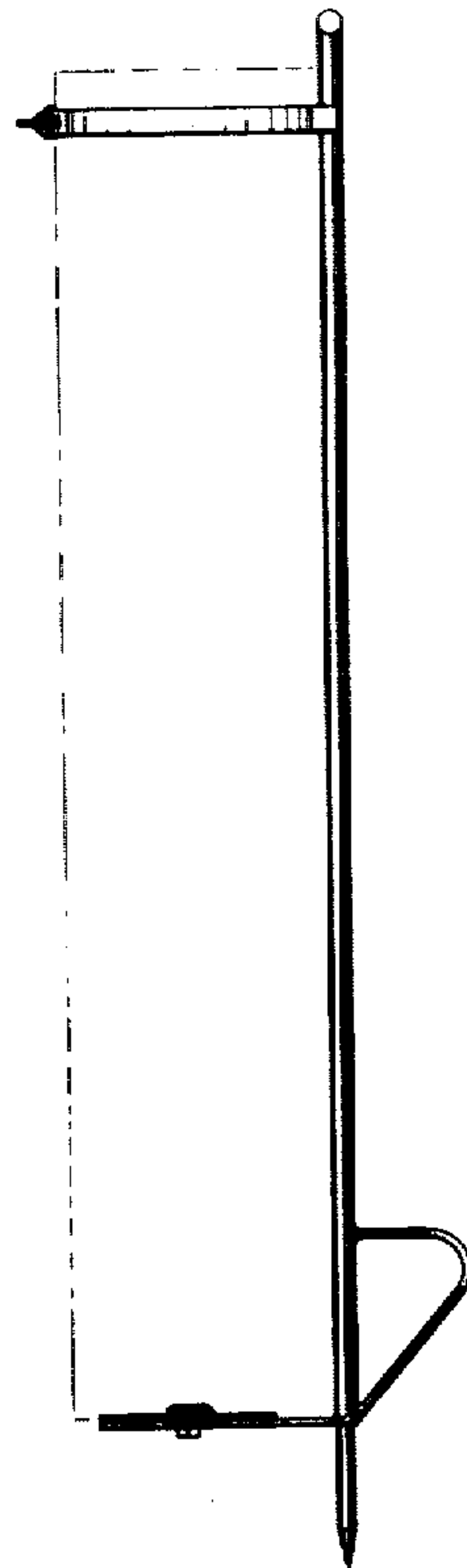

The ornamental design for a golf bag stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a golf bag stand showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the stand, the undisclosed side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan.
The golf bag shown by means of broken lines in FIG. 3 is for illustrative purposes only.



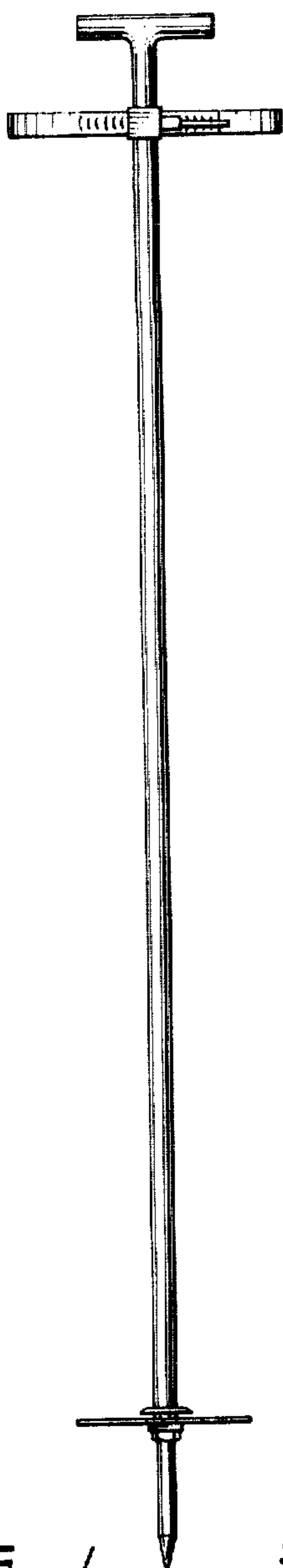

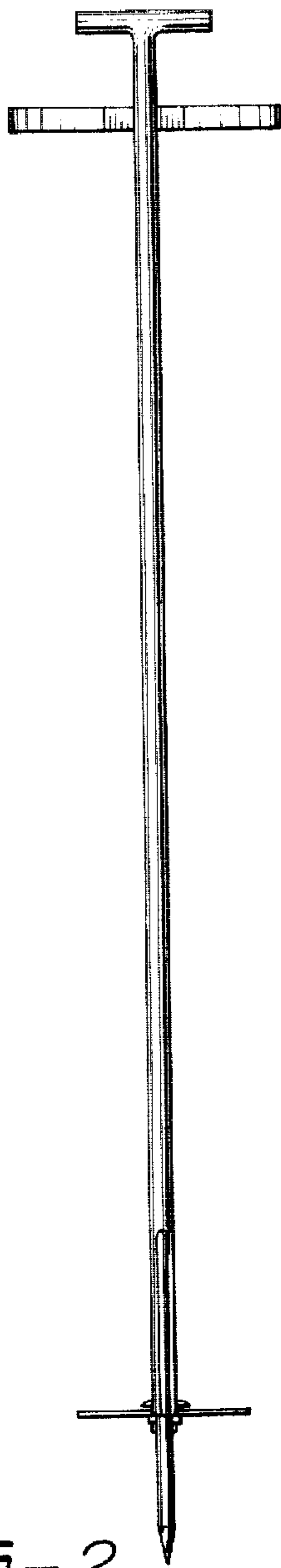

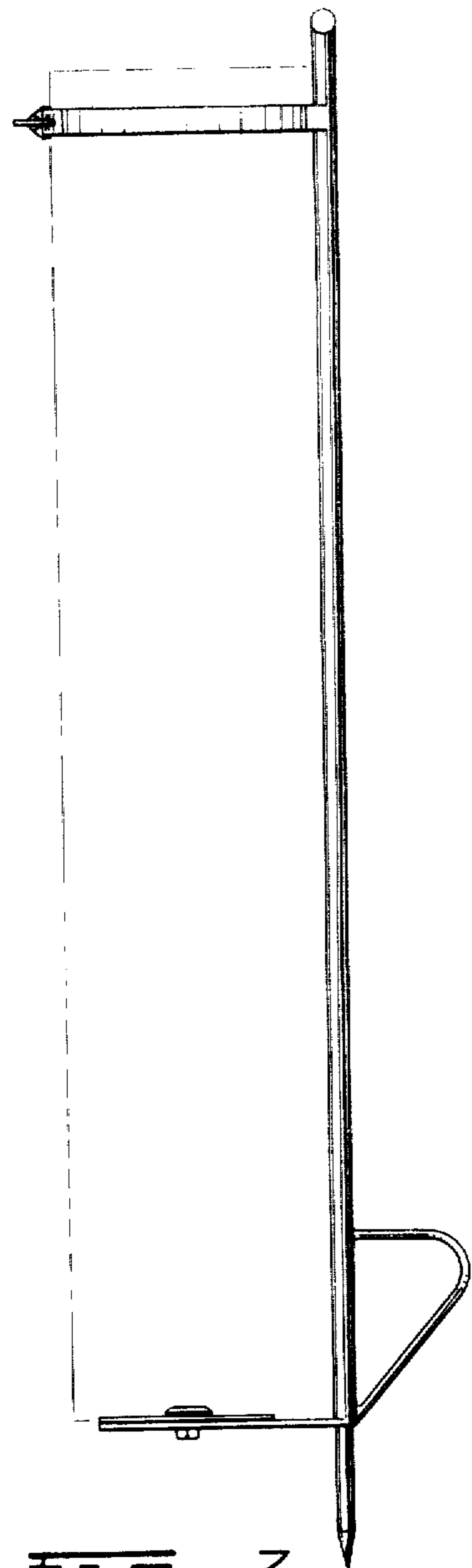

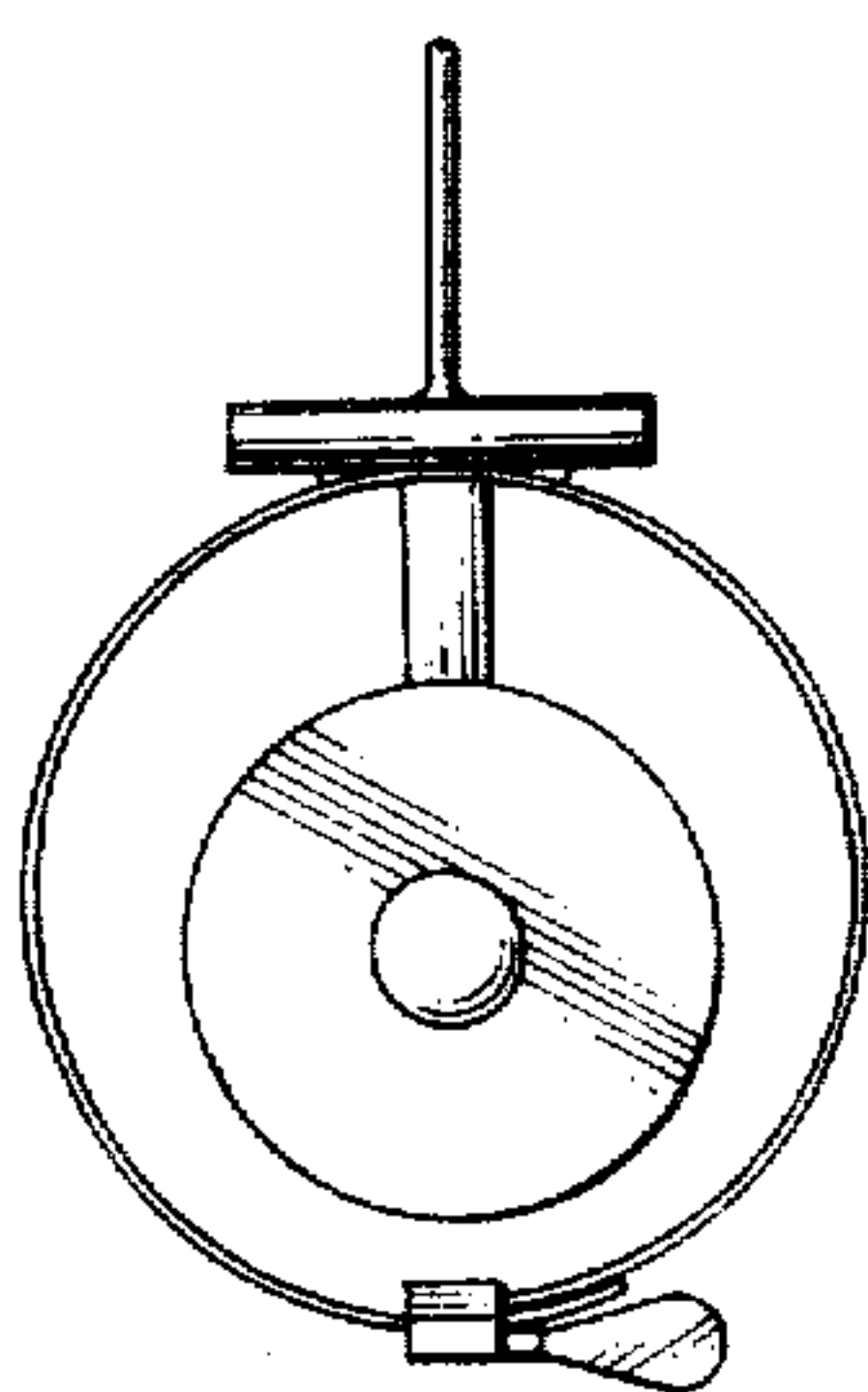

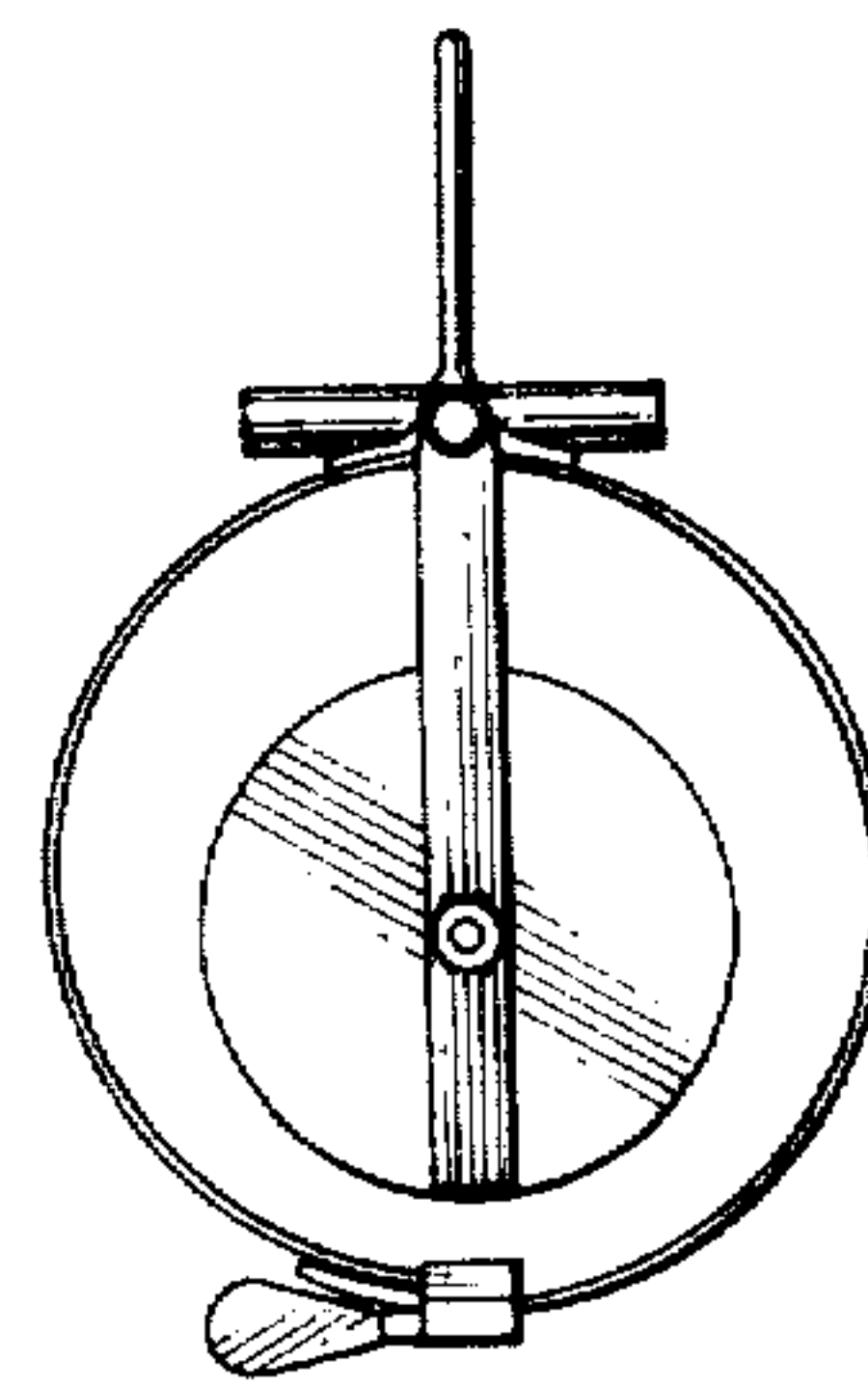
