[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined vending machine and storage cabinet unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined vending machine and storage cabinet unit showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being identical thereto;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a top and left front perspective view thereof.

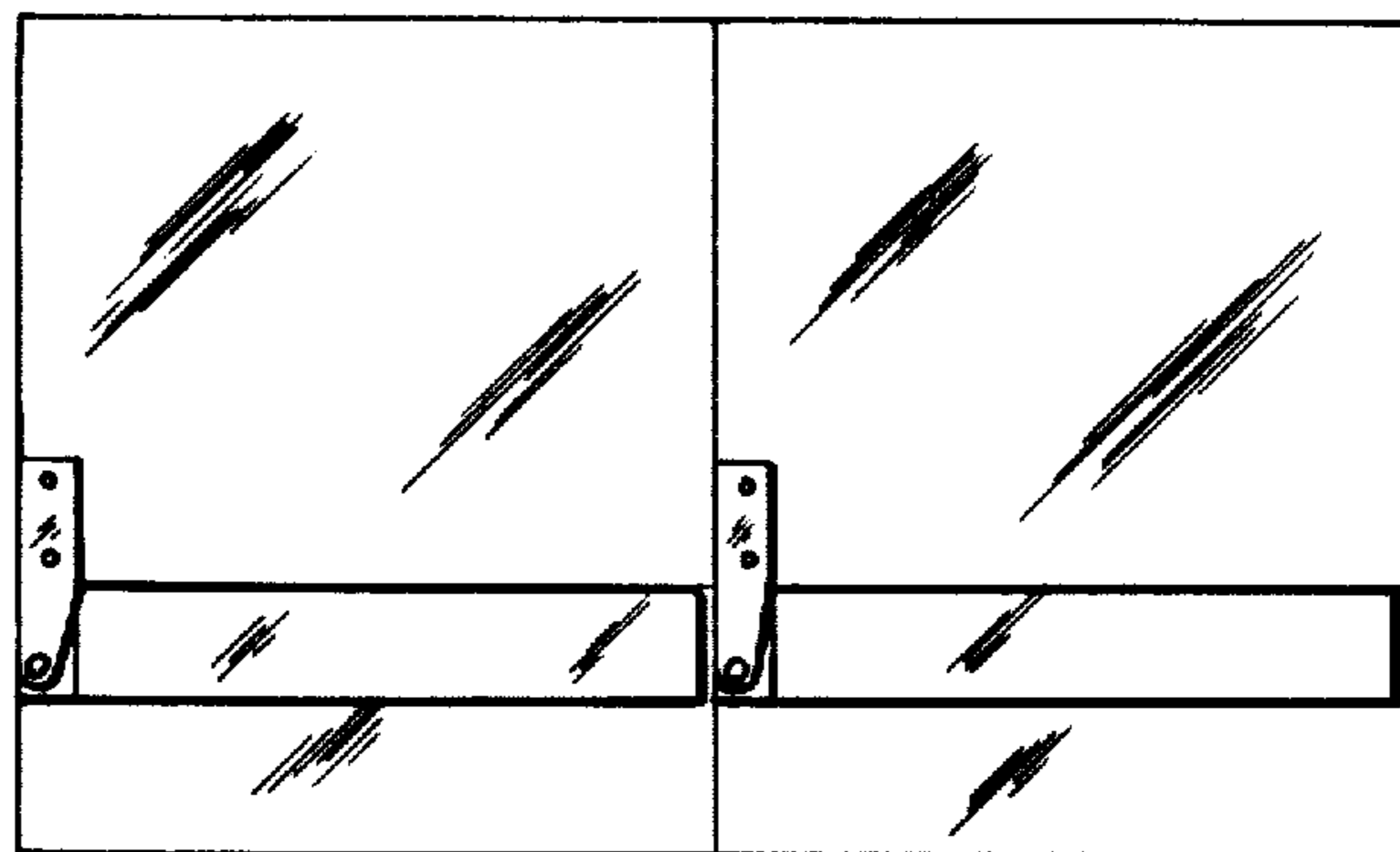

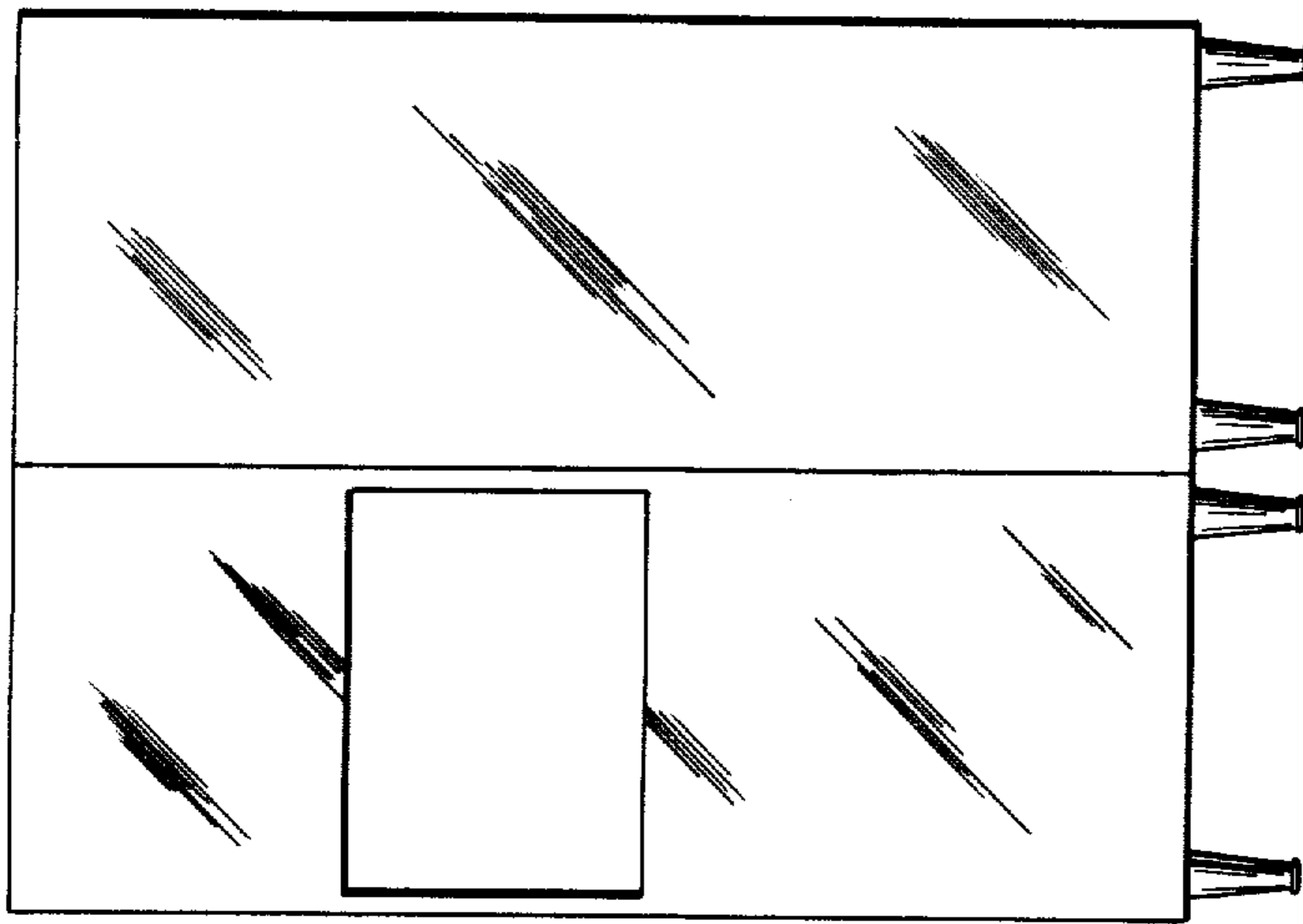

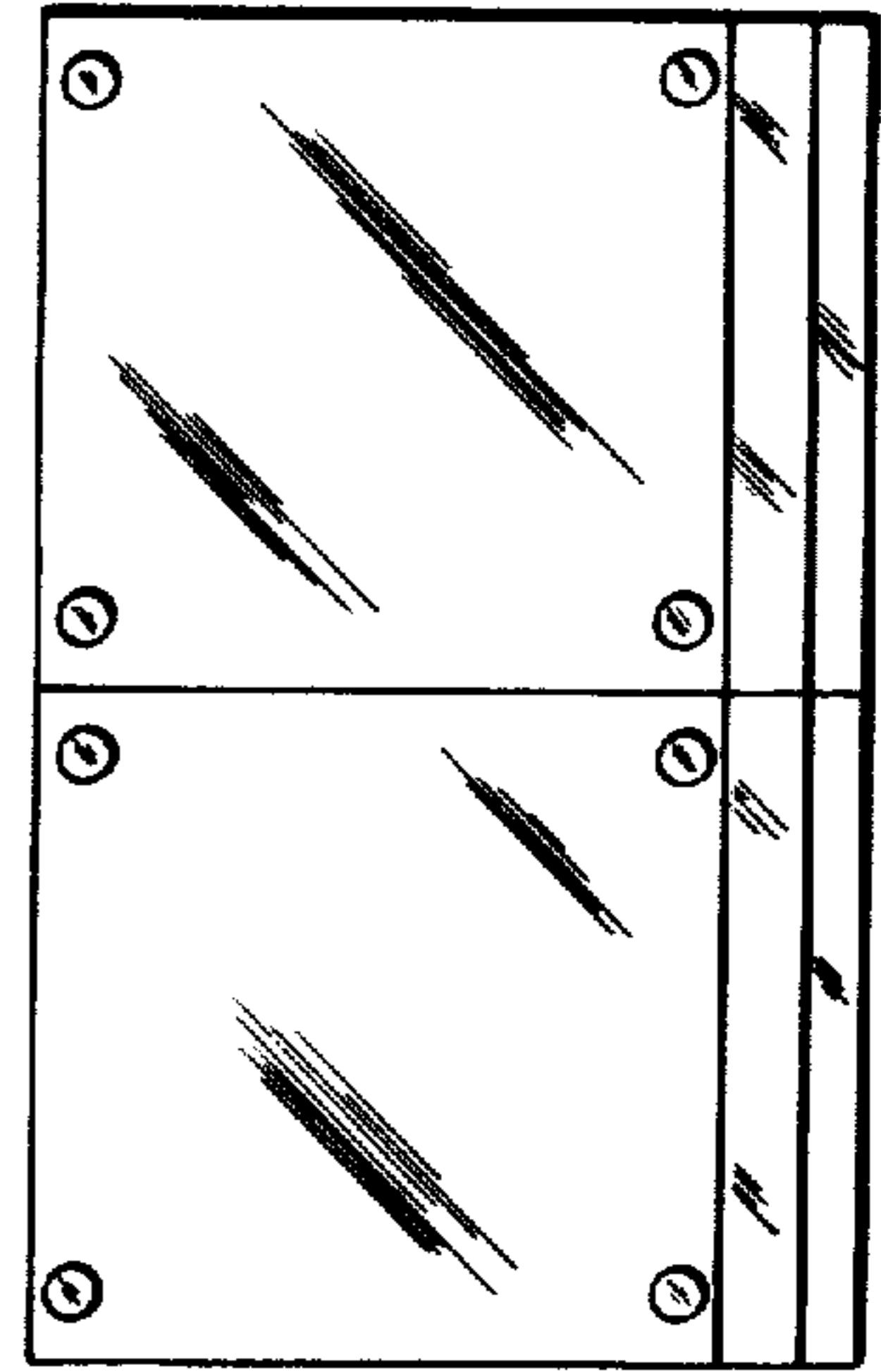

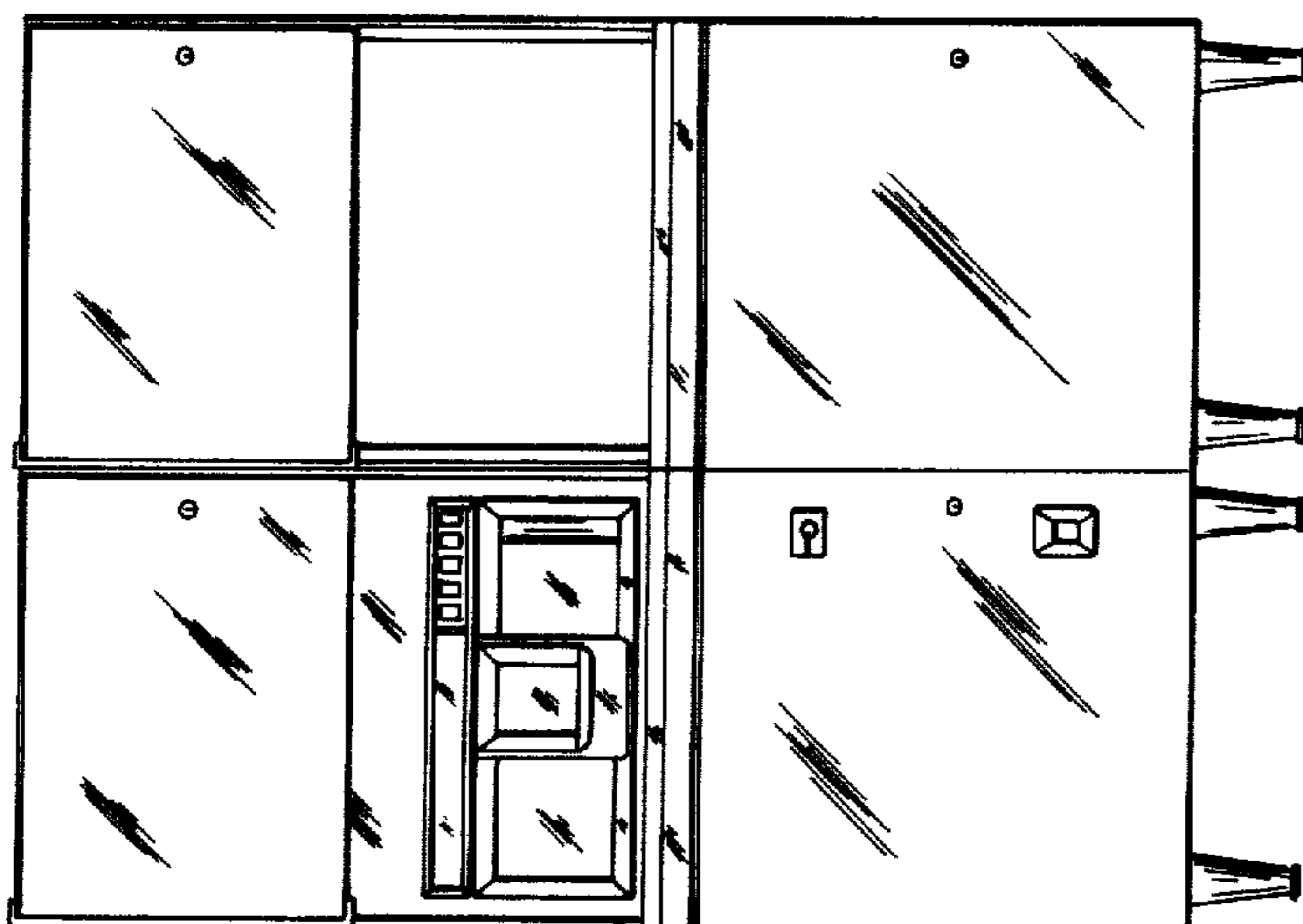

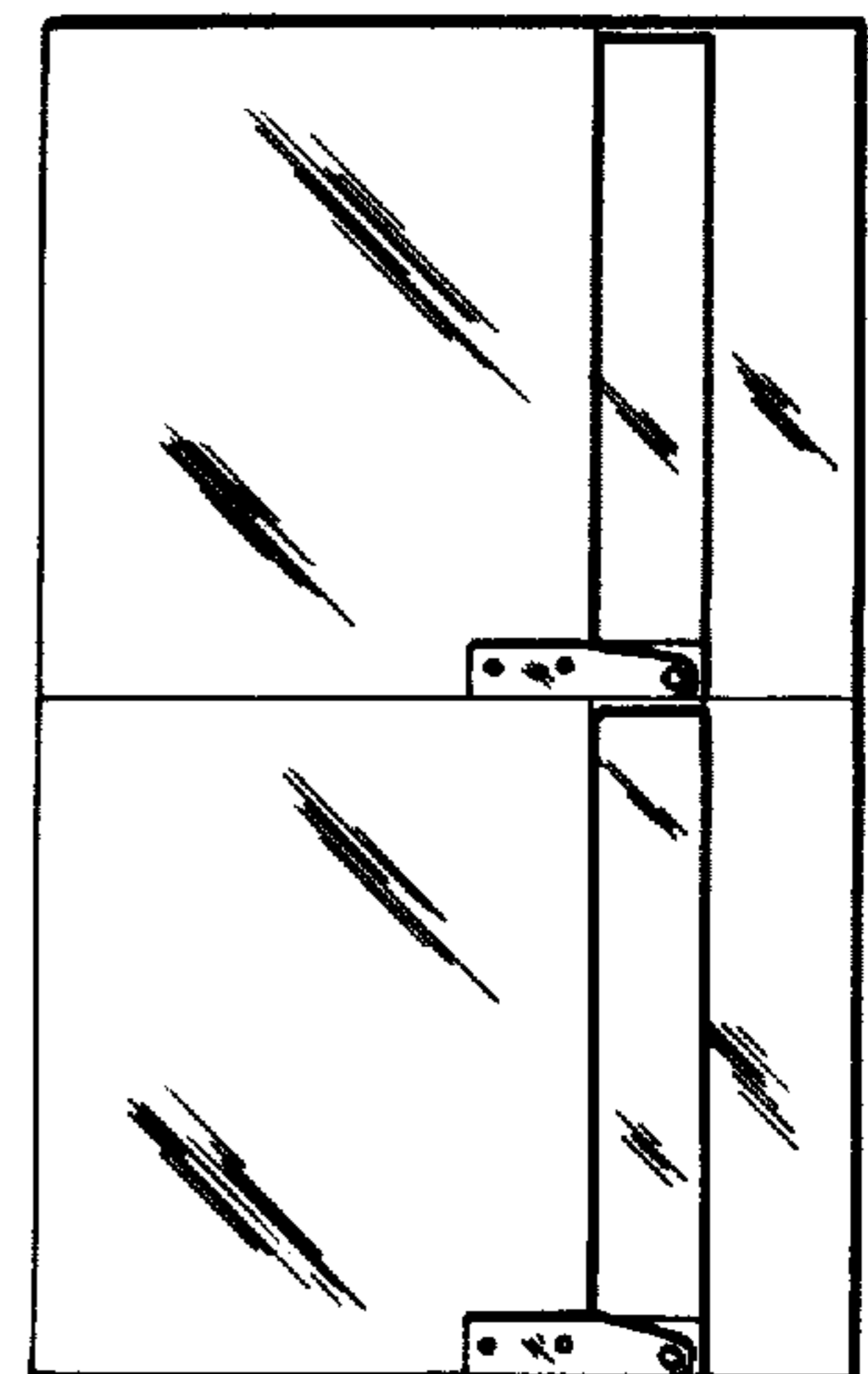

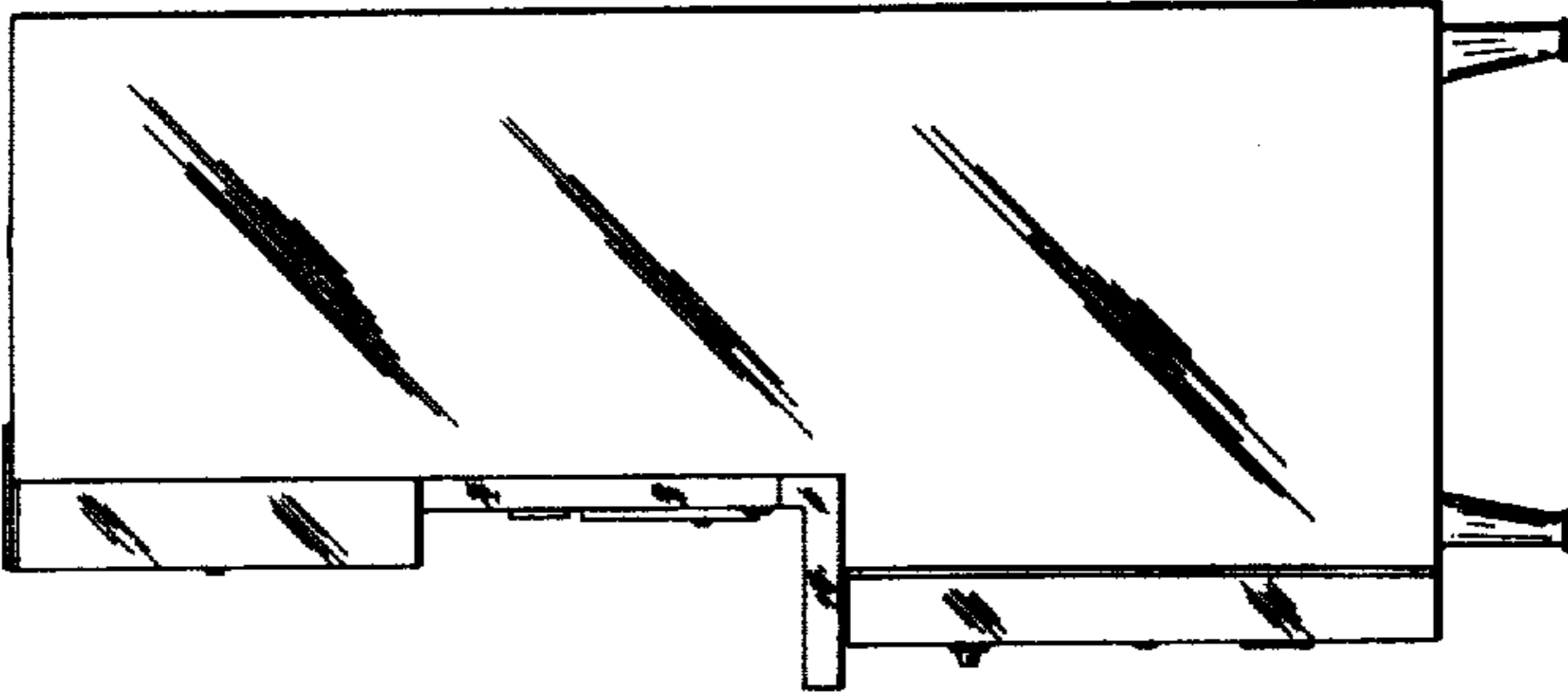
