[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a golf grip, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the golf club grip showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view taken from the left side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side view of the golf grip taken from the right side of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear view of the golf grip showing our new design;
FIG. 5 is a top view of the golf grip of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the golf grip of FIG. 1.

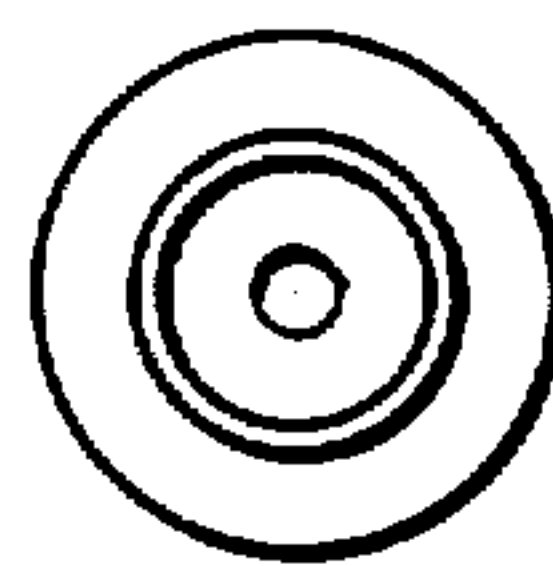
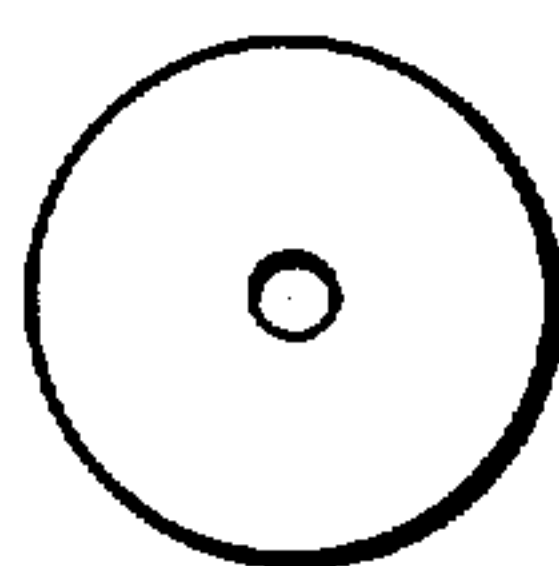

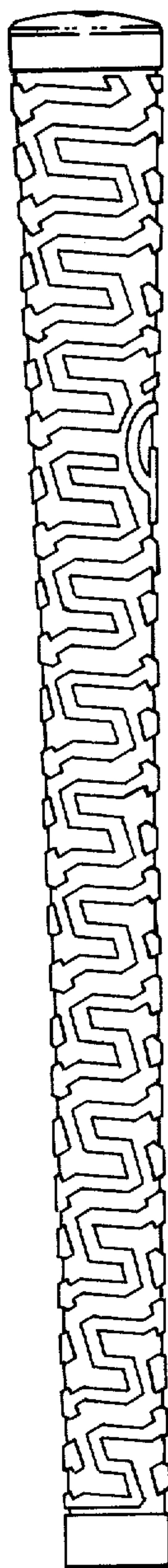

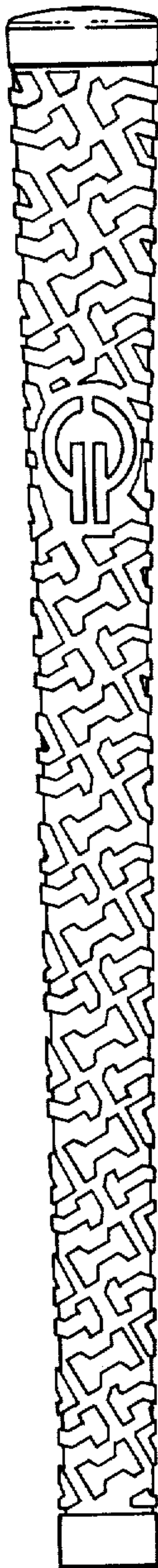

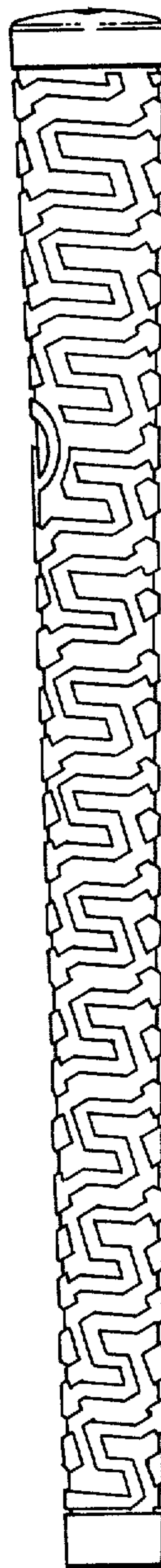
