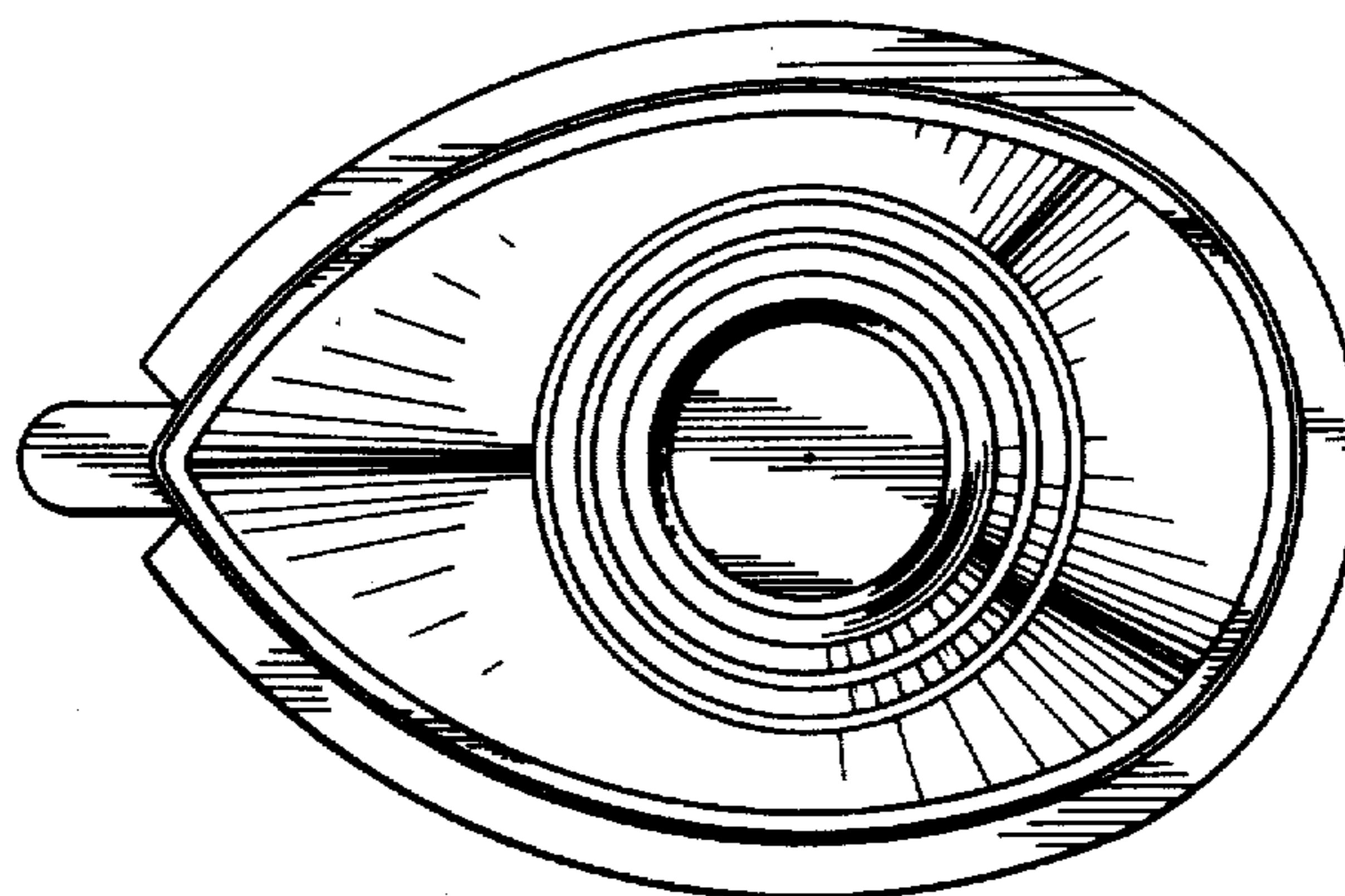
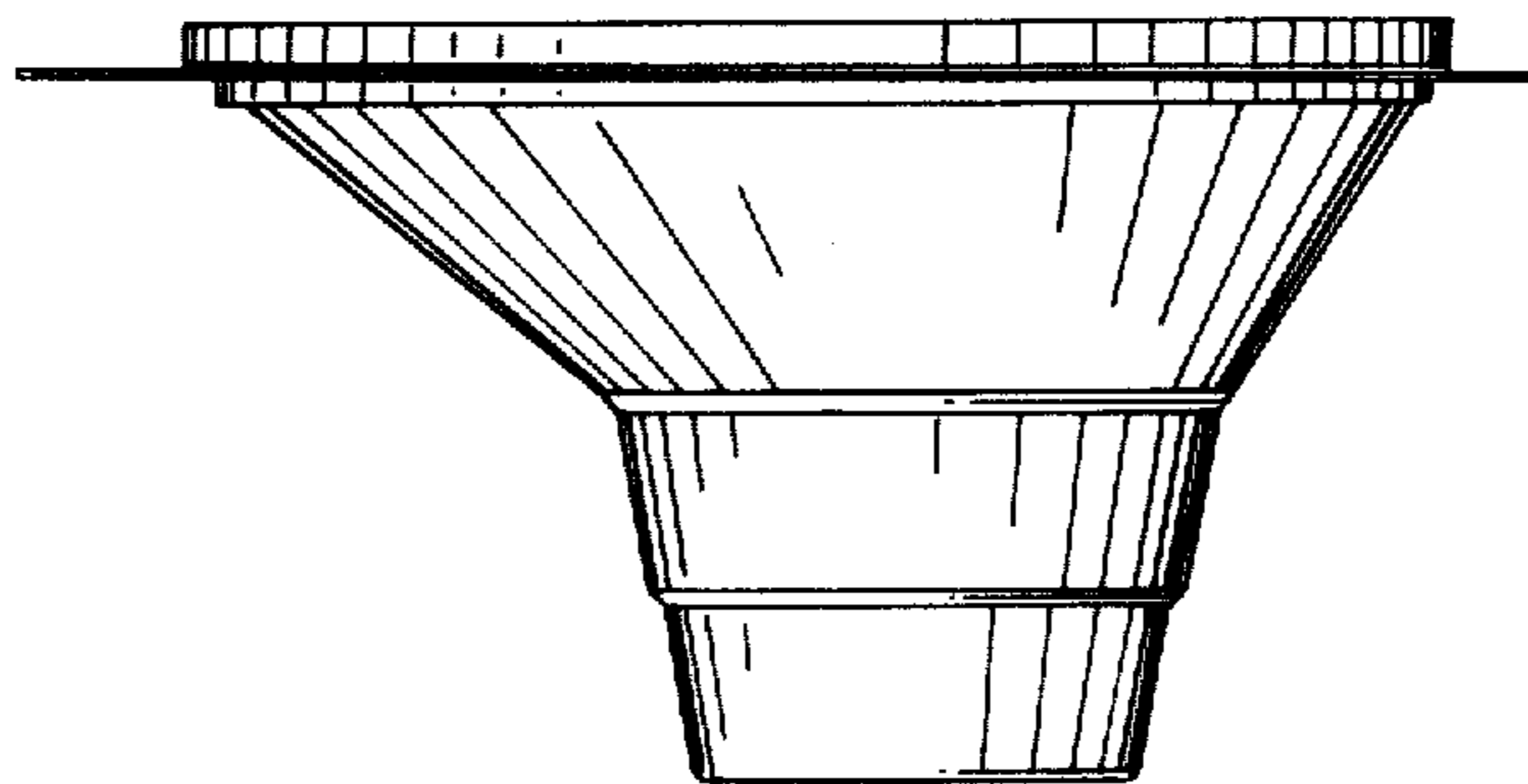

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a urine specimen container showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an end view thereof as seen from the right in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is an end view thereof as seen from the left in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a sectional view thereof taken along line 6—6 in FIG. 4.



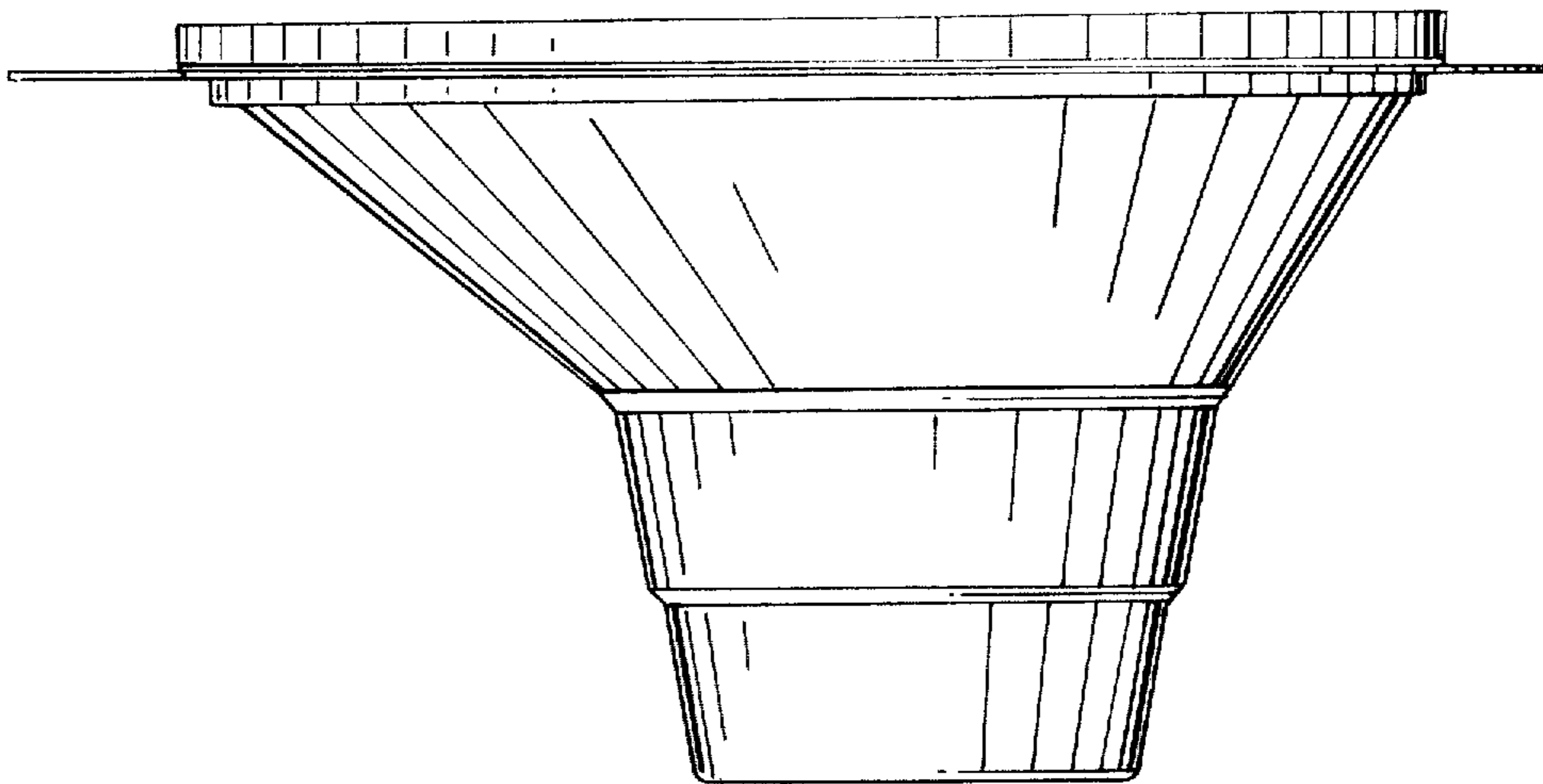
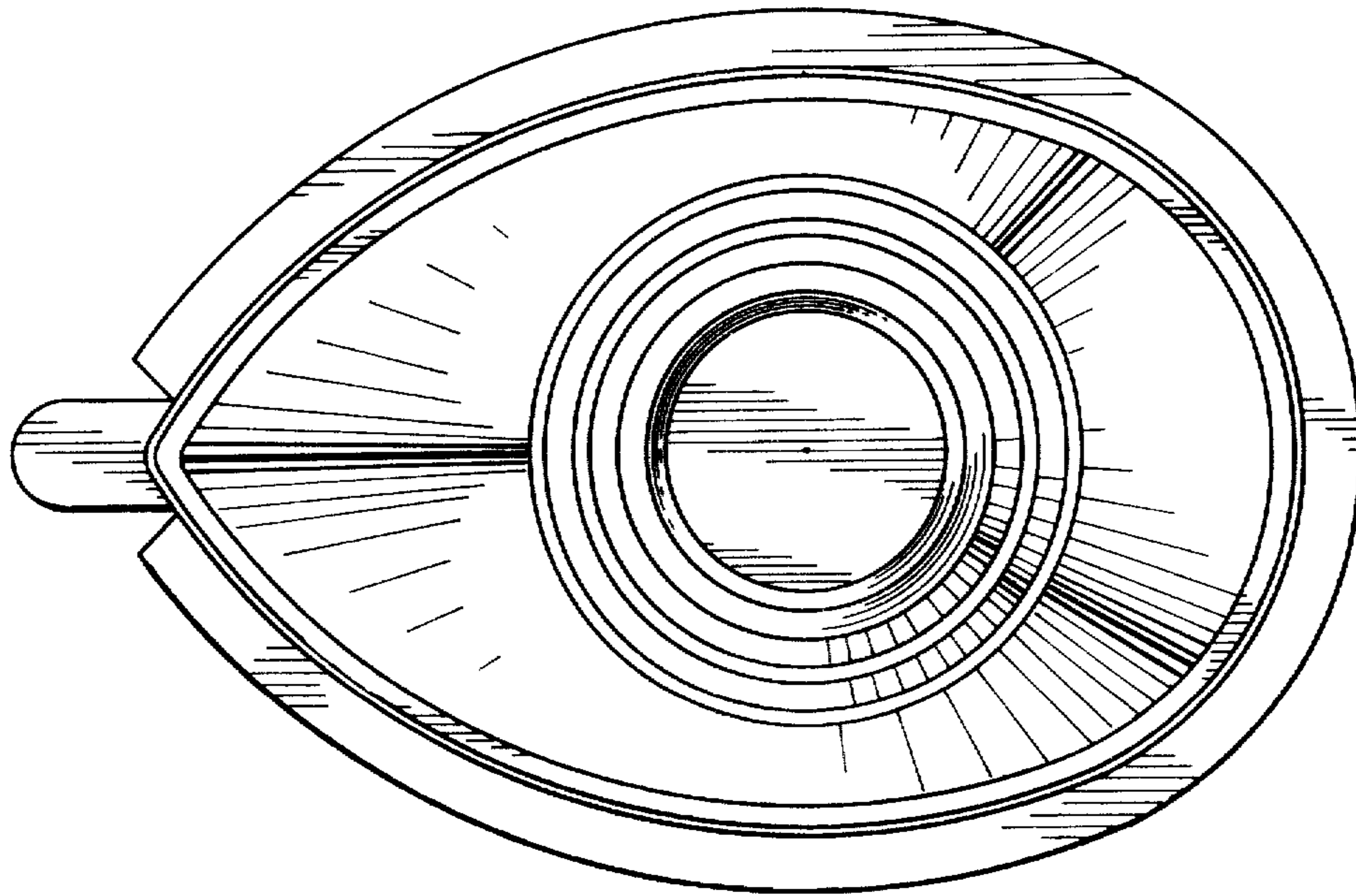

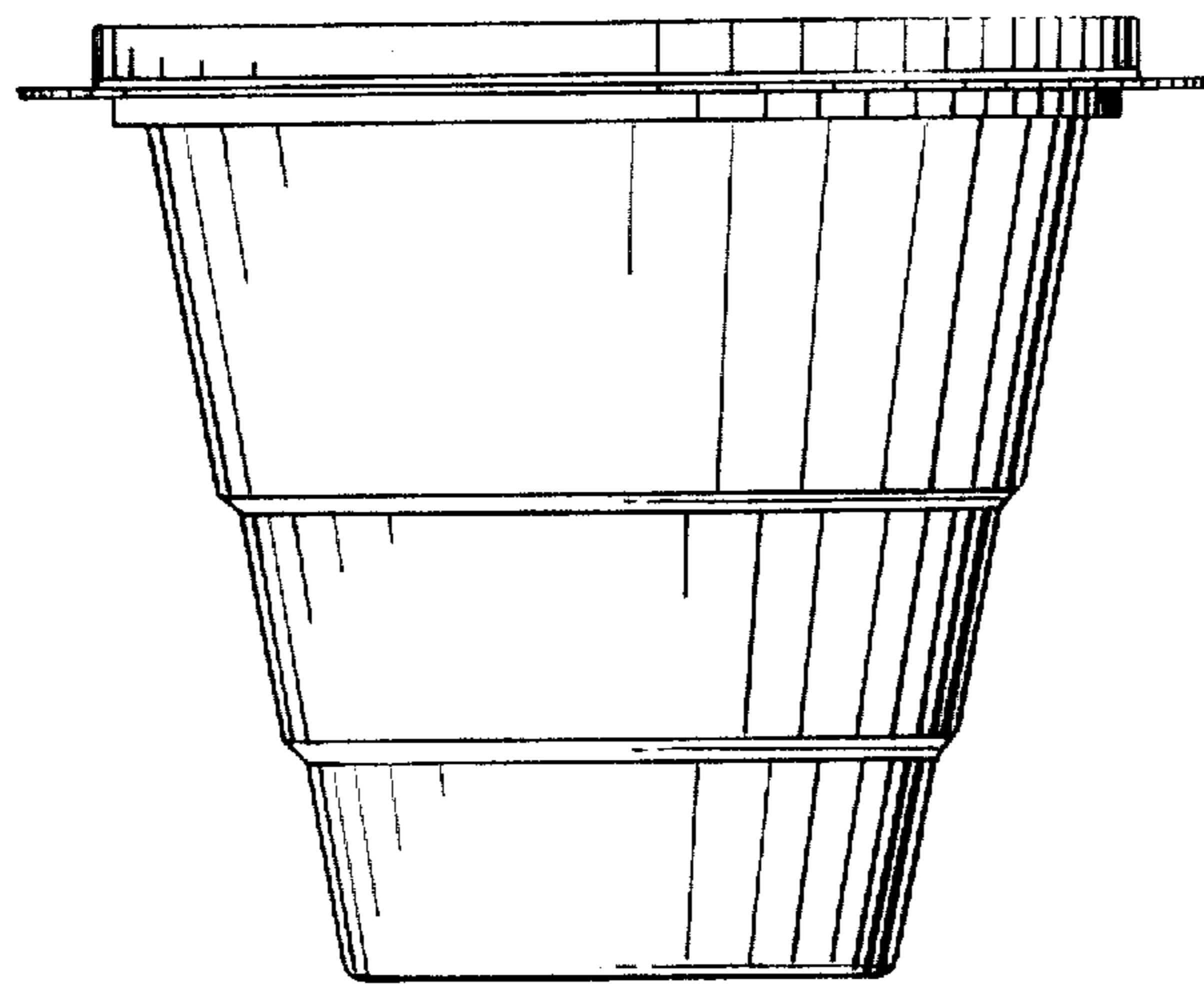

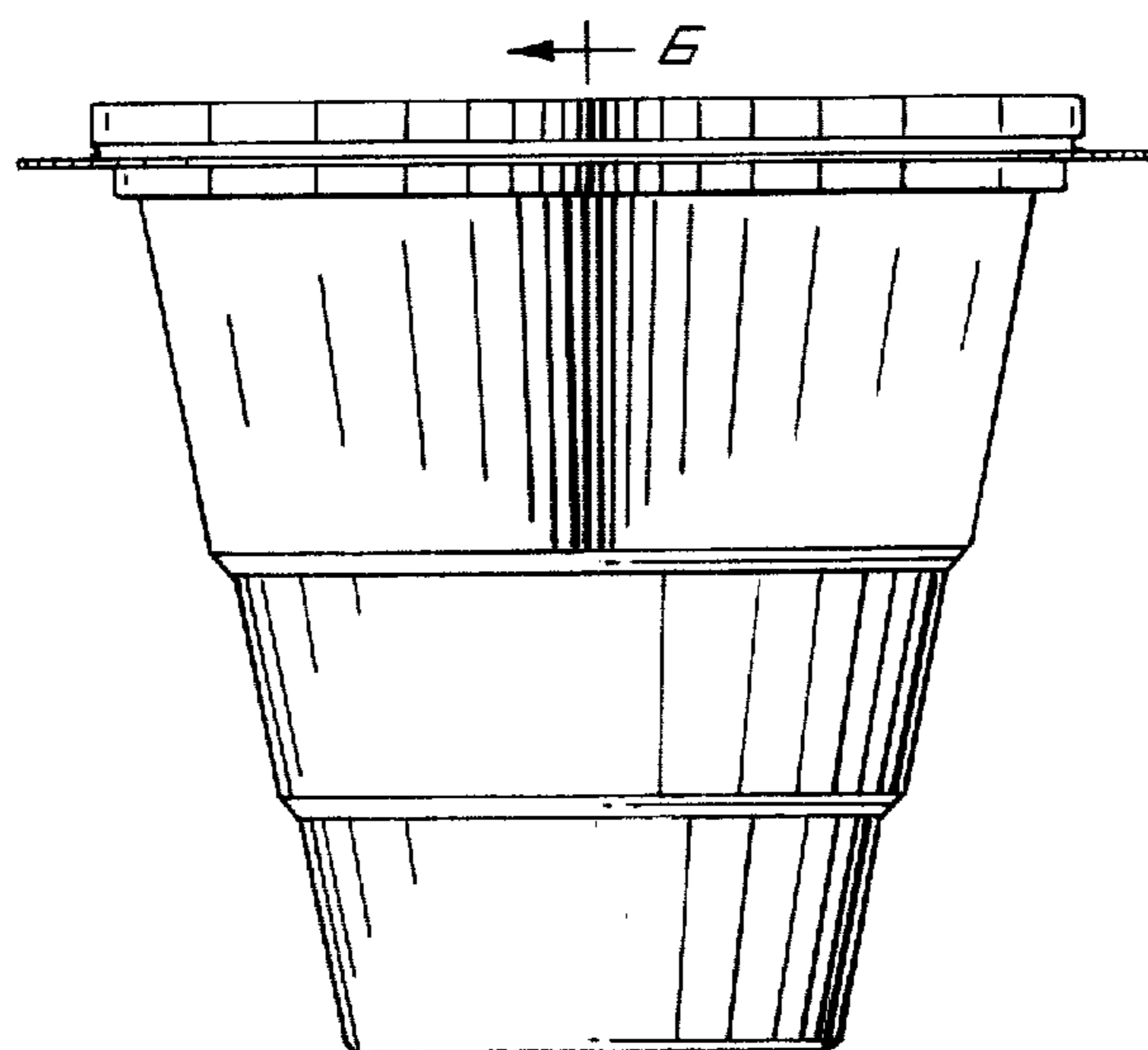

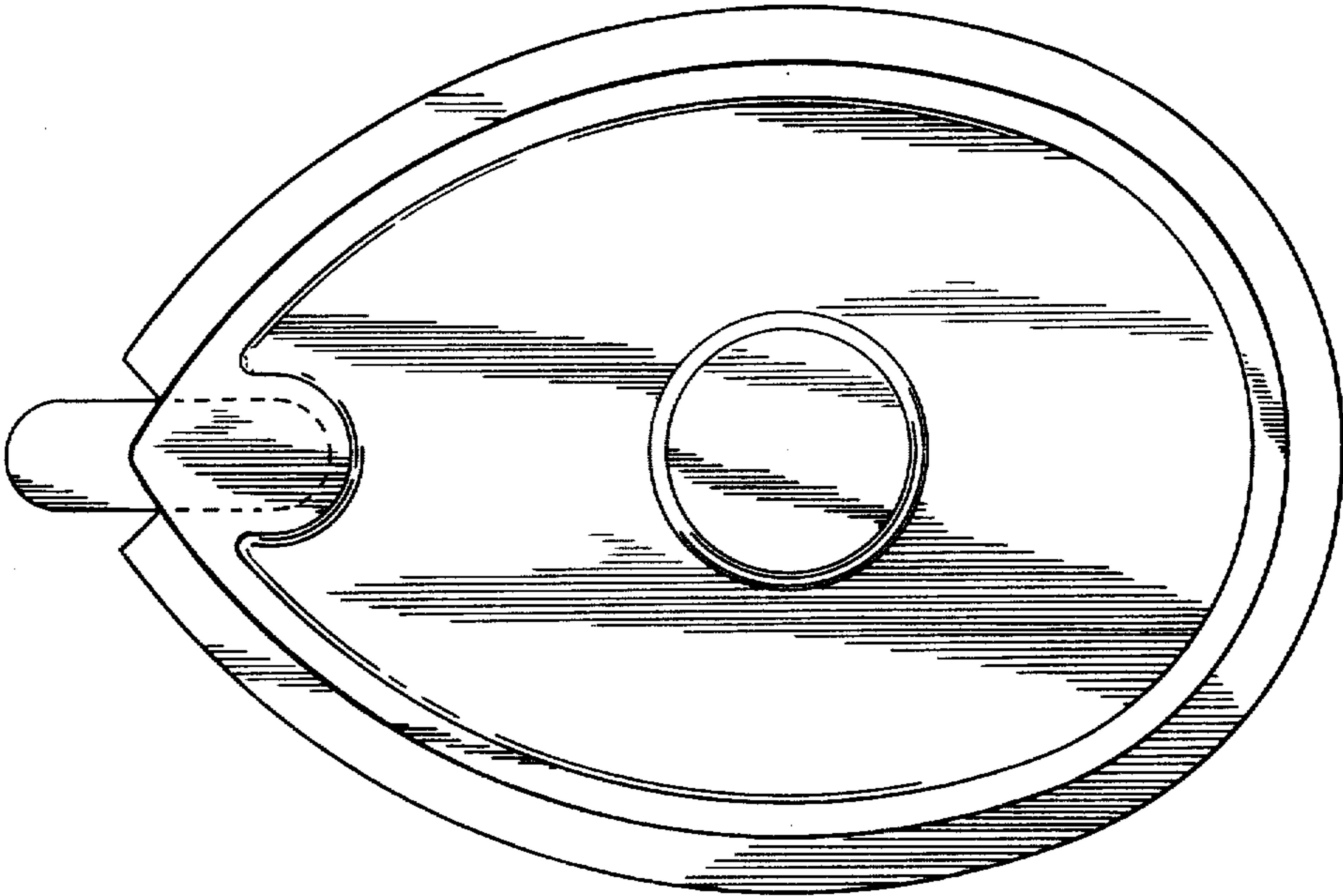

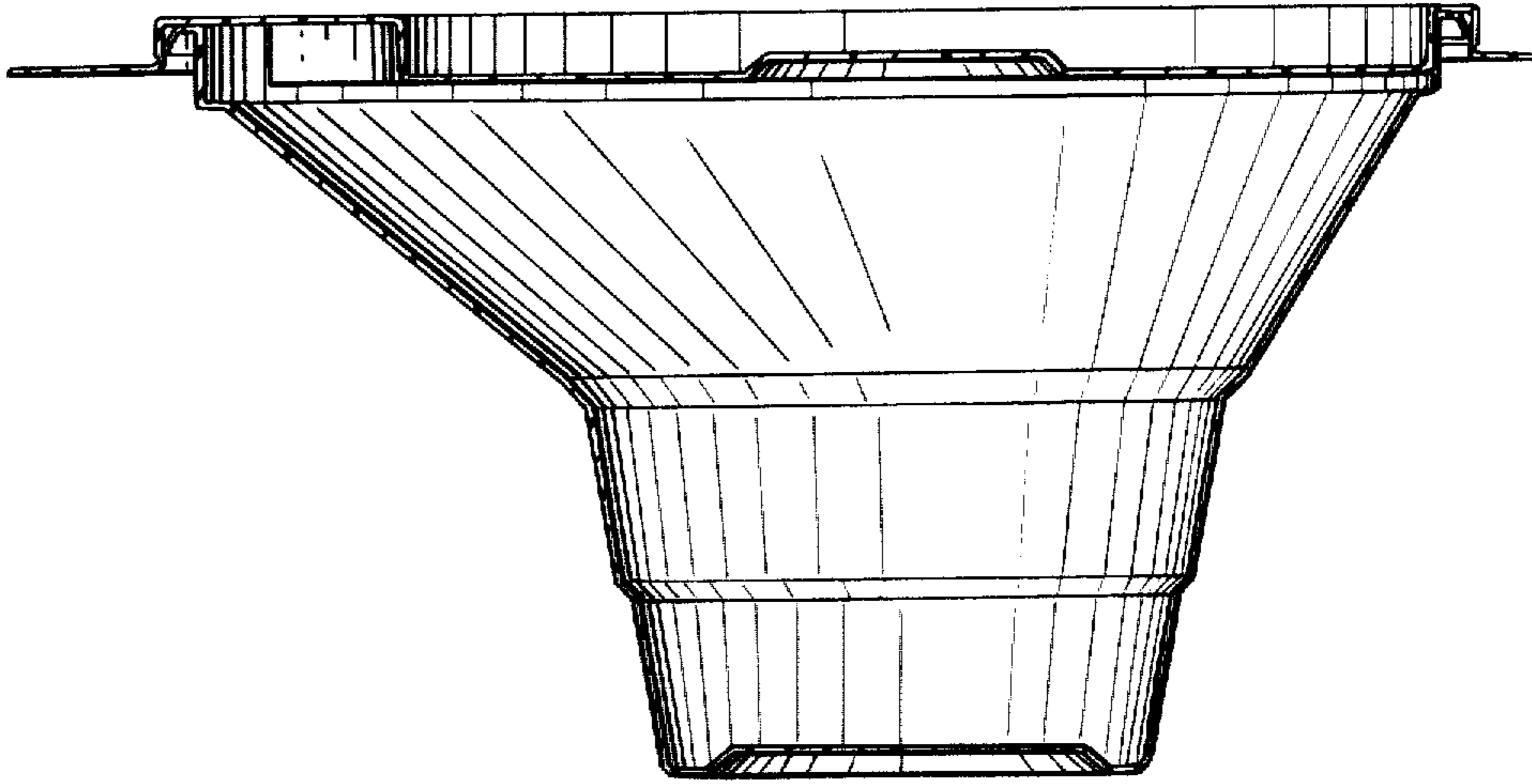
