The ornamental design for a puzzle toy, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom, right side and rear perspective view of a puzzle toy showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

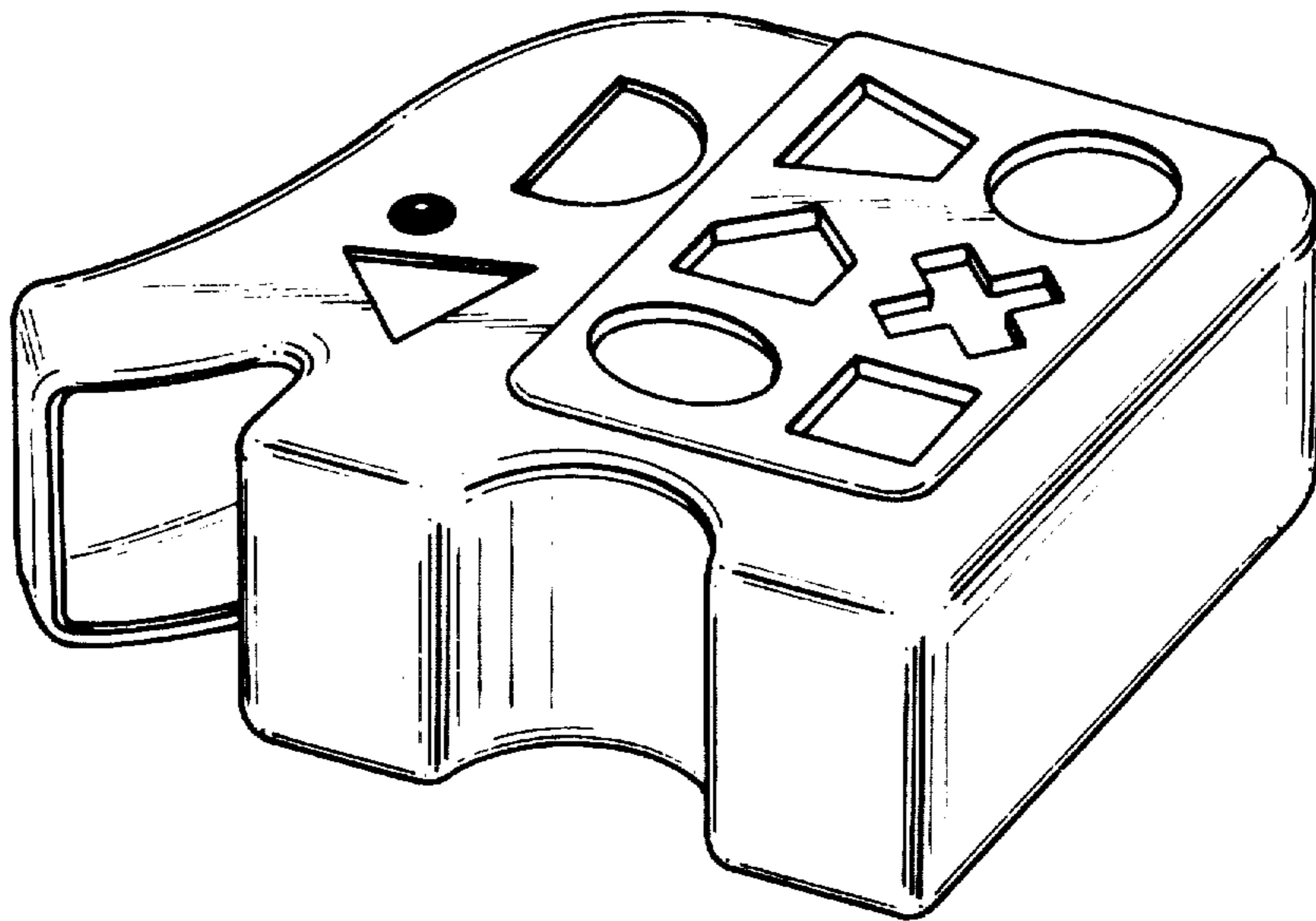

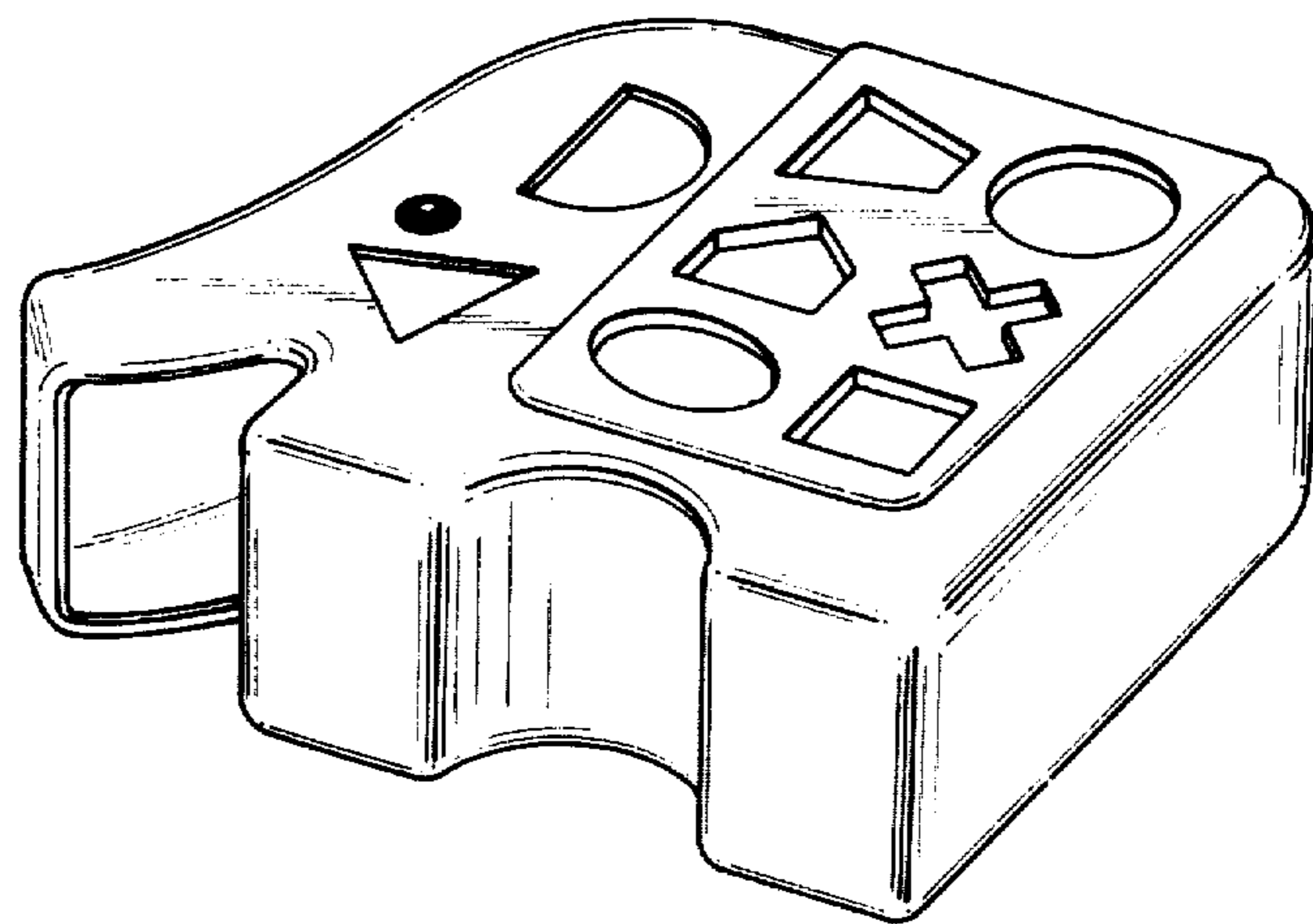

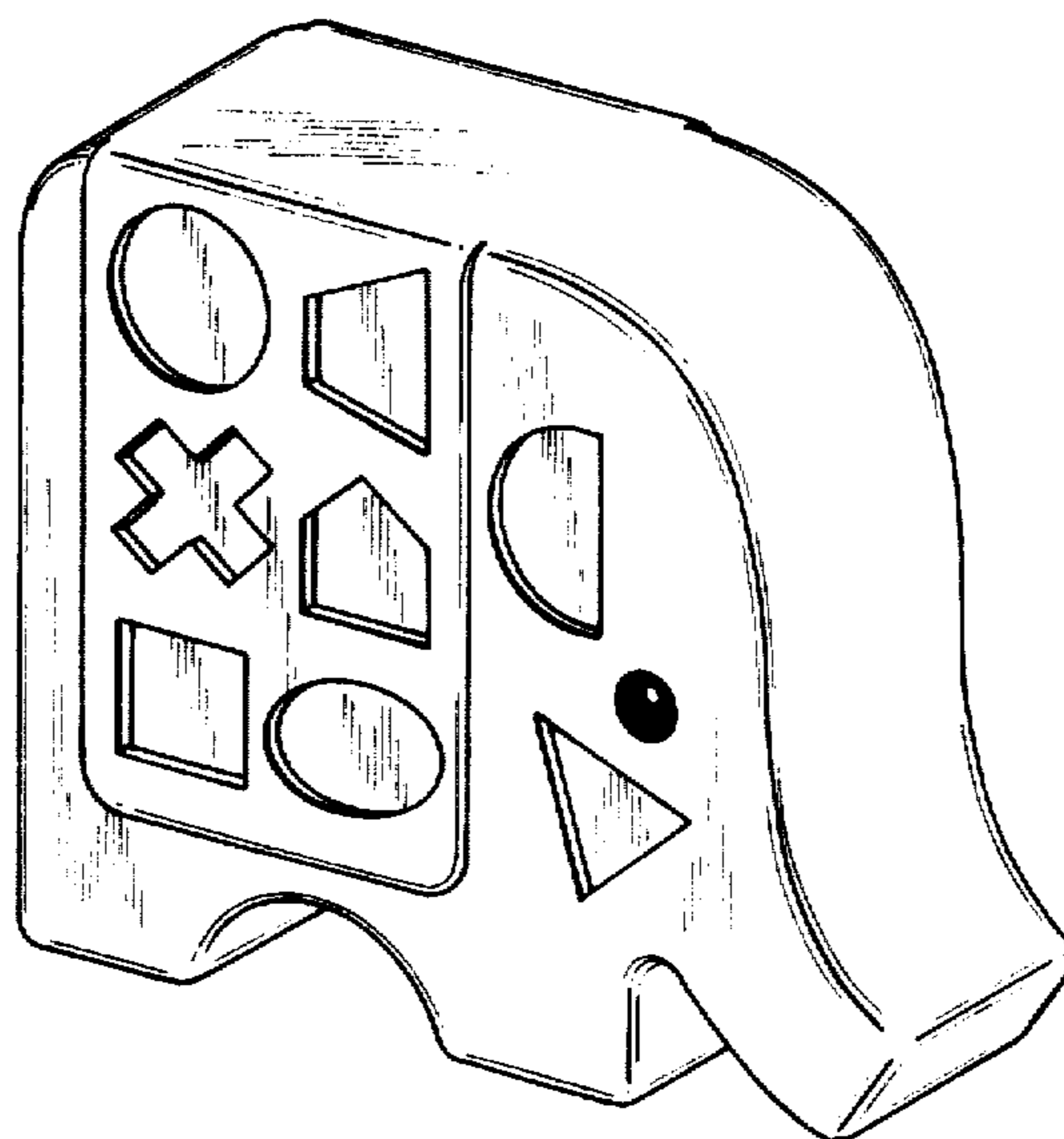

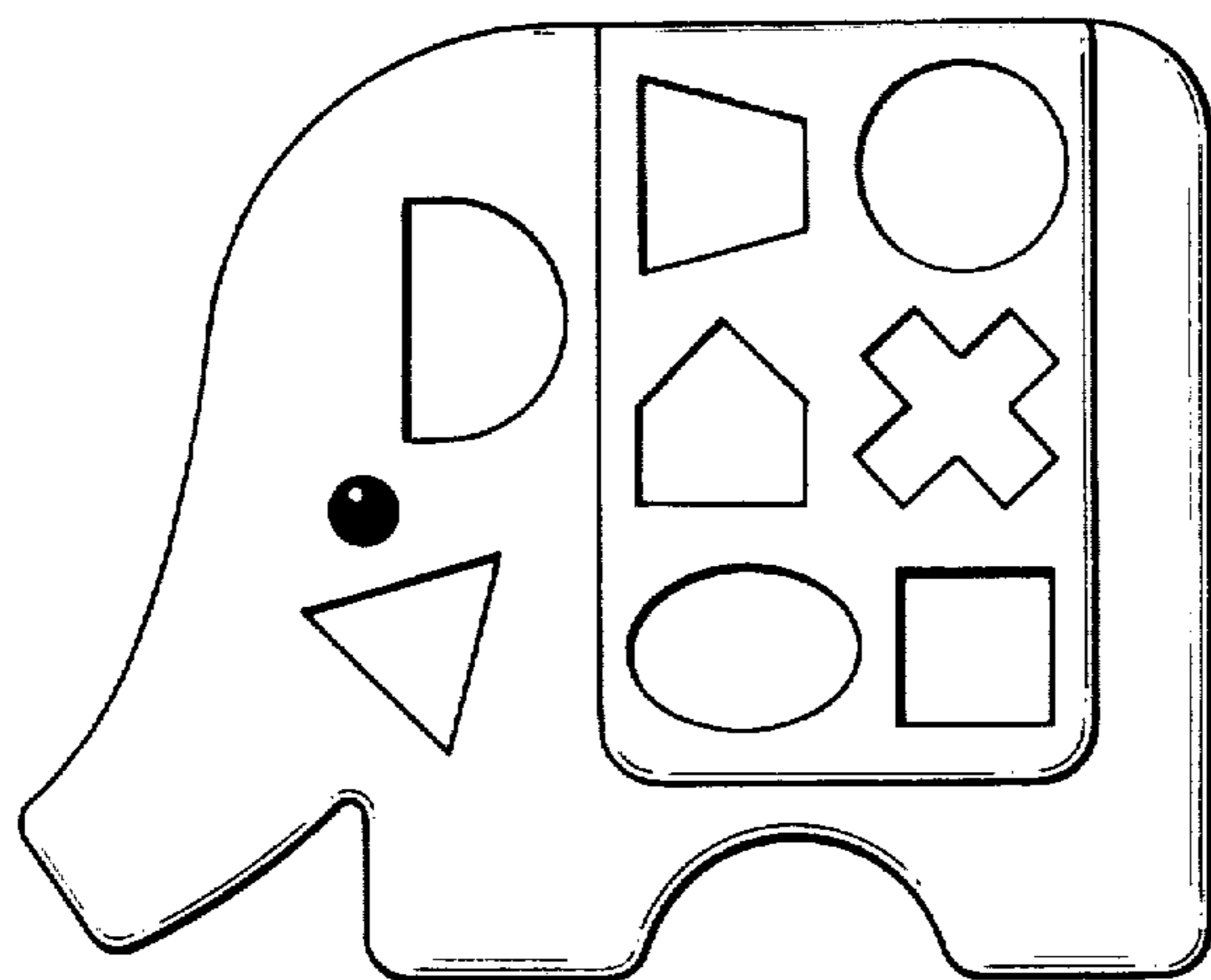

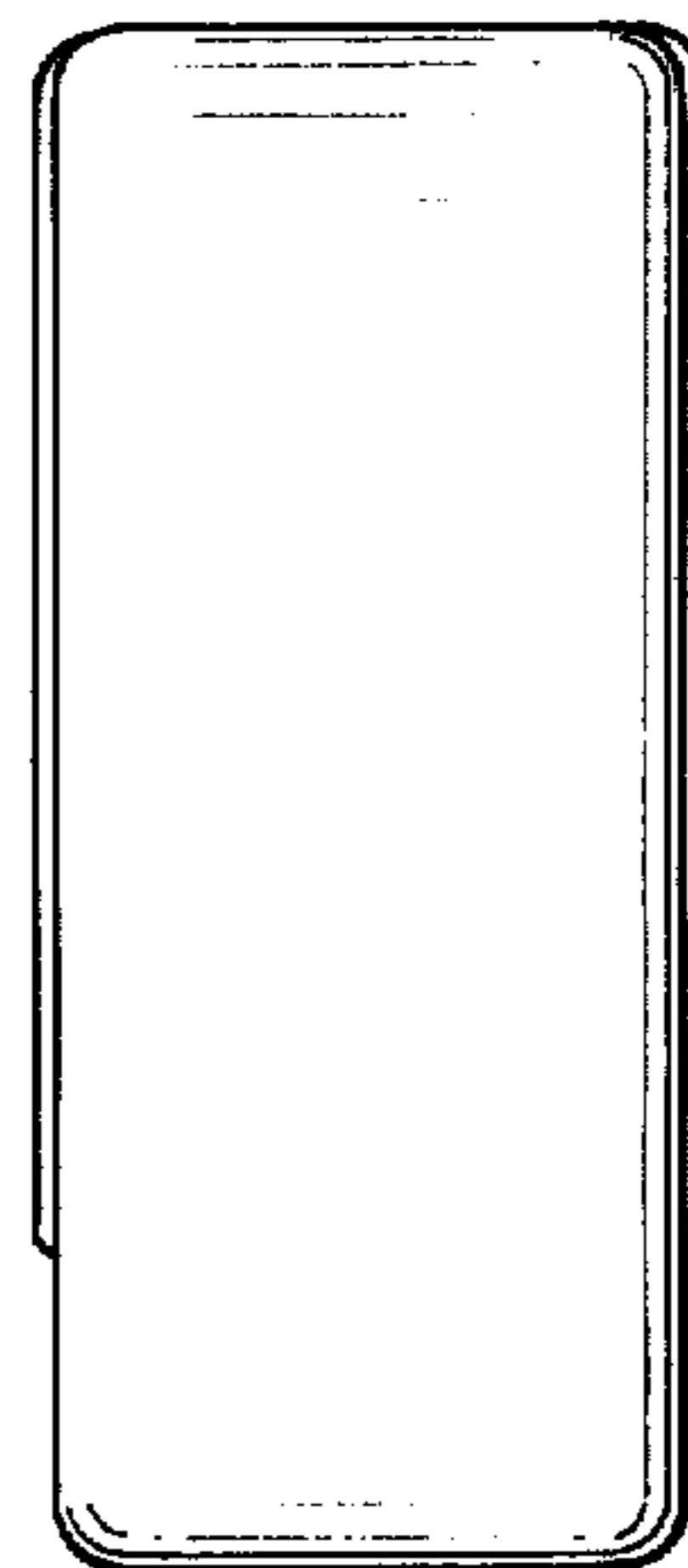

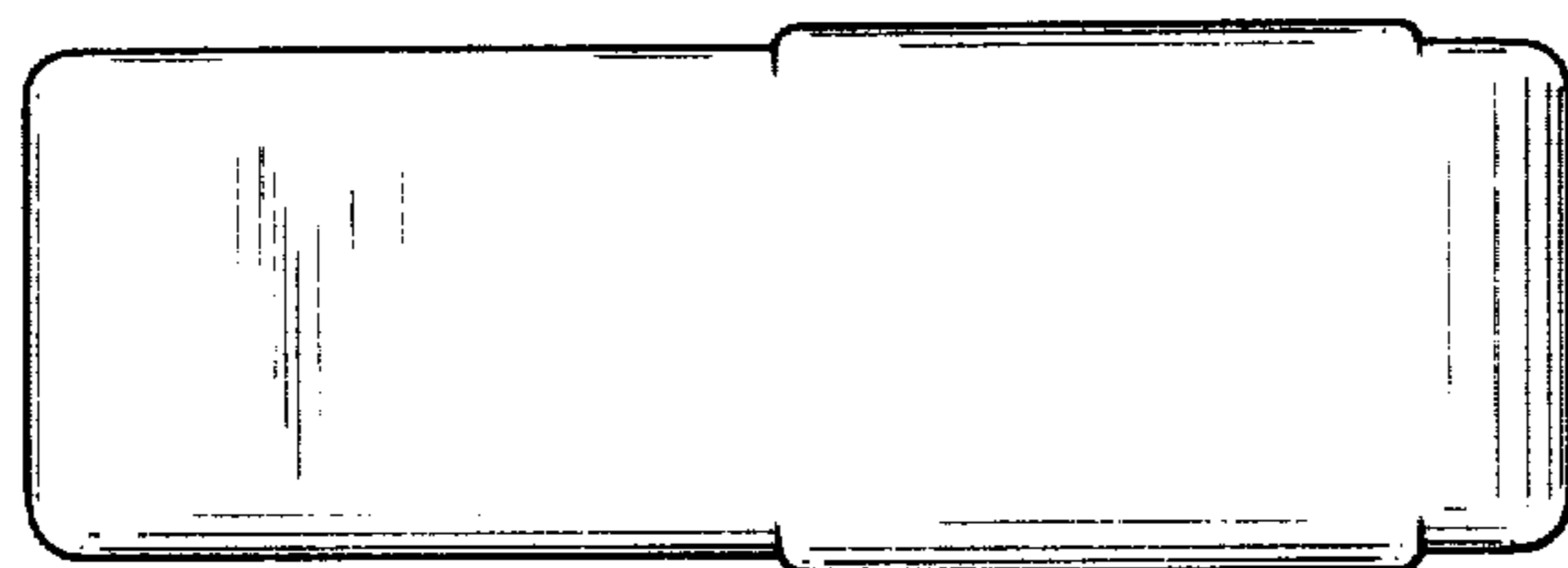

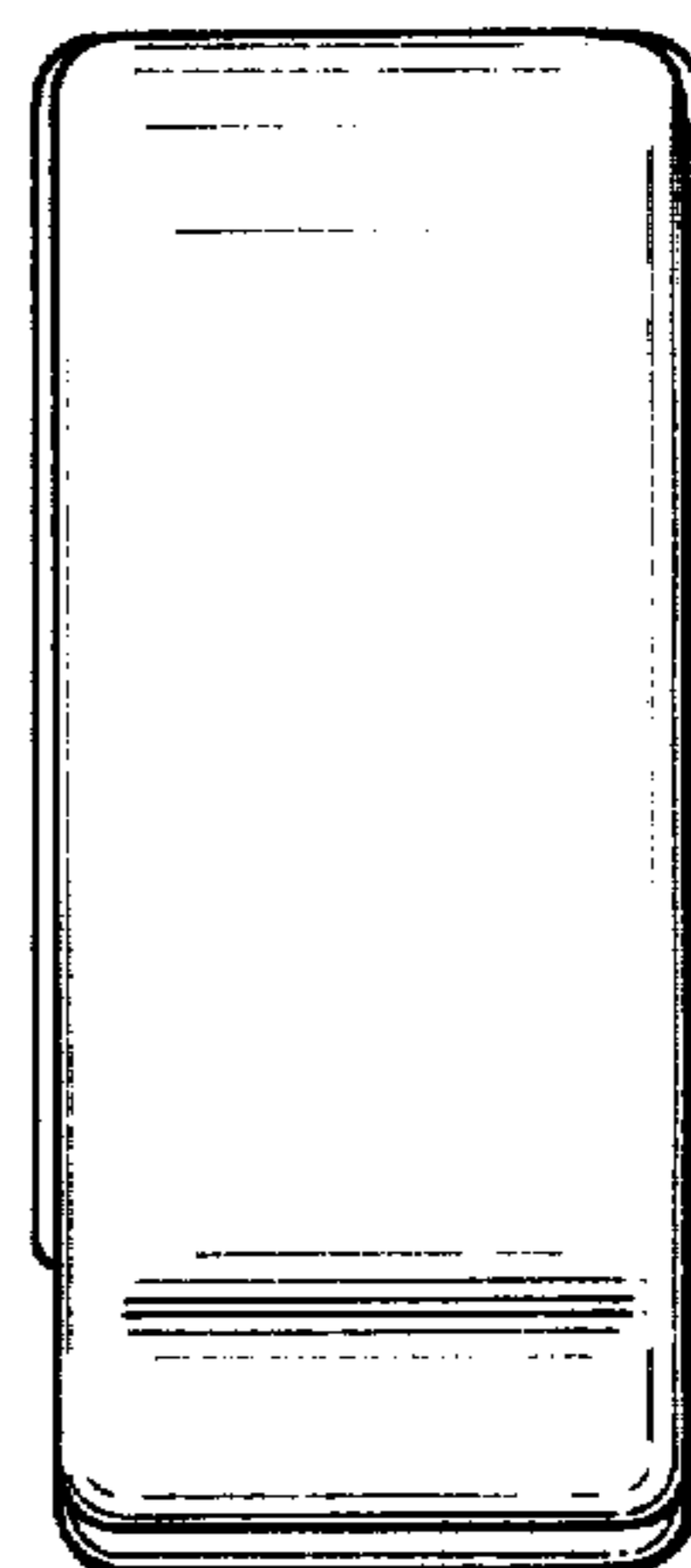
