DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a waterslide embodying the present design.

FIG. 2 is a longitudinal elevation taken substantially on line 2—2 of FIG. 1.

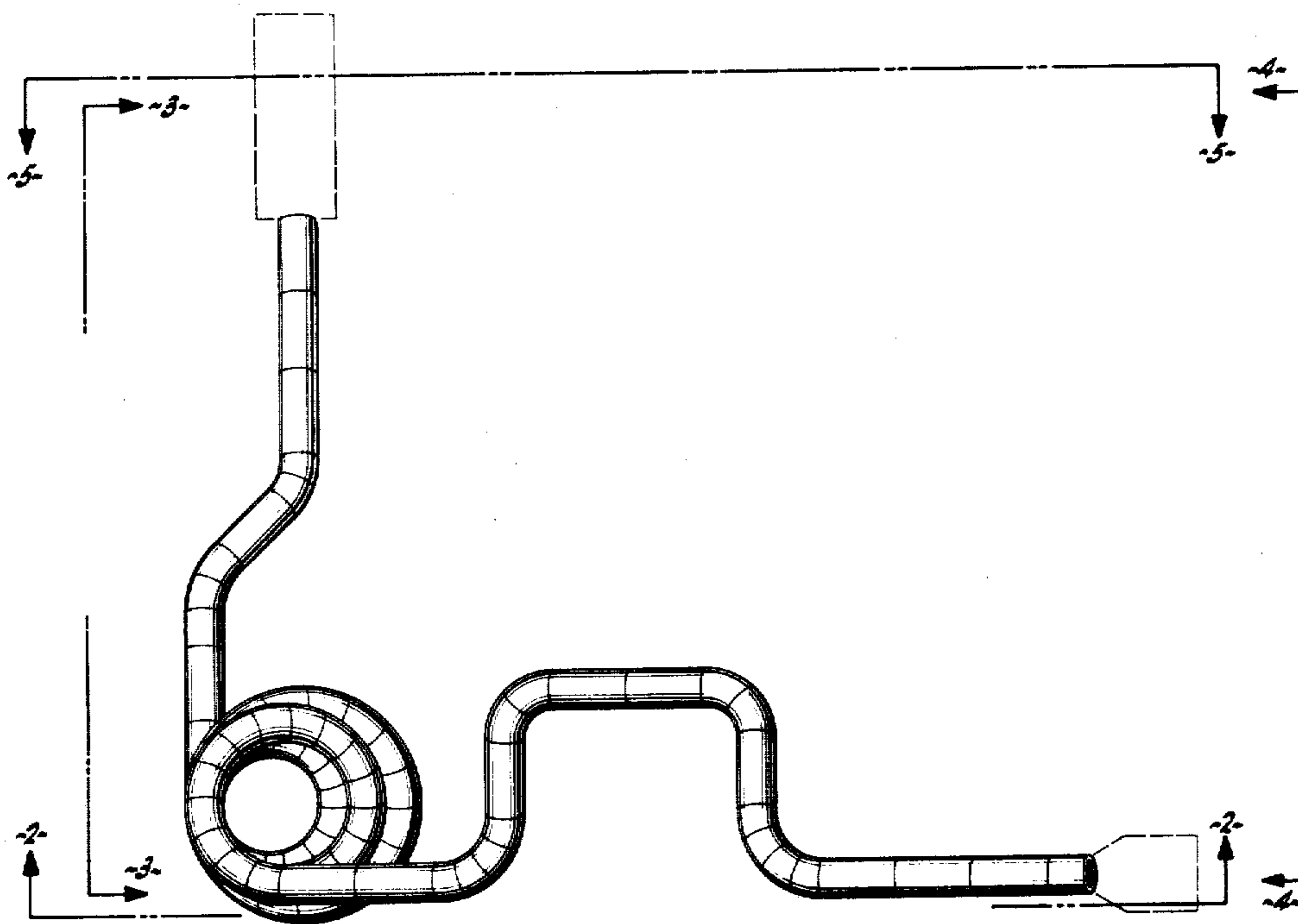
FIG. 3 is an end elevation taken substantially on line 3—3 of FIG. 1.

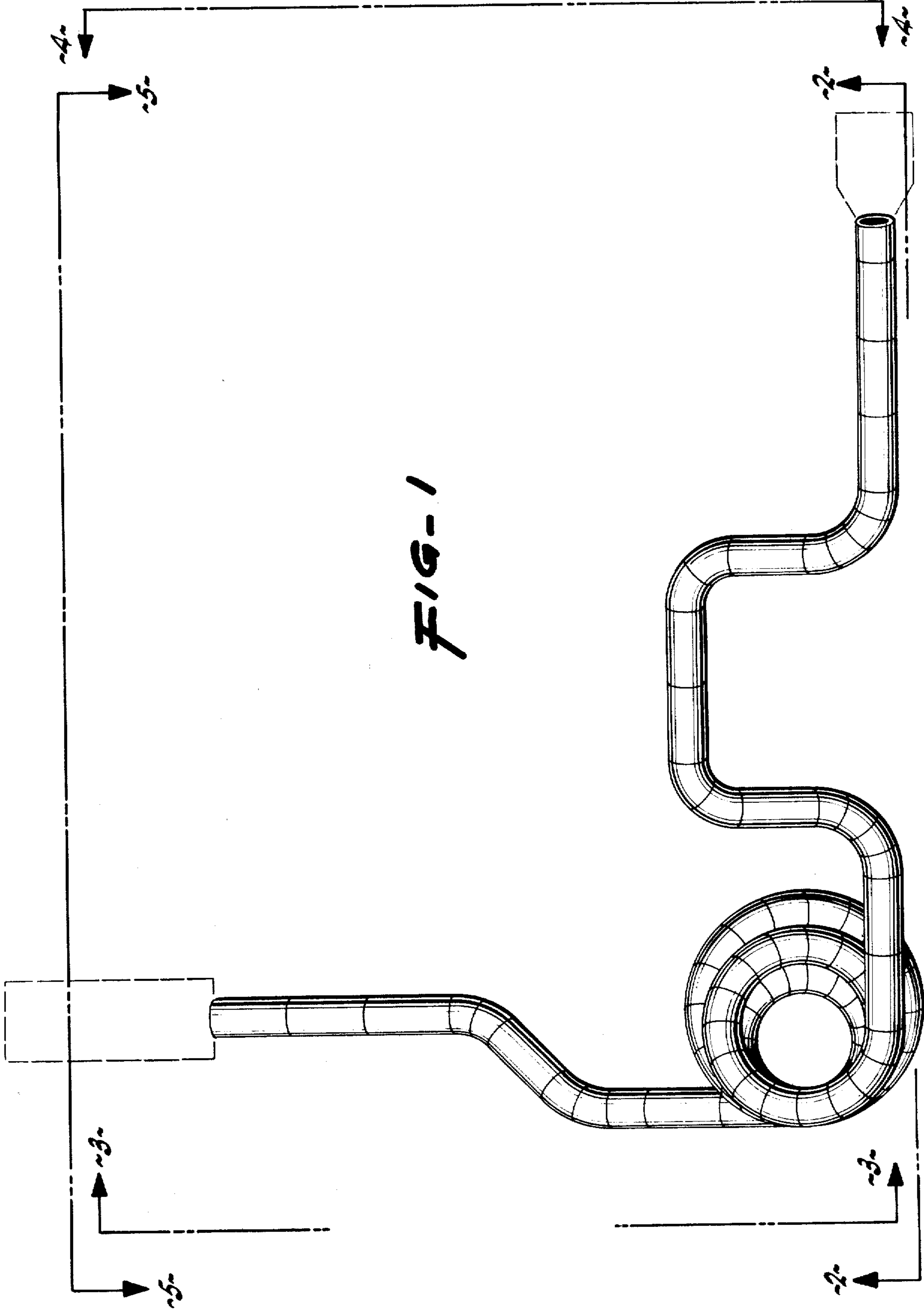
FIG. 4 is an opposite end elevation taken substantially on line 4—4 of FIG. 1.

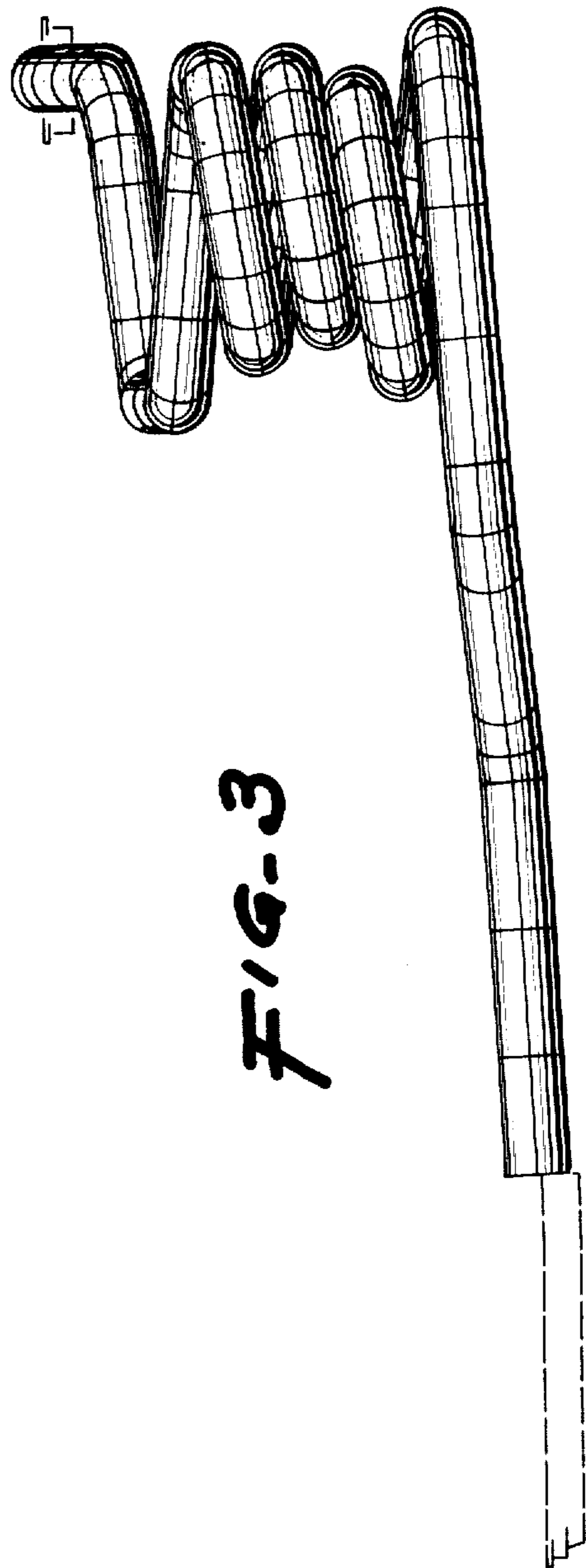
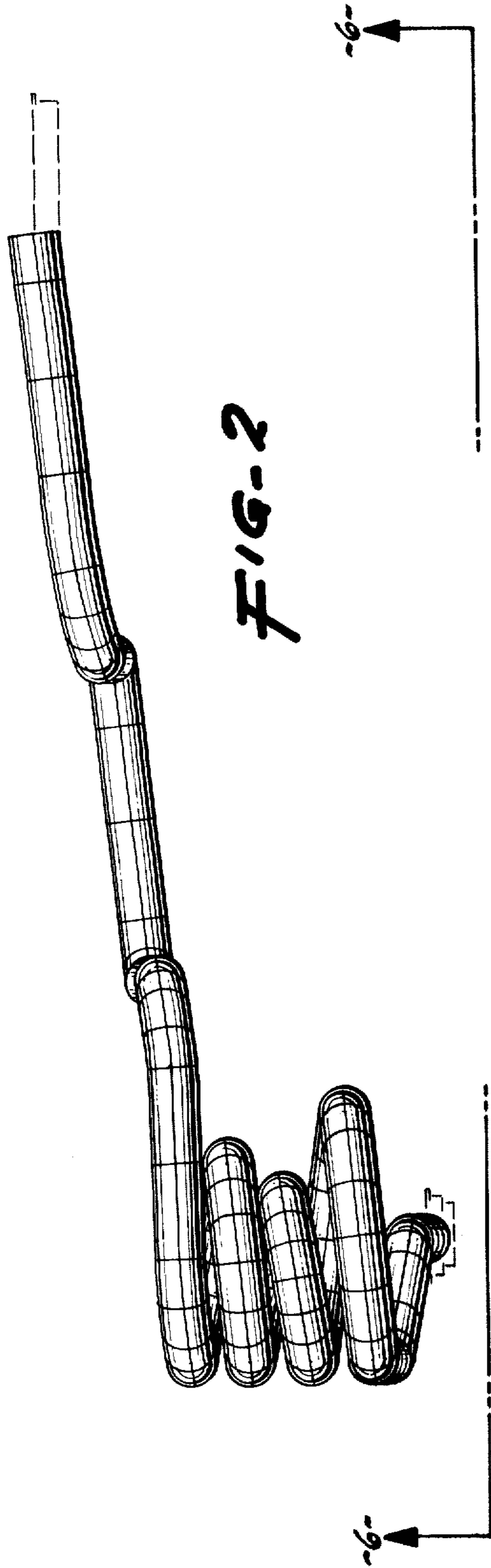
FIG. 5 is a longitudinal elevation, opposite from FIG. 2, taken substantially on line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

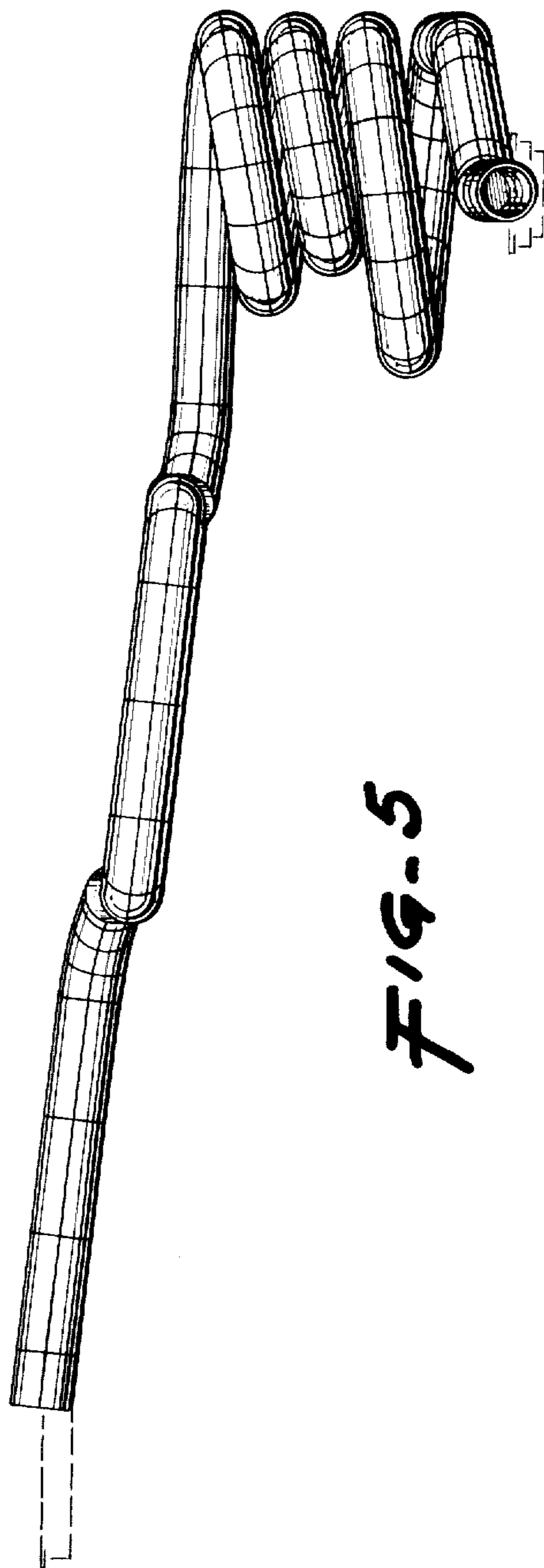
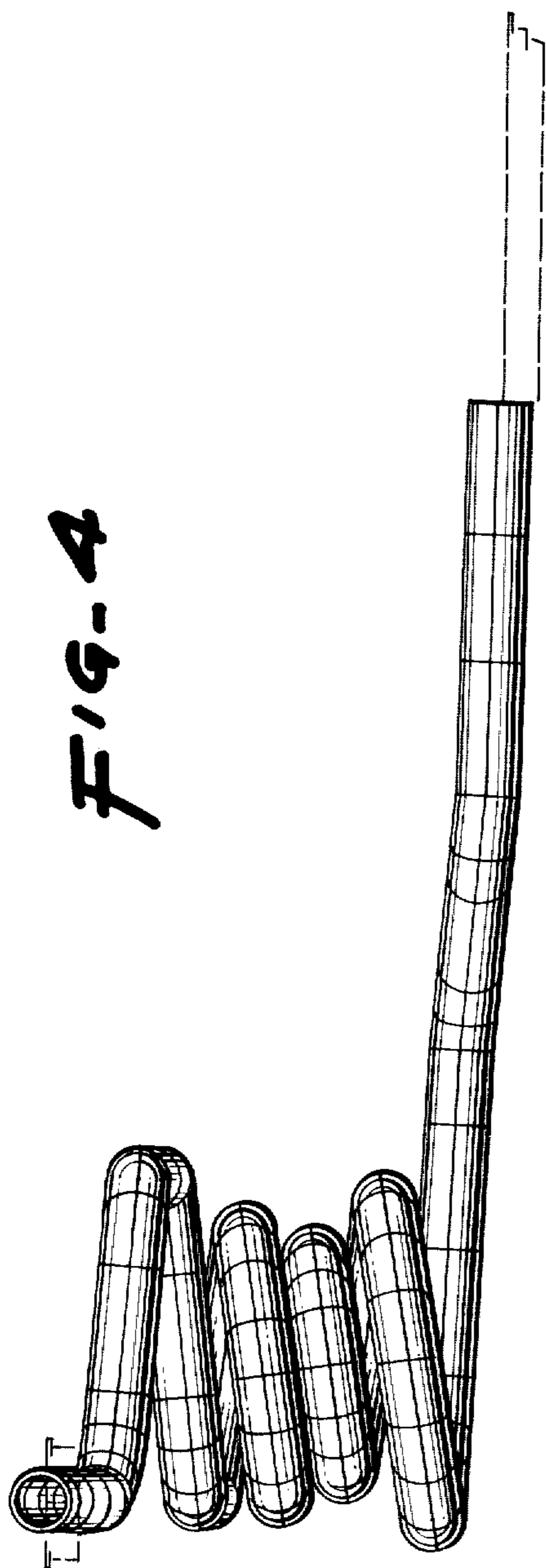
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view taken substantially on line 6—6 of FIG. 2.

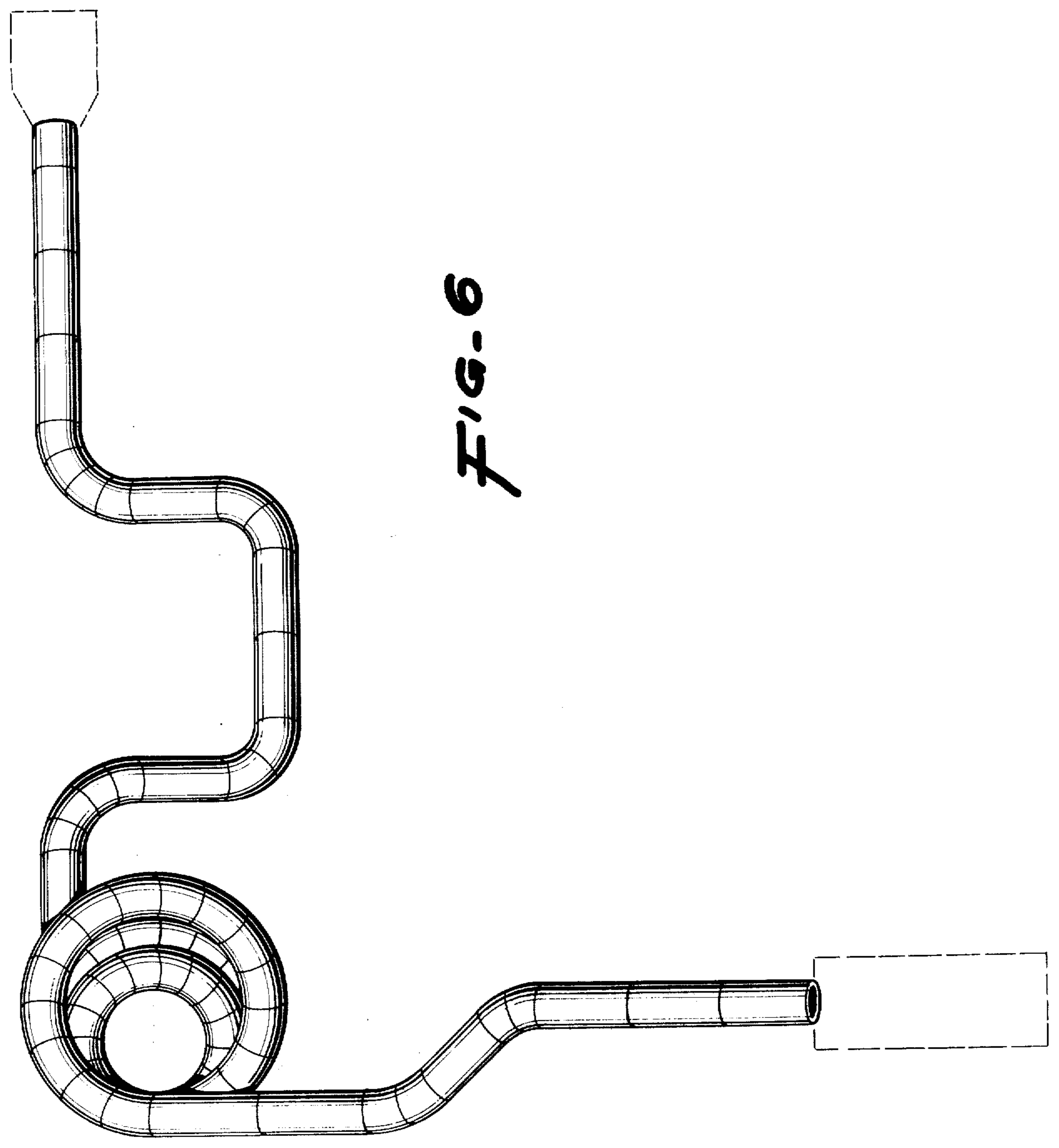
The entry and exit pools shown in broken lines at the ends of the waterslide are for positional illustration only and form no part of the present design.
