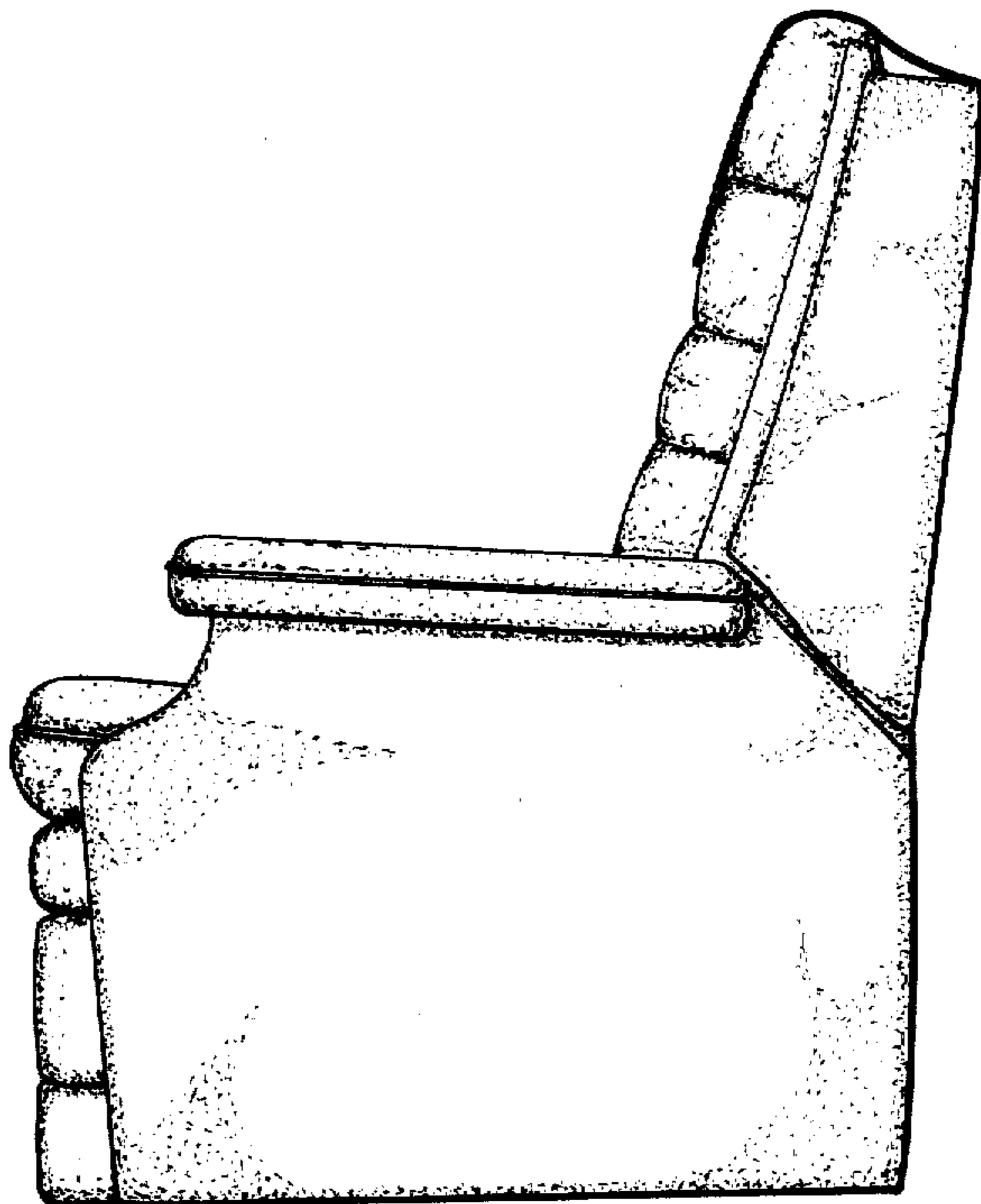

[57] The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a chair, showing my design.  
FIG. 2 is a back view thereof.  
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof.  
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof.  
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.  
The side of the chair not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 4.



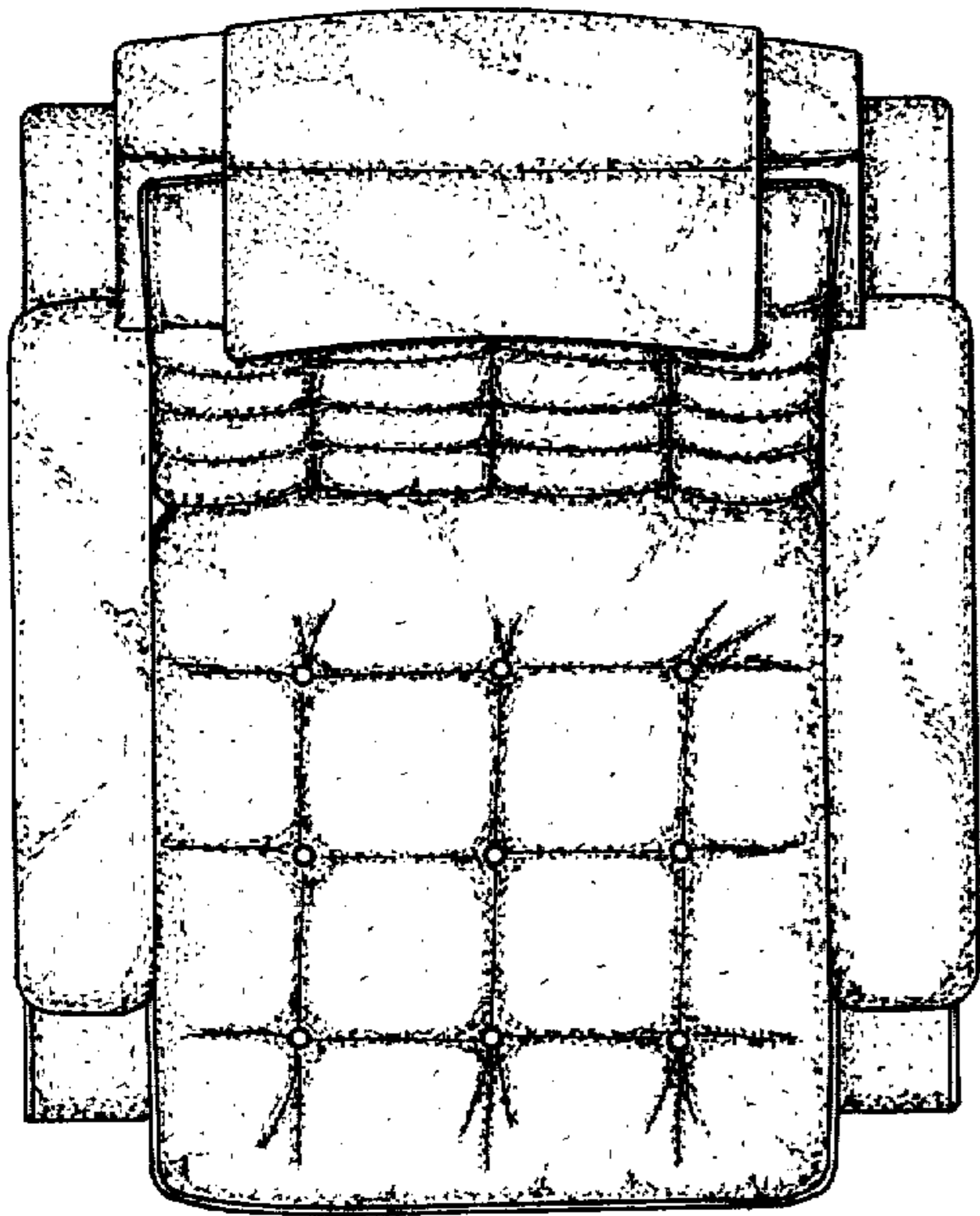

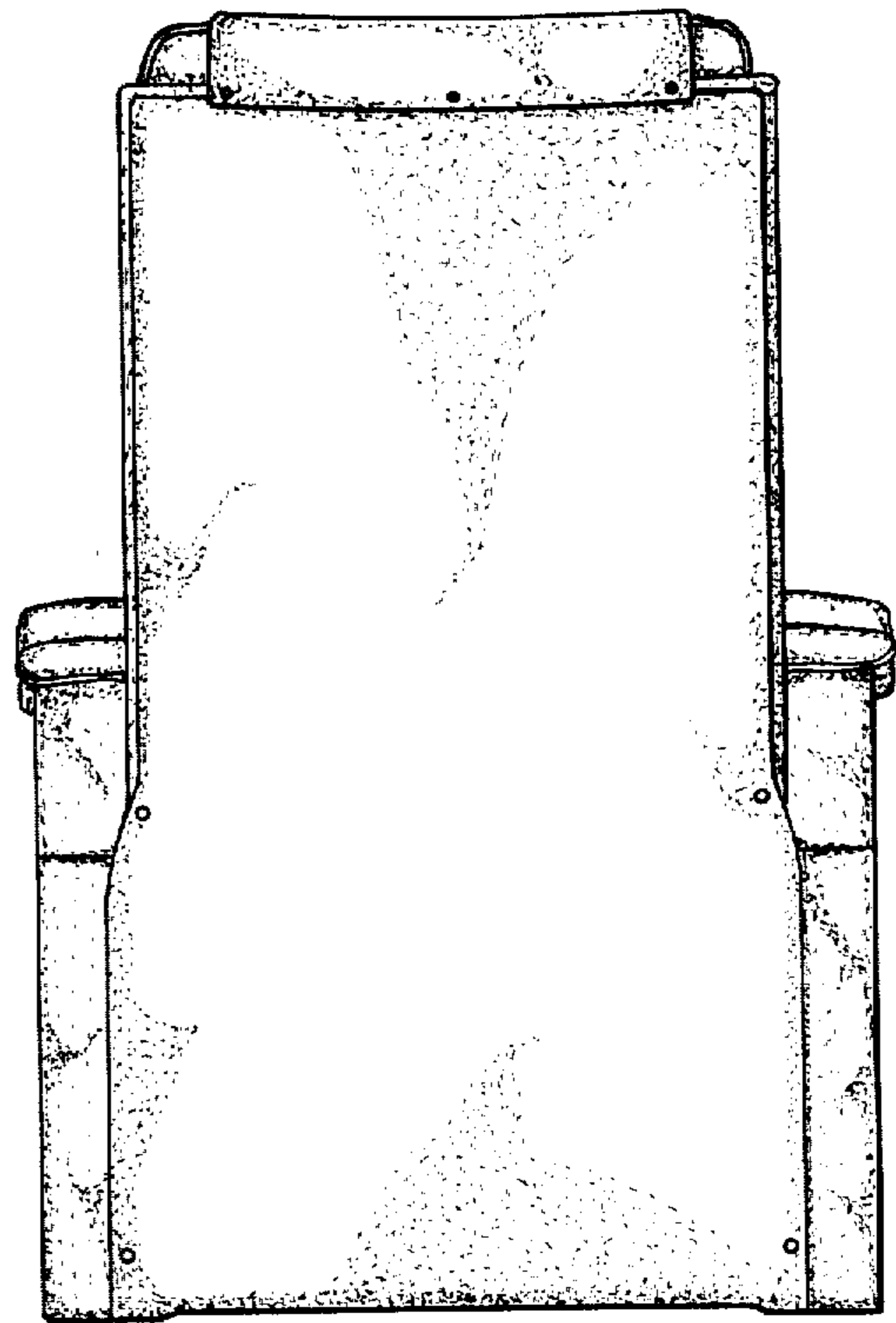

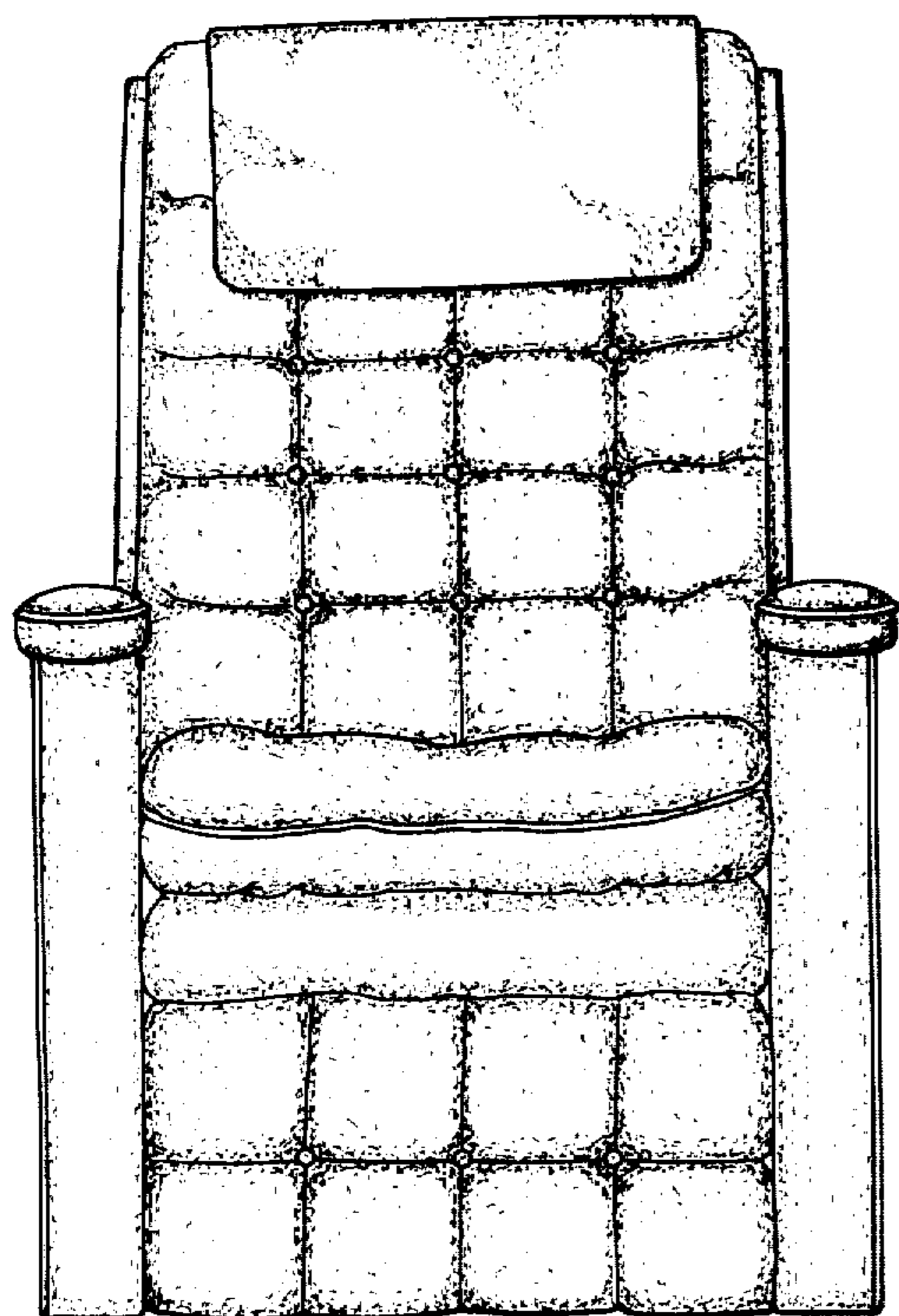

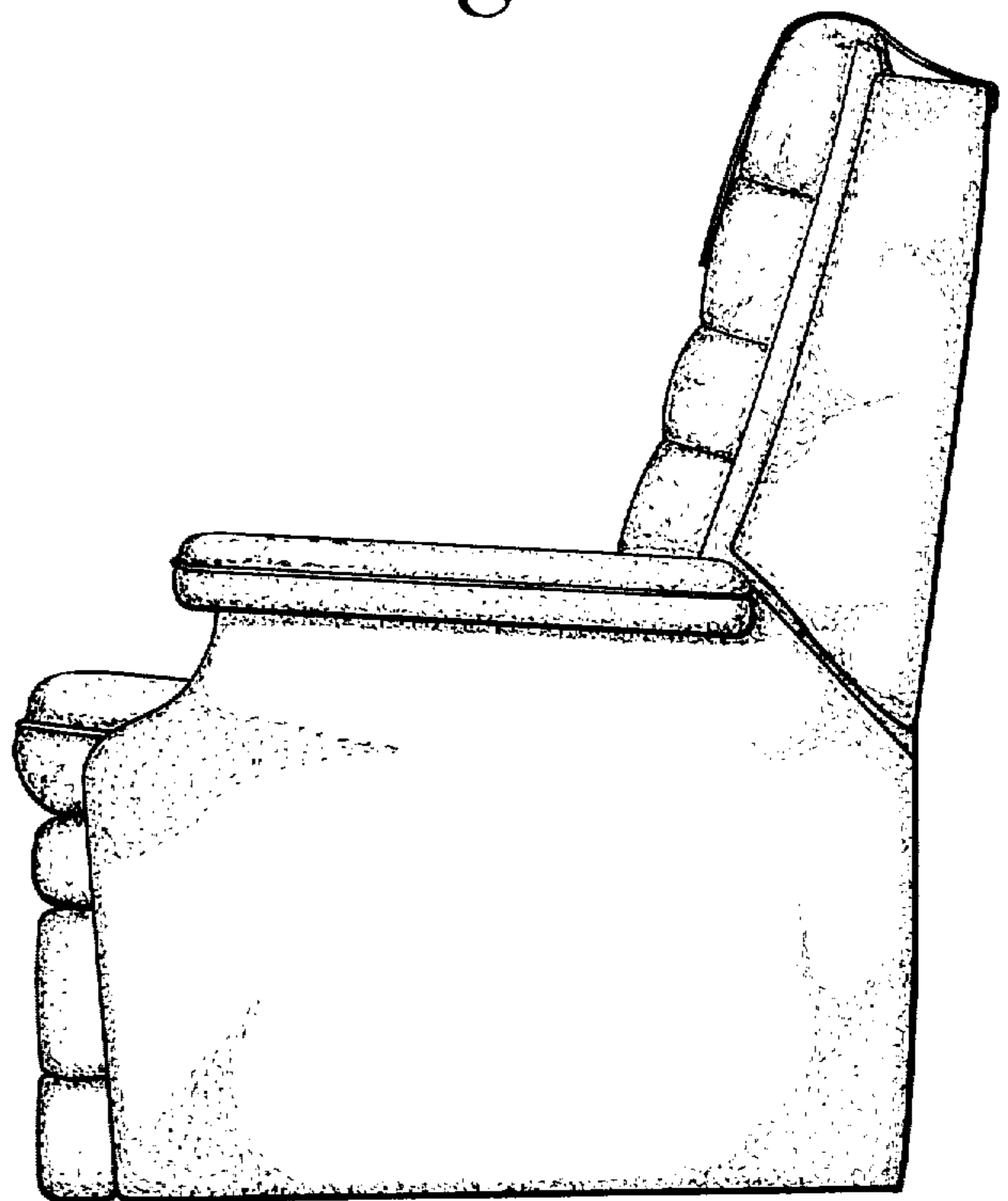

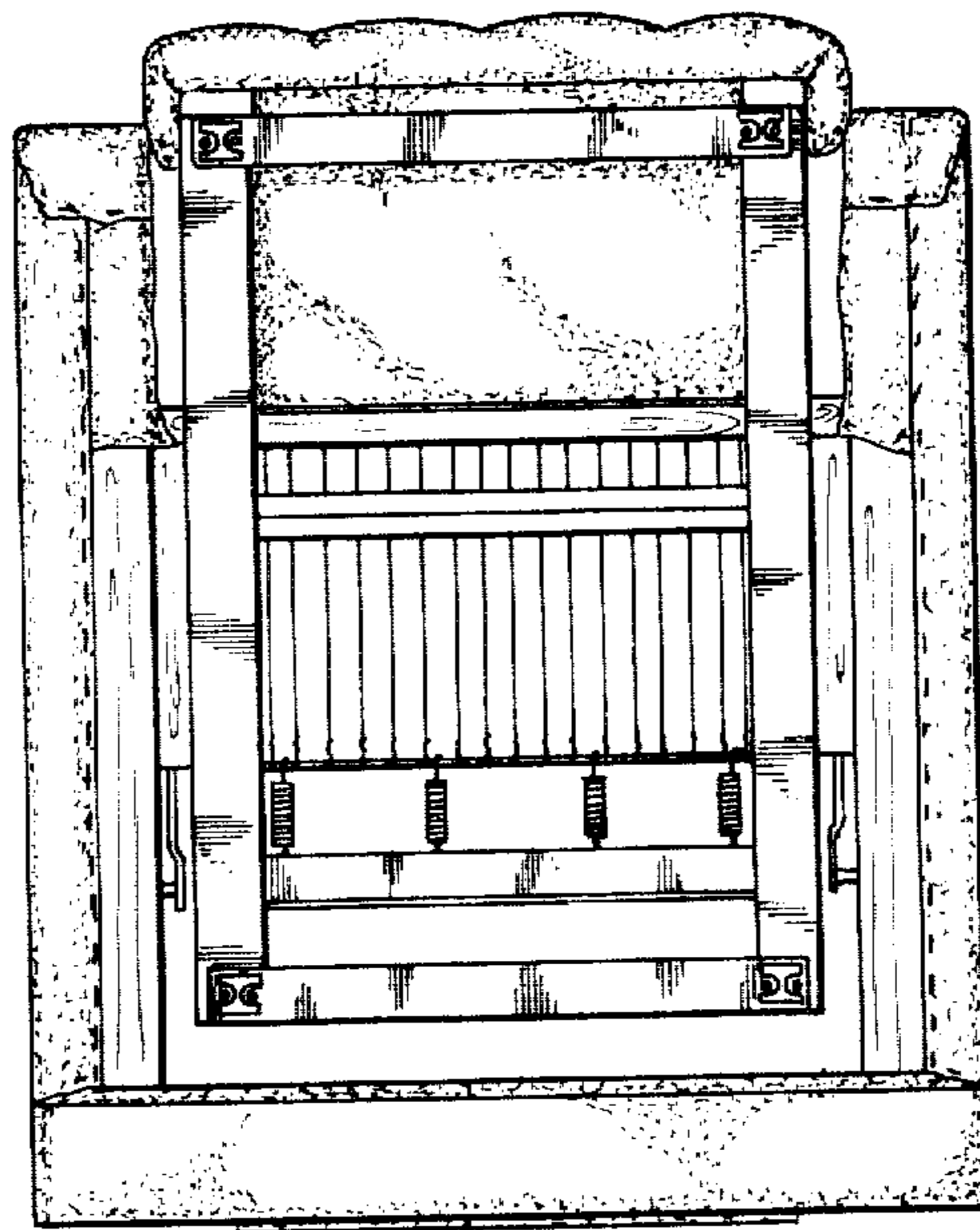
