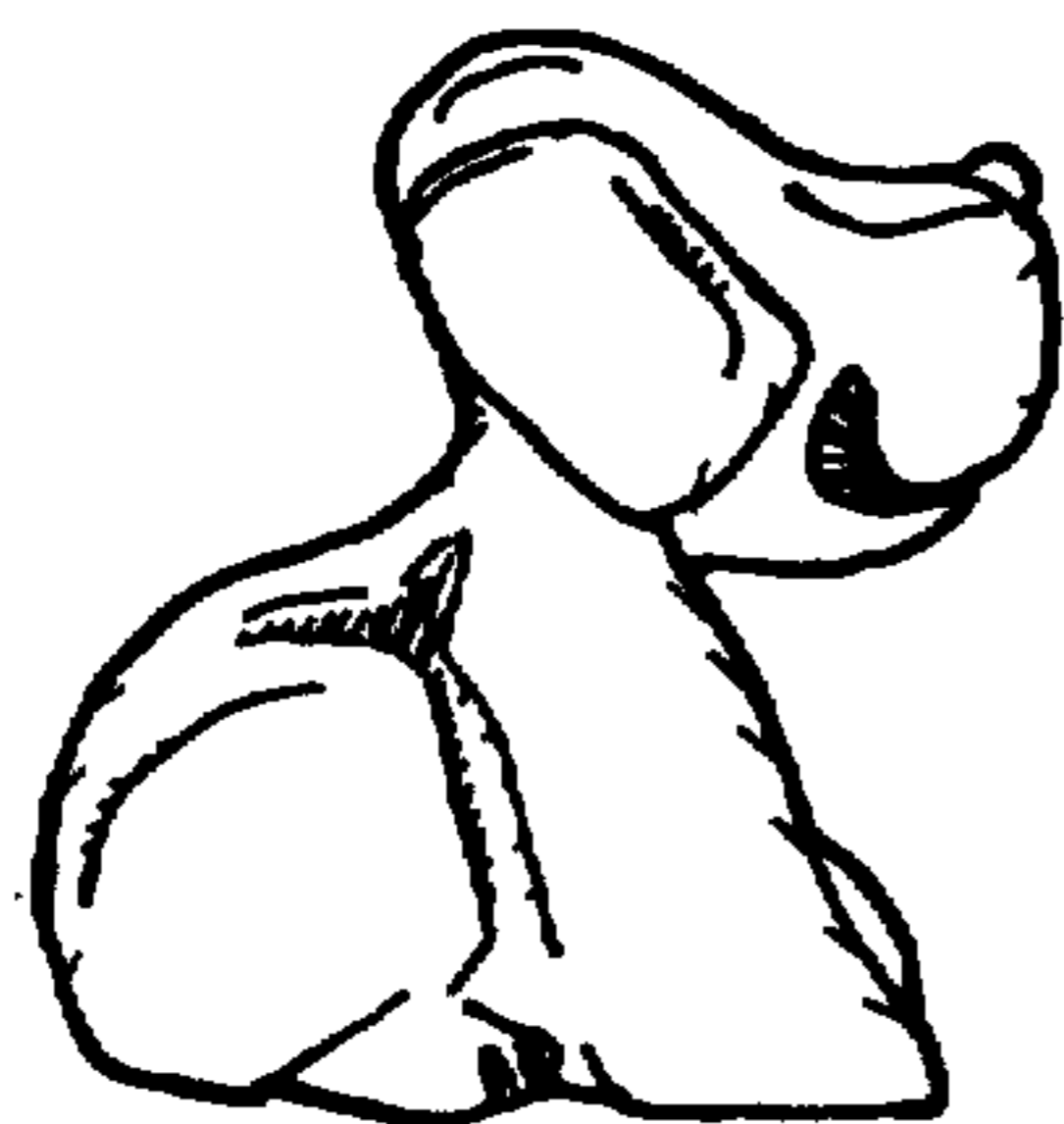

DESCRIPTION

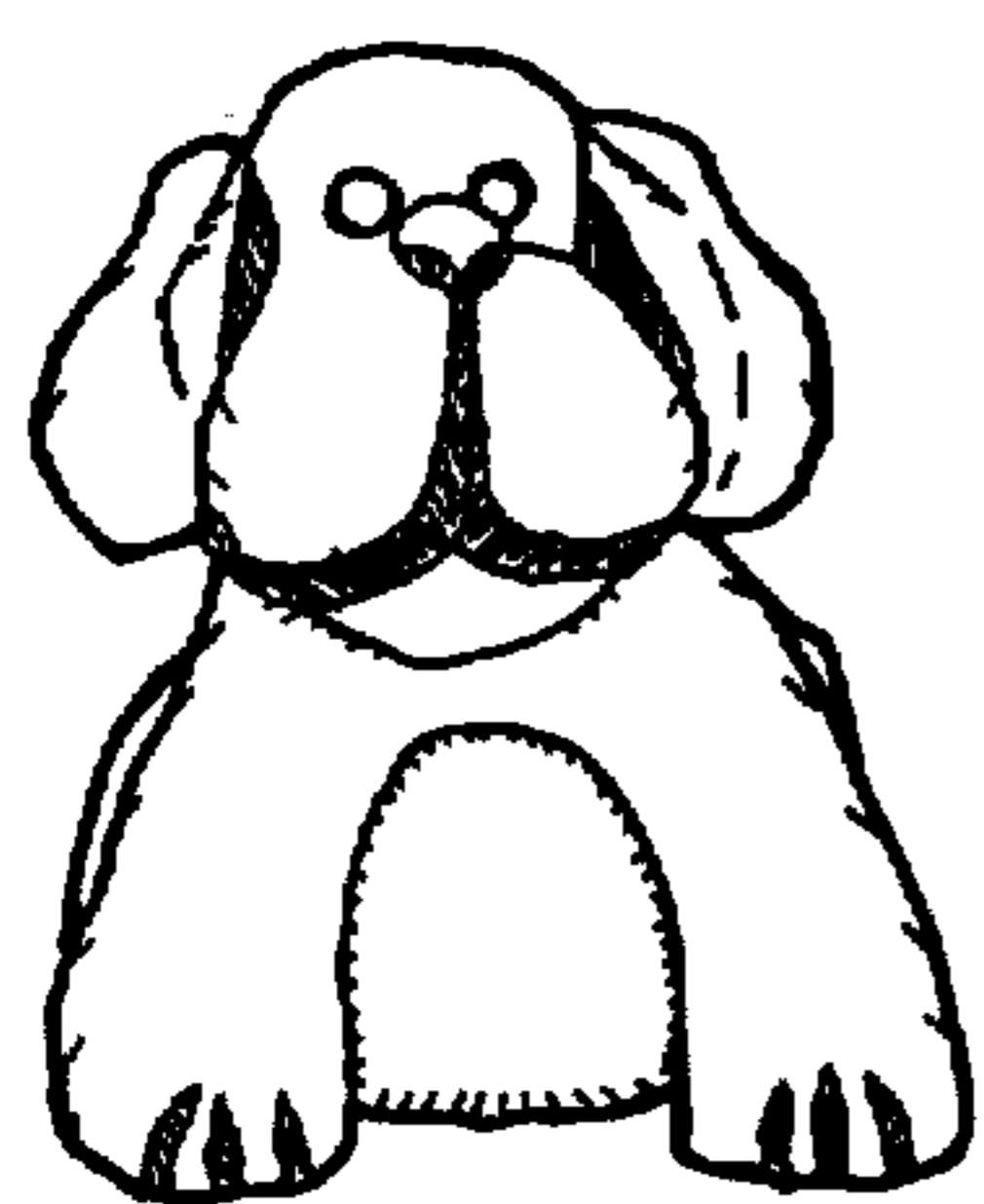

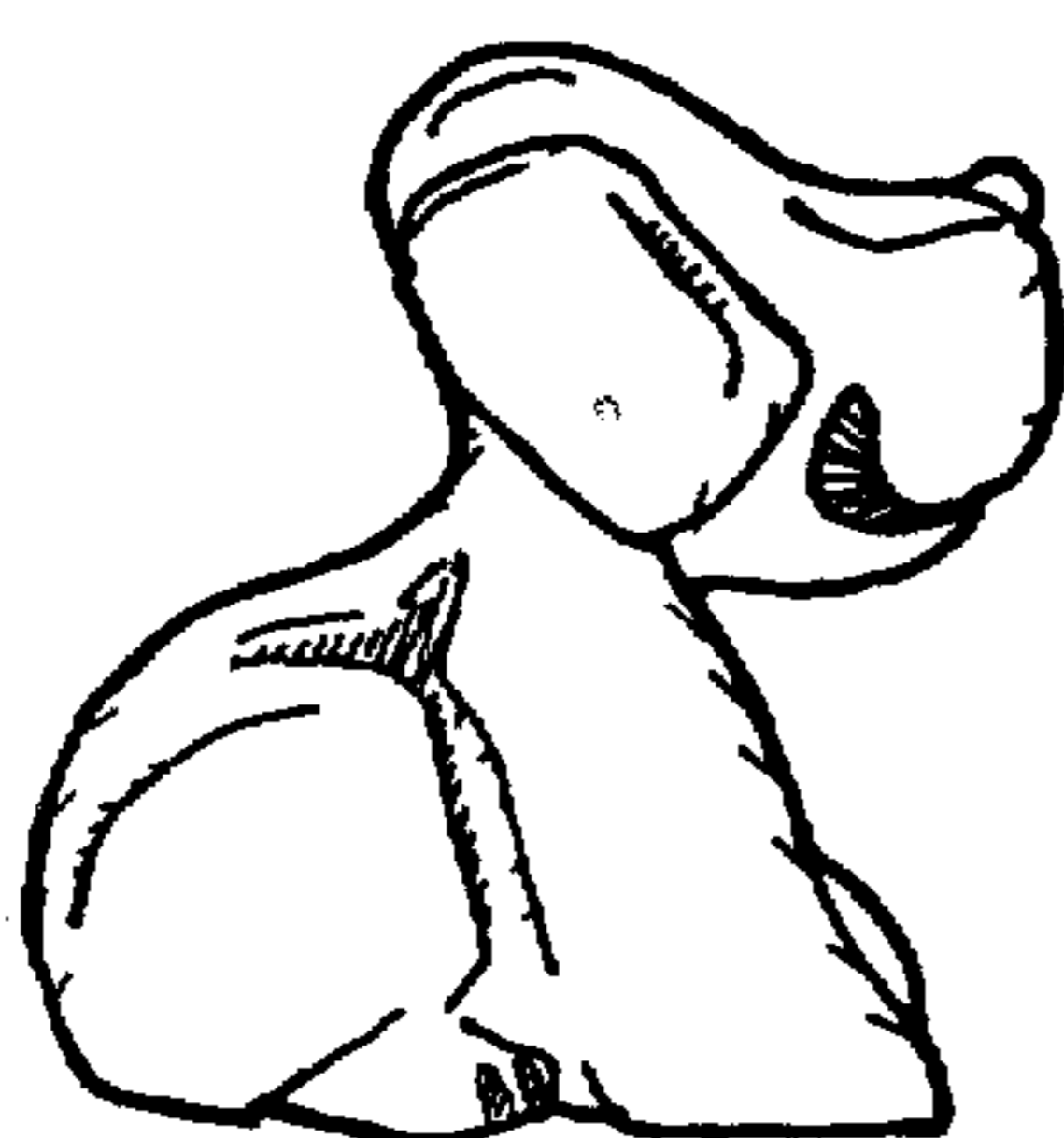
