The ornamental design for a combined monkey figure and wheel chair, substantially as shown and described.

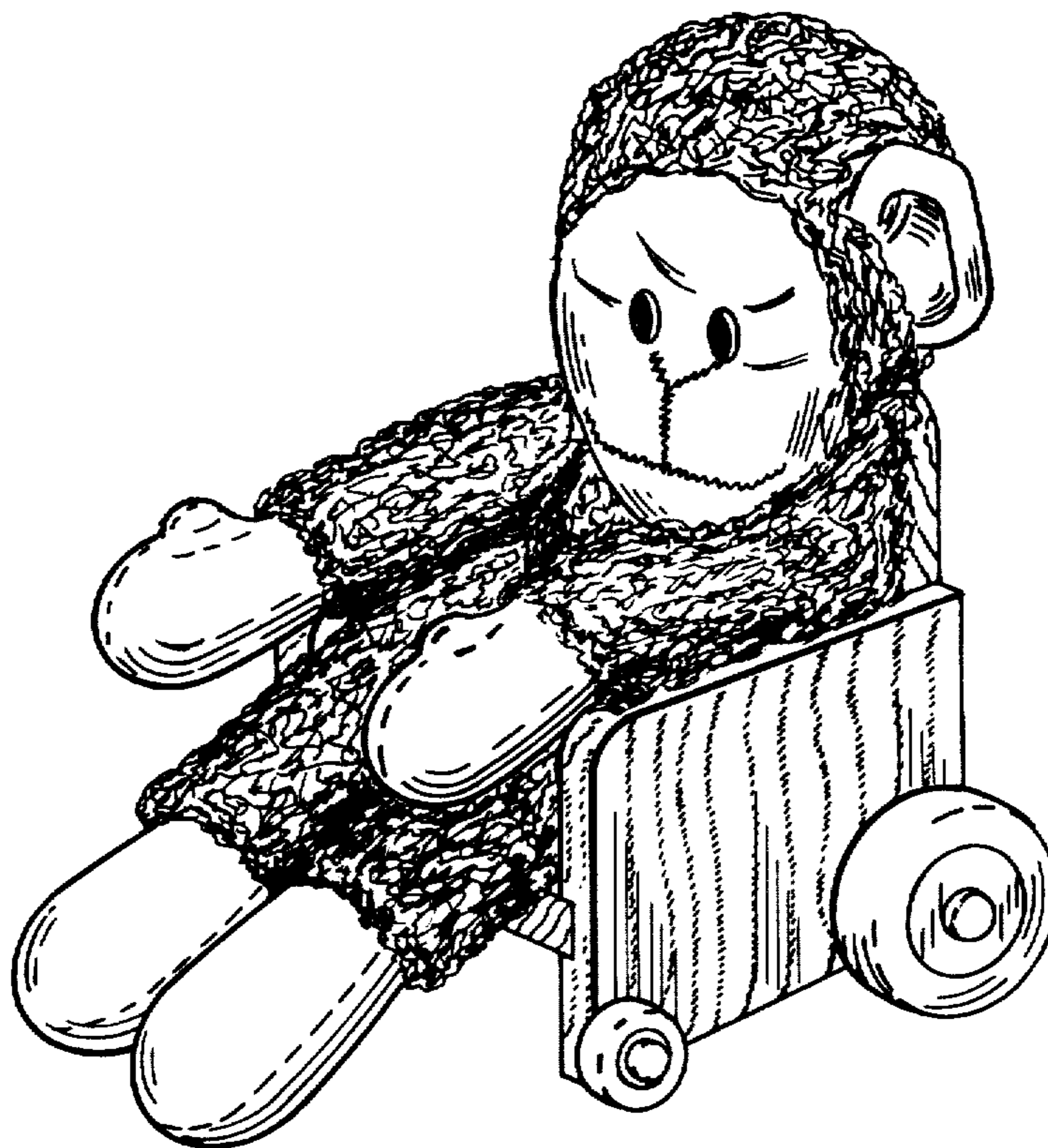
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of a combined monkey figure and wheel chair showing my new design.



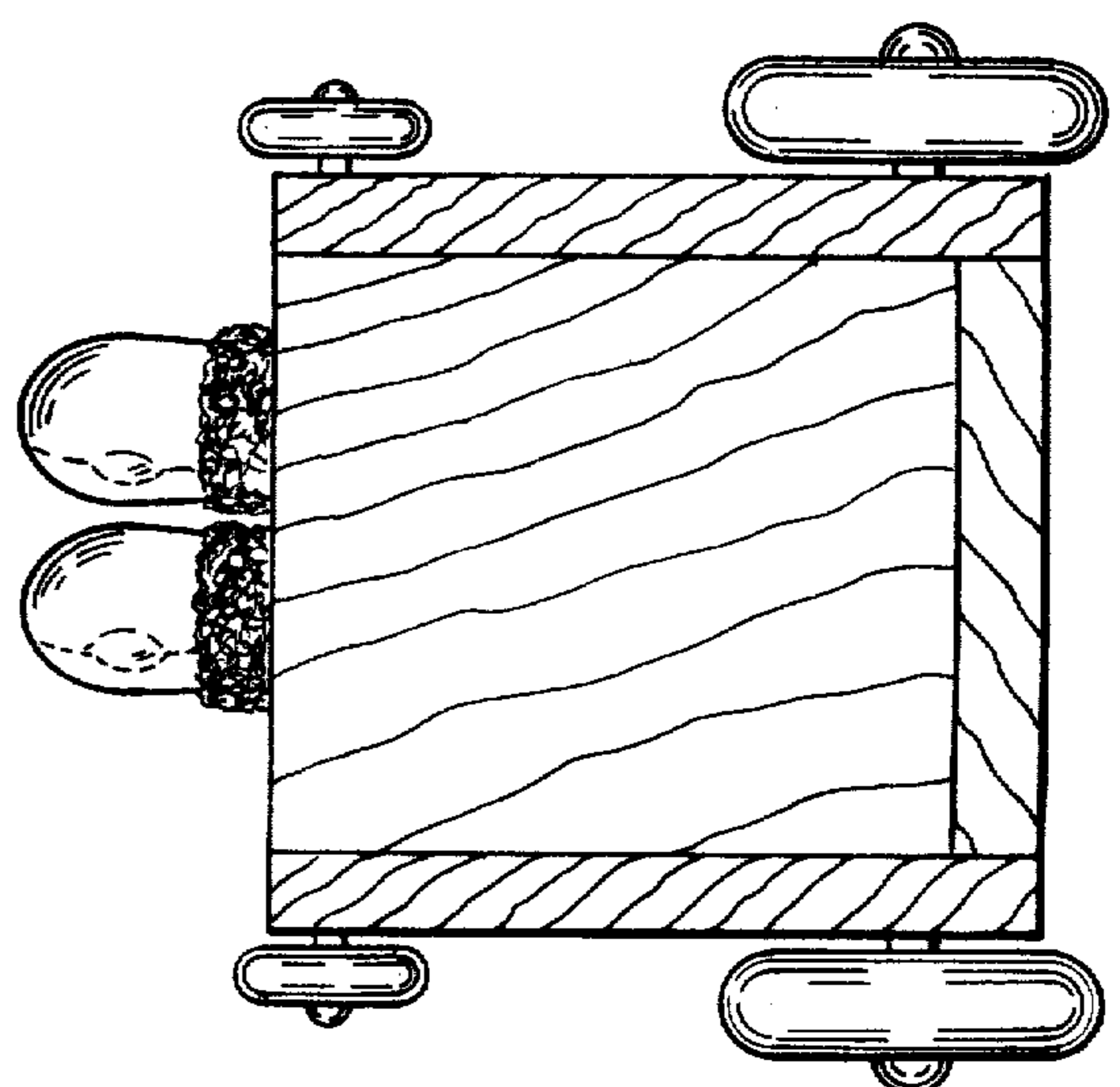
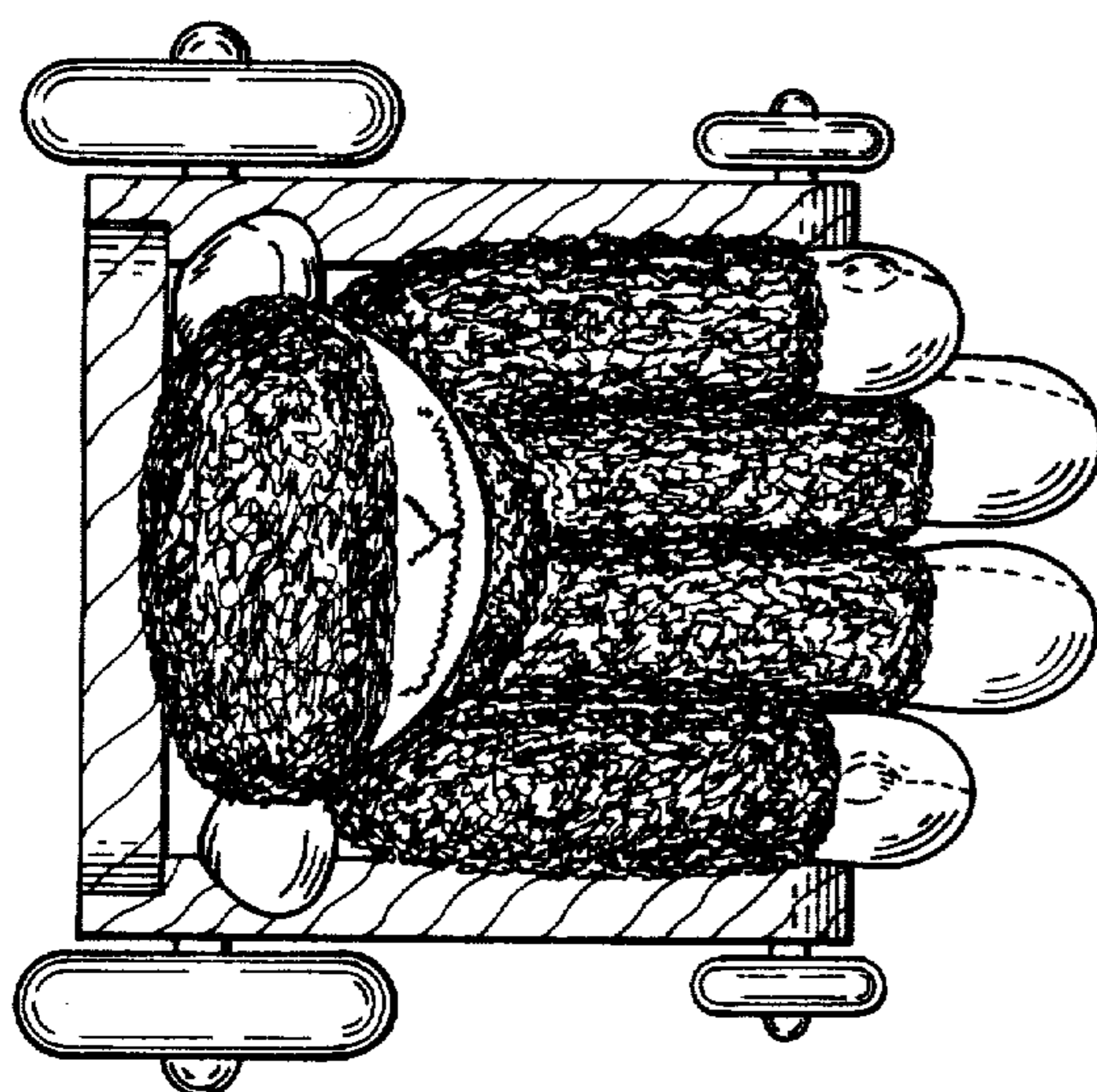
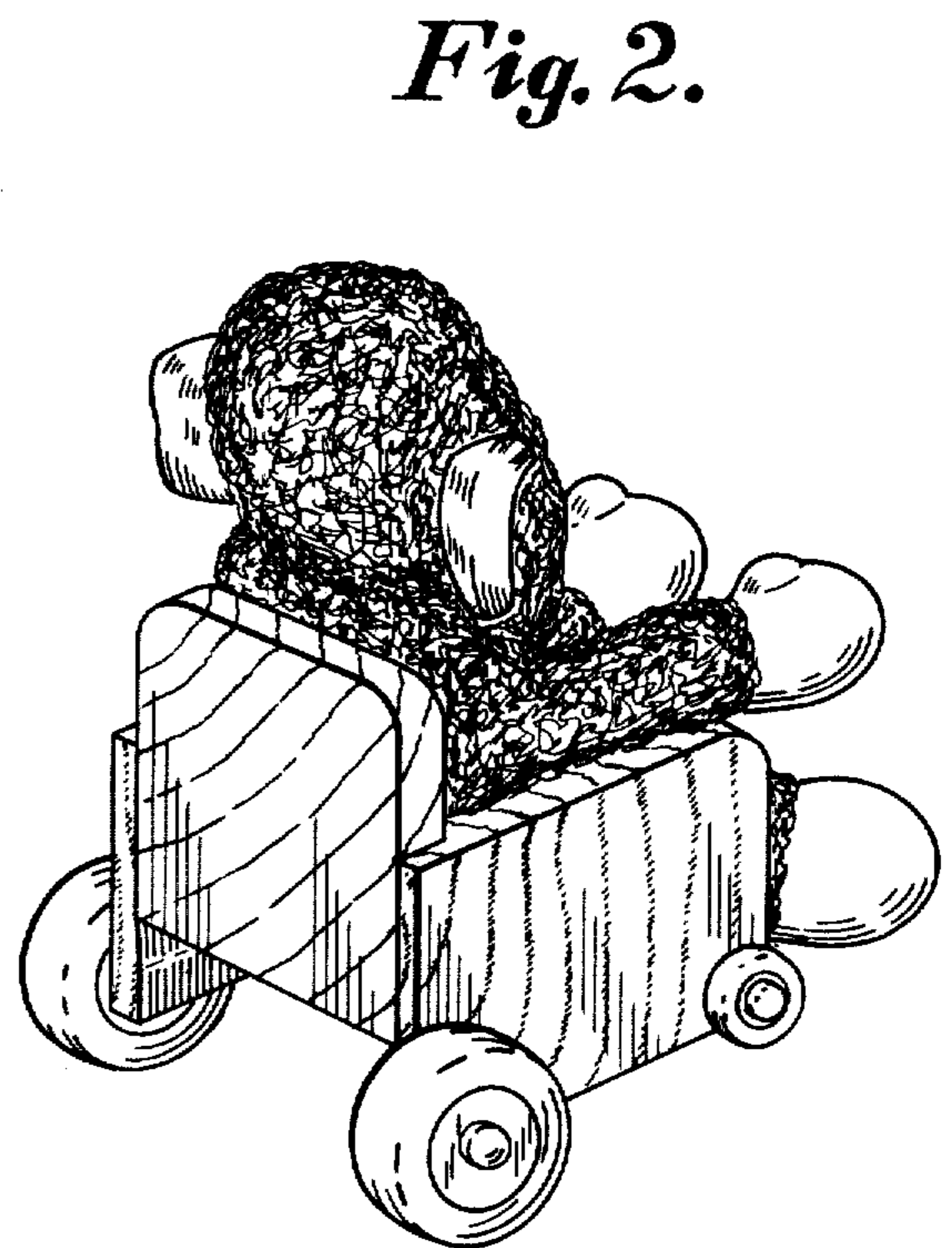
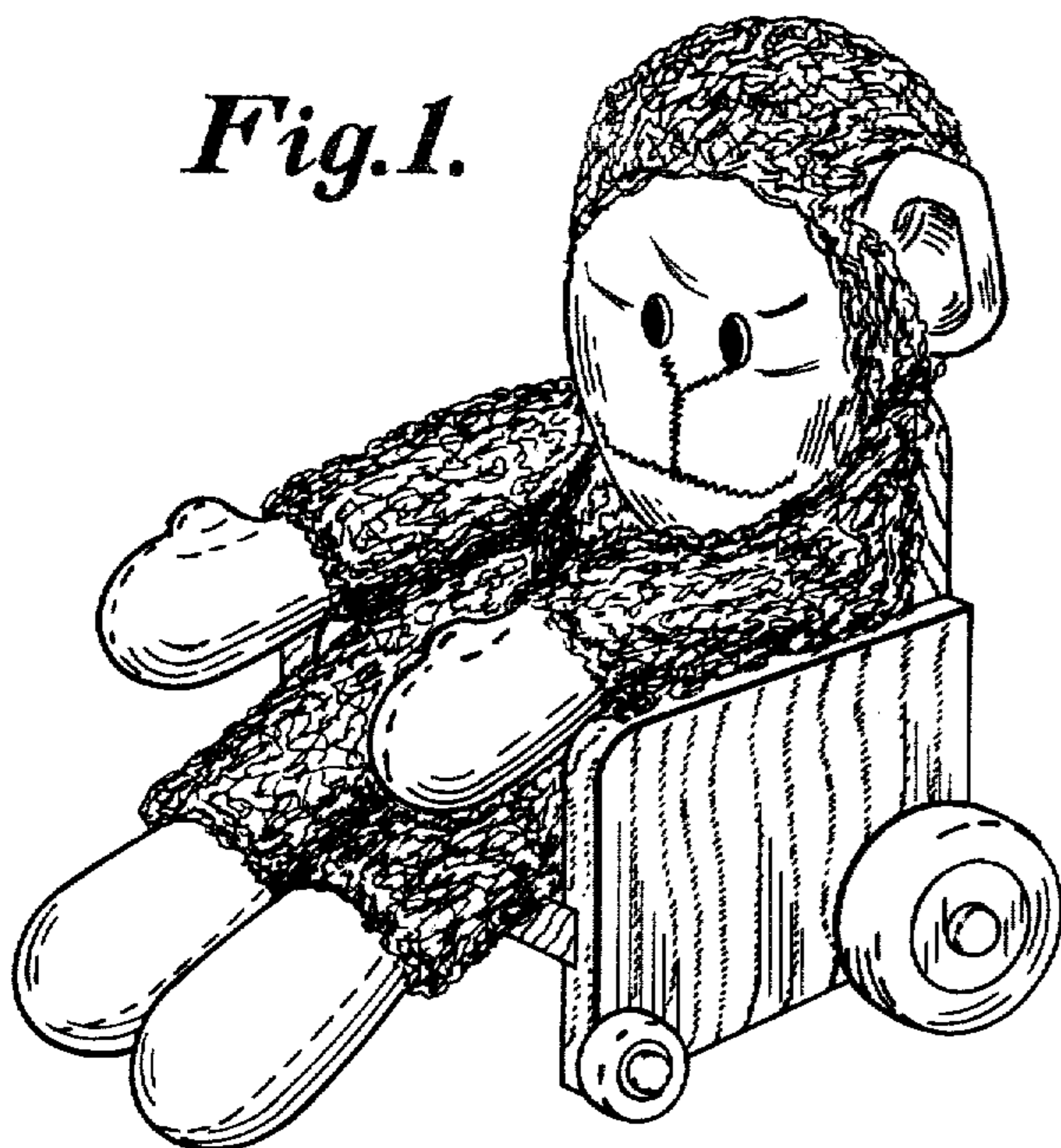
