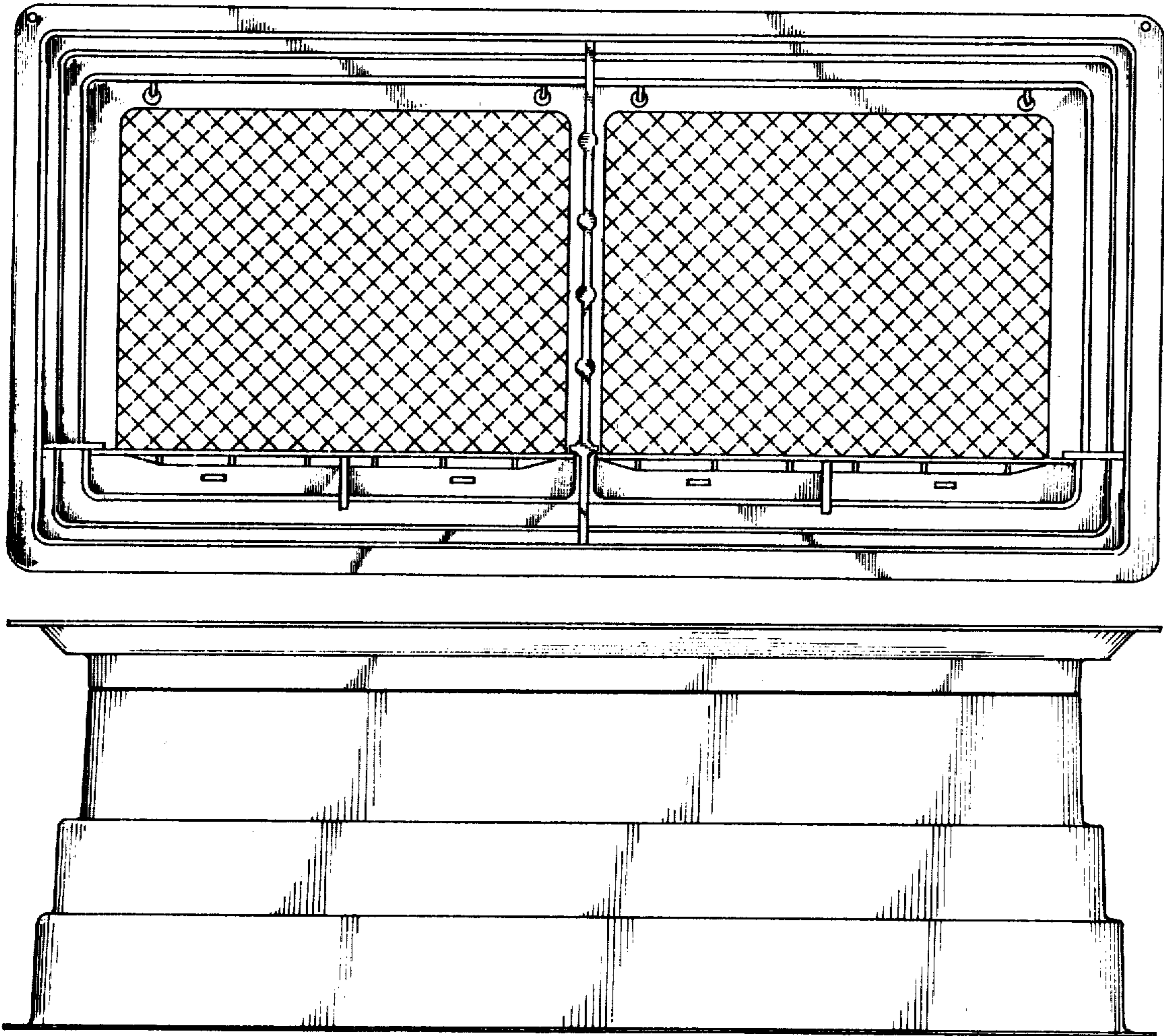
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the ventilator showing our new design;

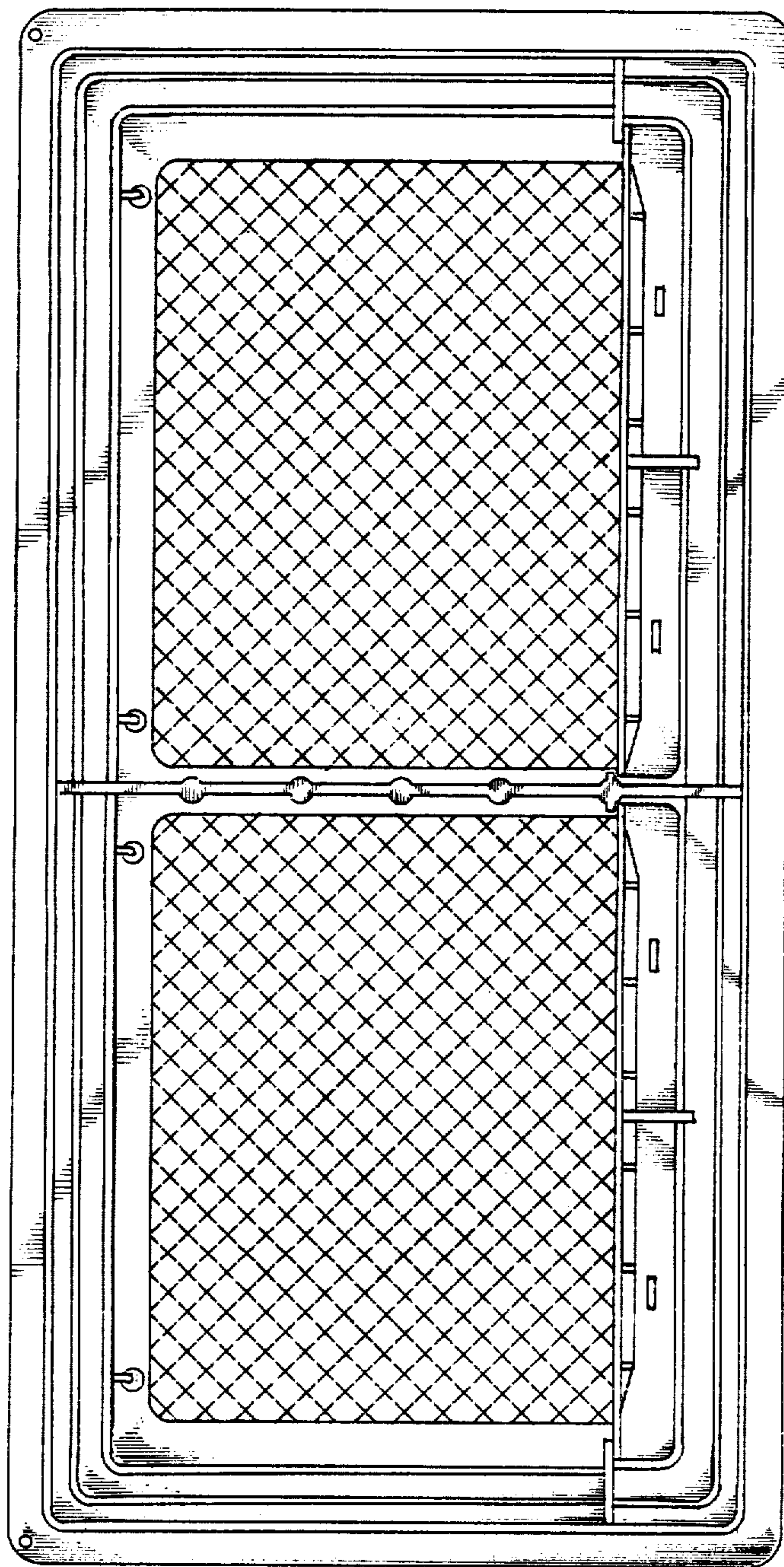

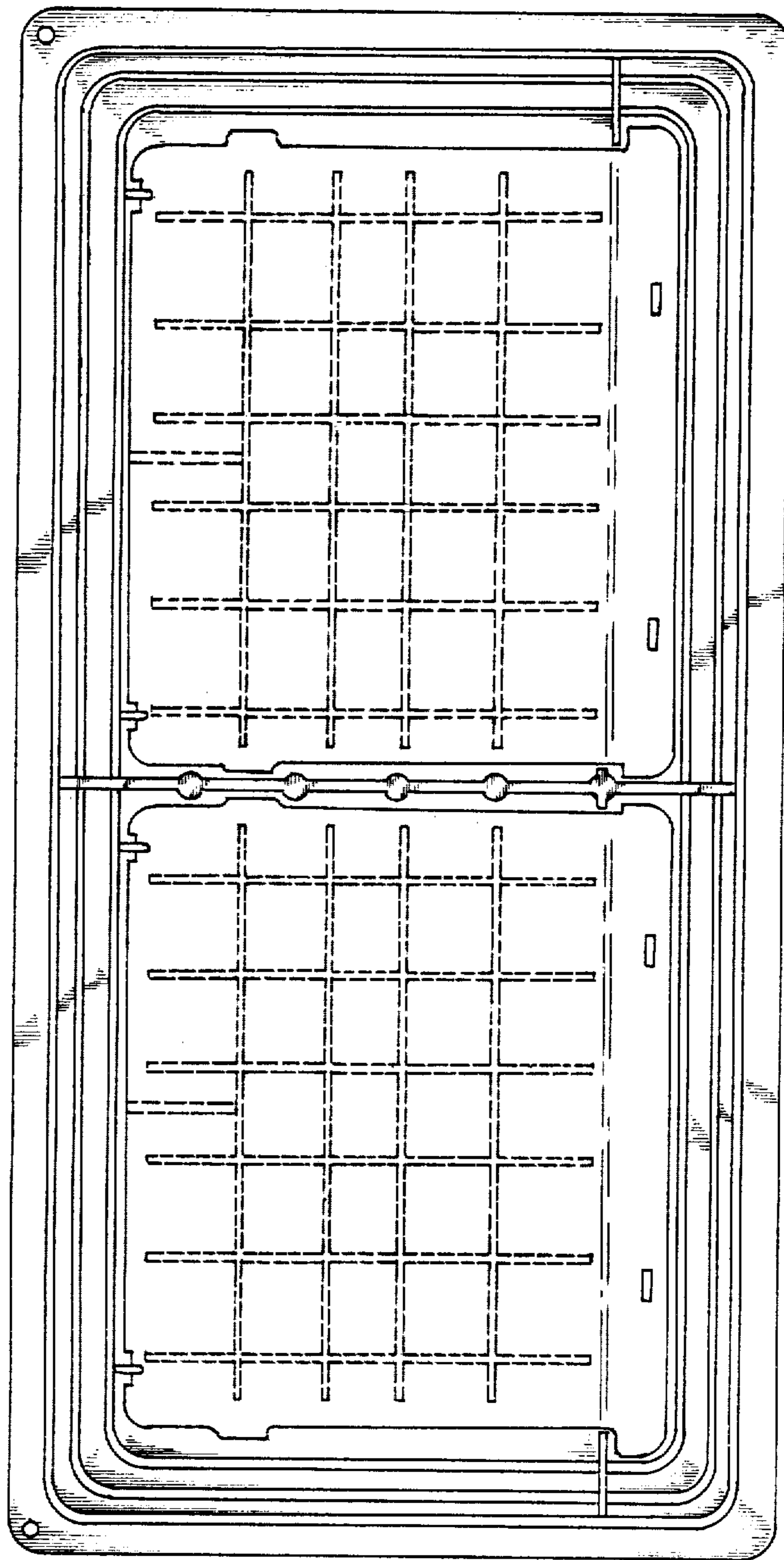

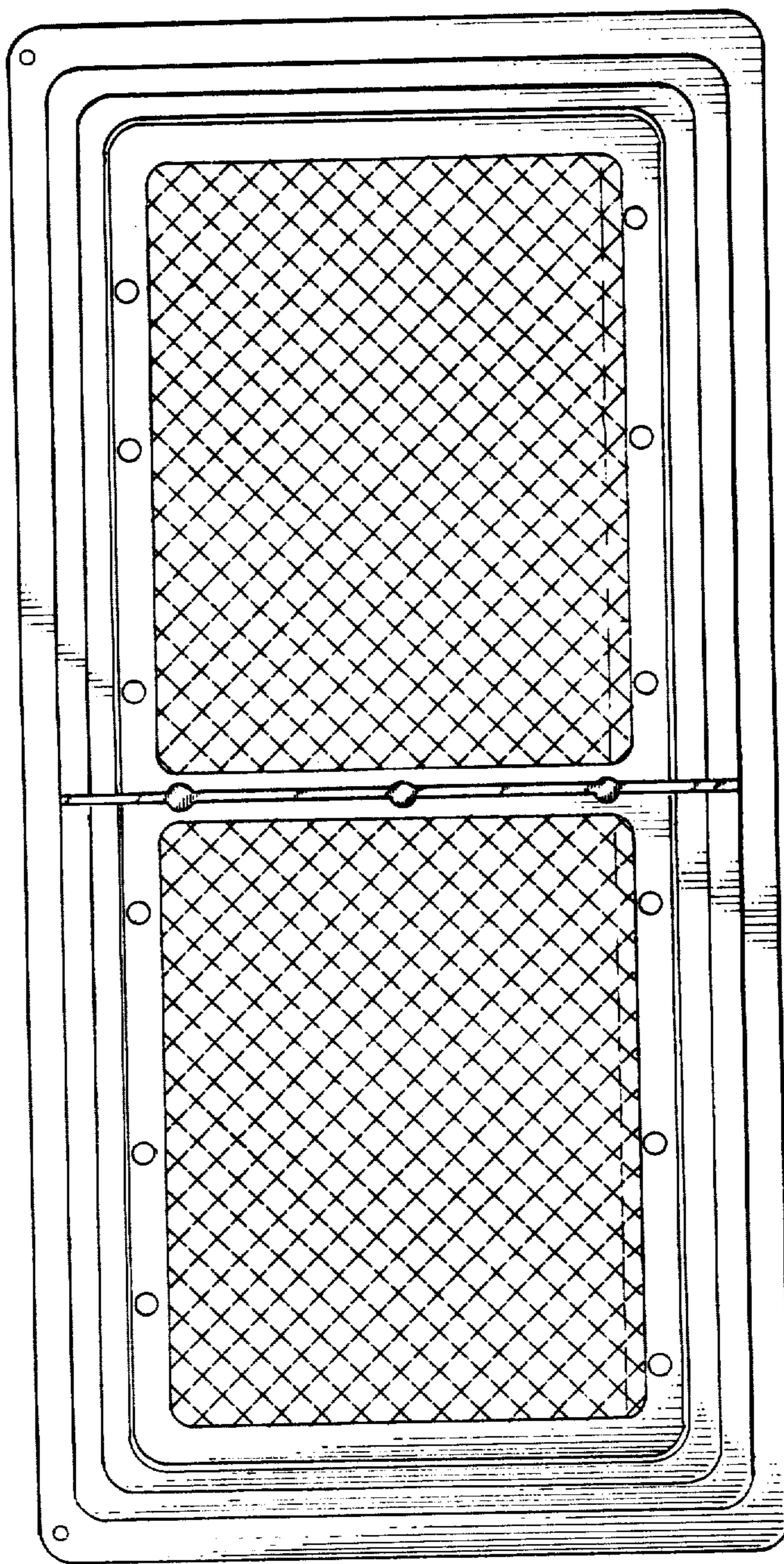

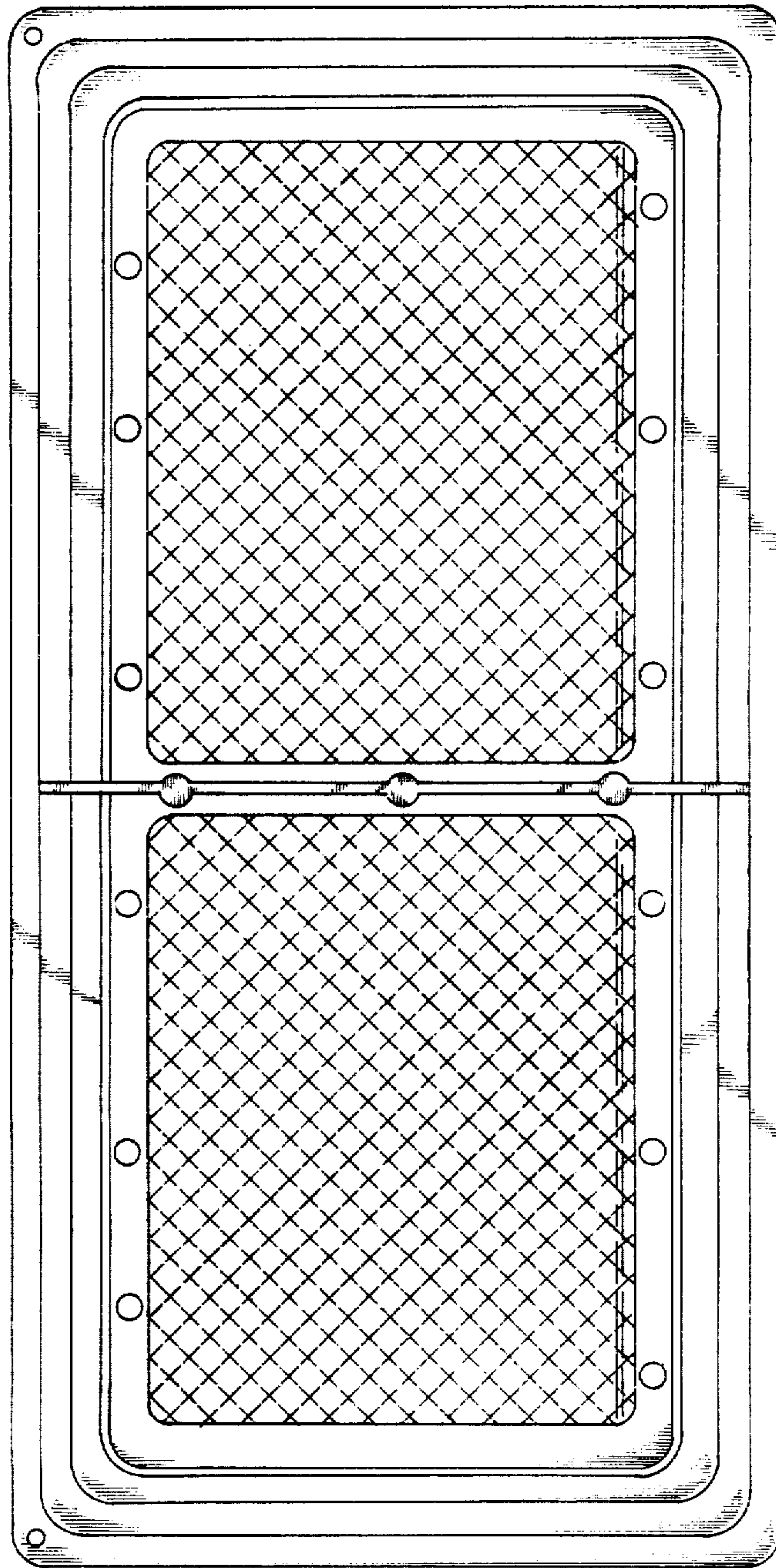

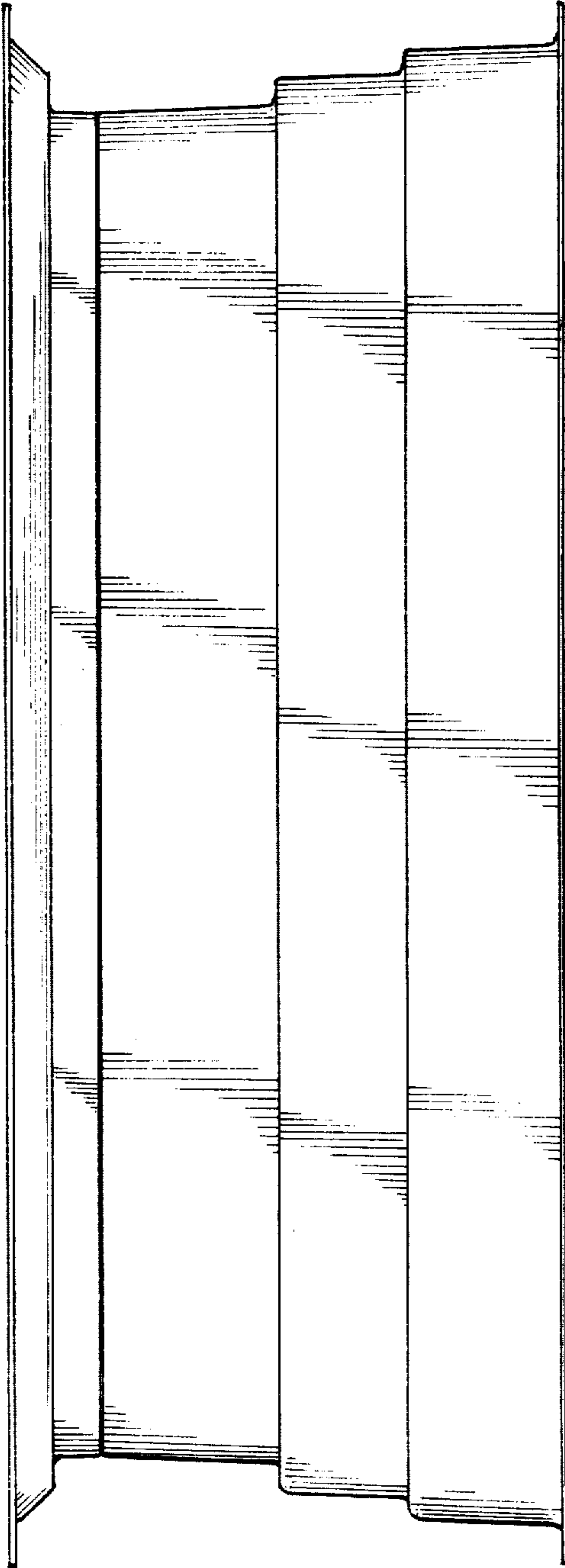

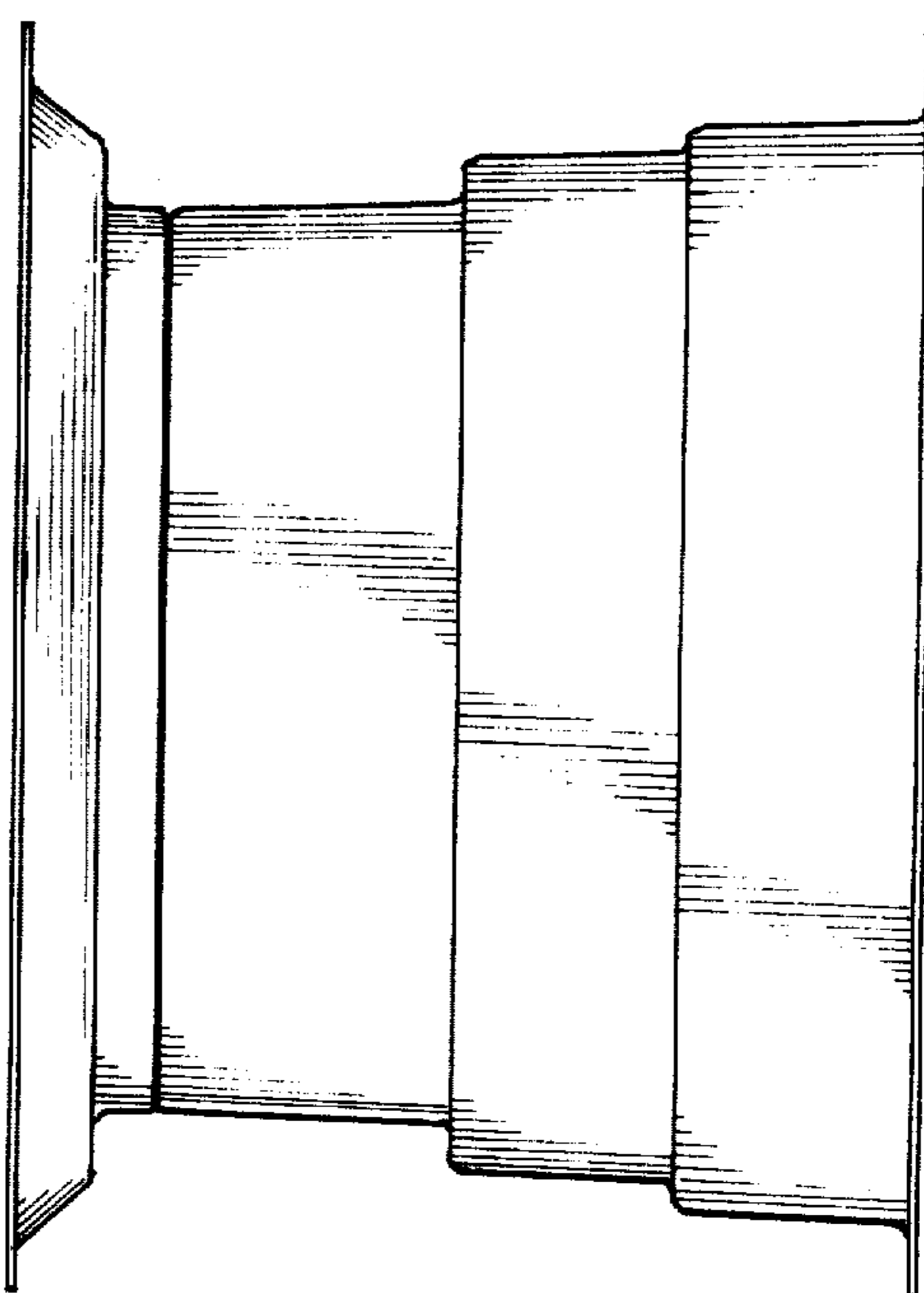
