[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tab for an easy opening can end, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a tab for an easy opening can end showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a sectional view taken longitudinally through the middle of FIG. 1.

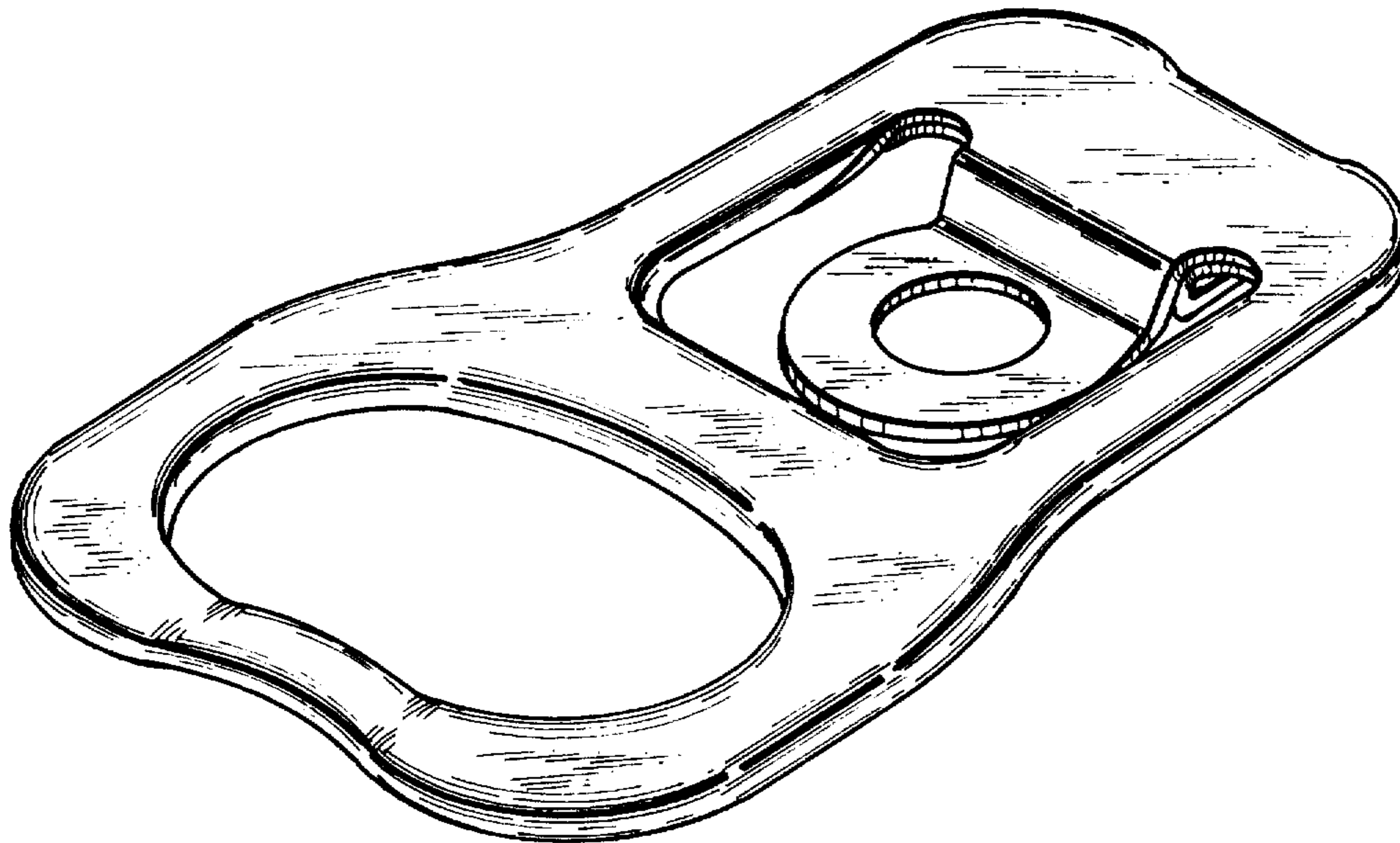

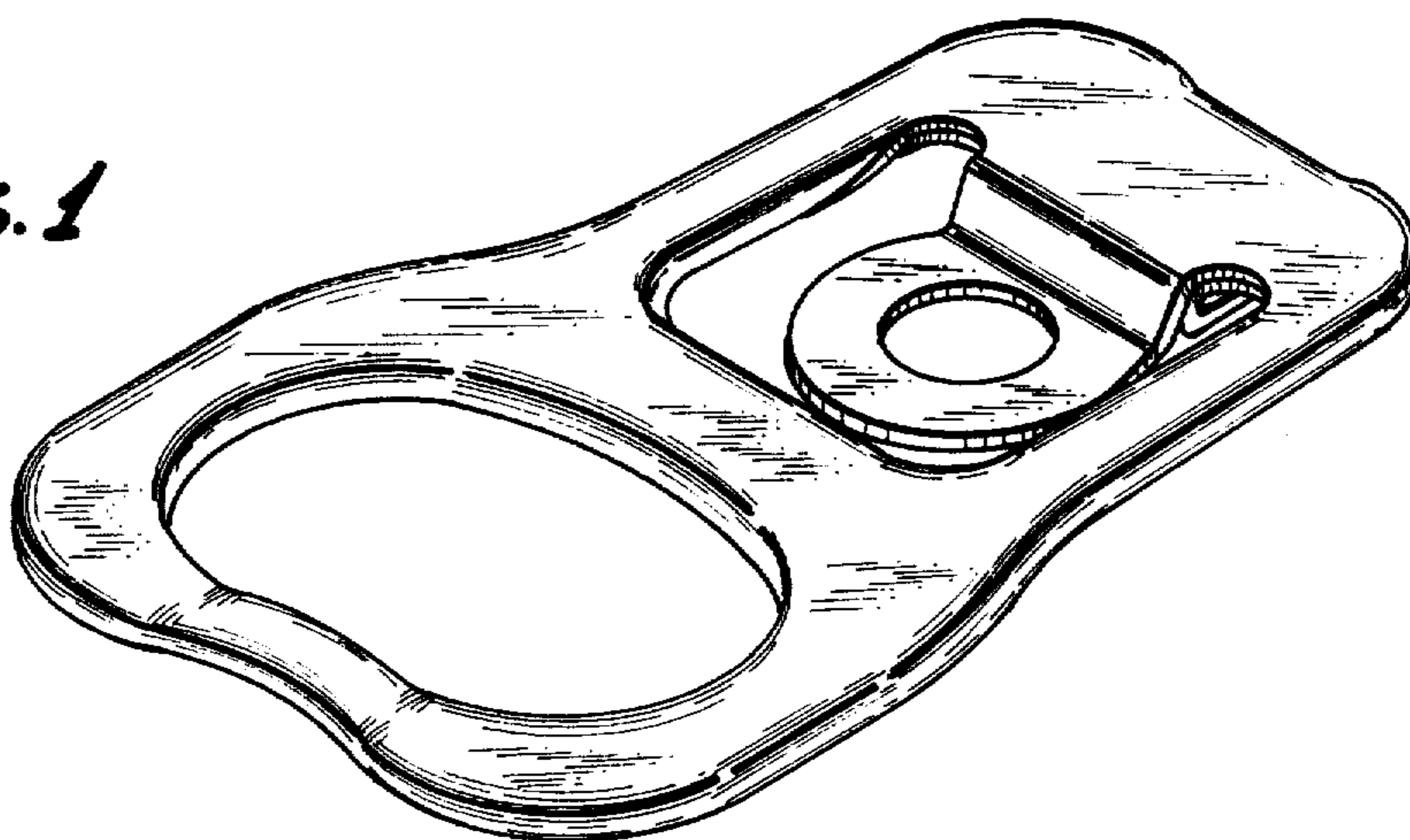

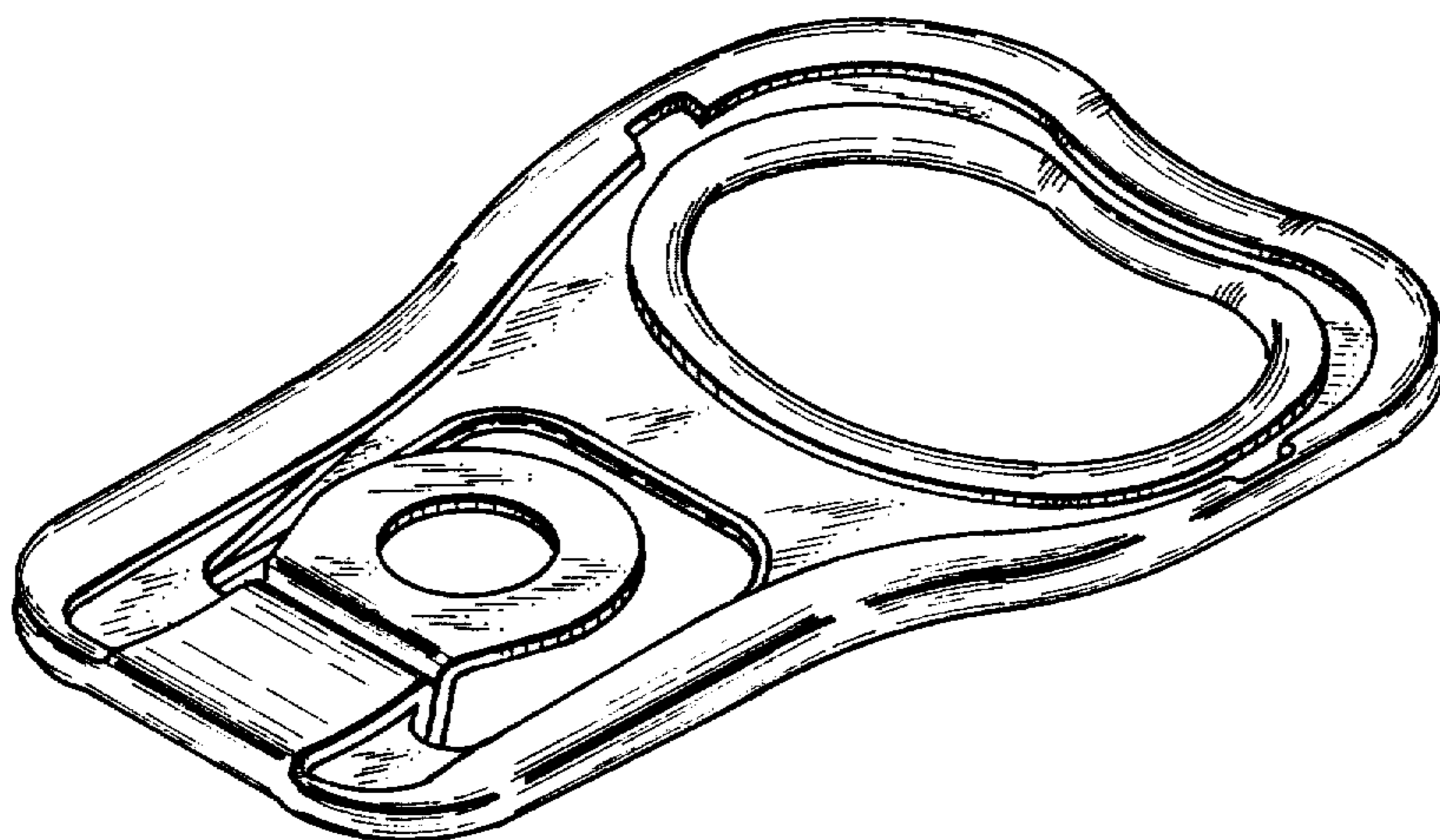
