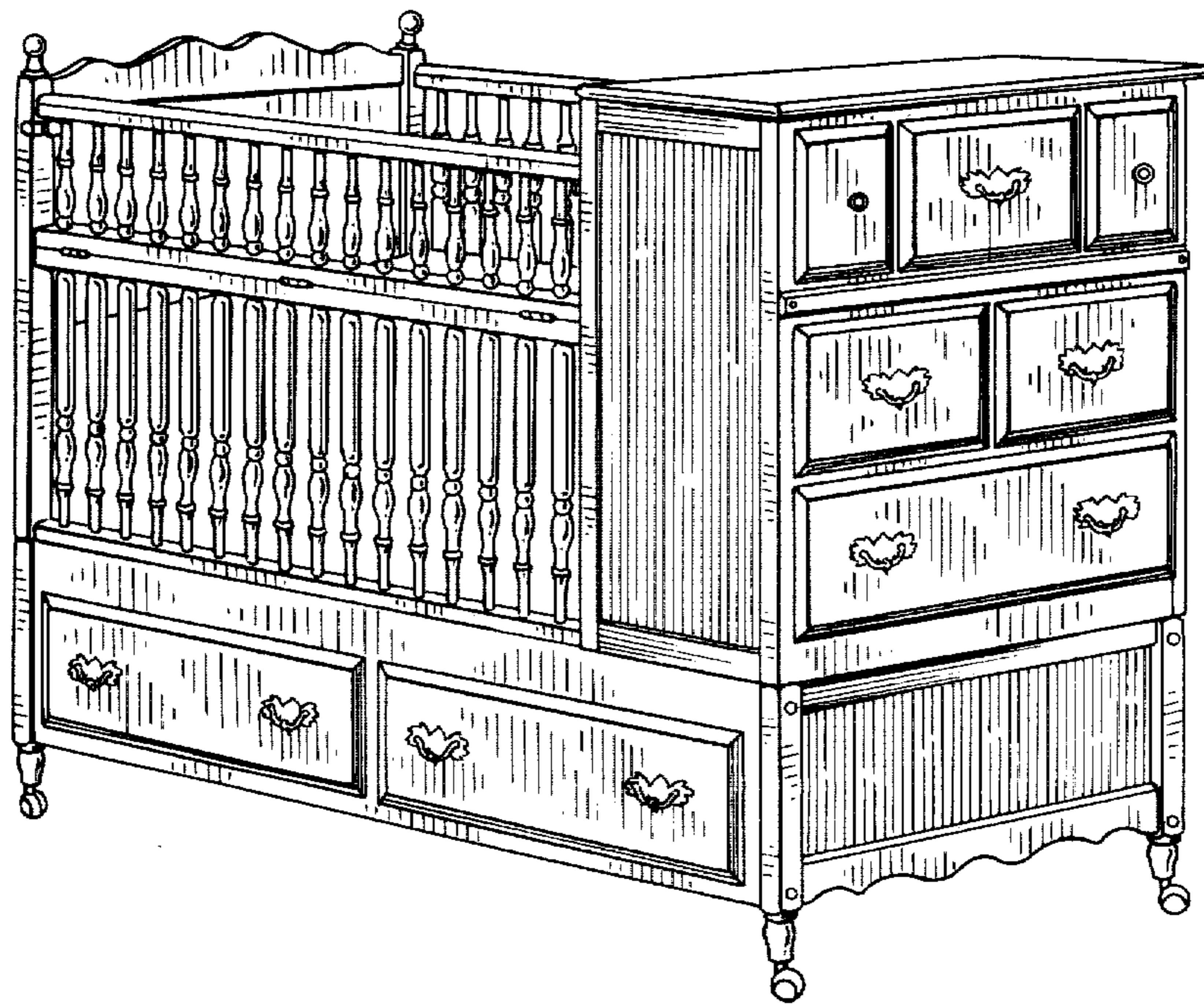

DESCRIPTION

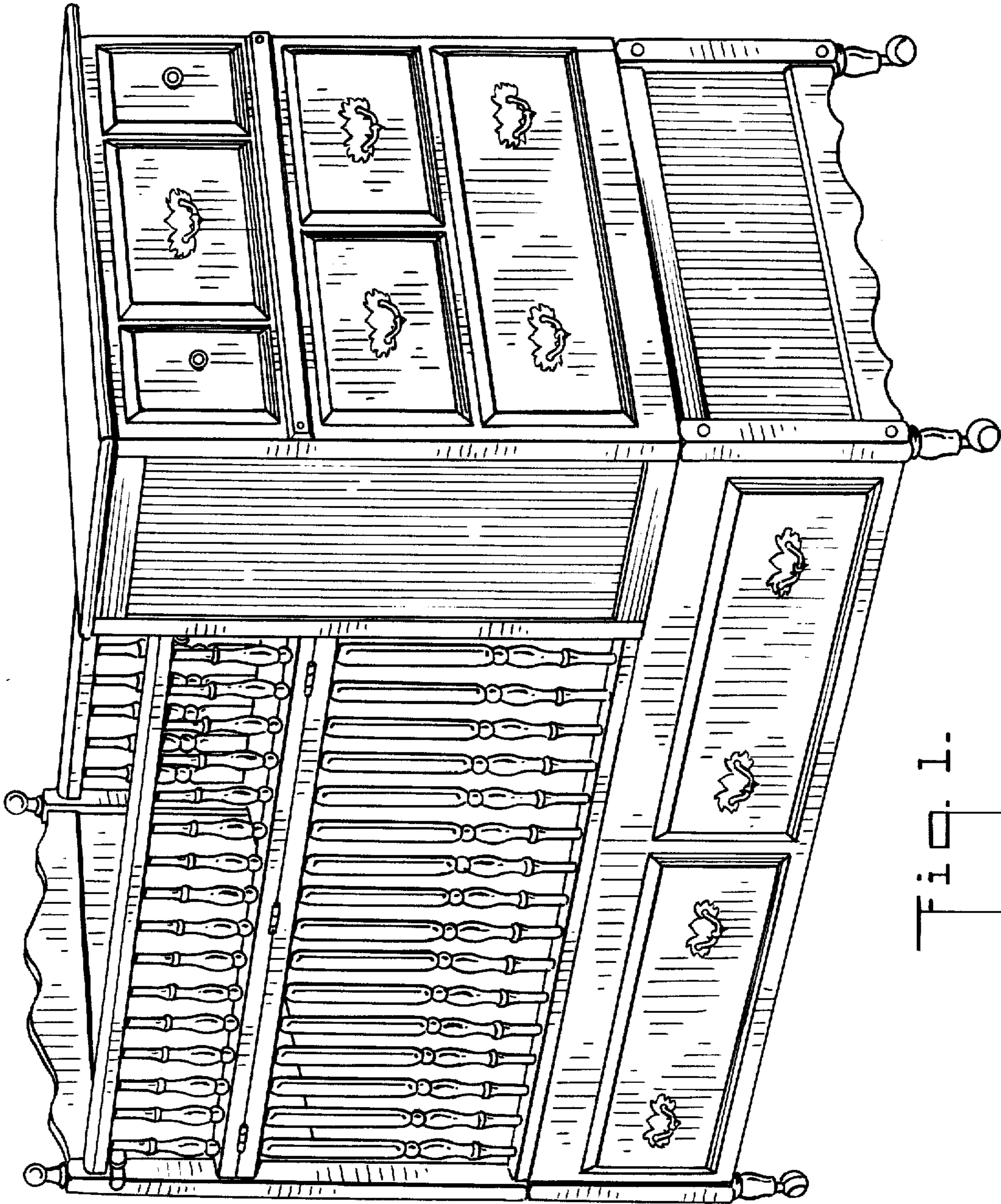

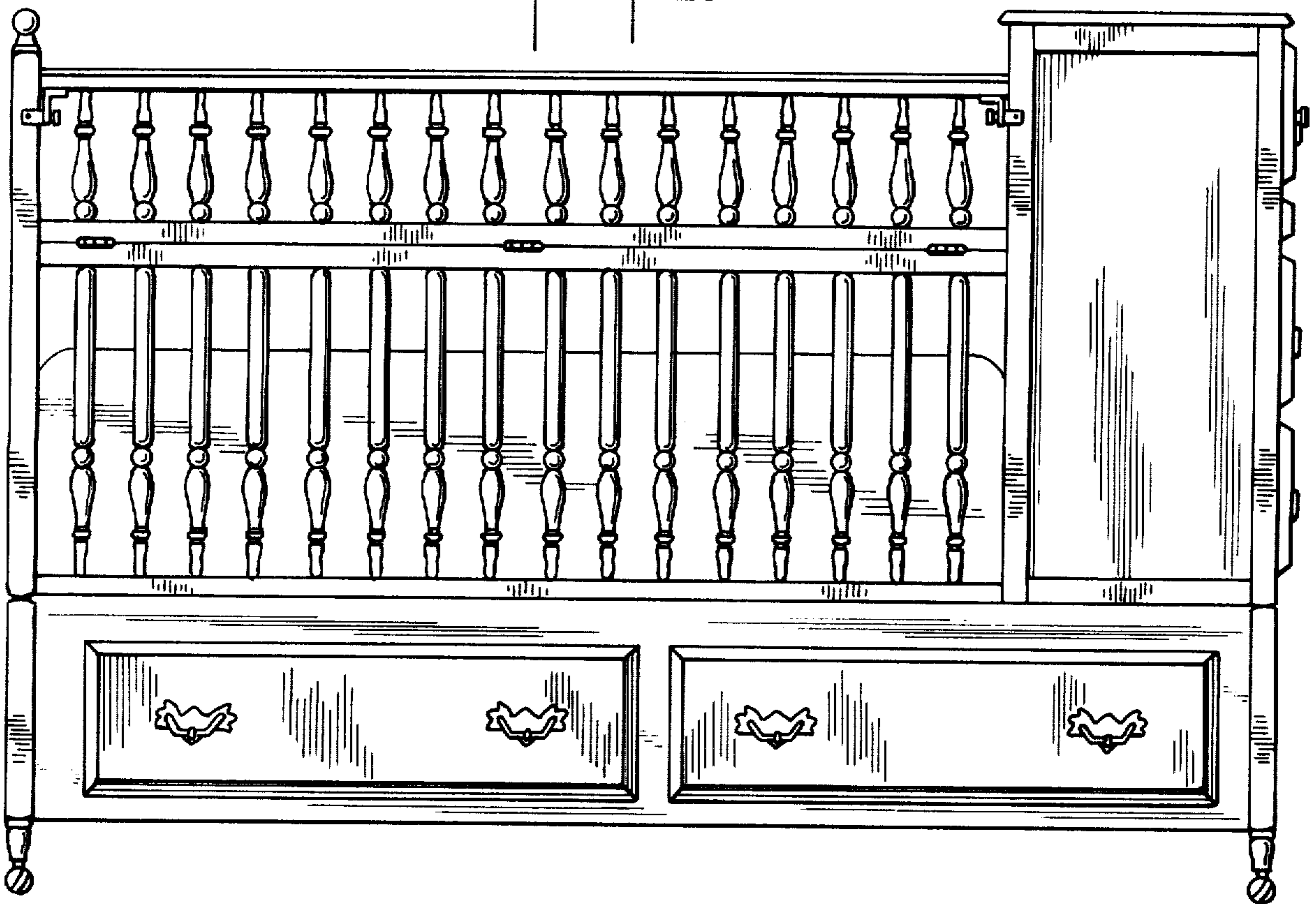

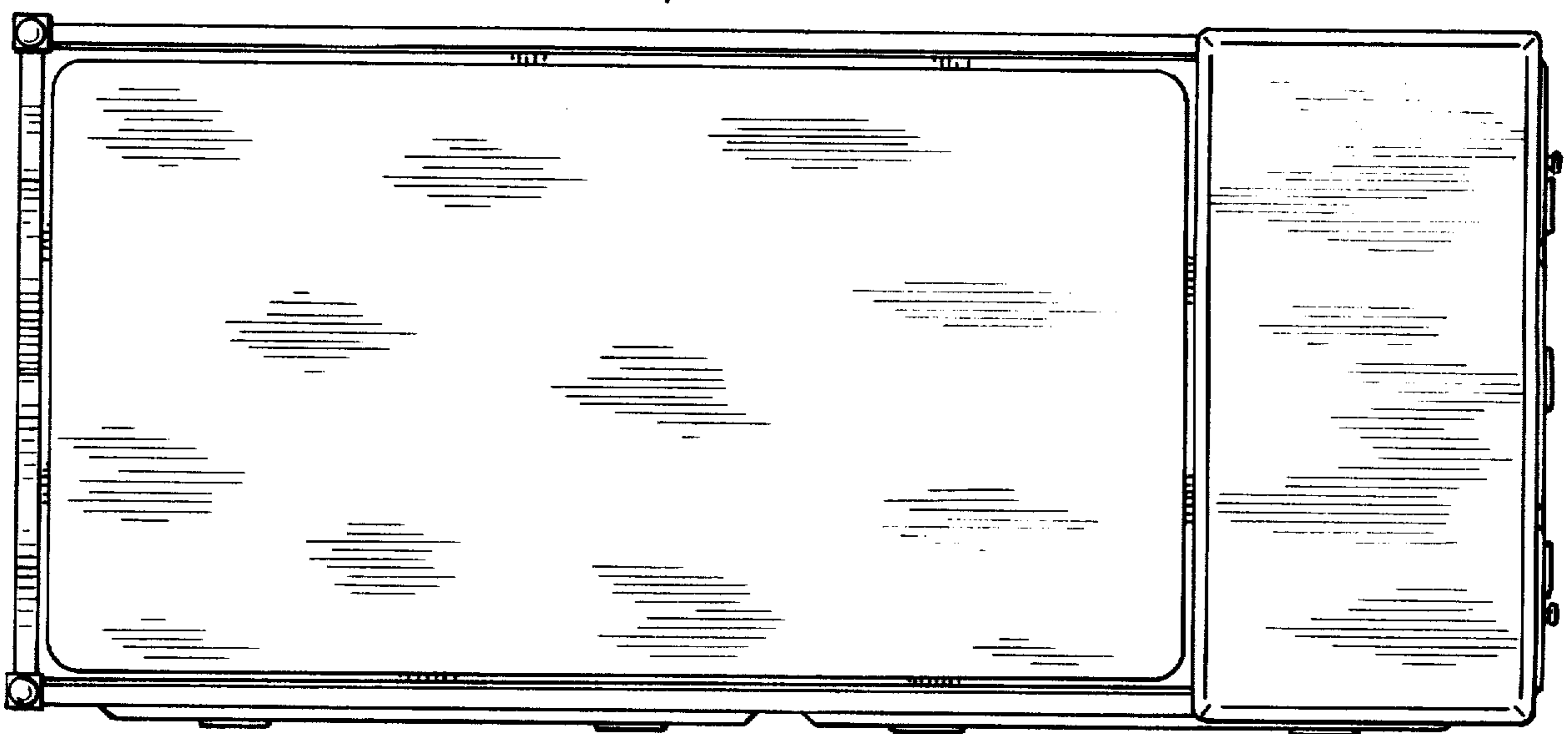

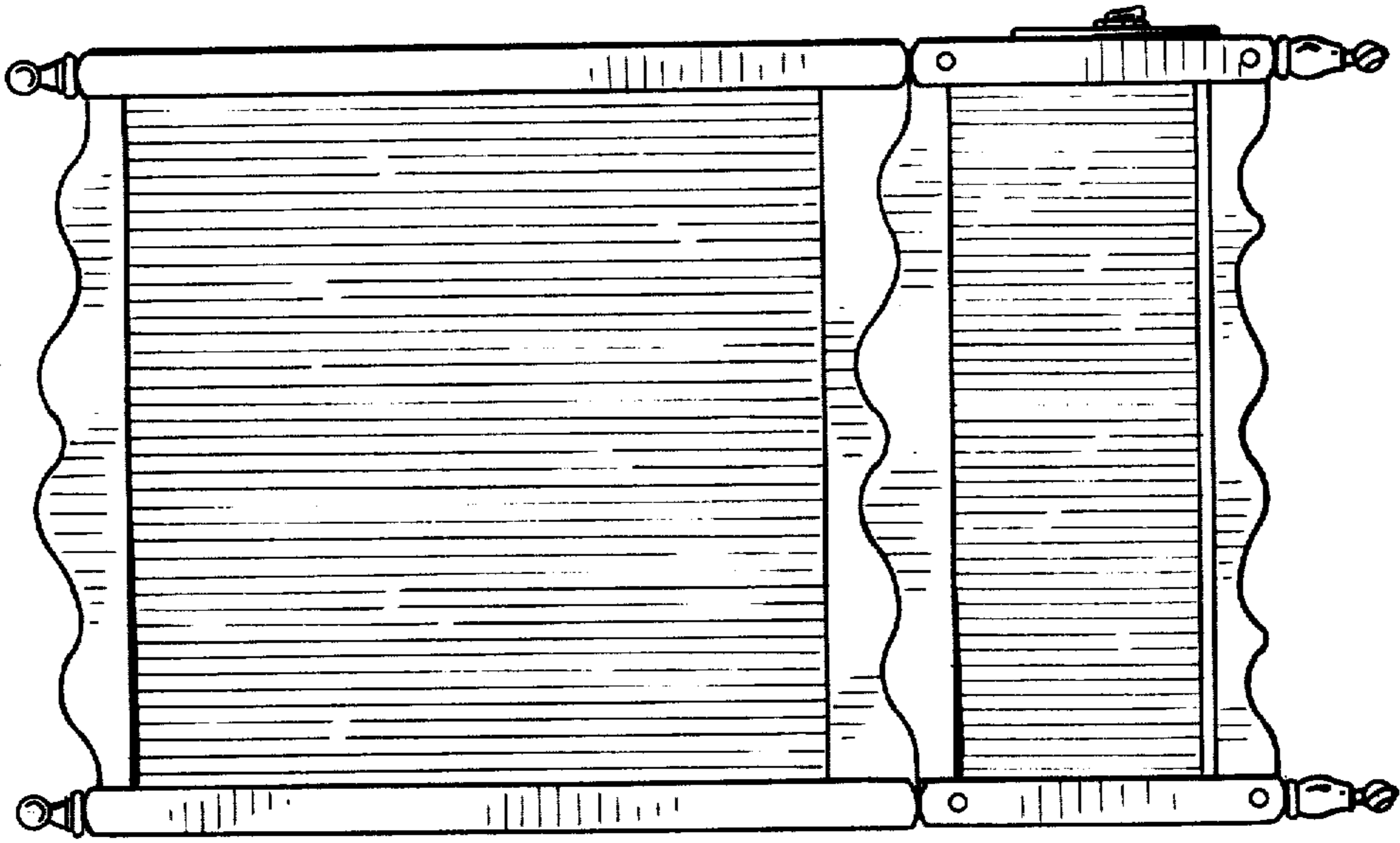

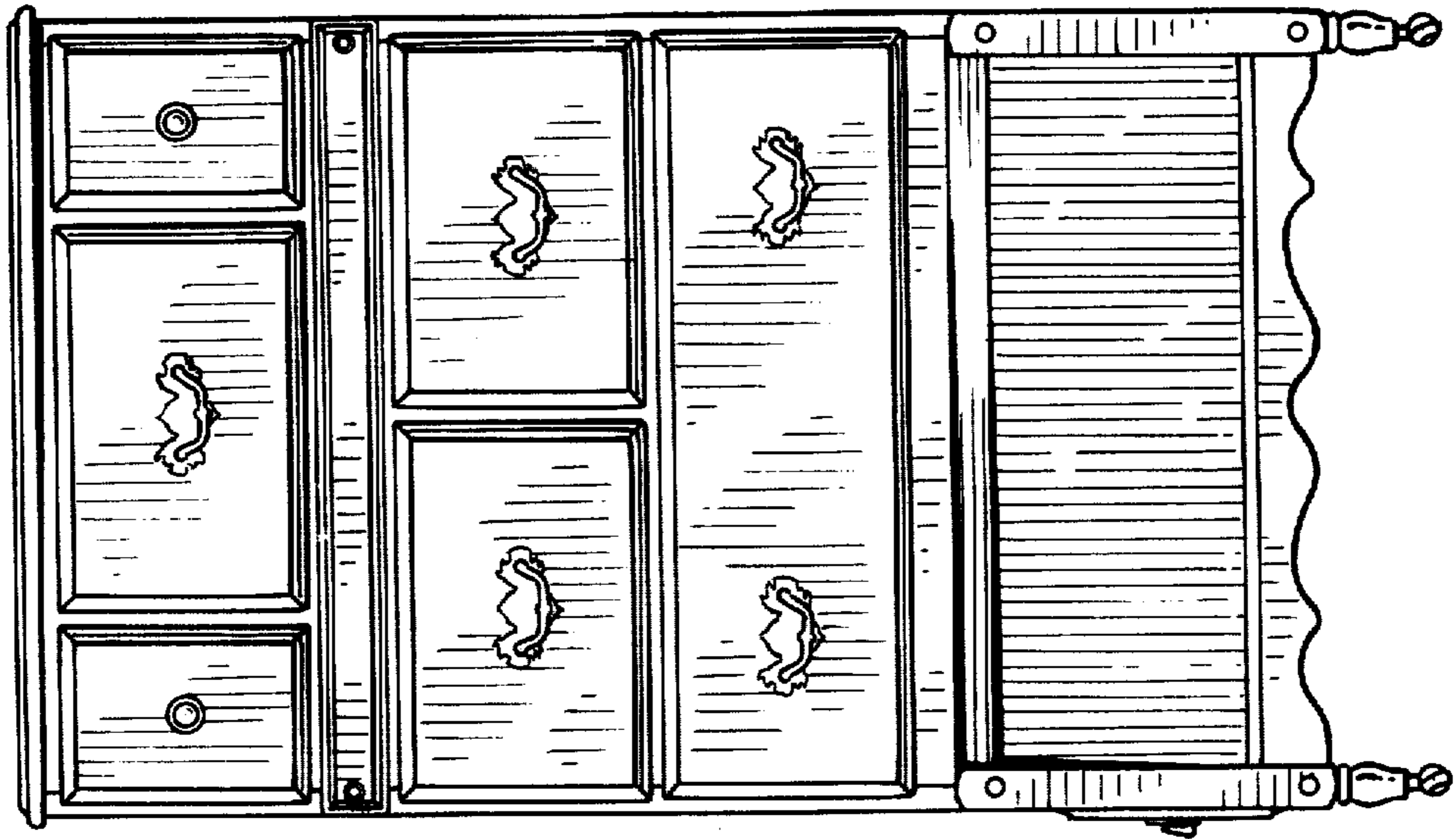
