[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined toy motorcycle and rider, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combined toy motorcycle and rider showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1.

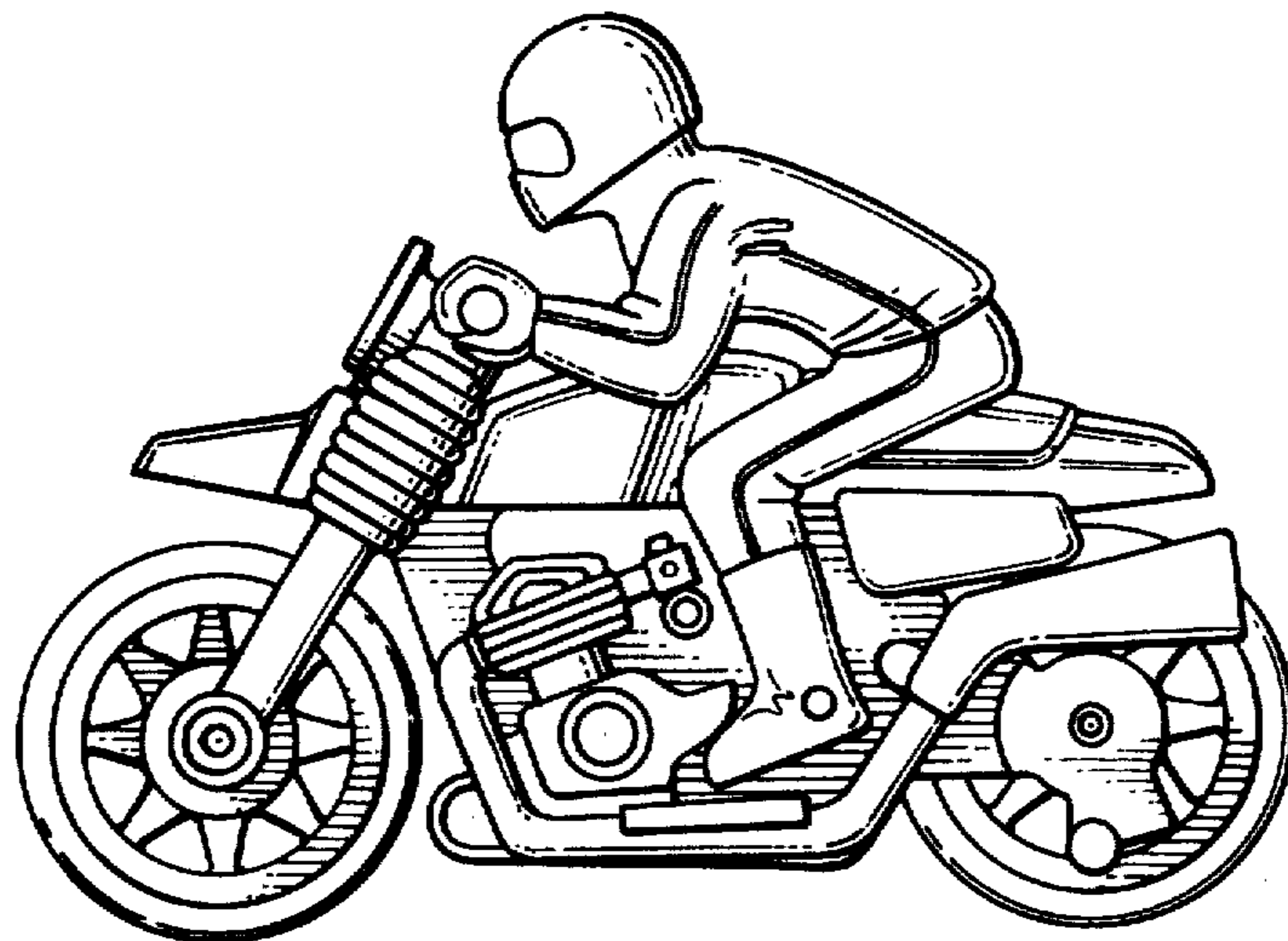

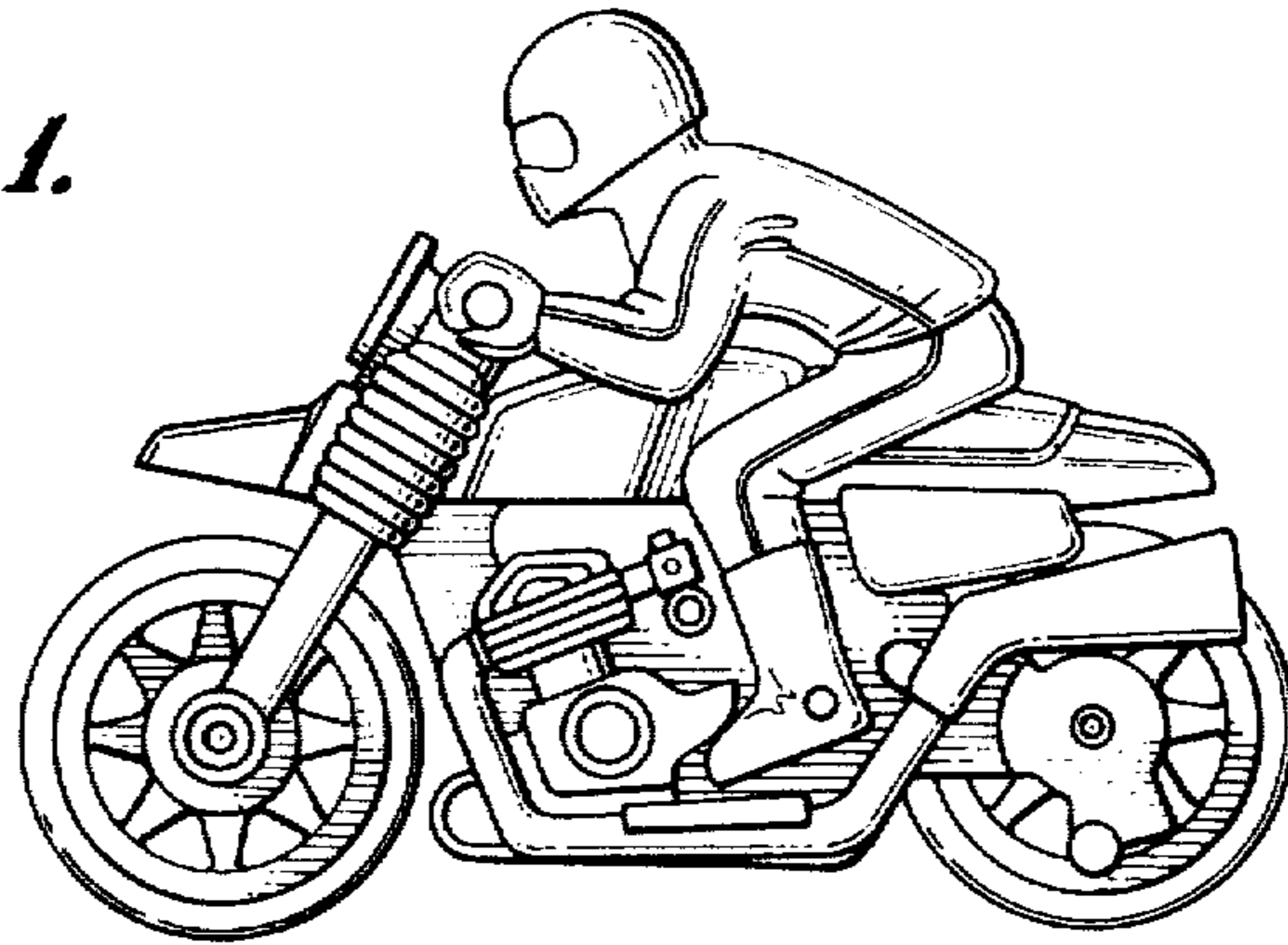

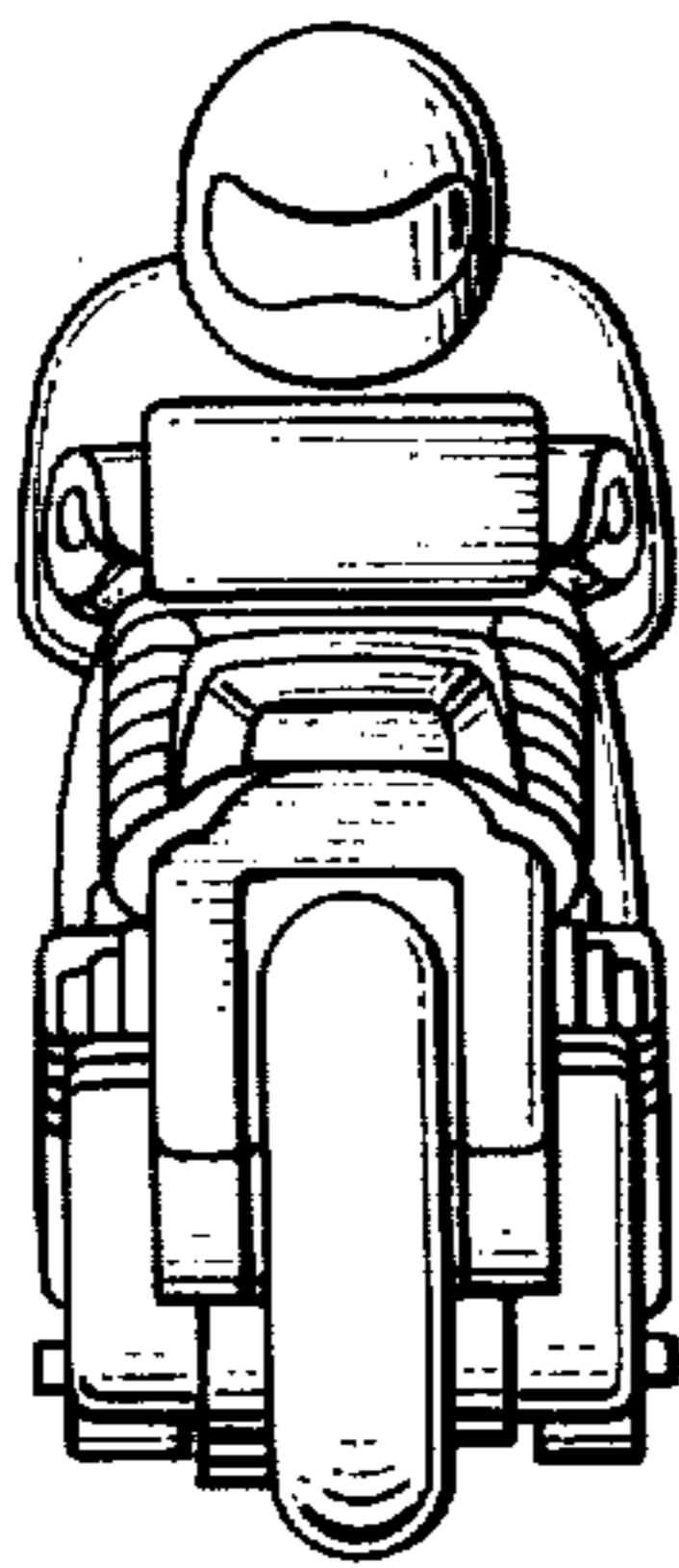

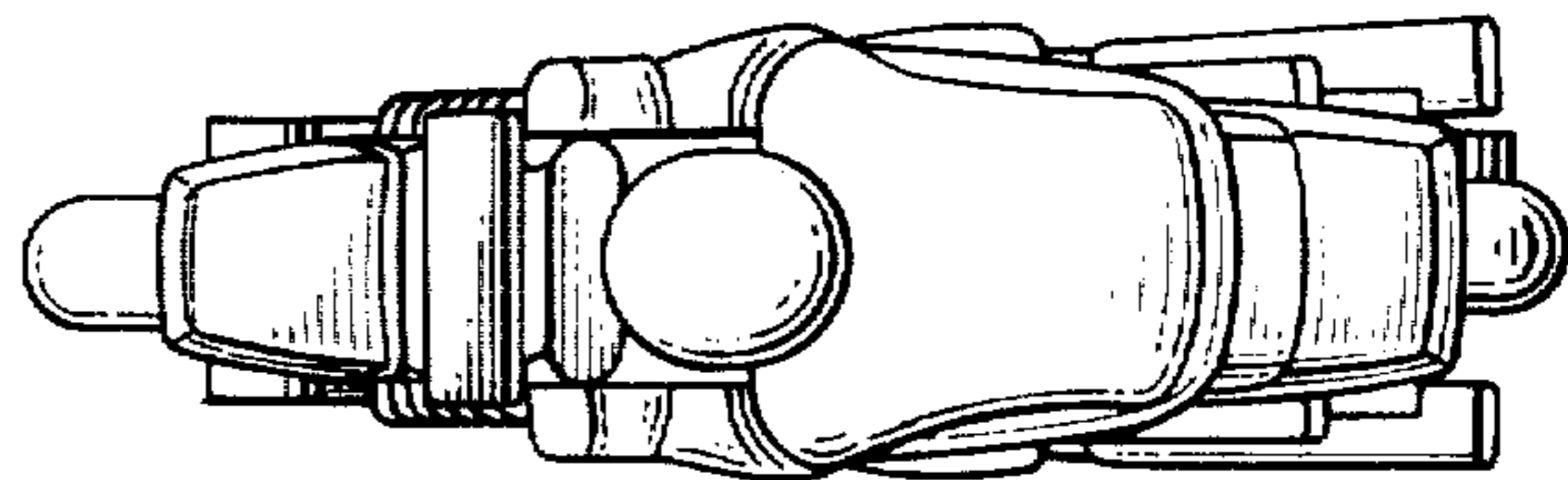

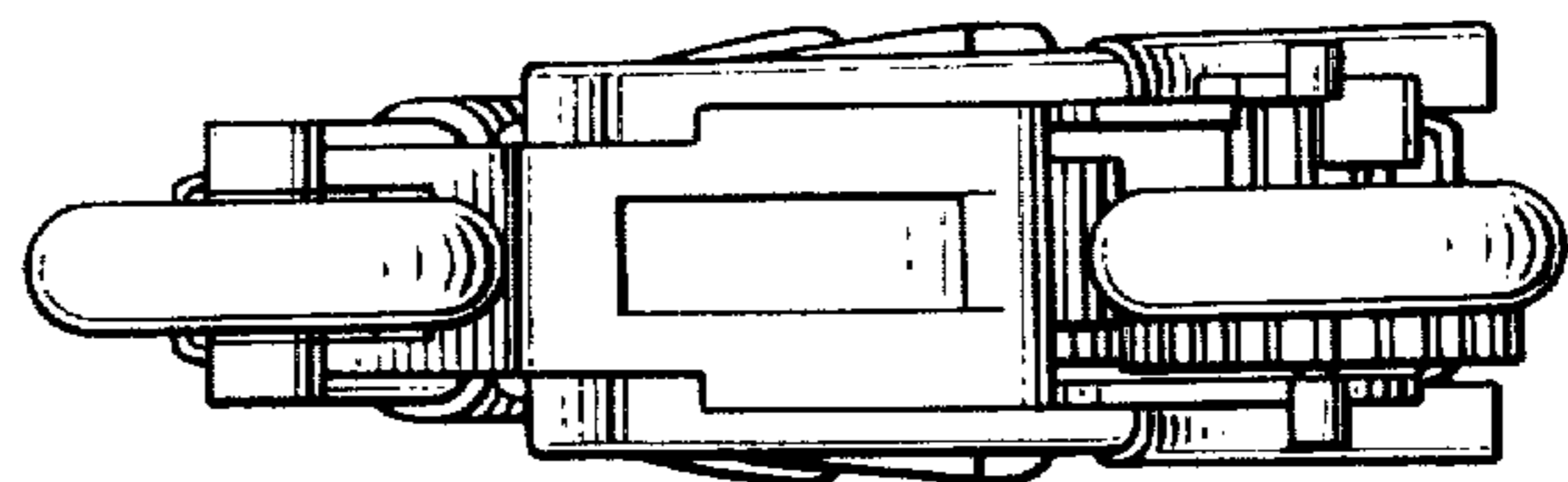

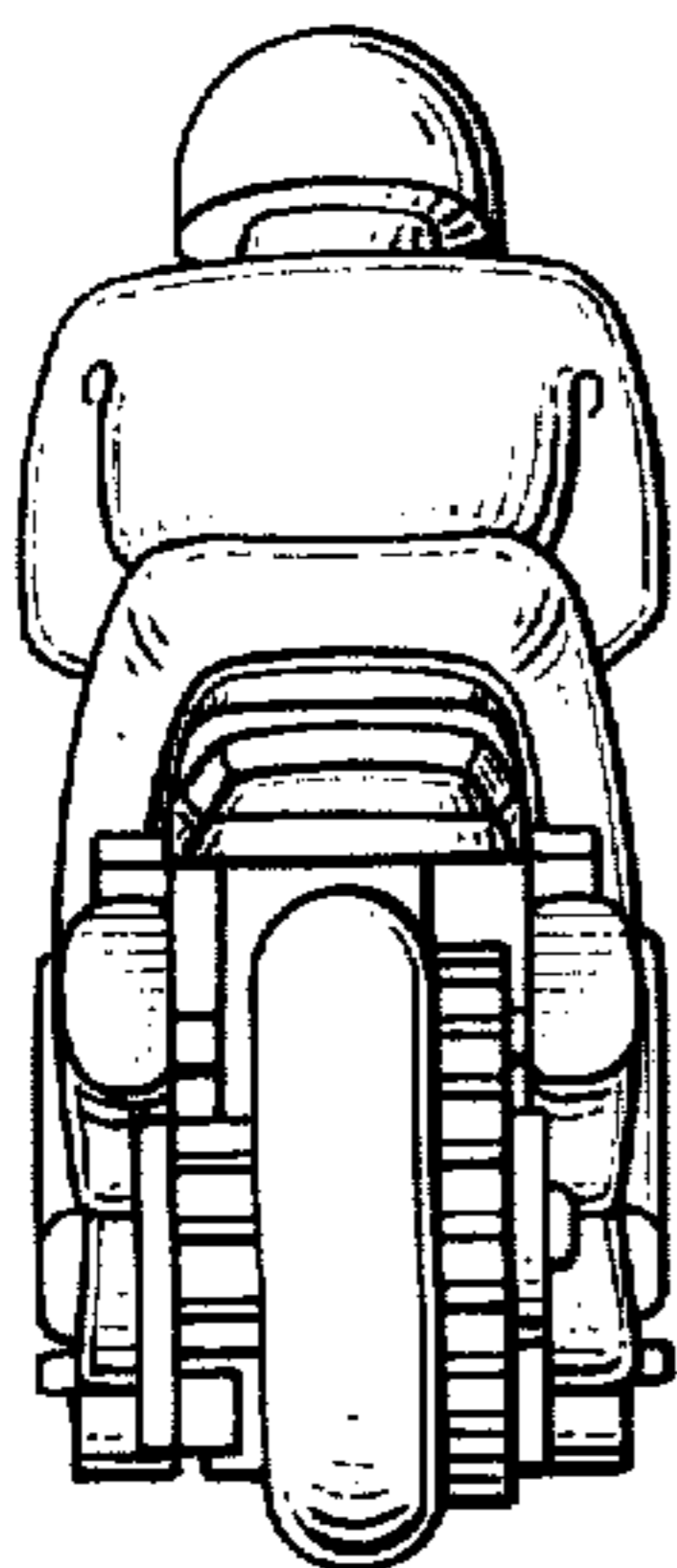
