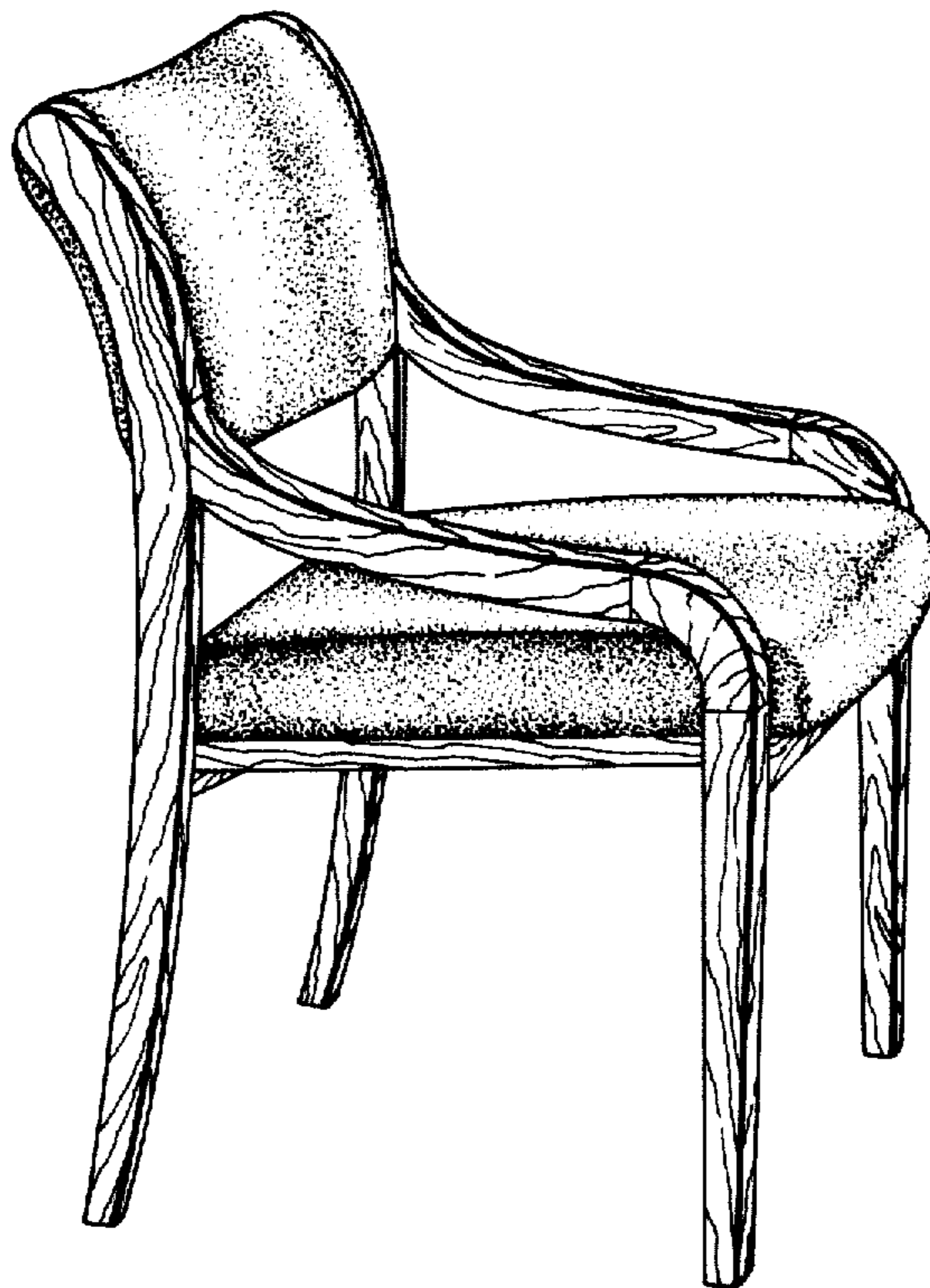
[57] CLAIM

FIG. 2 is a three dimensional perspective view of a chair showing my new design, the rear, left side, and top of the chair to advantage.



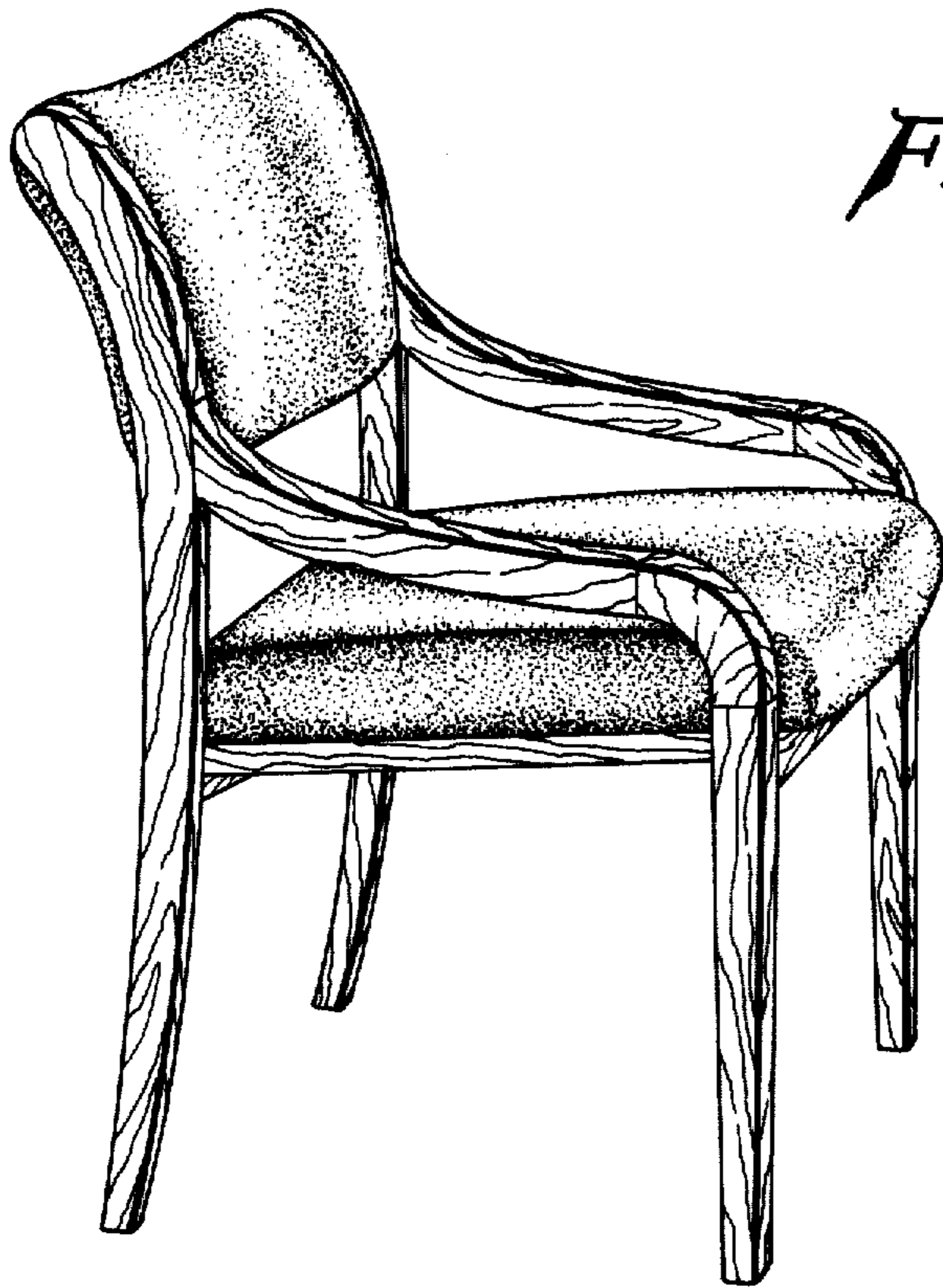
