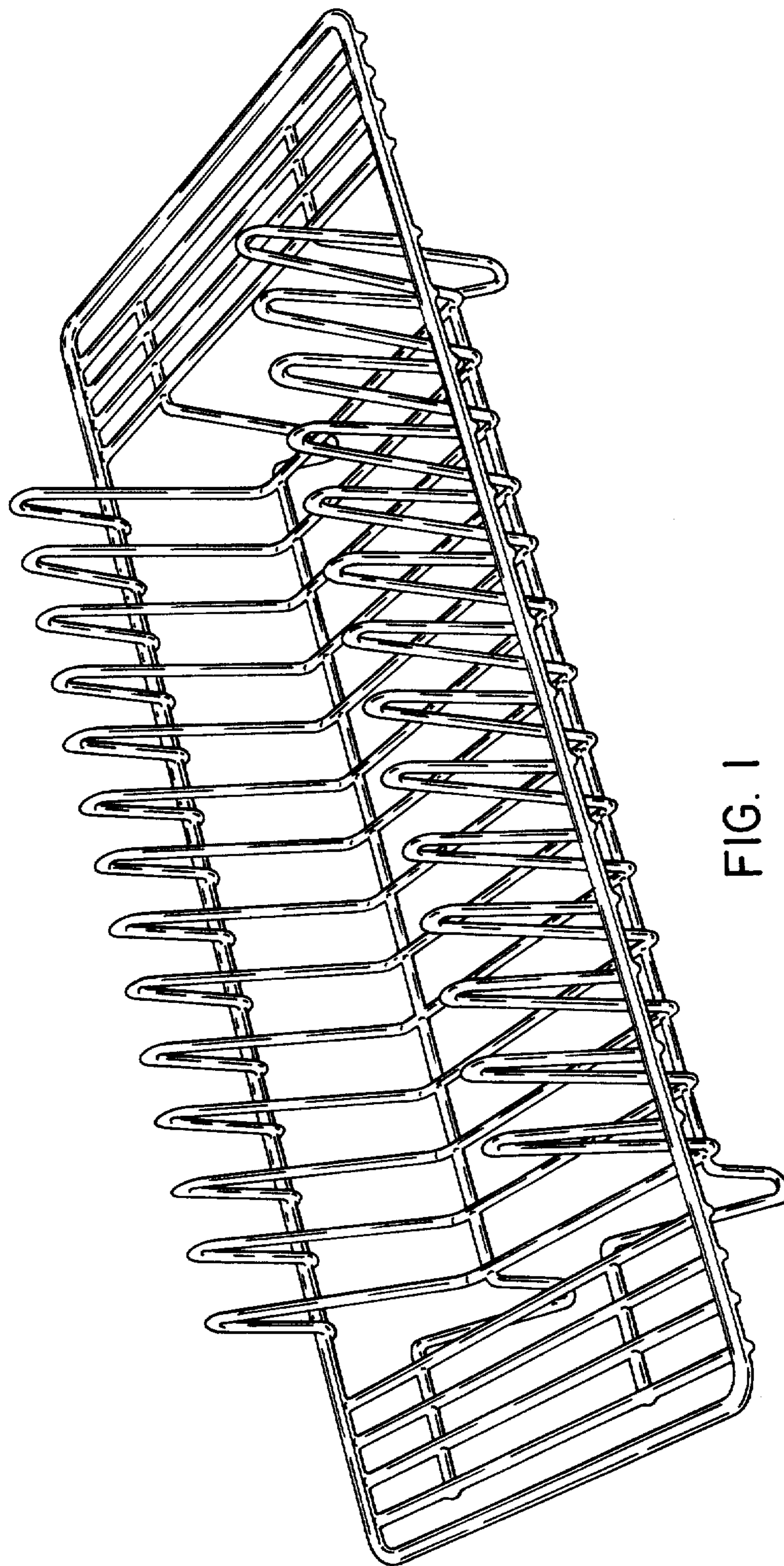

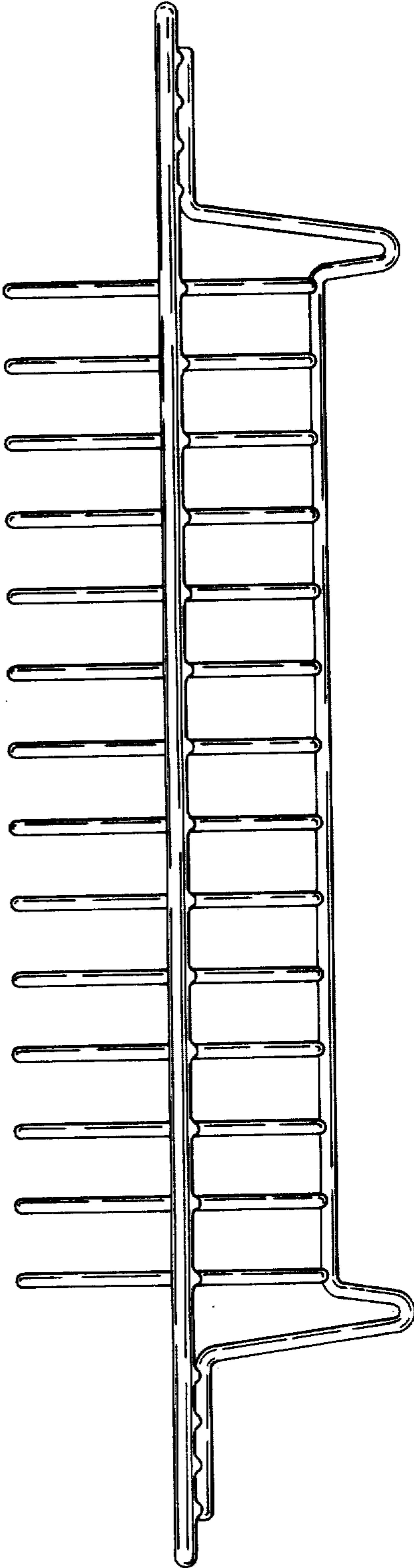
