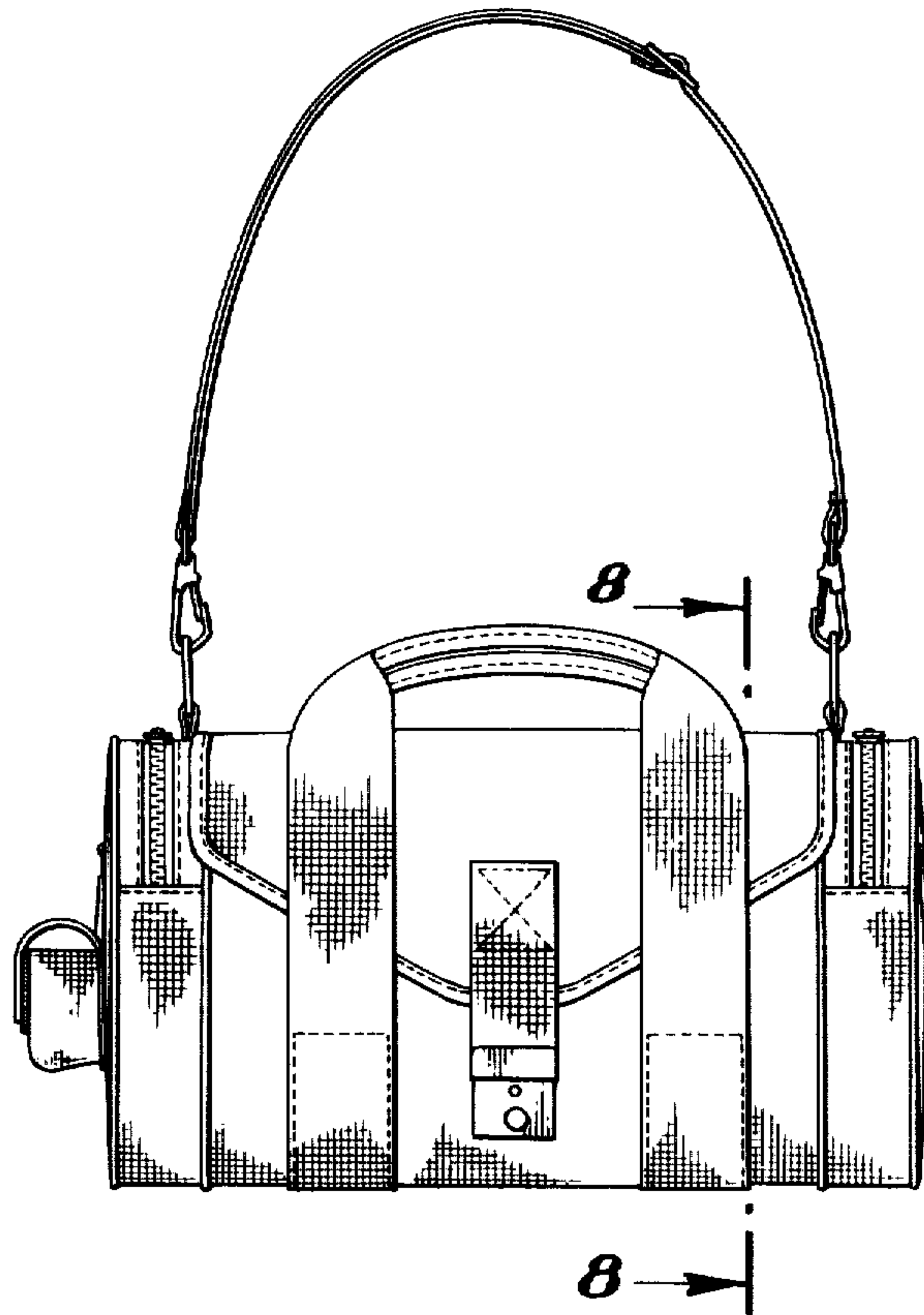

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a camera bag, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a camera bag showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along the line 7-7 of FIG. 3;
FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view along the line 8-8 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 9 is an exploded perspective view of the camera bag in an open position with a portion of the carrying strap omitted for convenience of illustration.



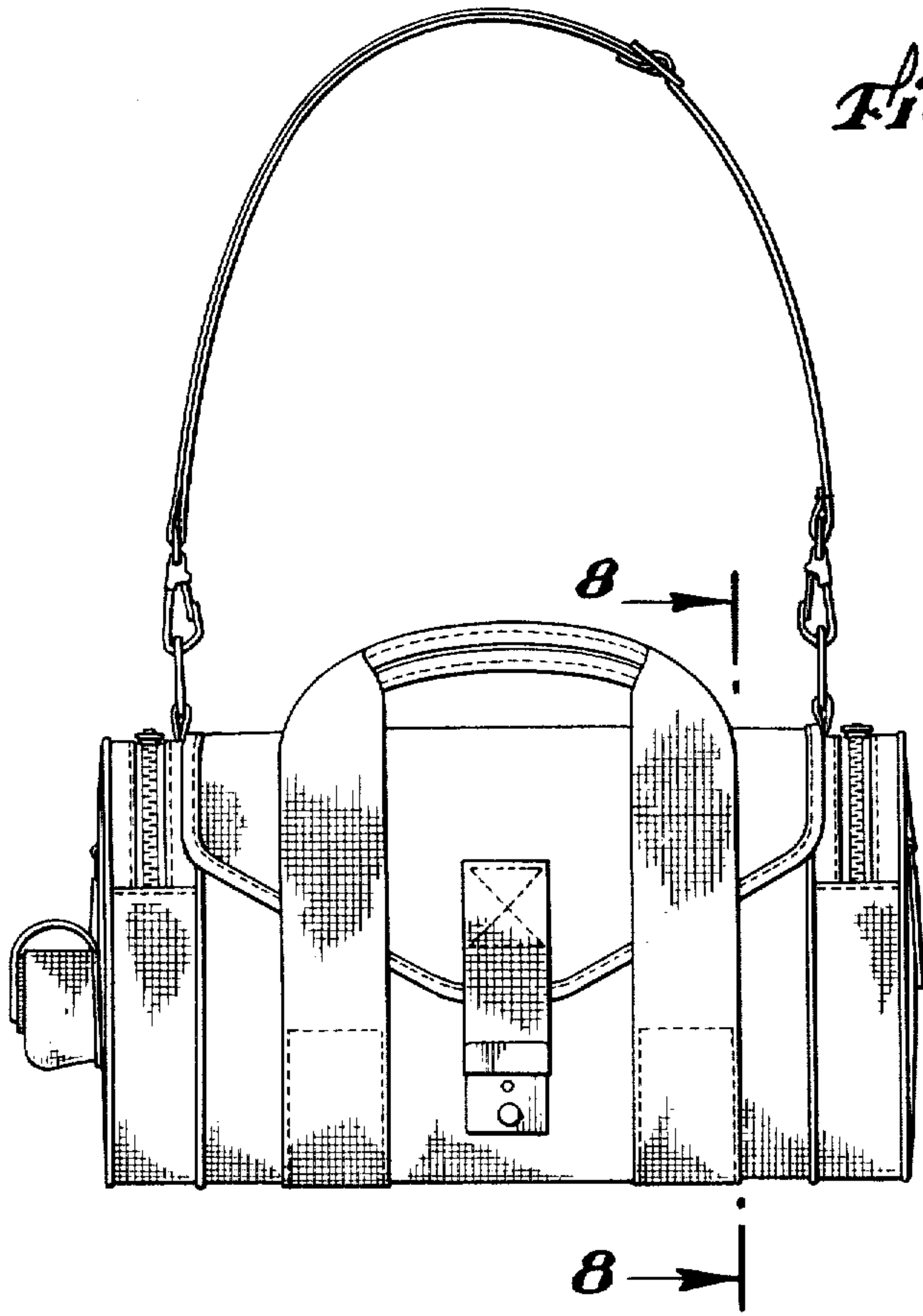

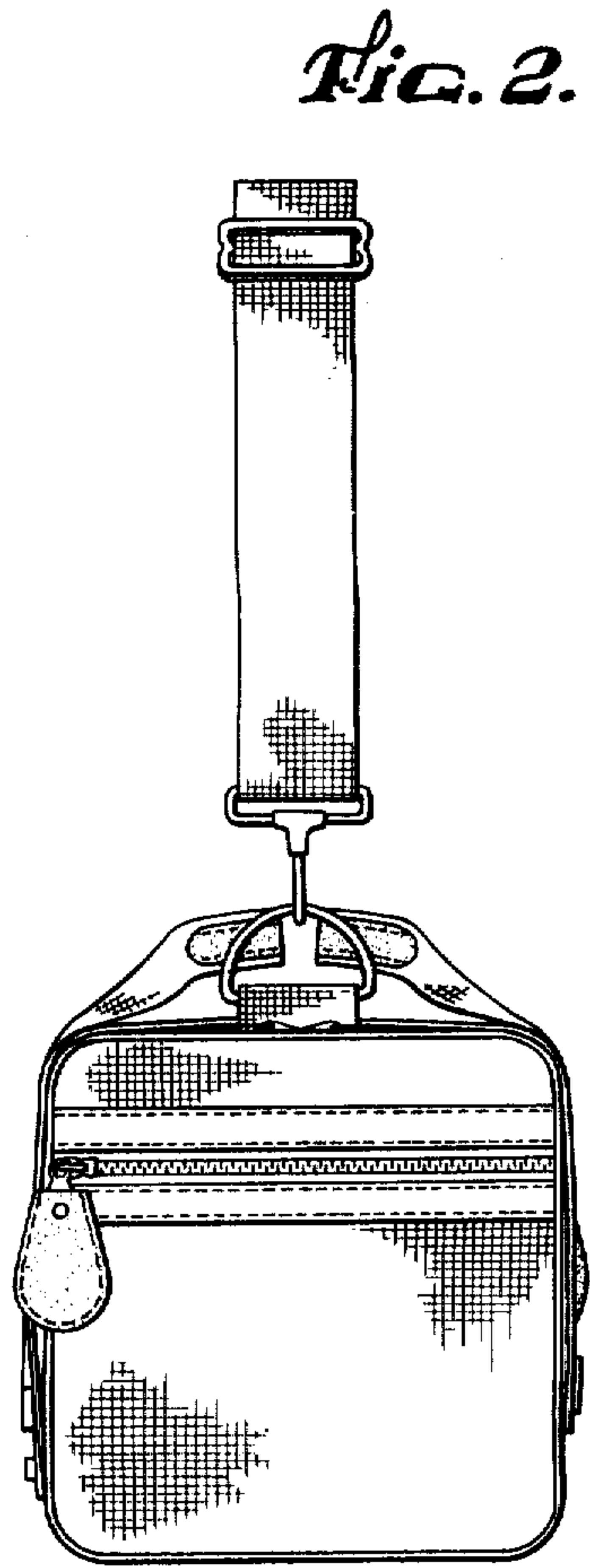

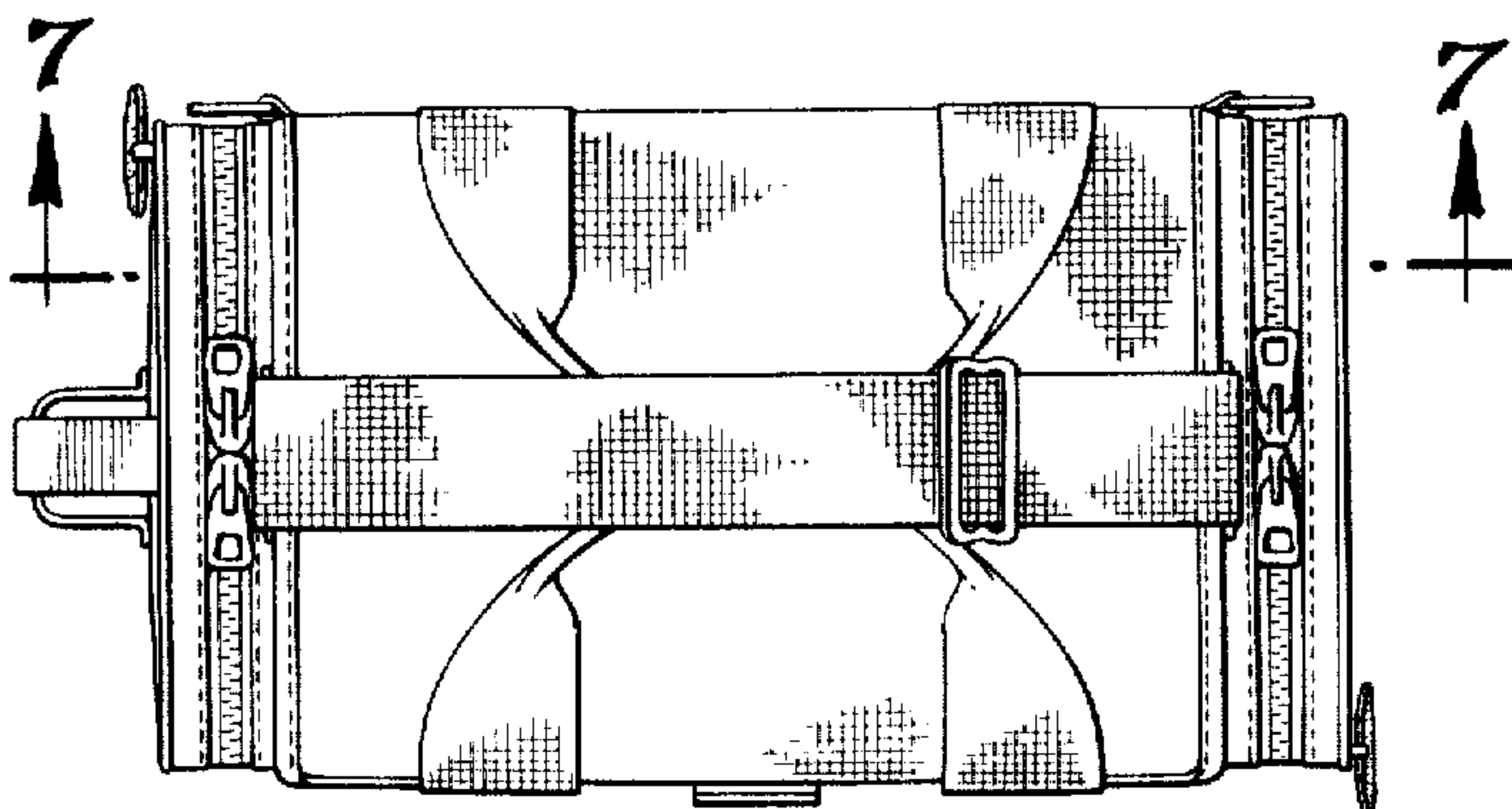

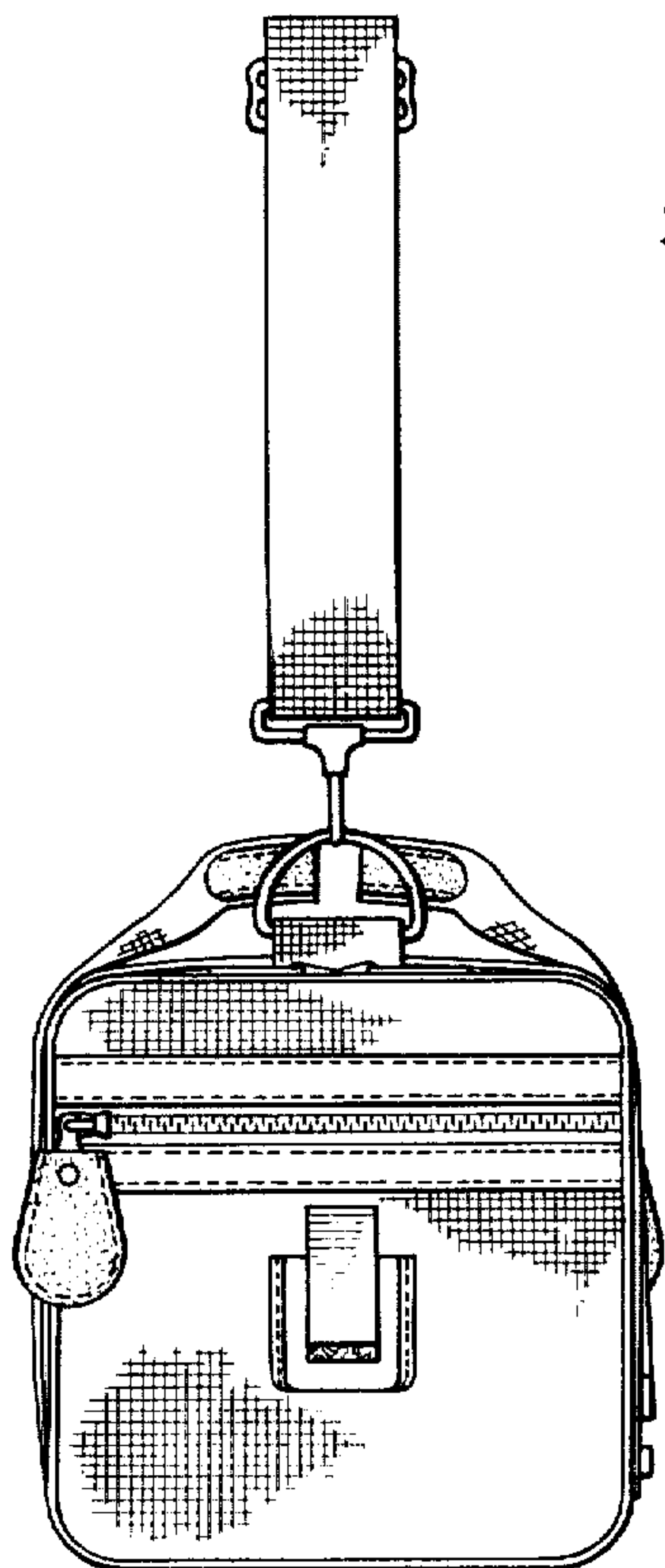

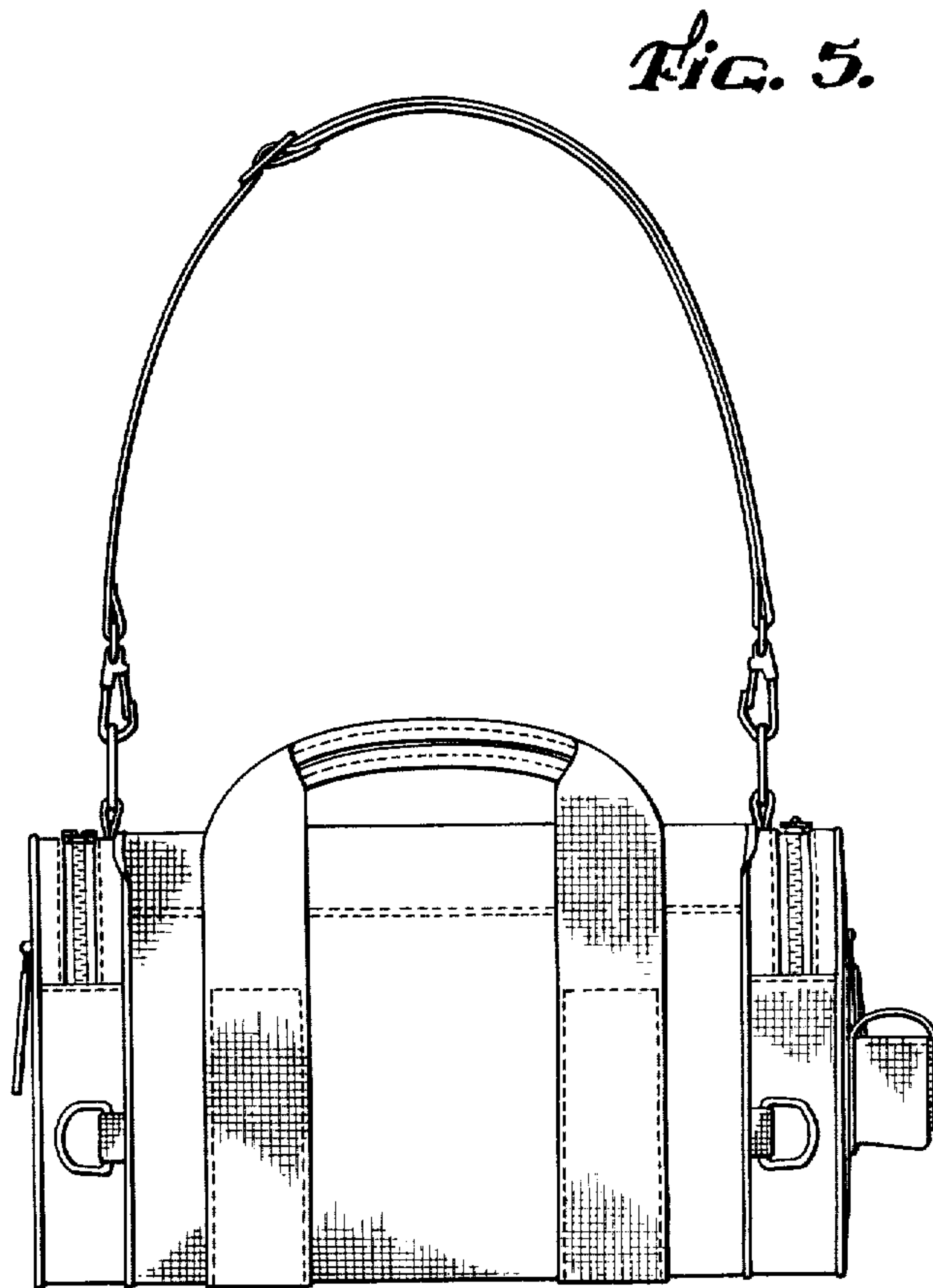

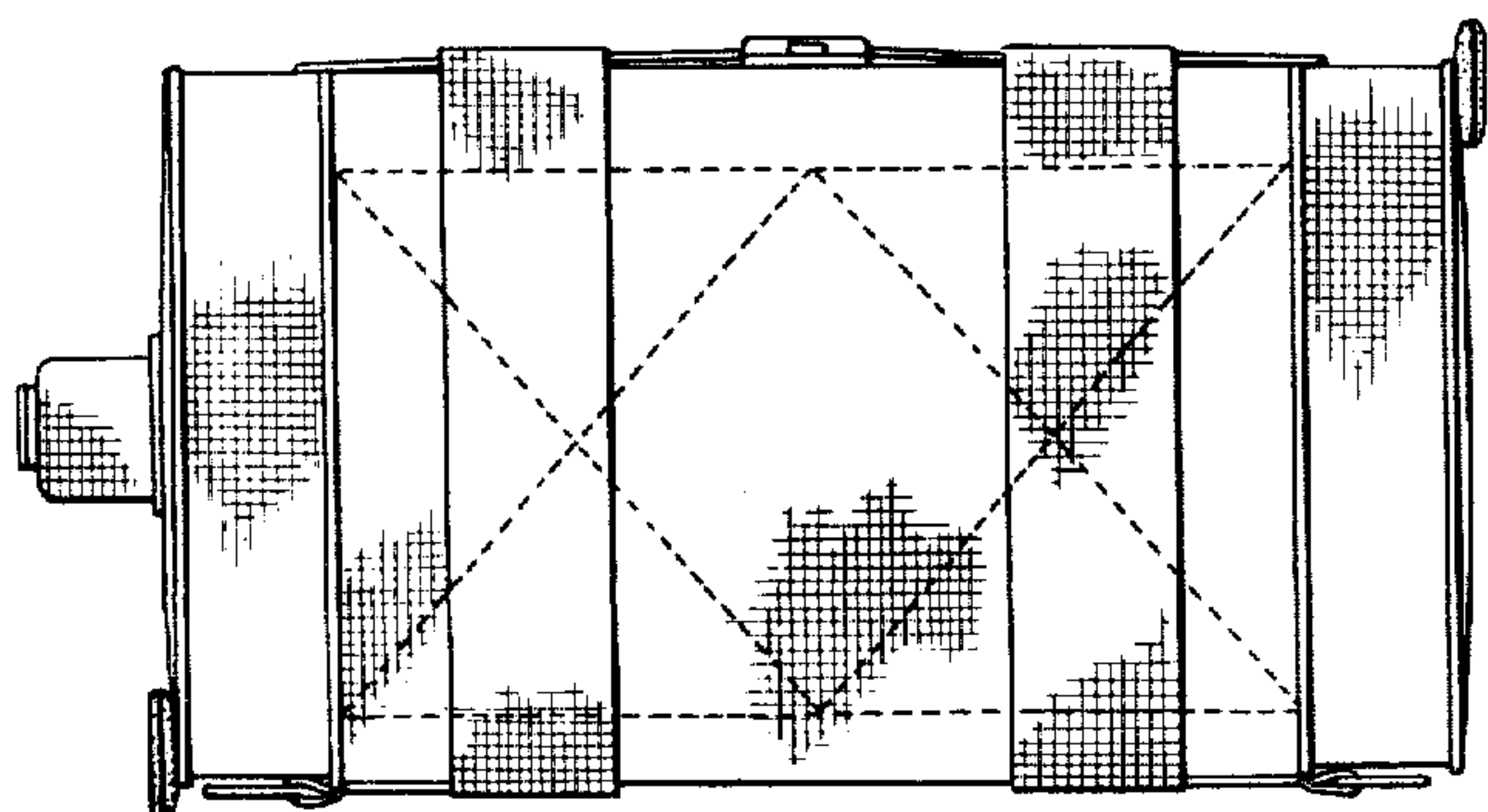

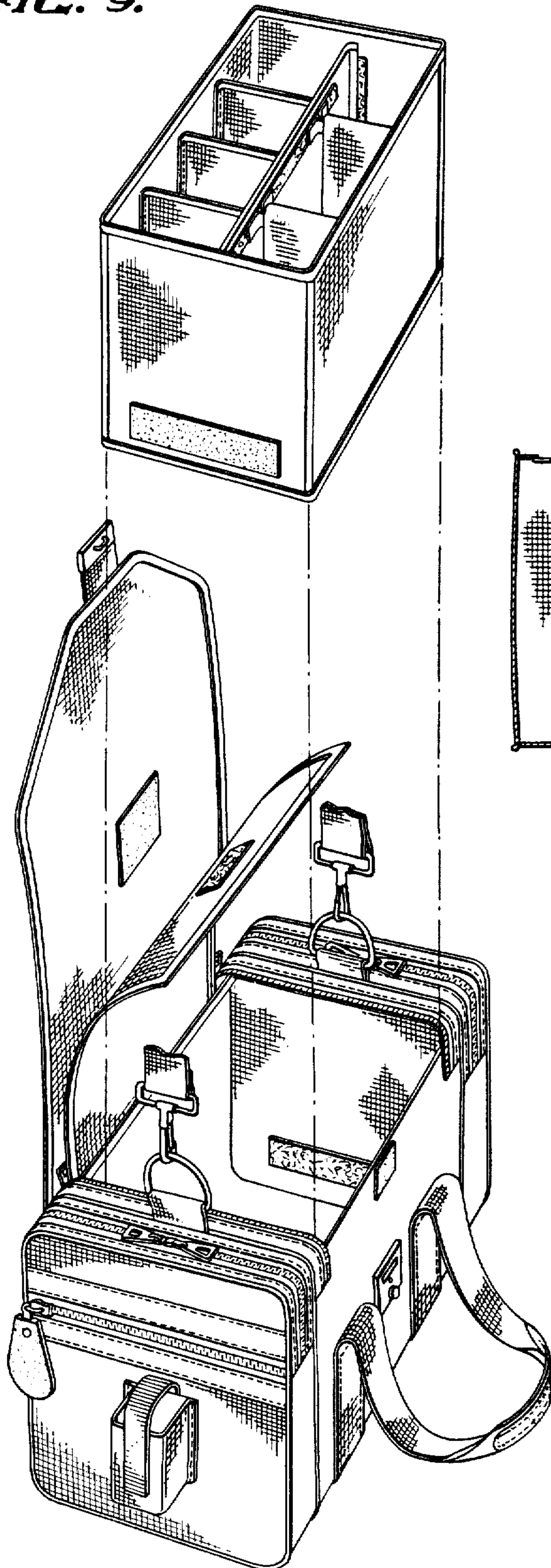

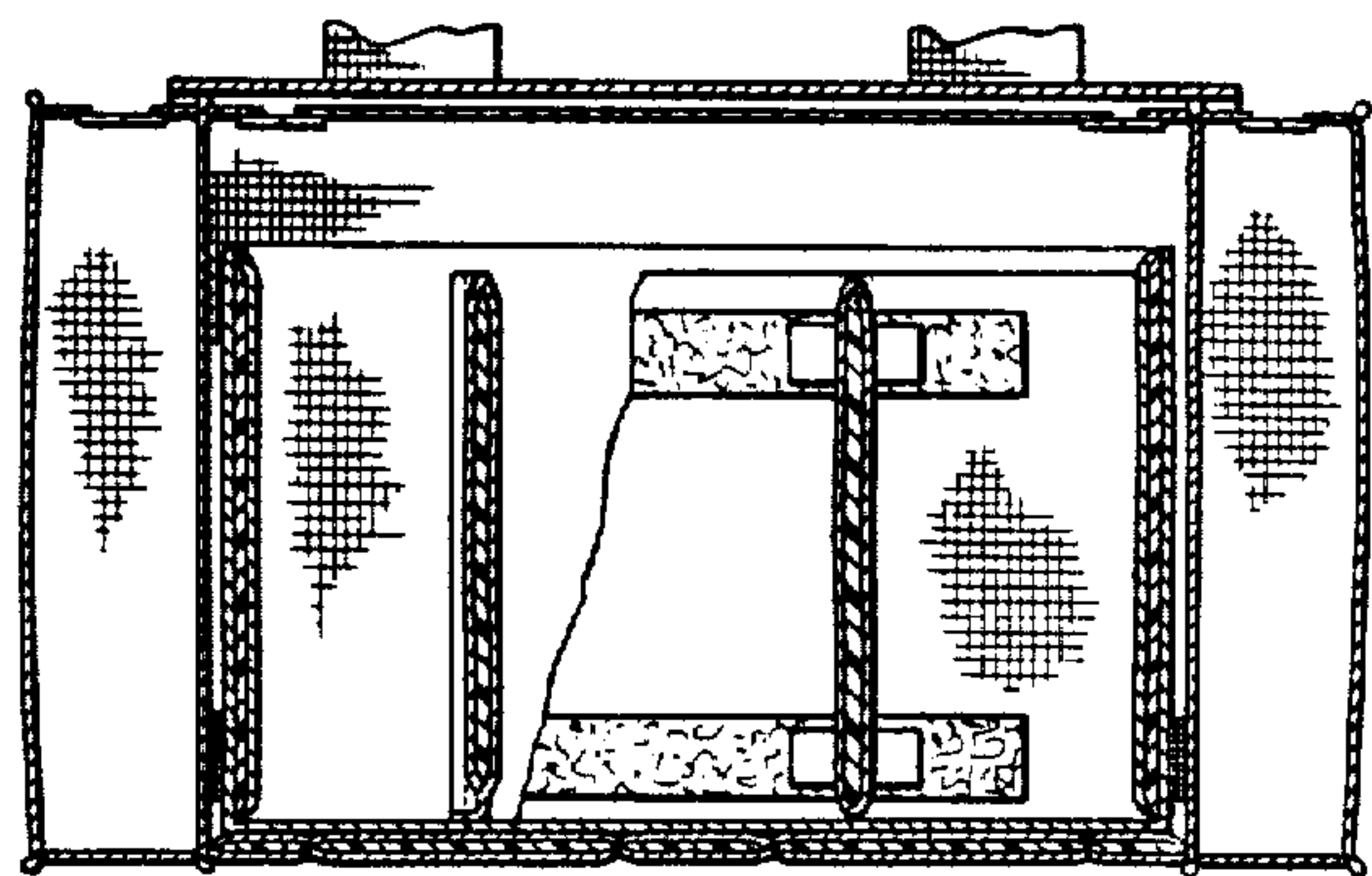
