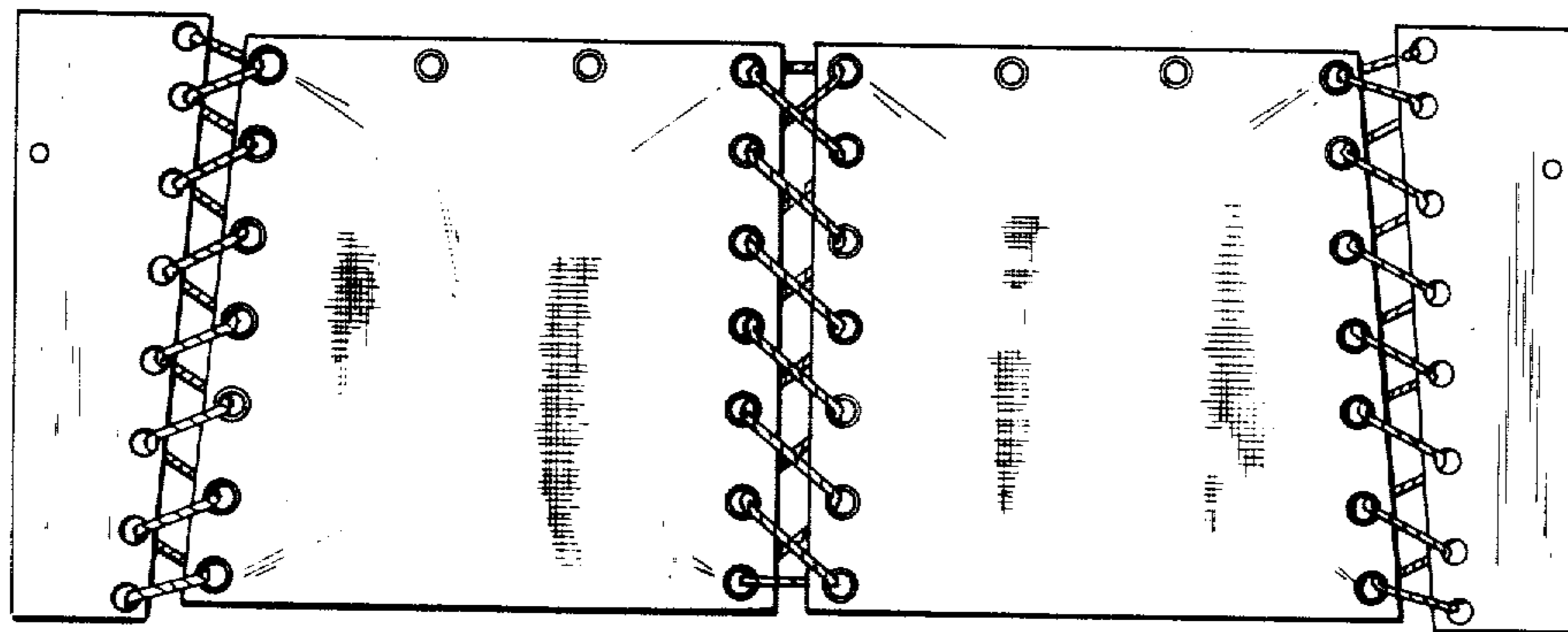
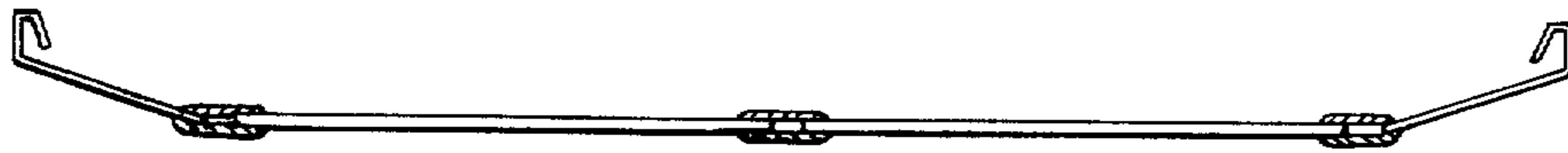

 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of my invention.



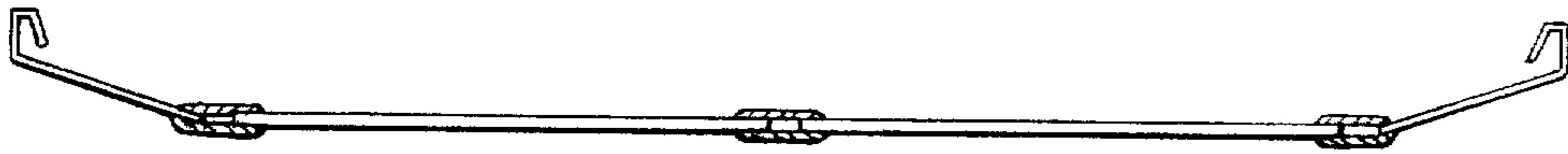

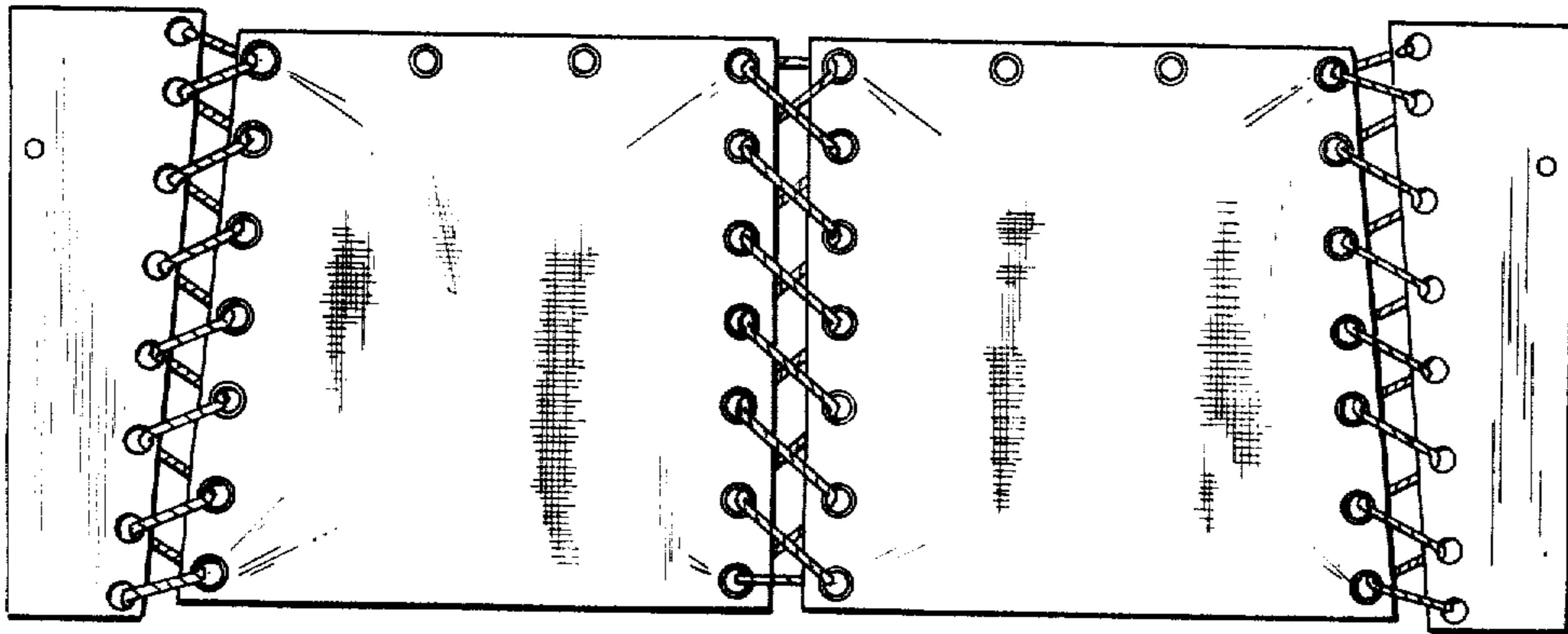

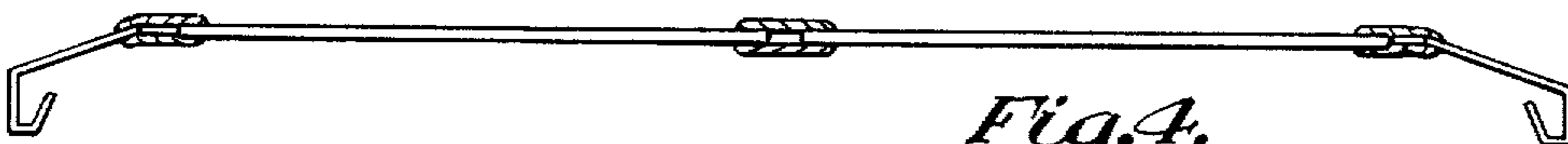

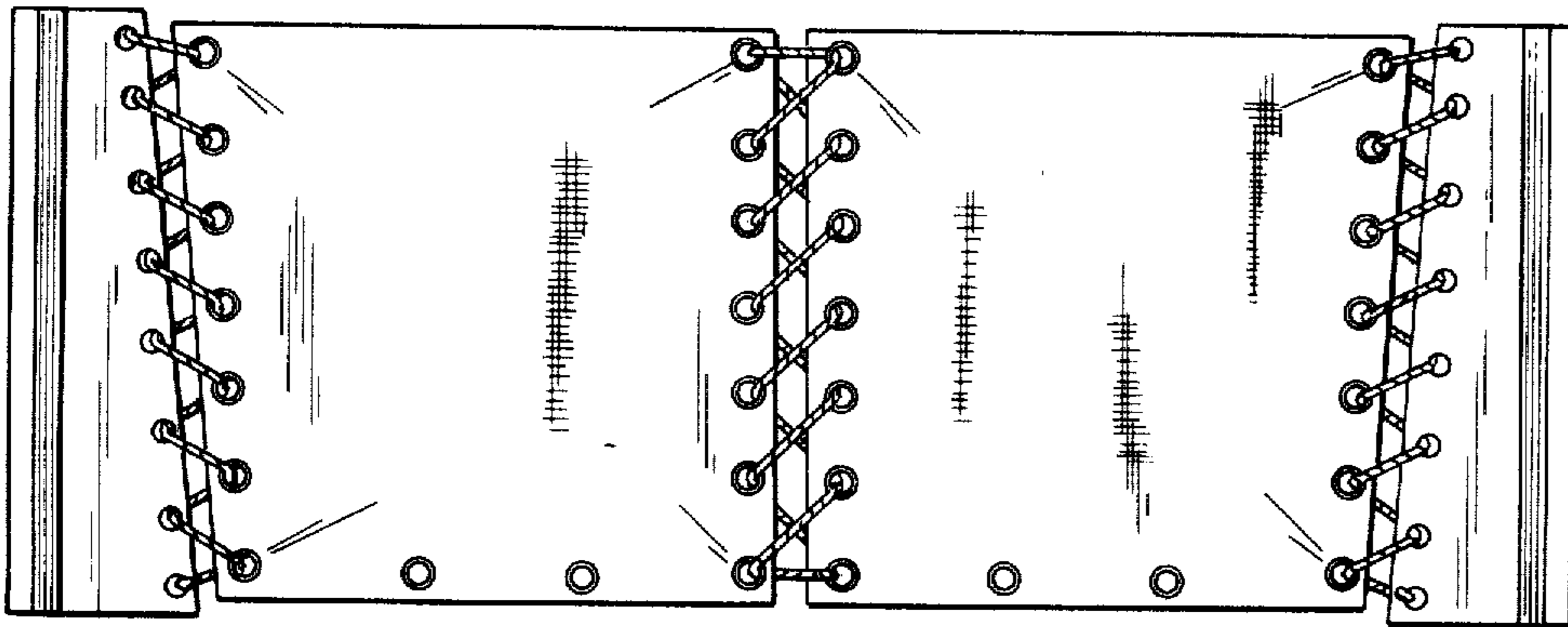
