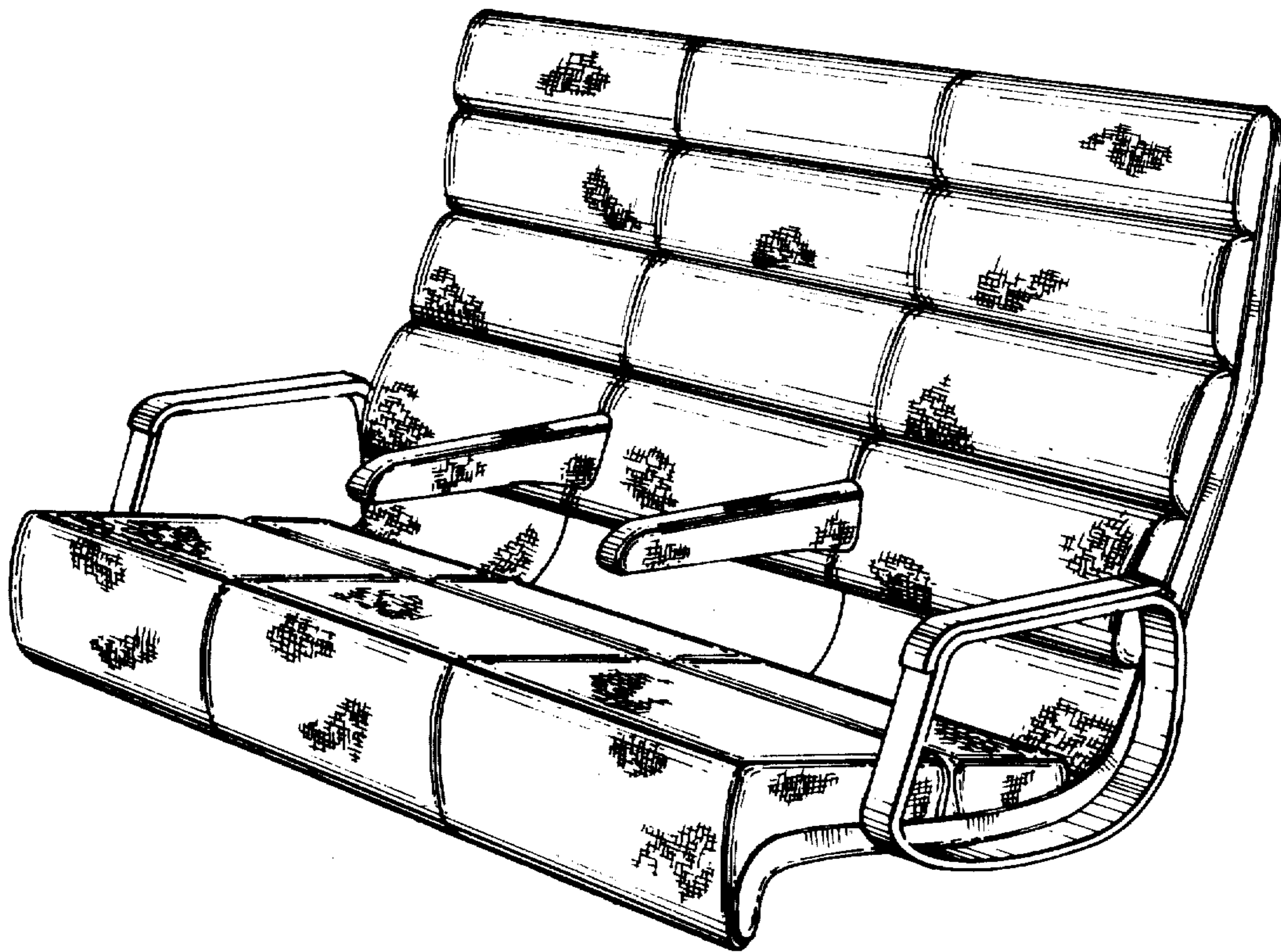

The ornamental design for a vehicle seat or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a vehicle seat or the like embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a modified form thereof.



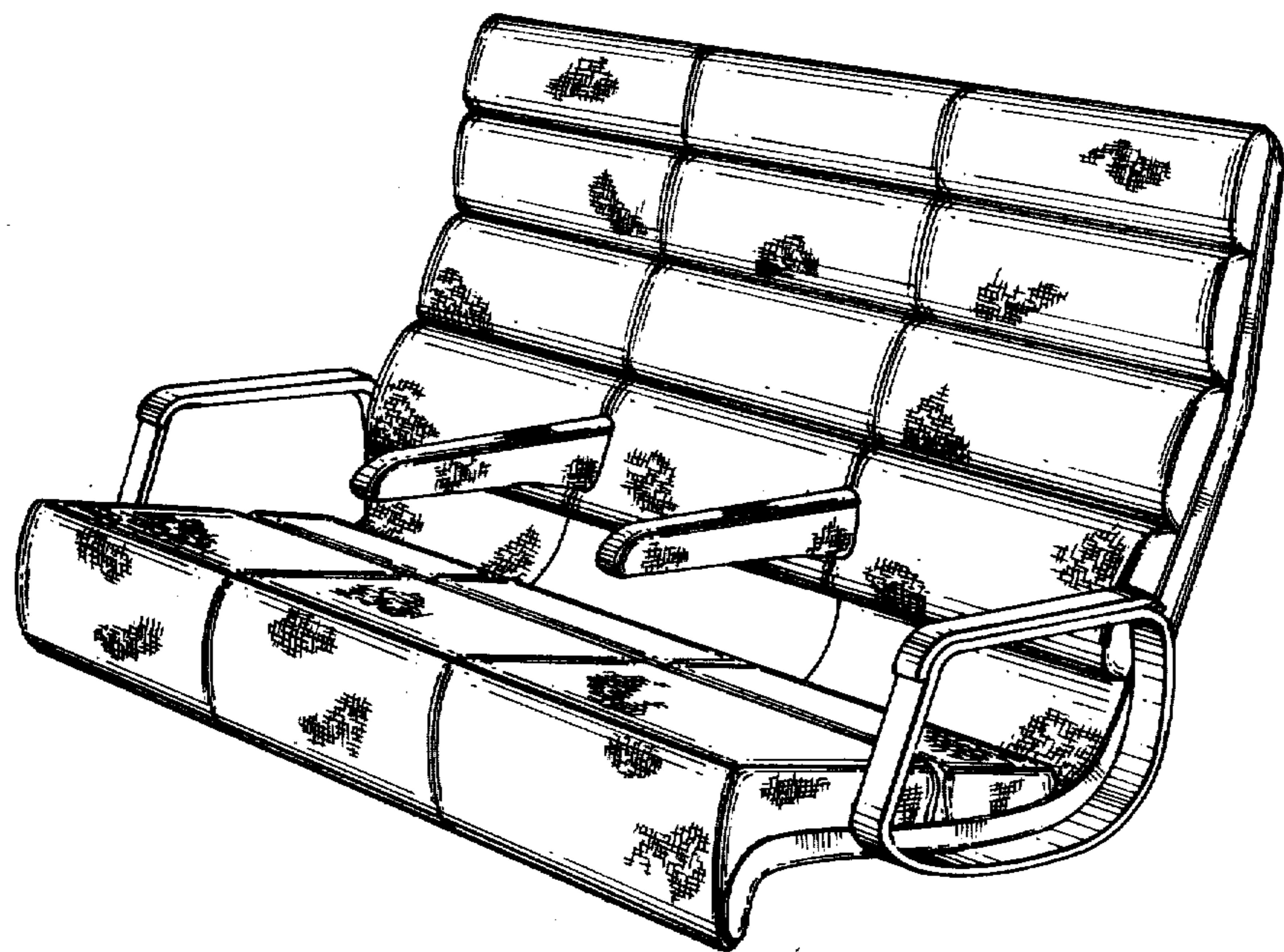

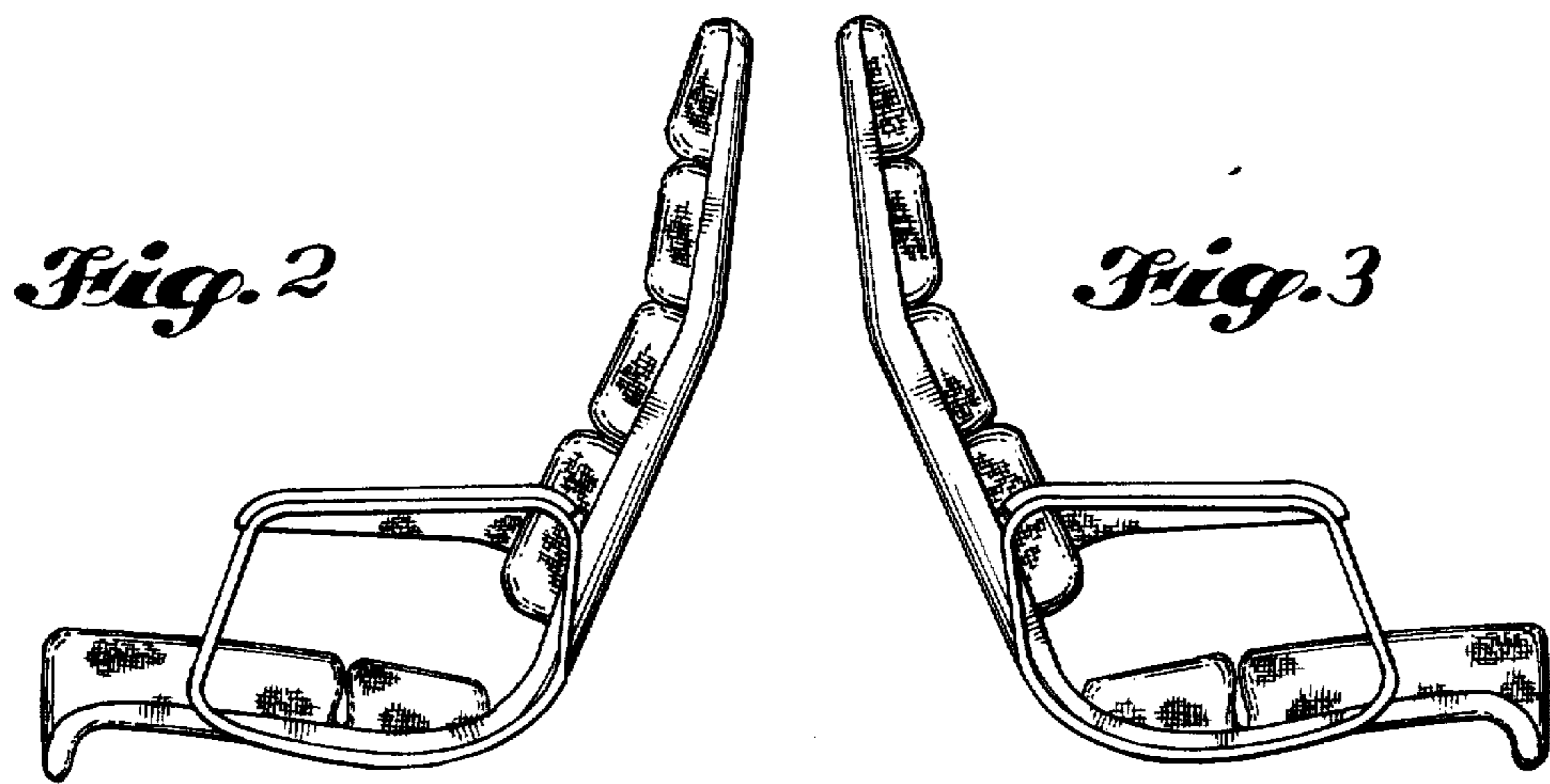

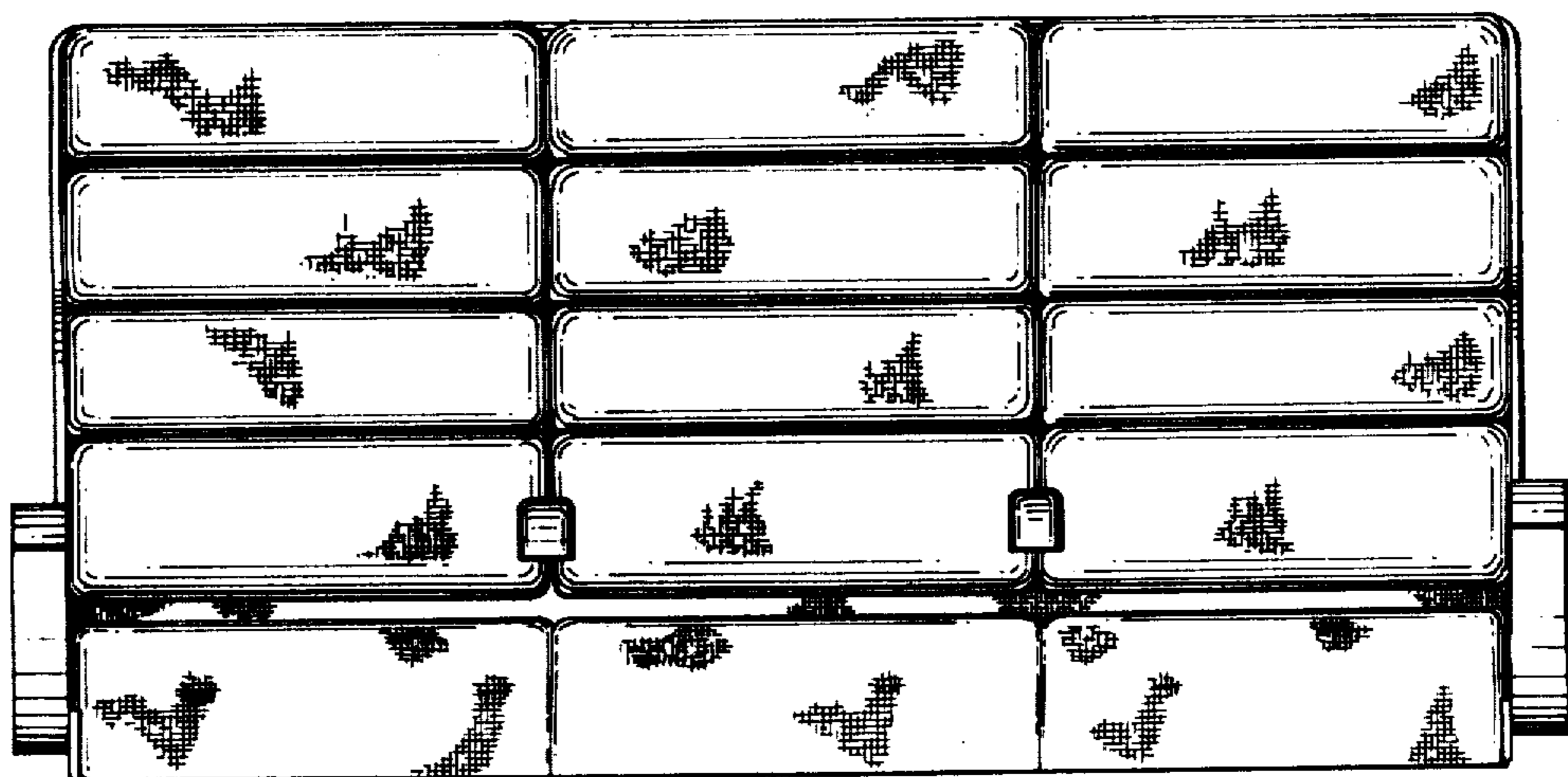

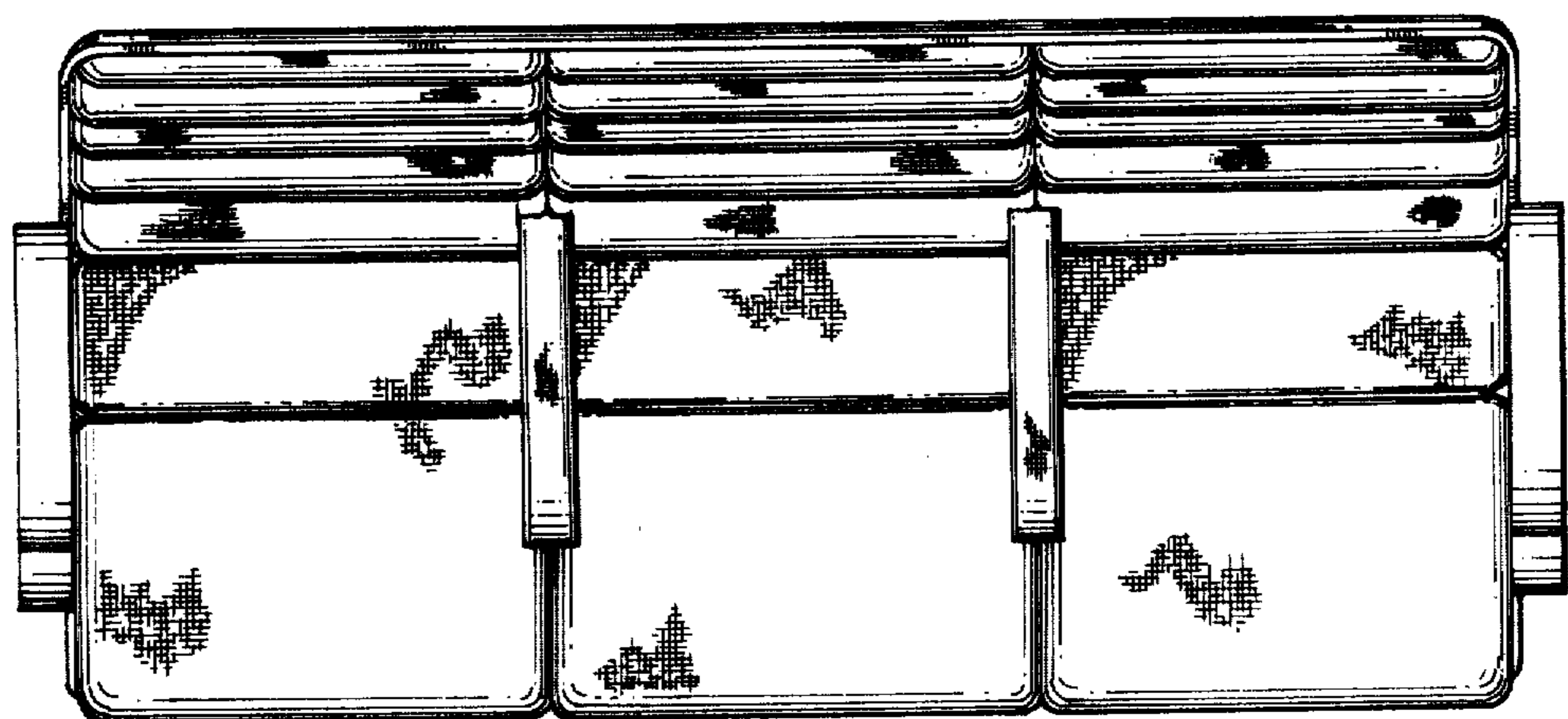

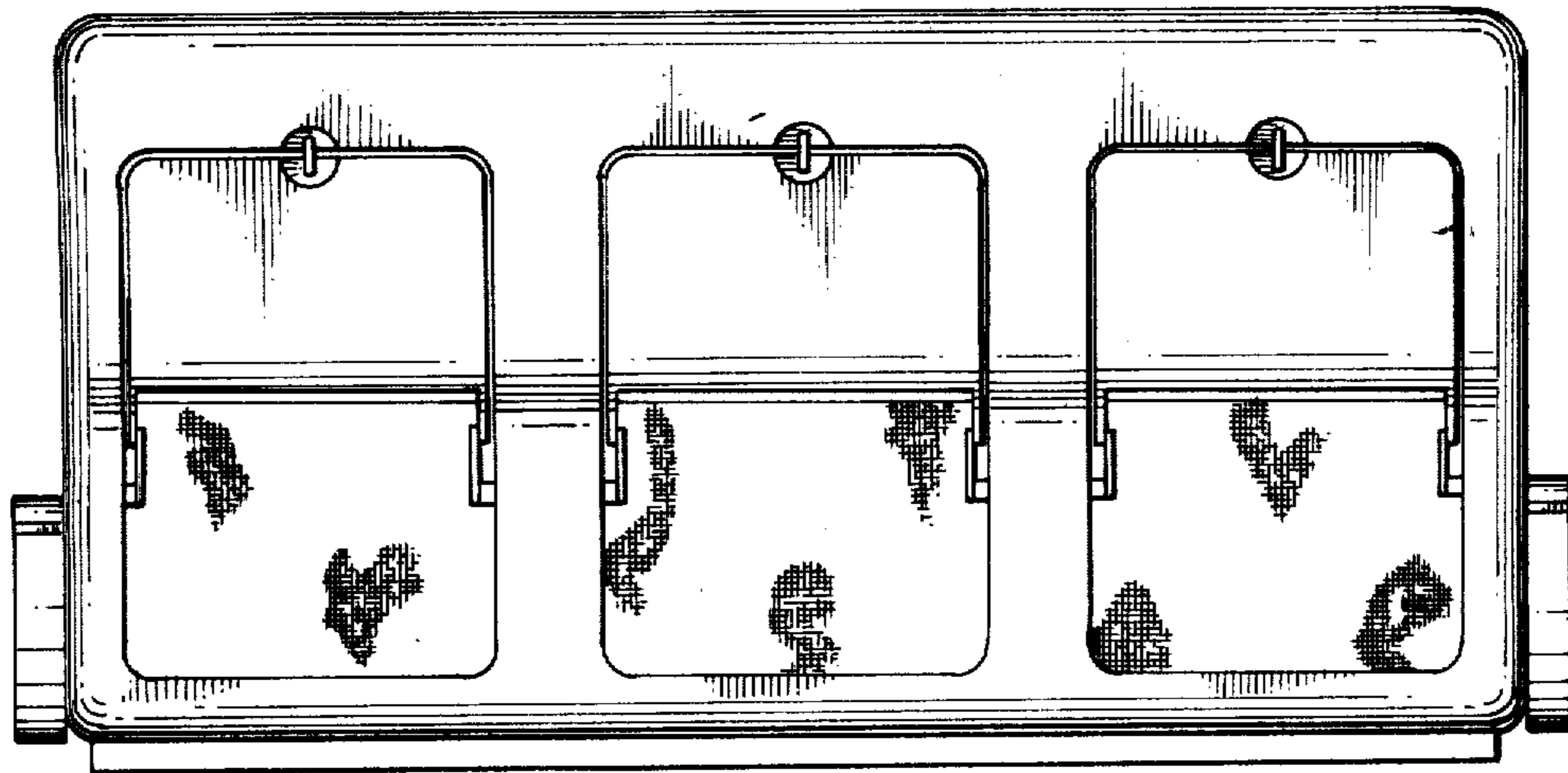

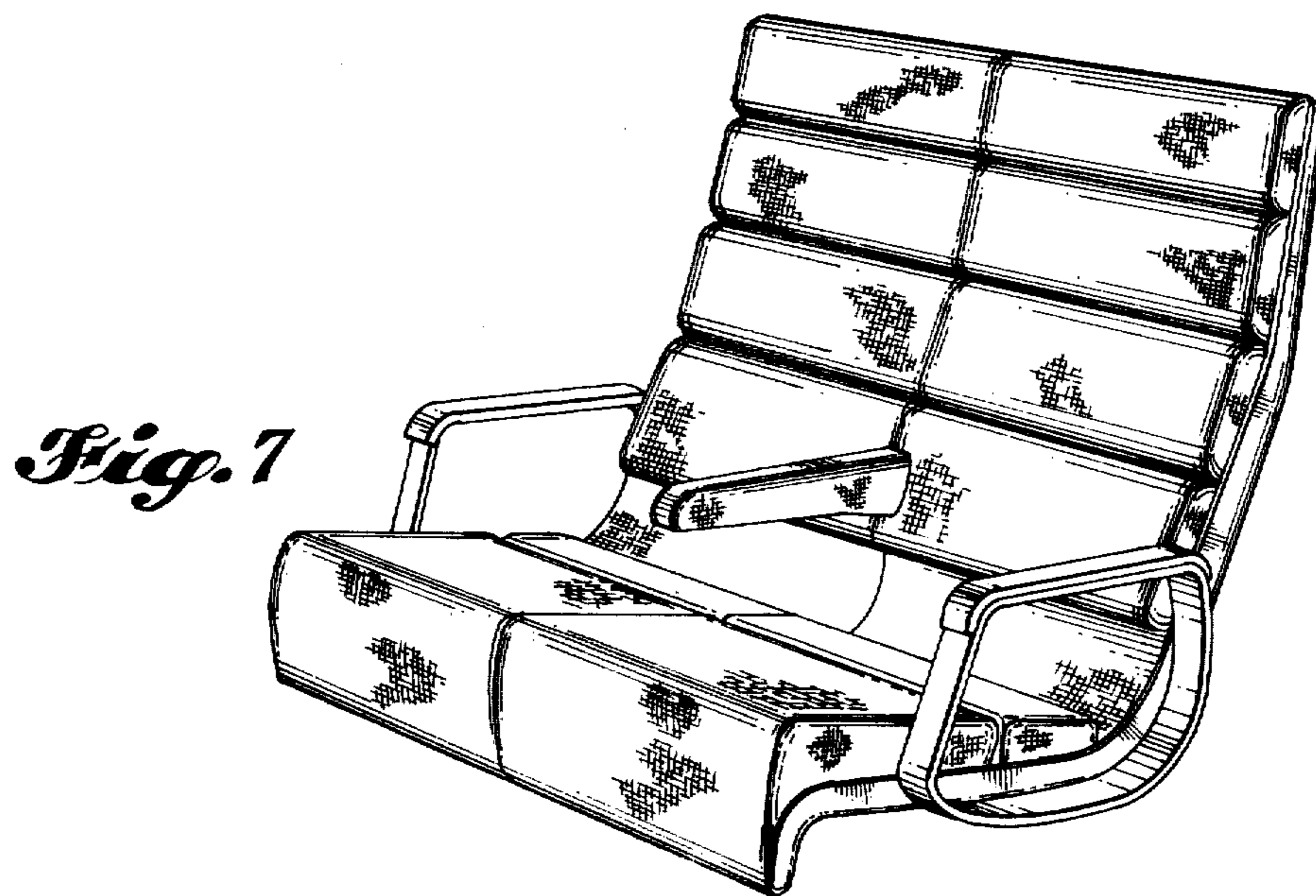
