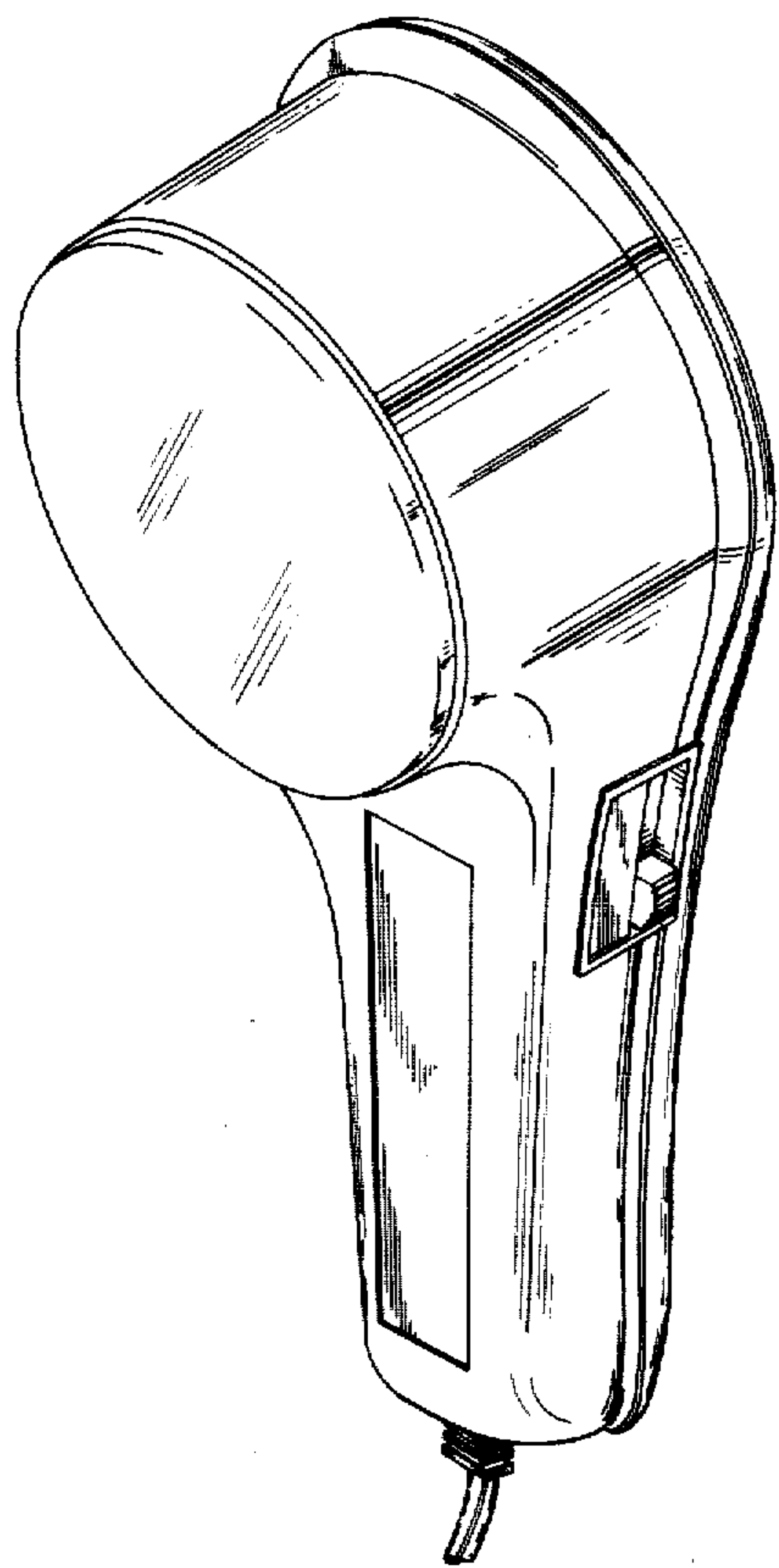

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a massaging appliance
embodying the new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is one side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is the opposite side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
In several of the views, a non-ornamental connecting
power supply cord has been broken away.



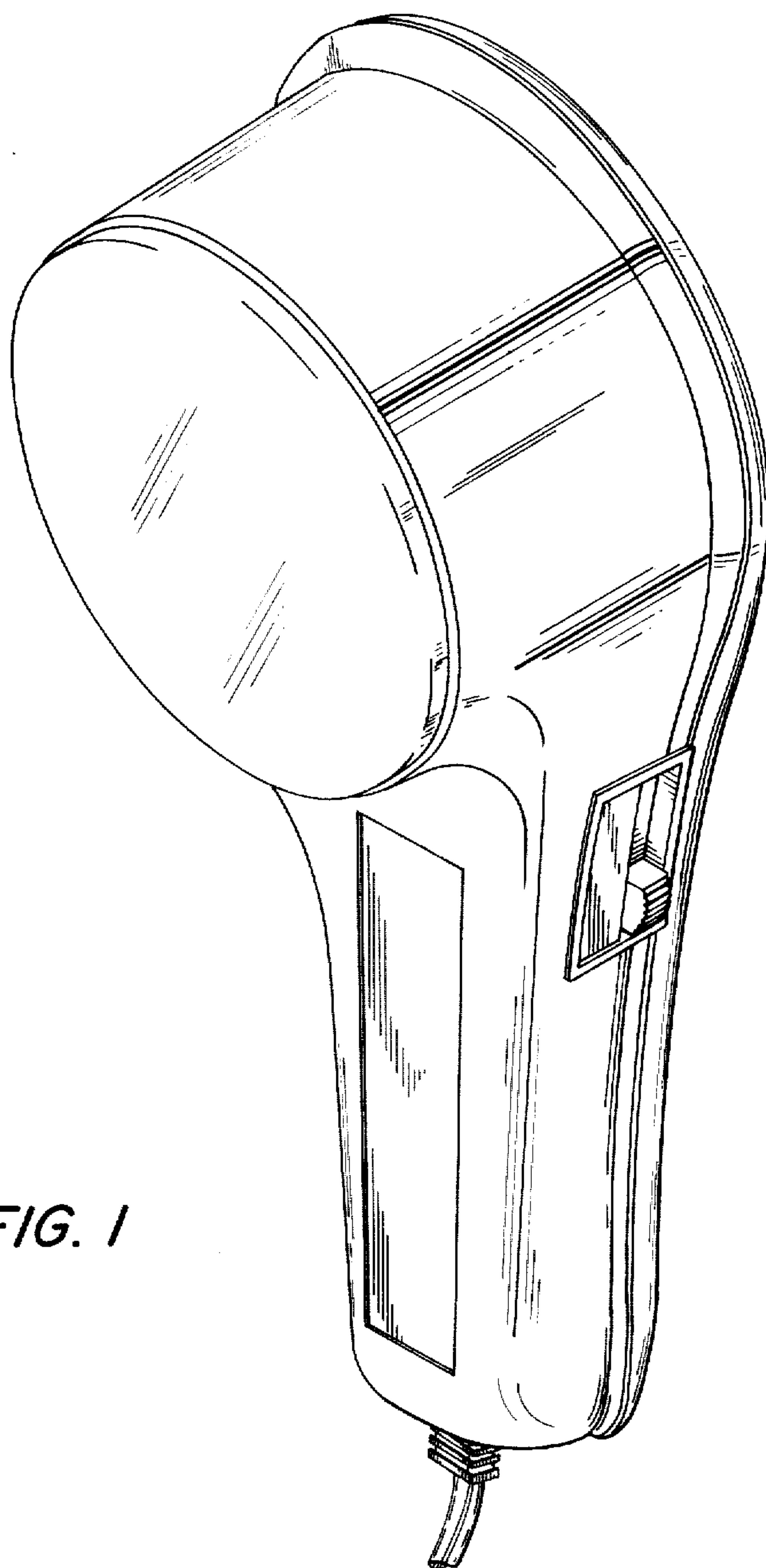

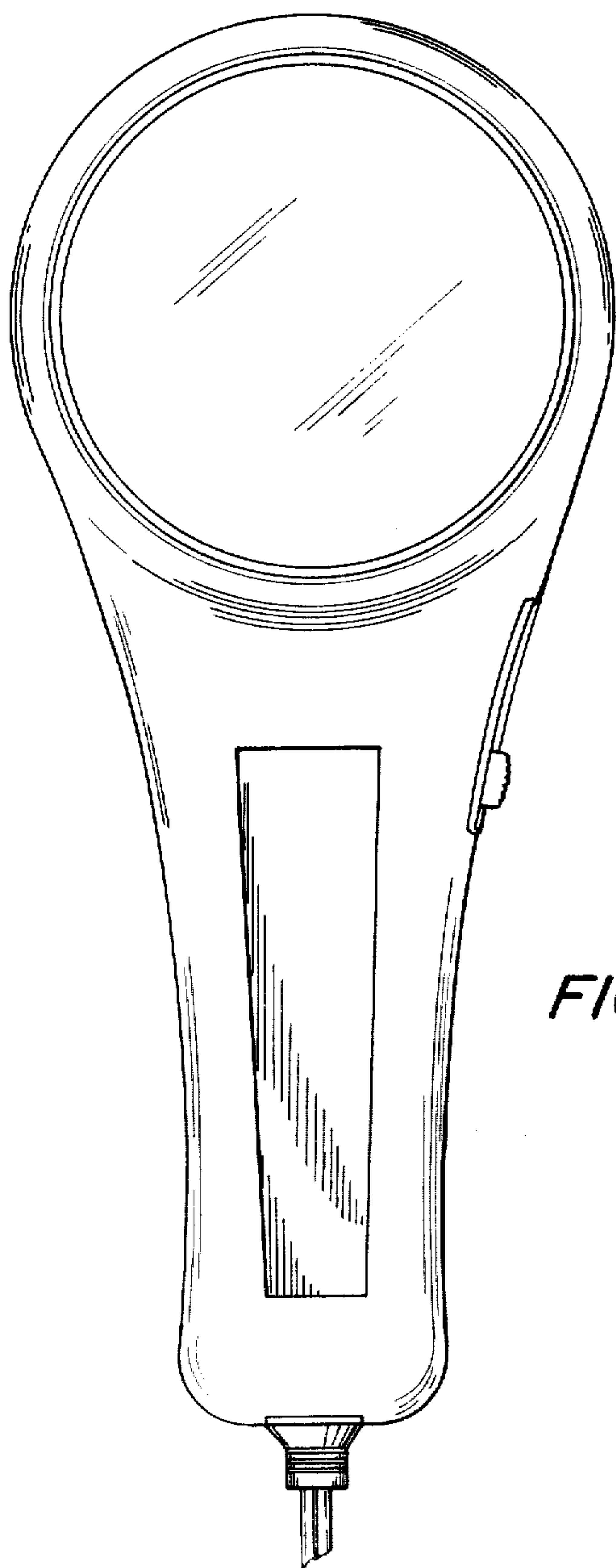

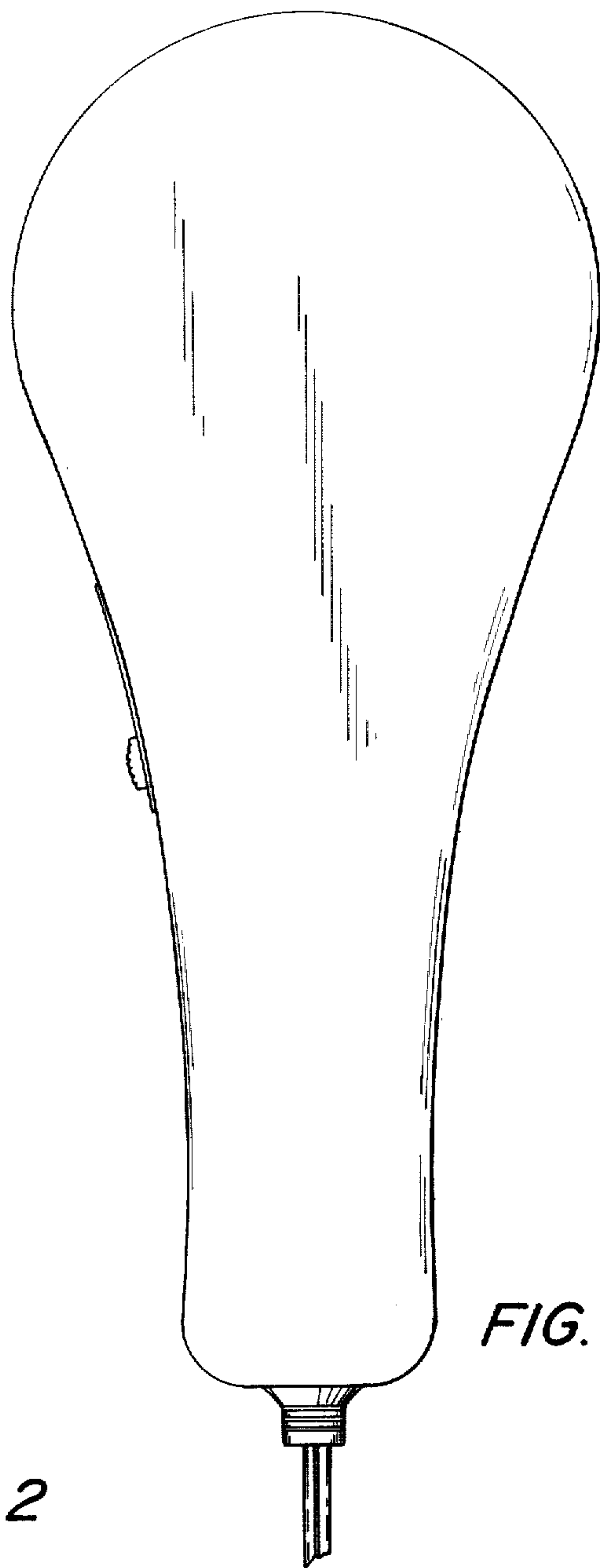

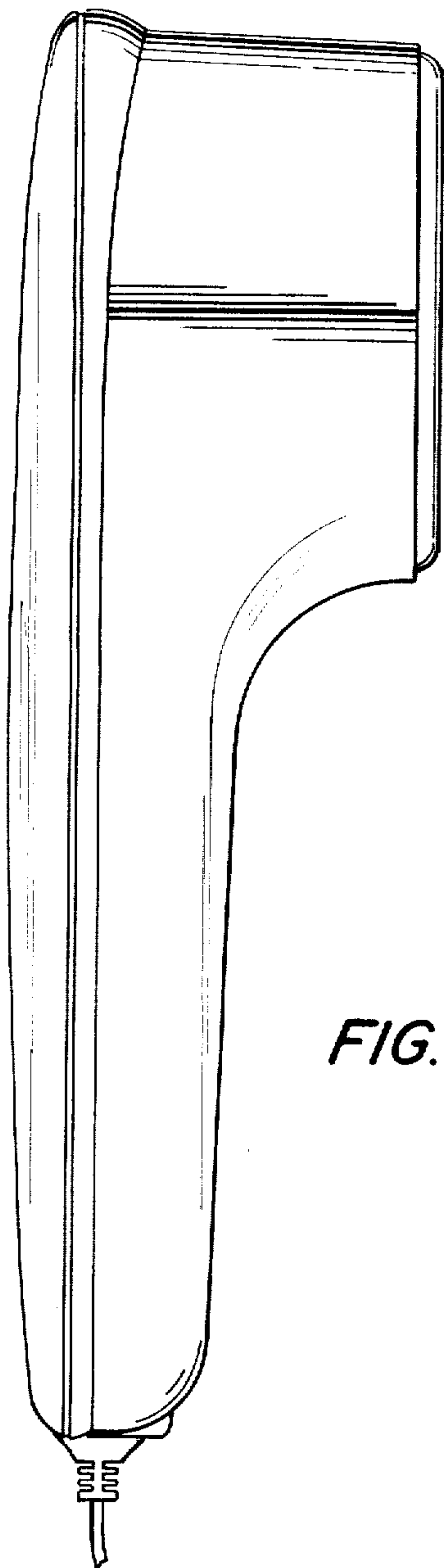

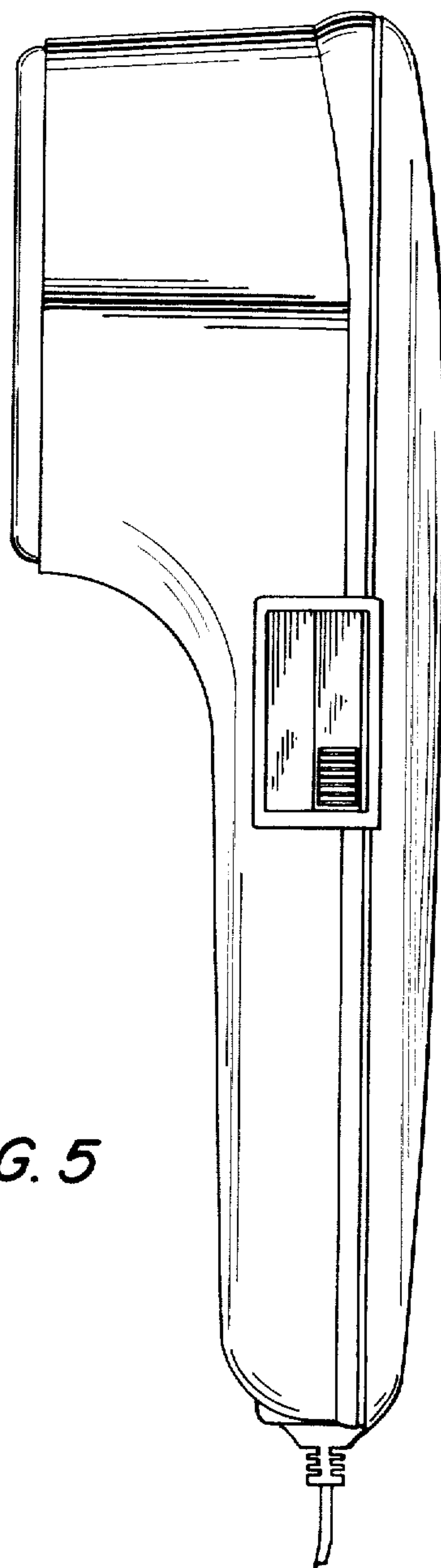

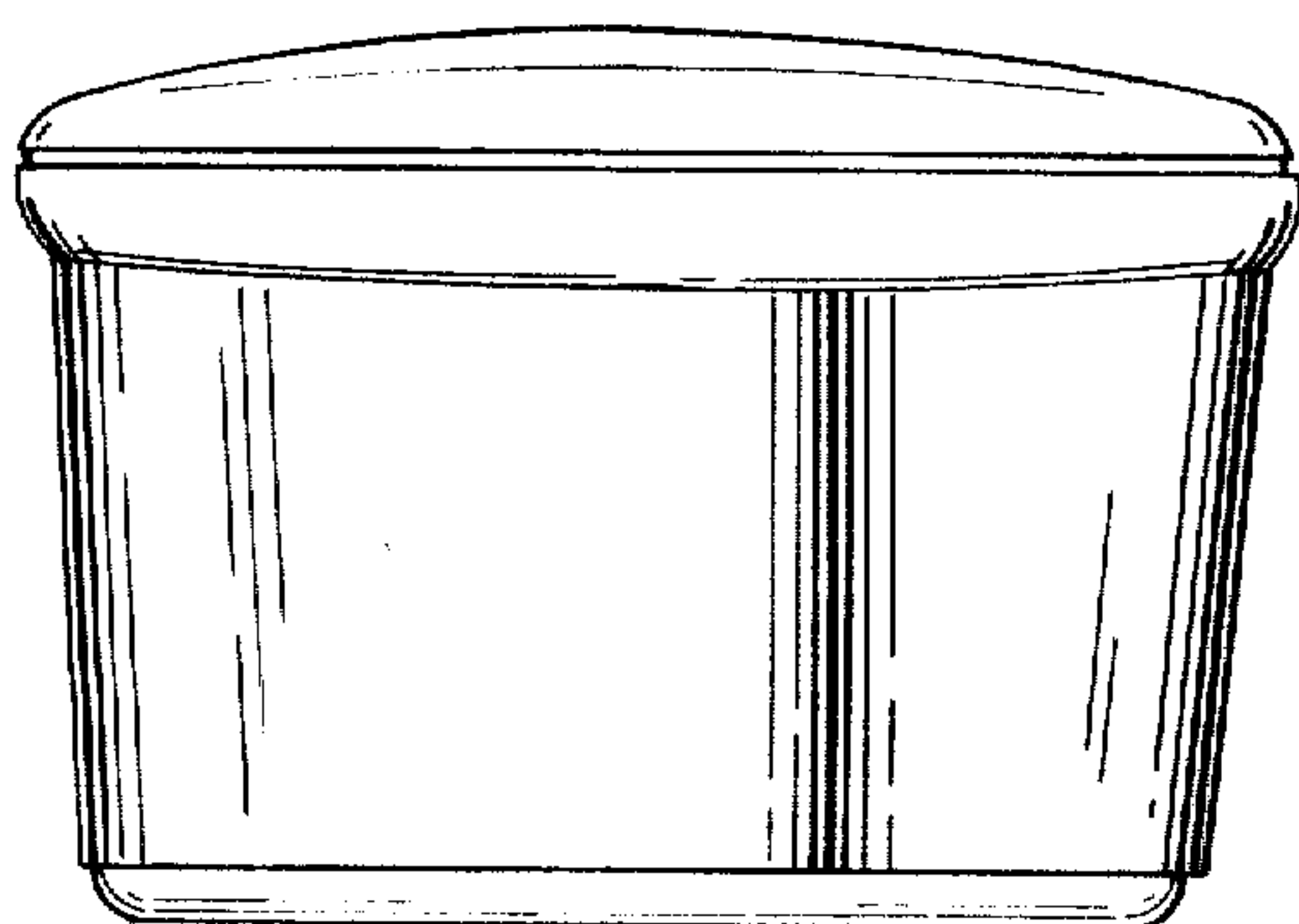

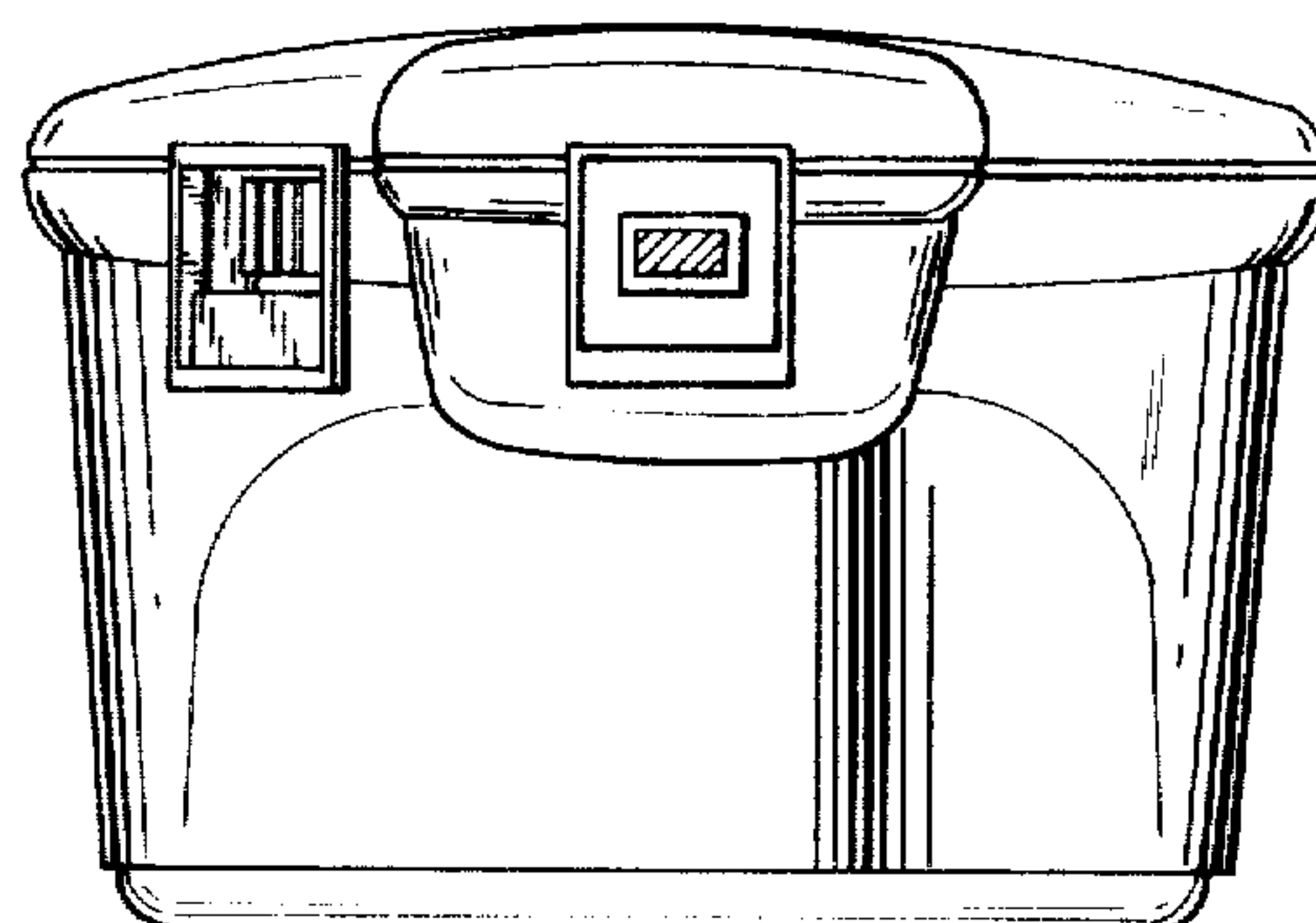
