The ornamental design for a stethoscope head, substantially as shown and described.

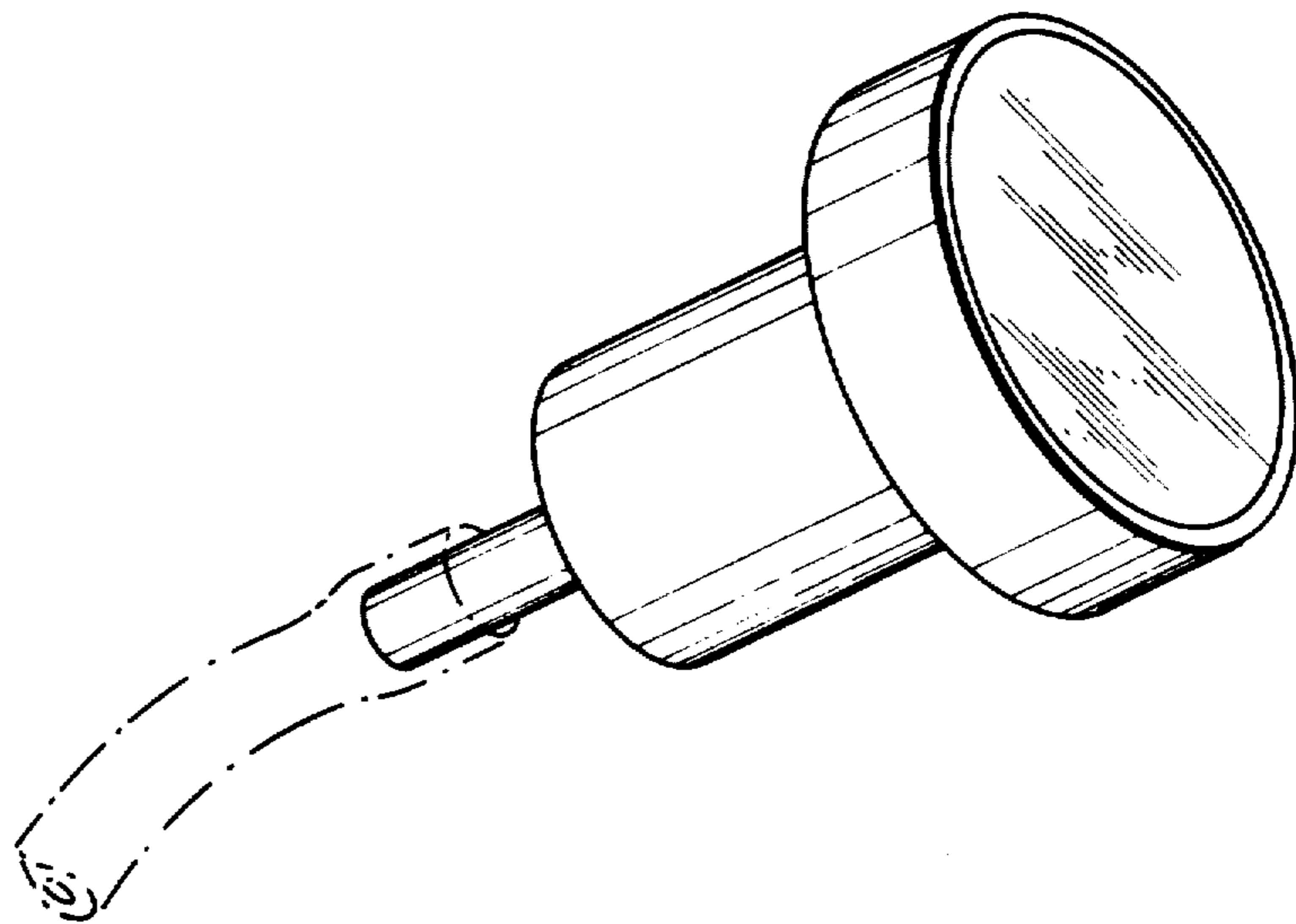
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof.



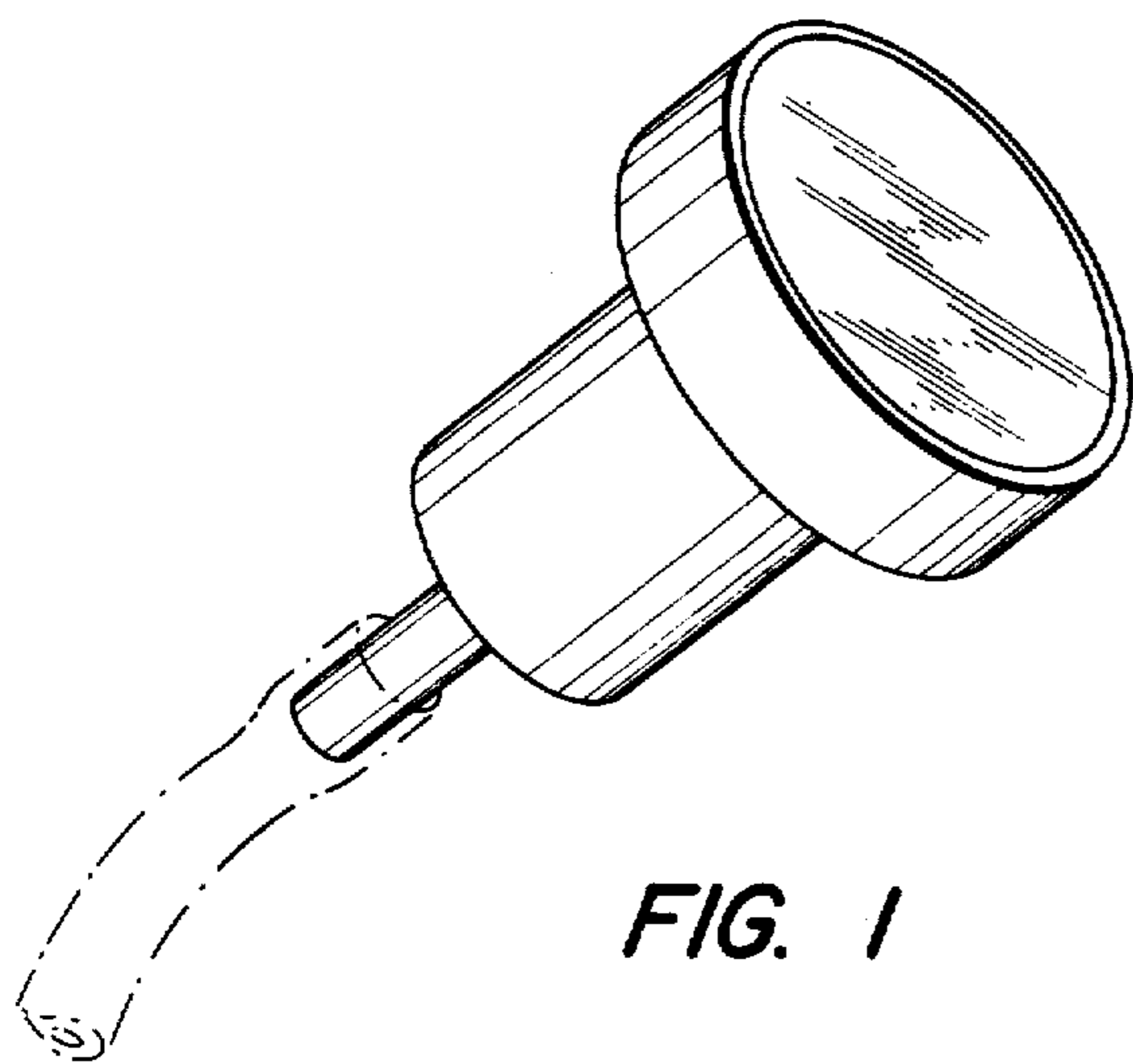

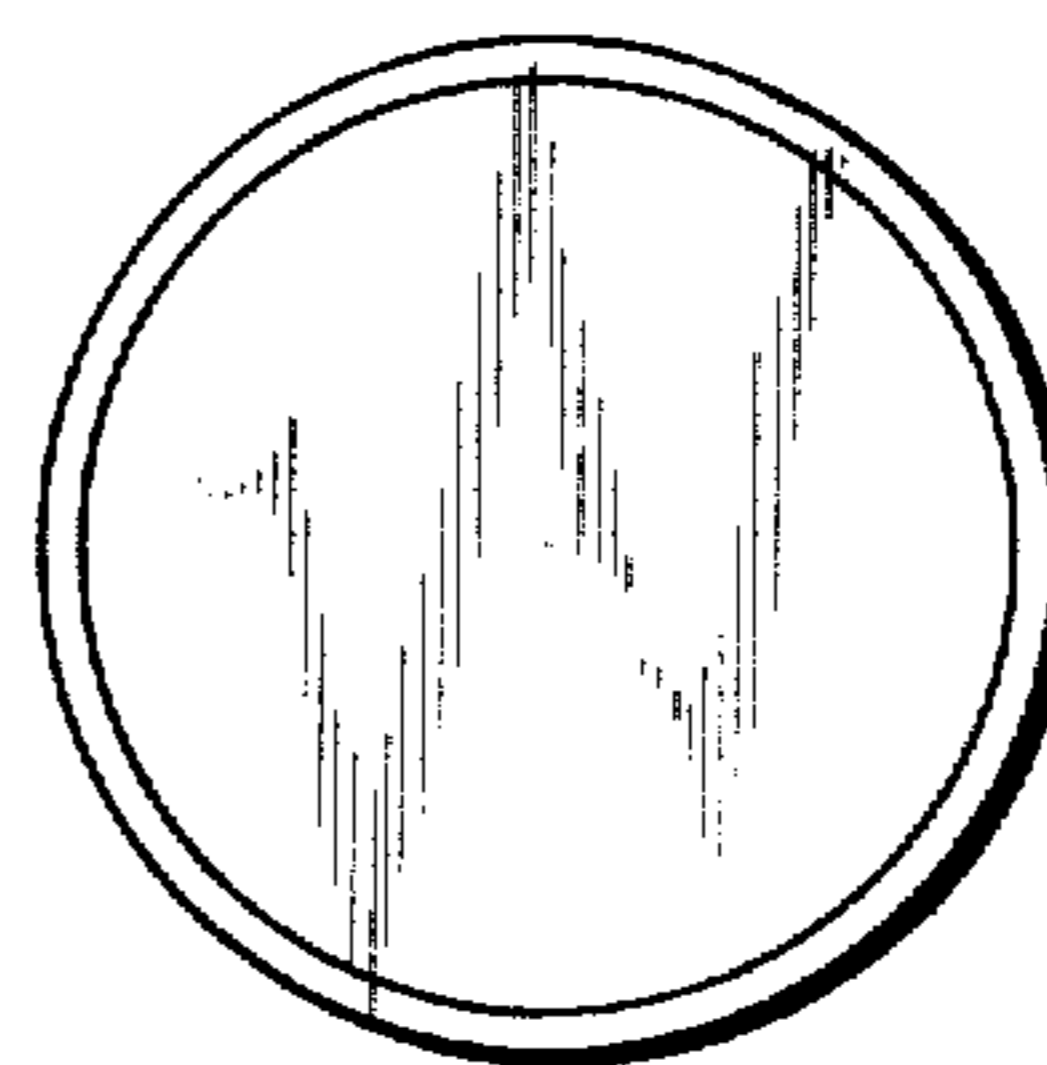

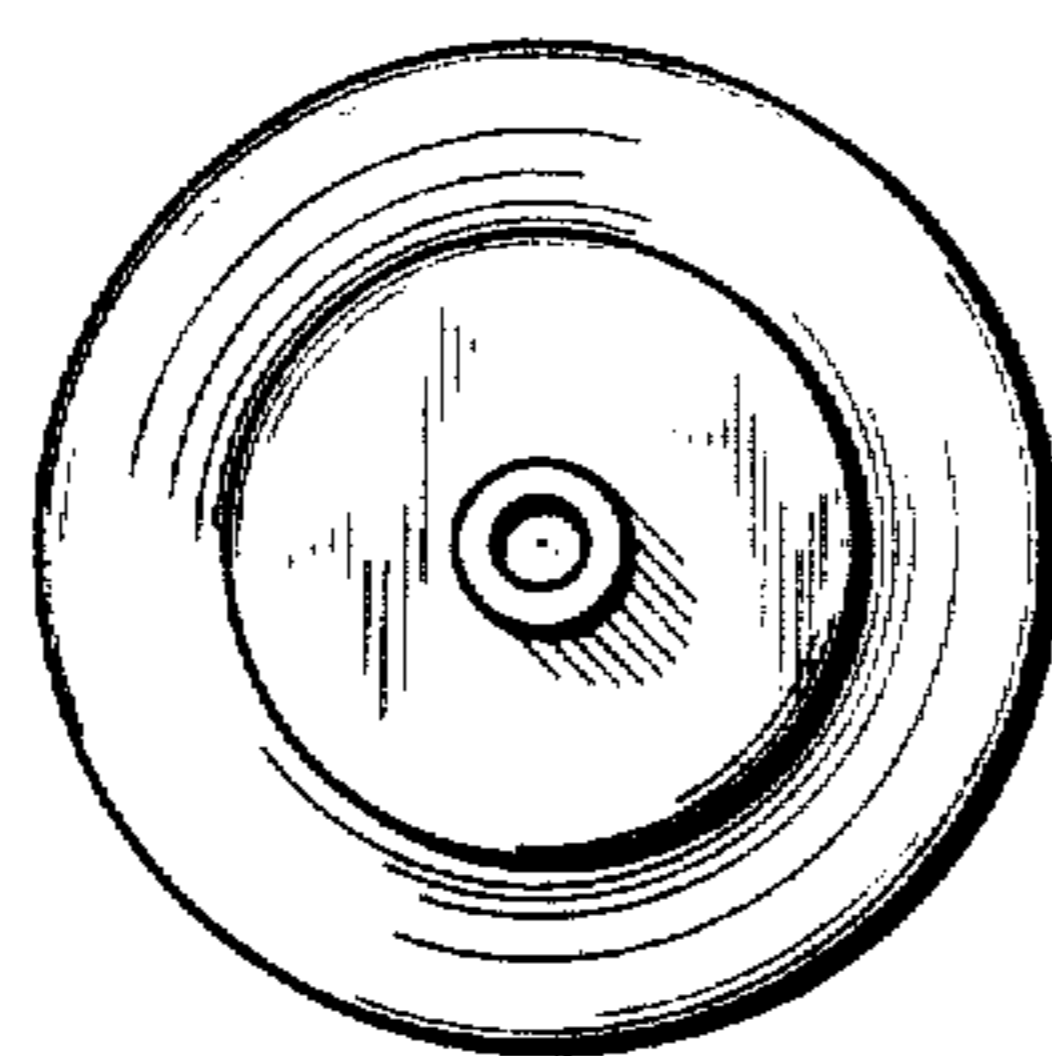

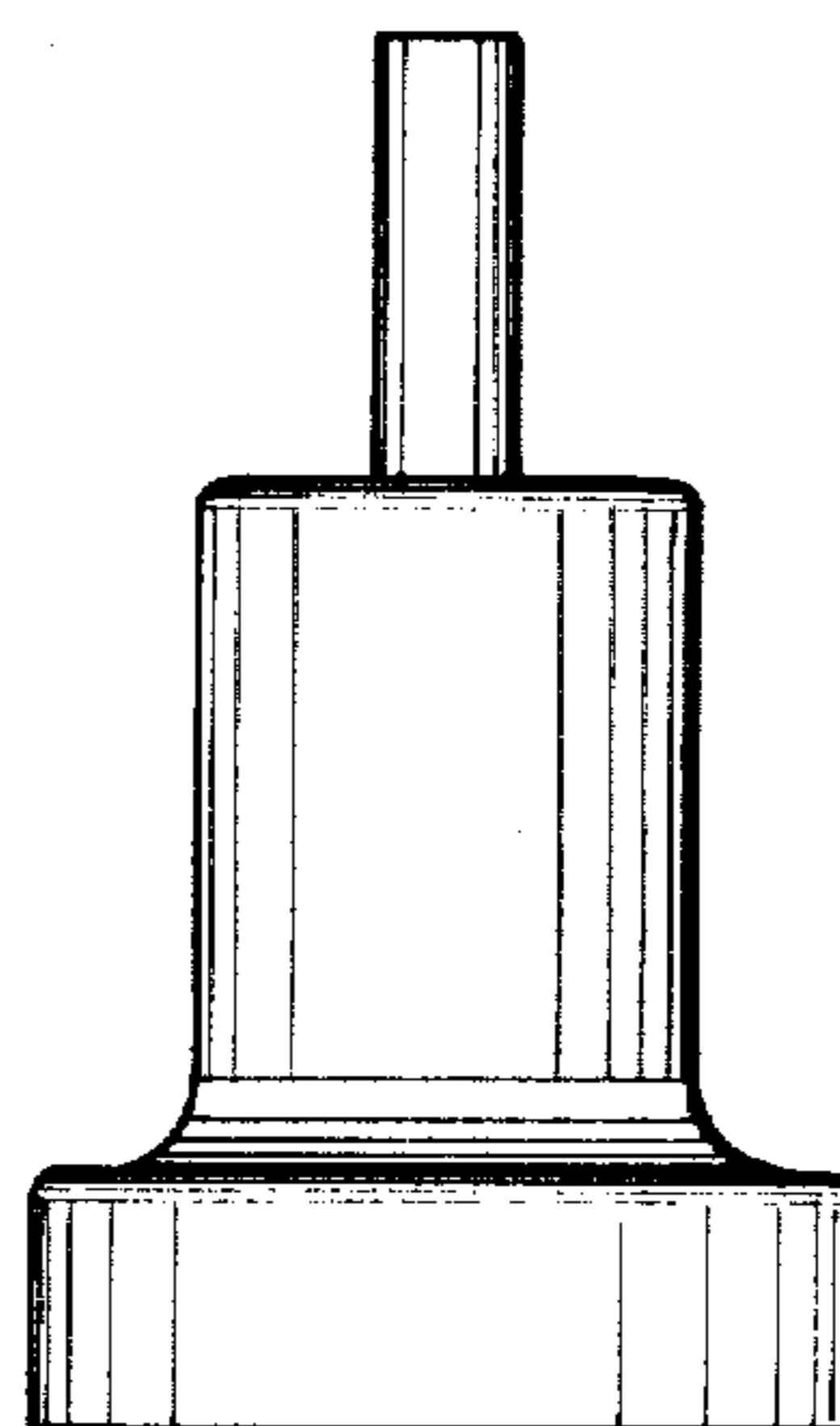
