The ornamental design for a microwave espresso coffee maker, as shown and described.

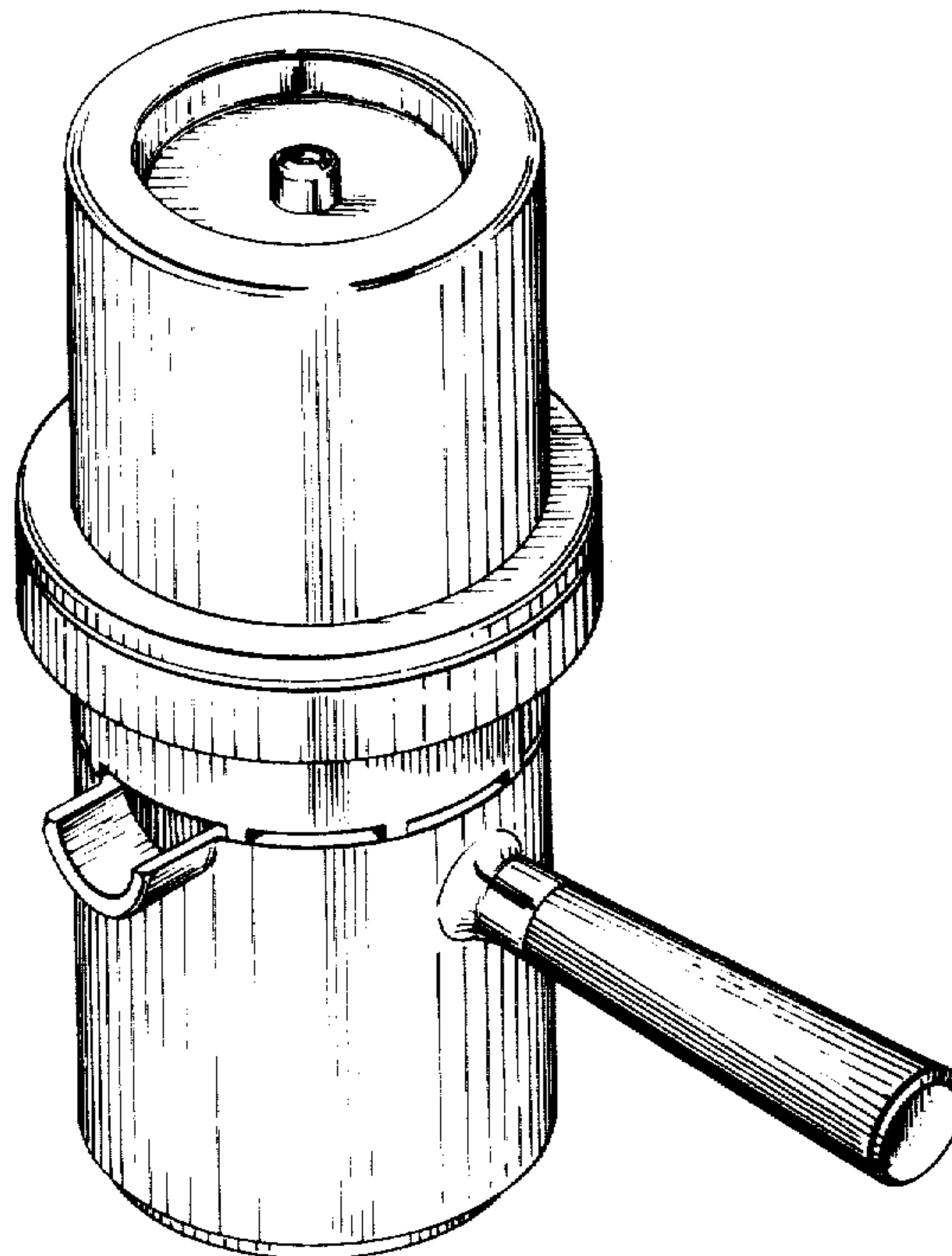
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a microwave espresso coffee maker showing one side of our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view is similar thereto with the spout omitted; and

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The side opposite that shown in FIG. 1 is a mirror image thereof with the handle omitted.



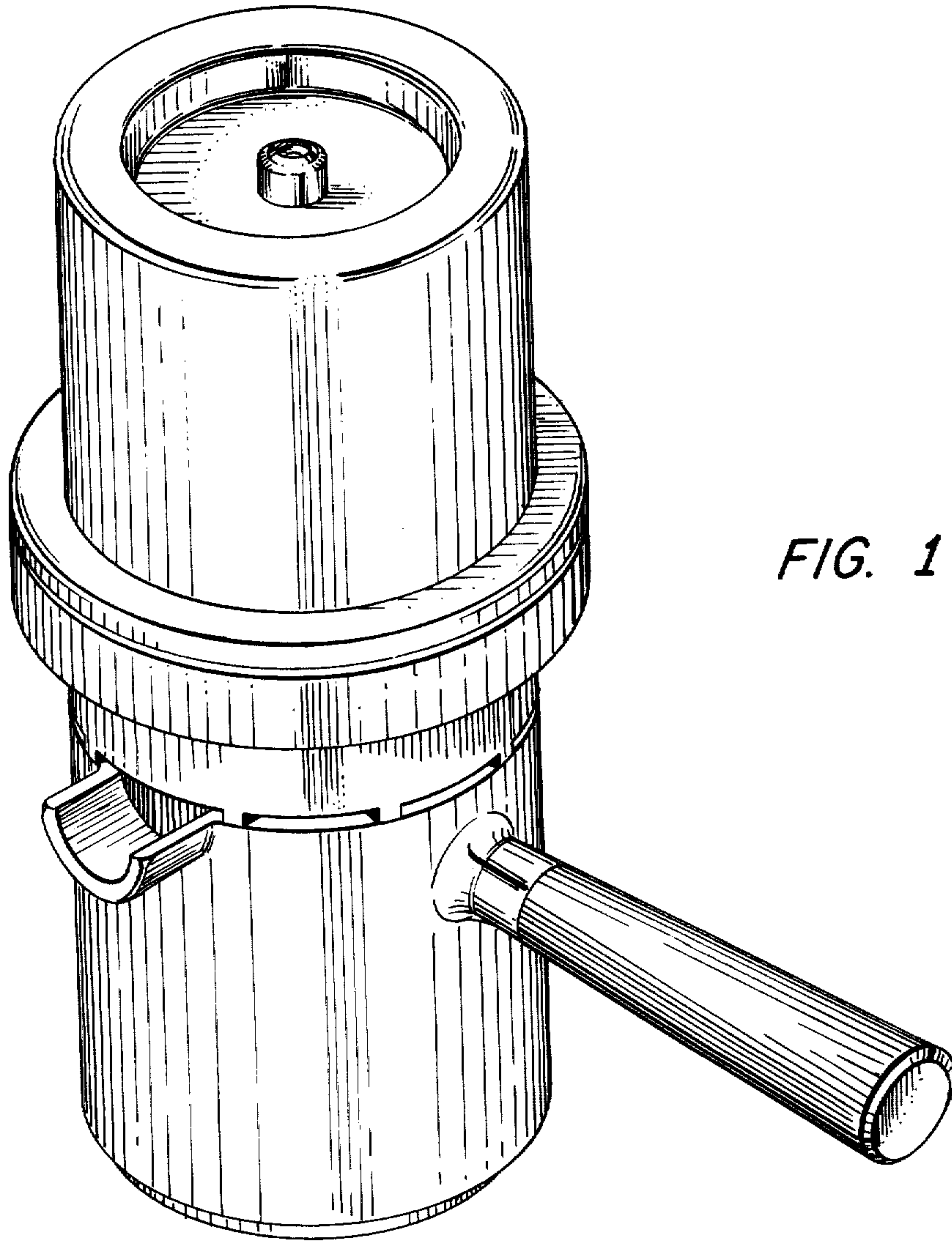

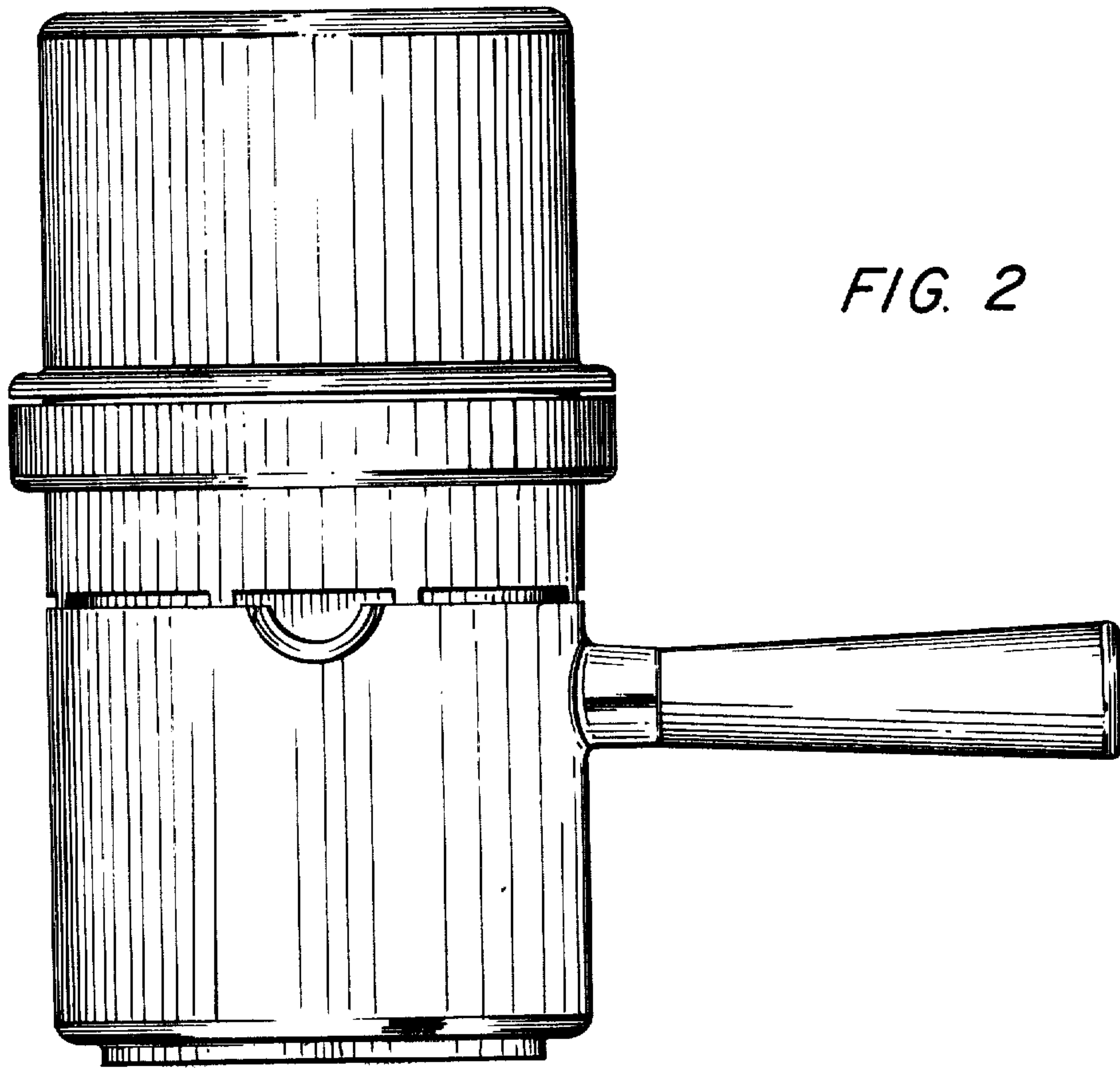

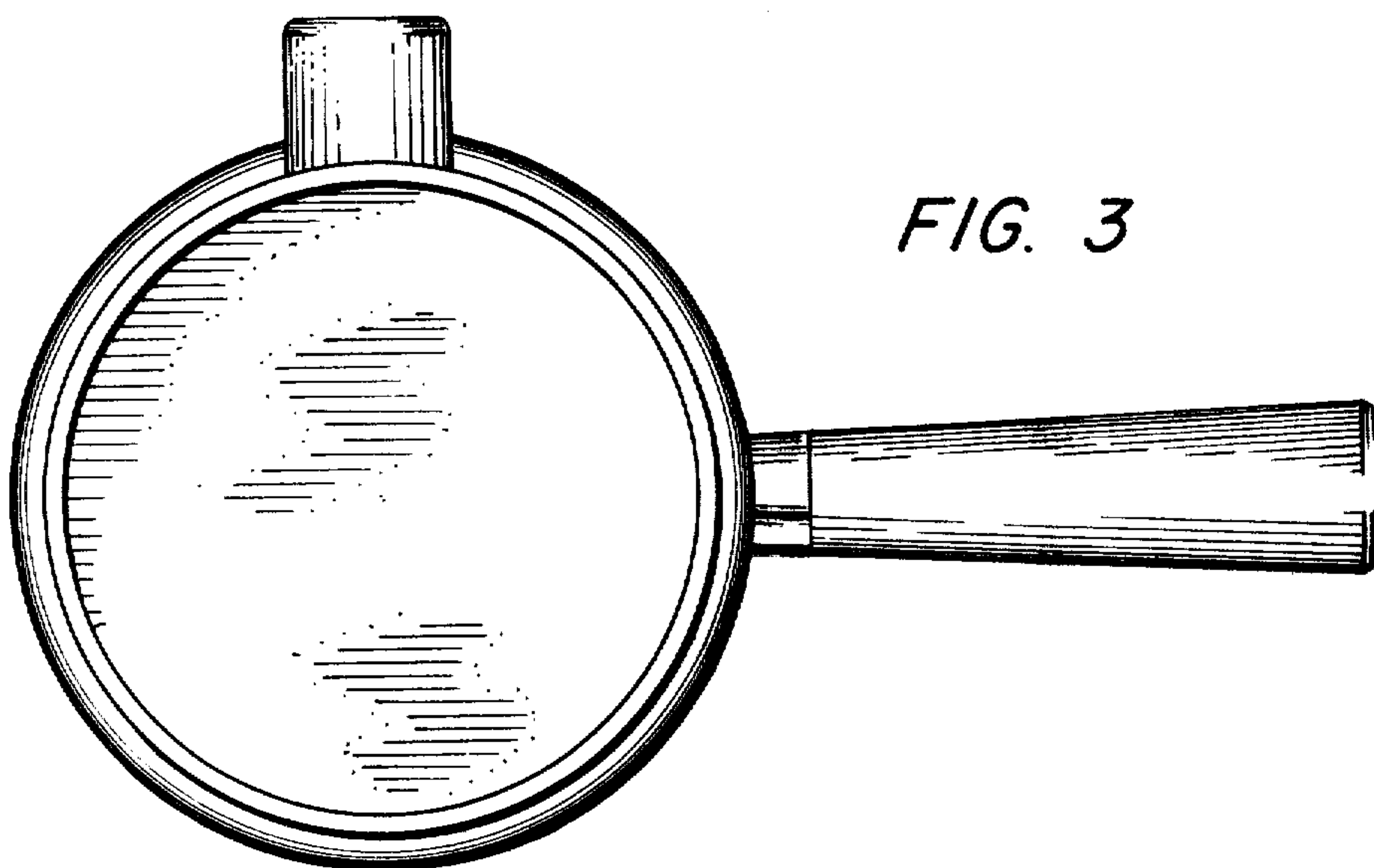
