CLAIM [57]

The ornamental design for an inflatable, swimming cap, or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side perspective view of an inflatable swimming cap, or similar article showing my new design; the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view of a portion of the band of the cap, taken along the line 3-3 of FIG. 1; and FIG. 4 is a partial front elevational view of the strap member of the cap.
