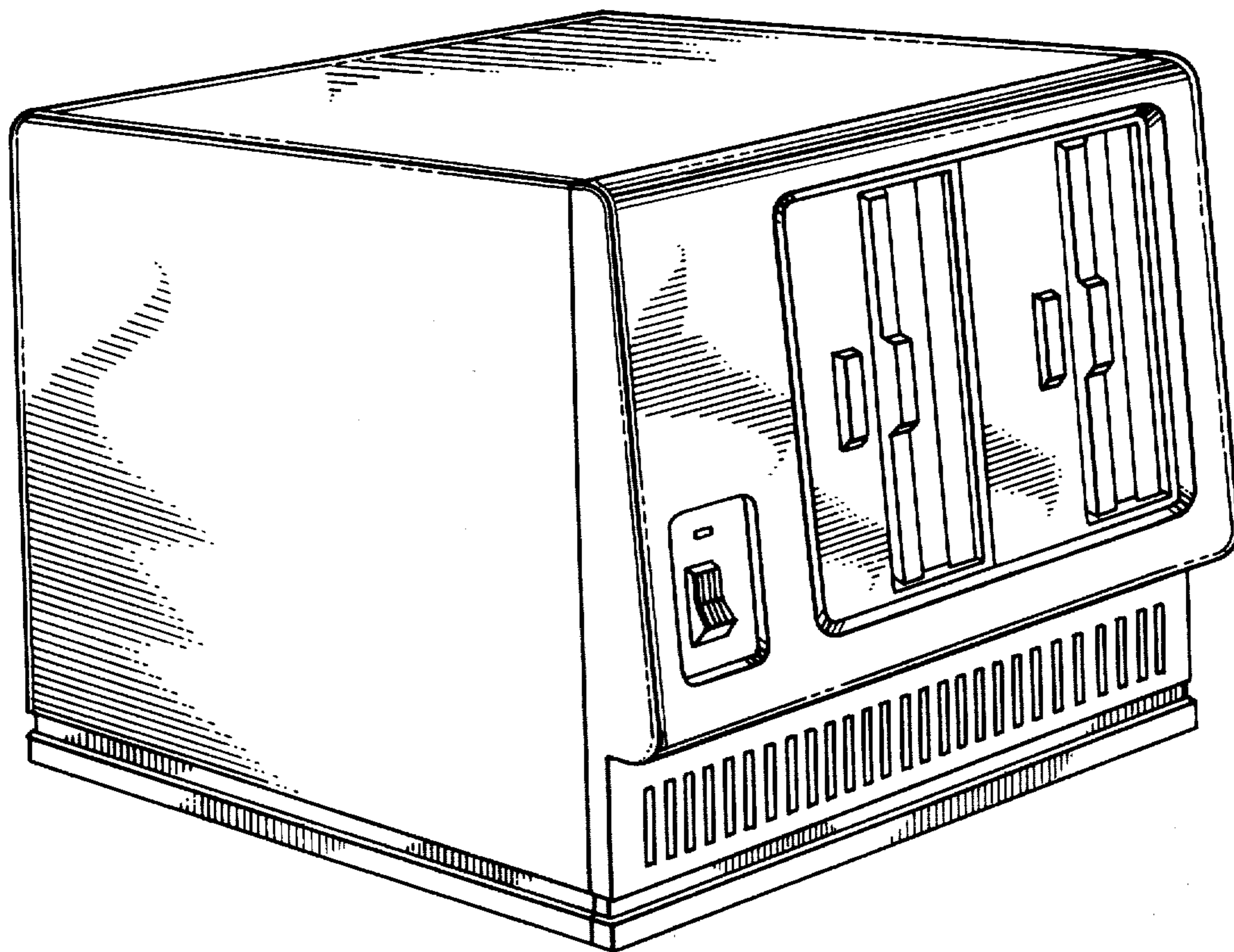

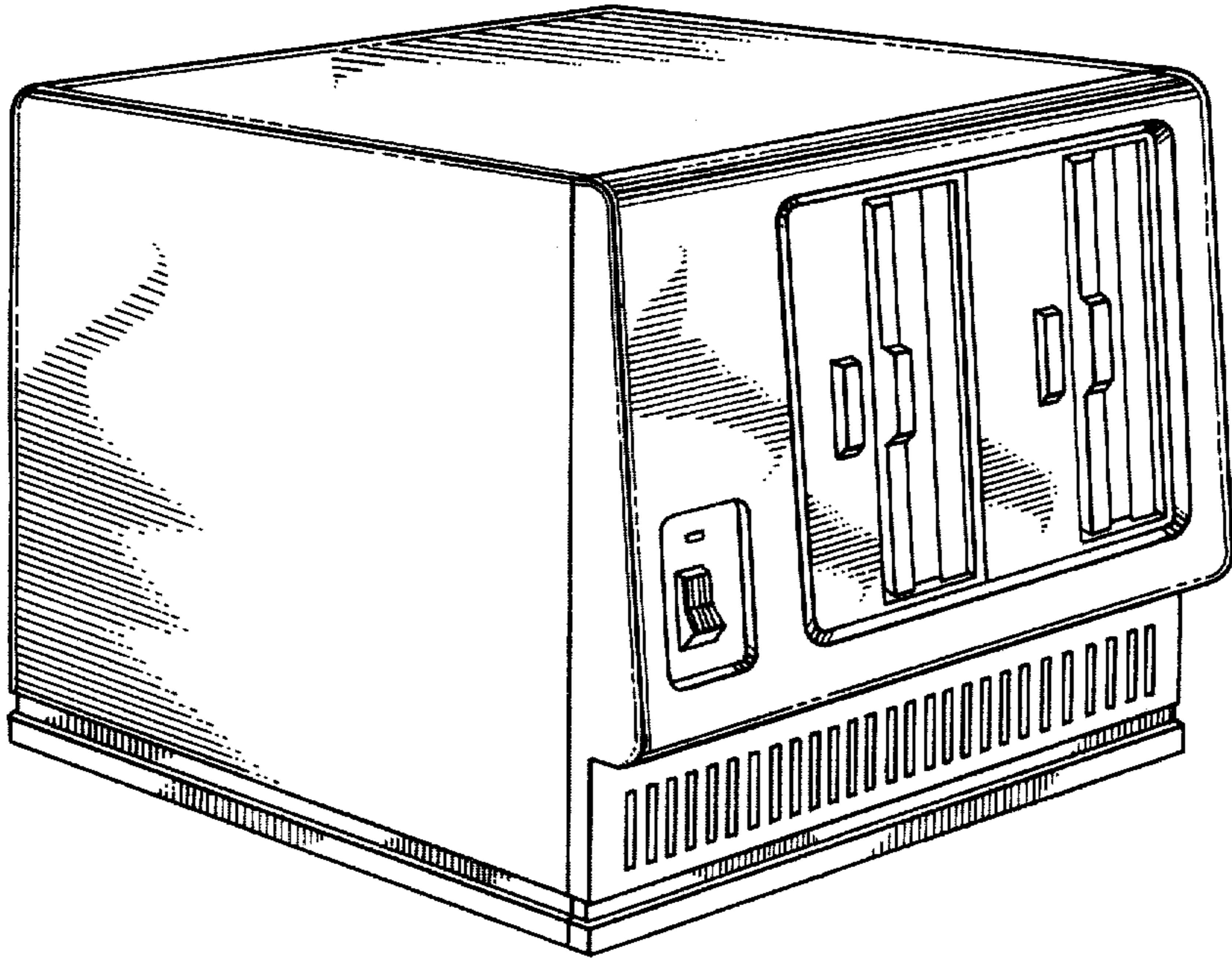
**CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a floppy disc console, as shown.

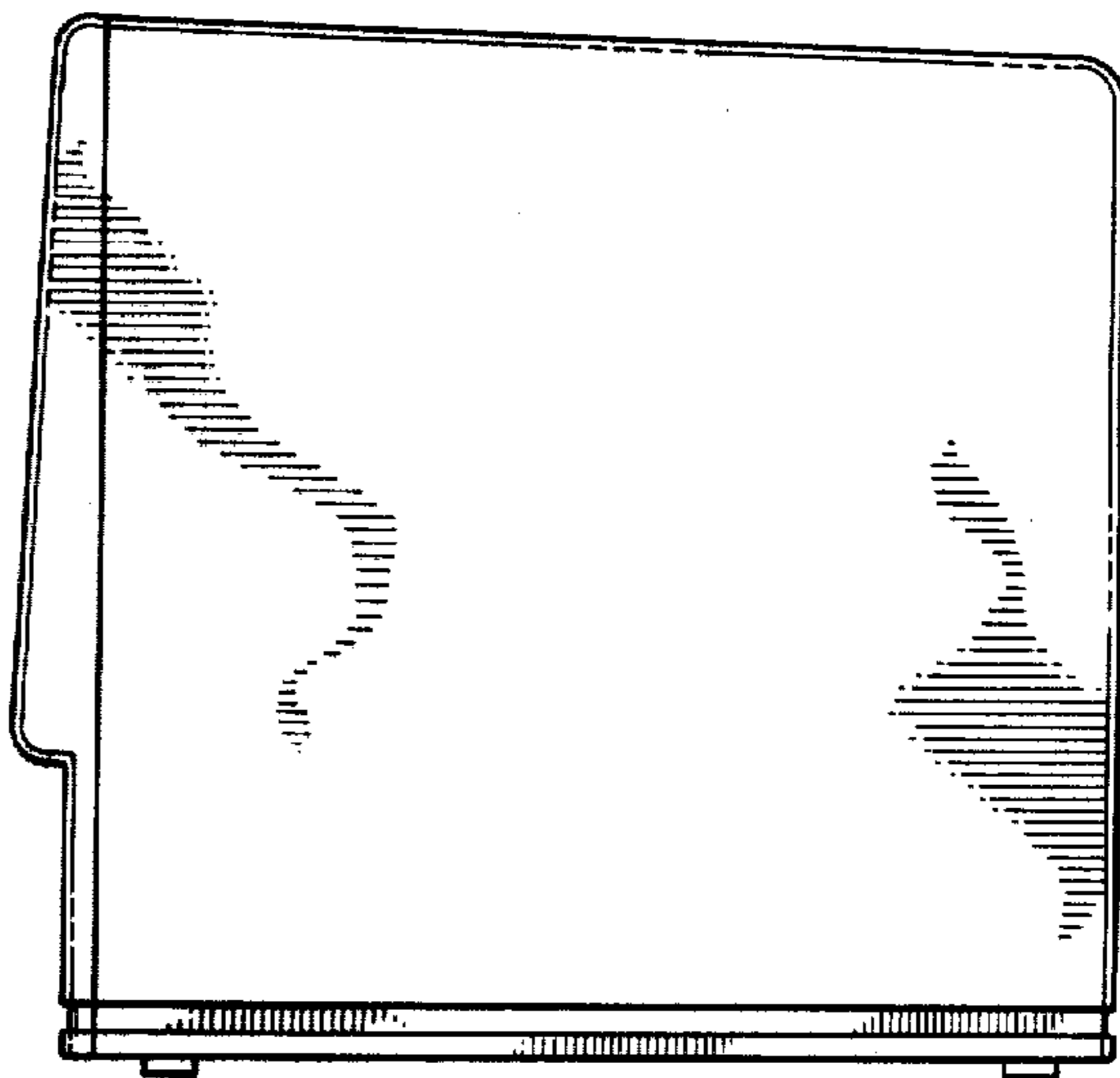
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

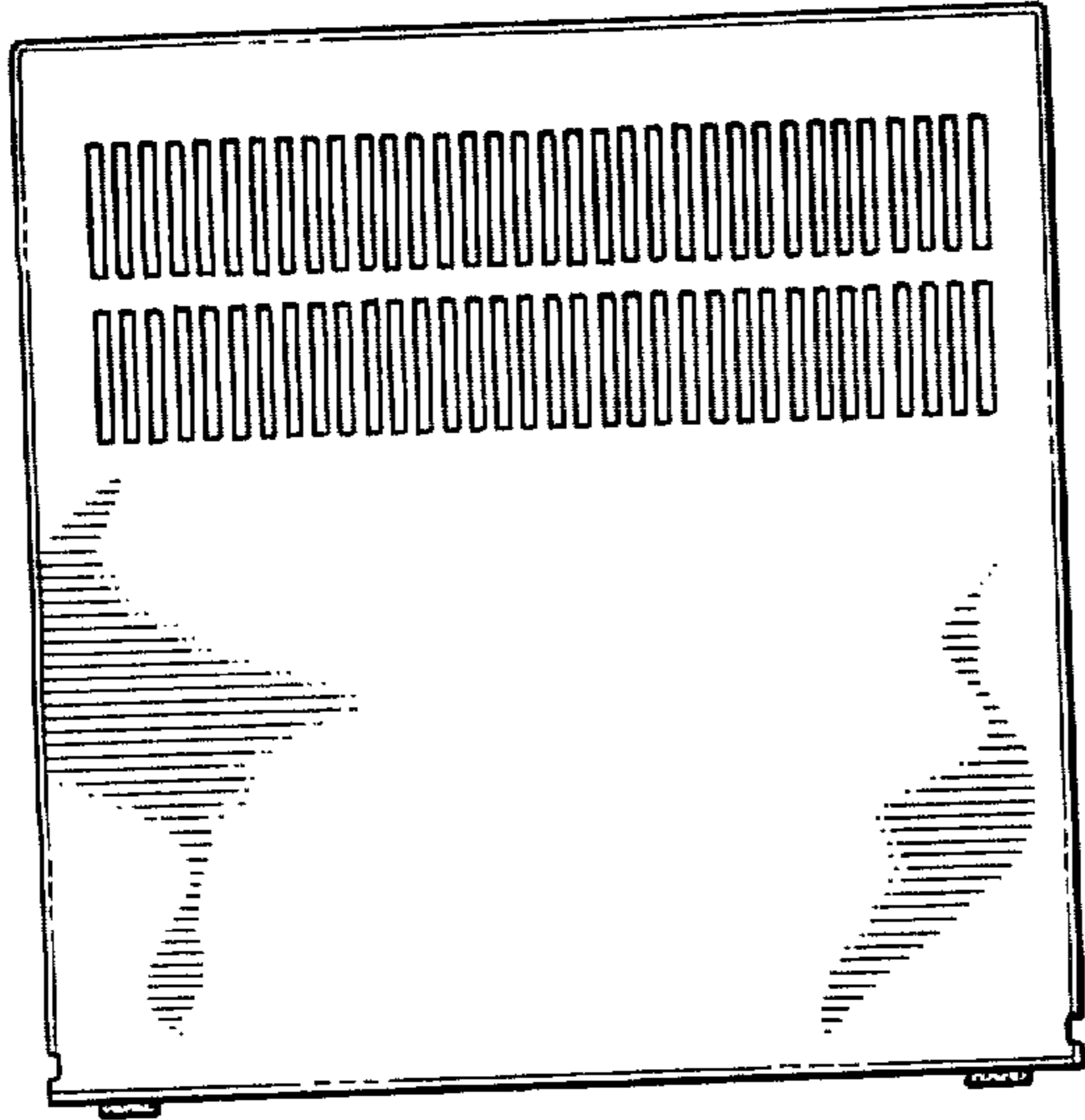




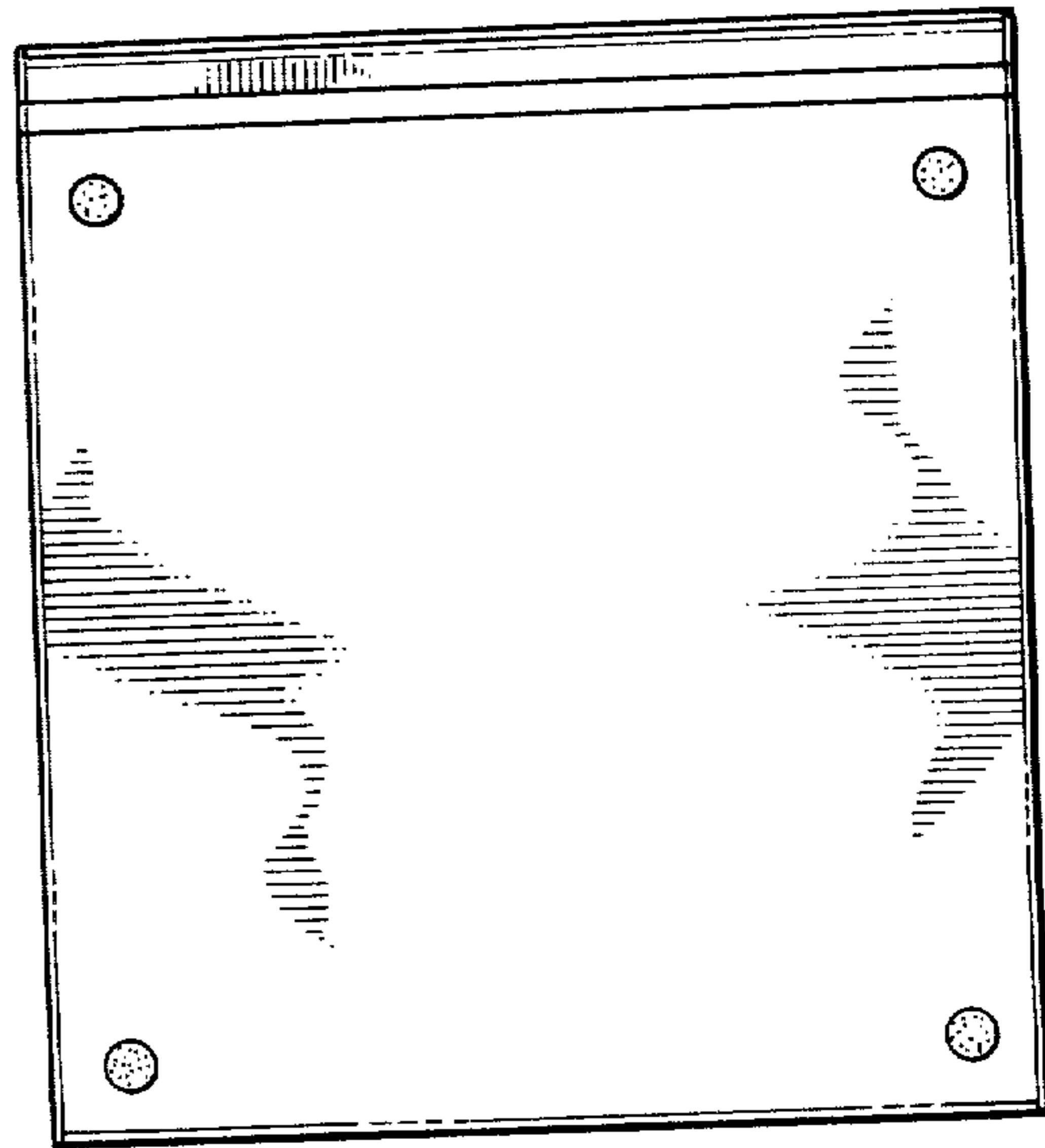
