DESCRIPTION

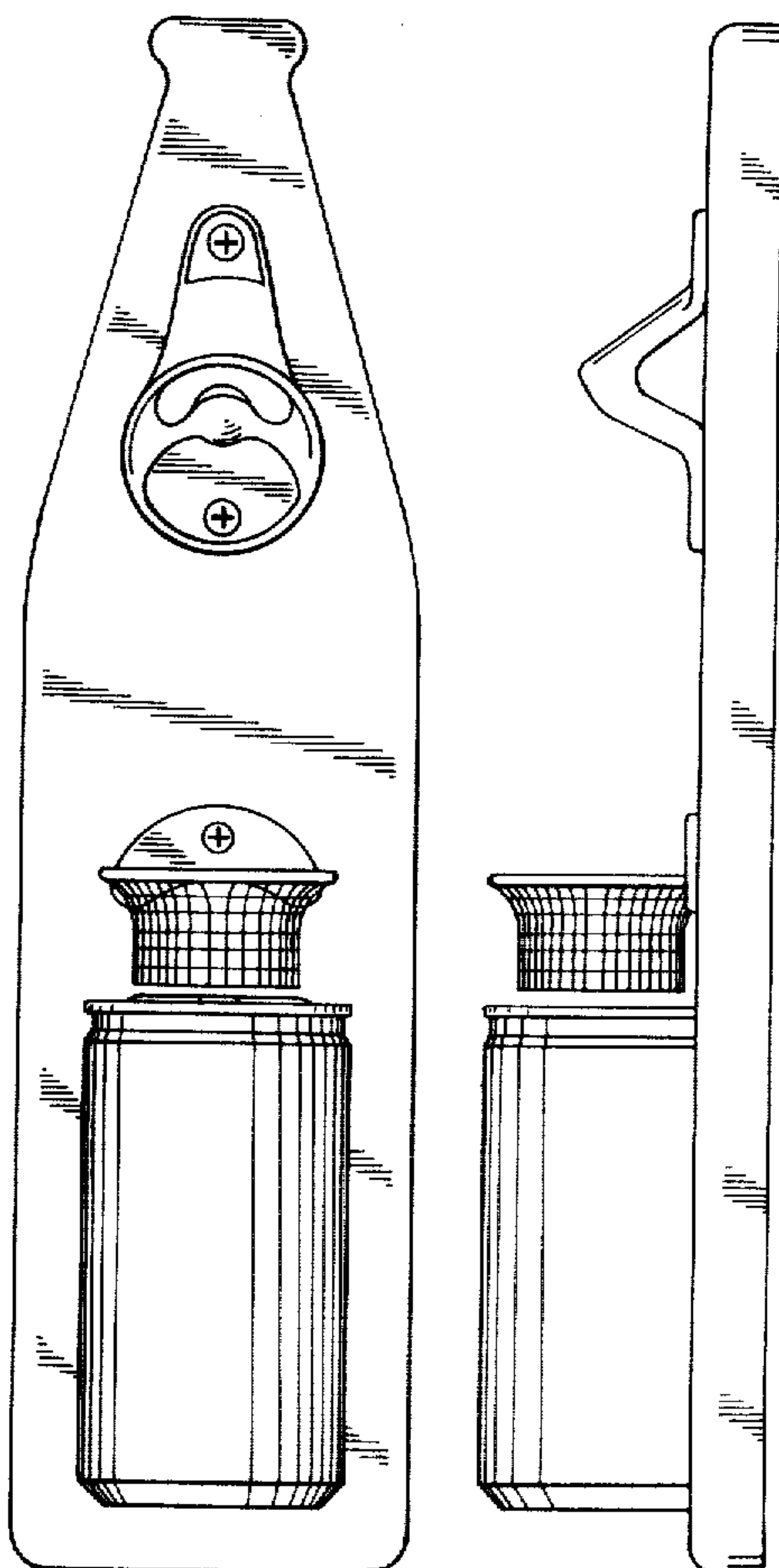
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined wall mounted bottle opener and cap receptacle showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



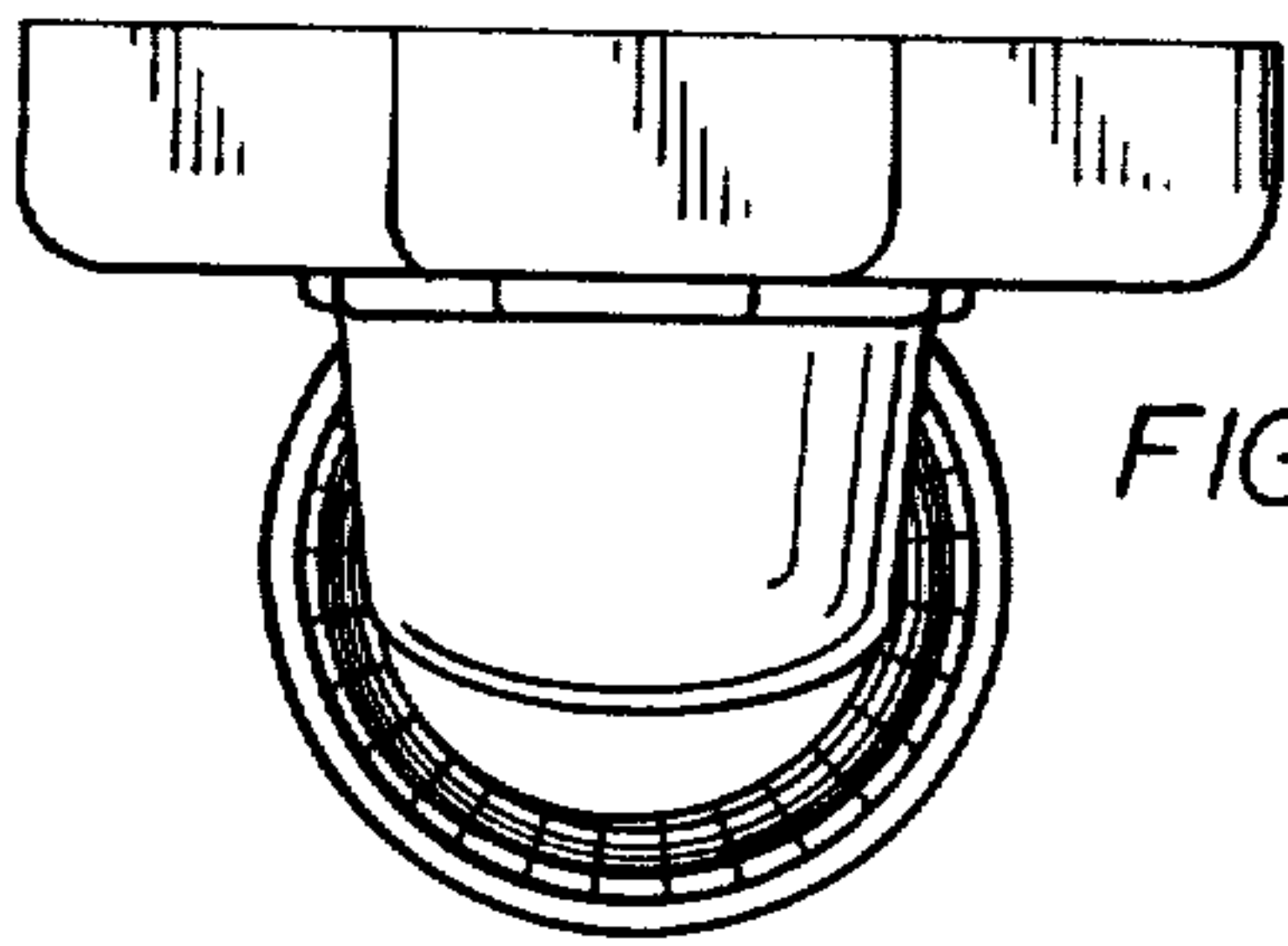

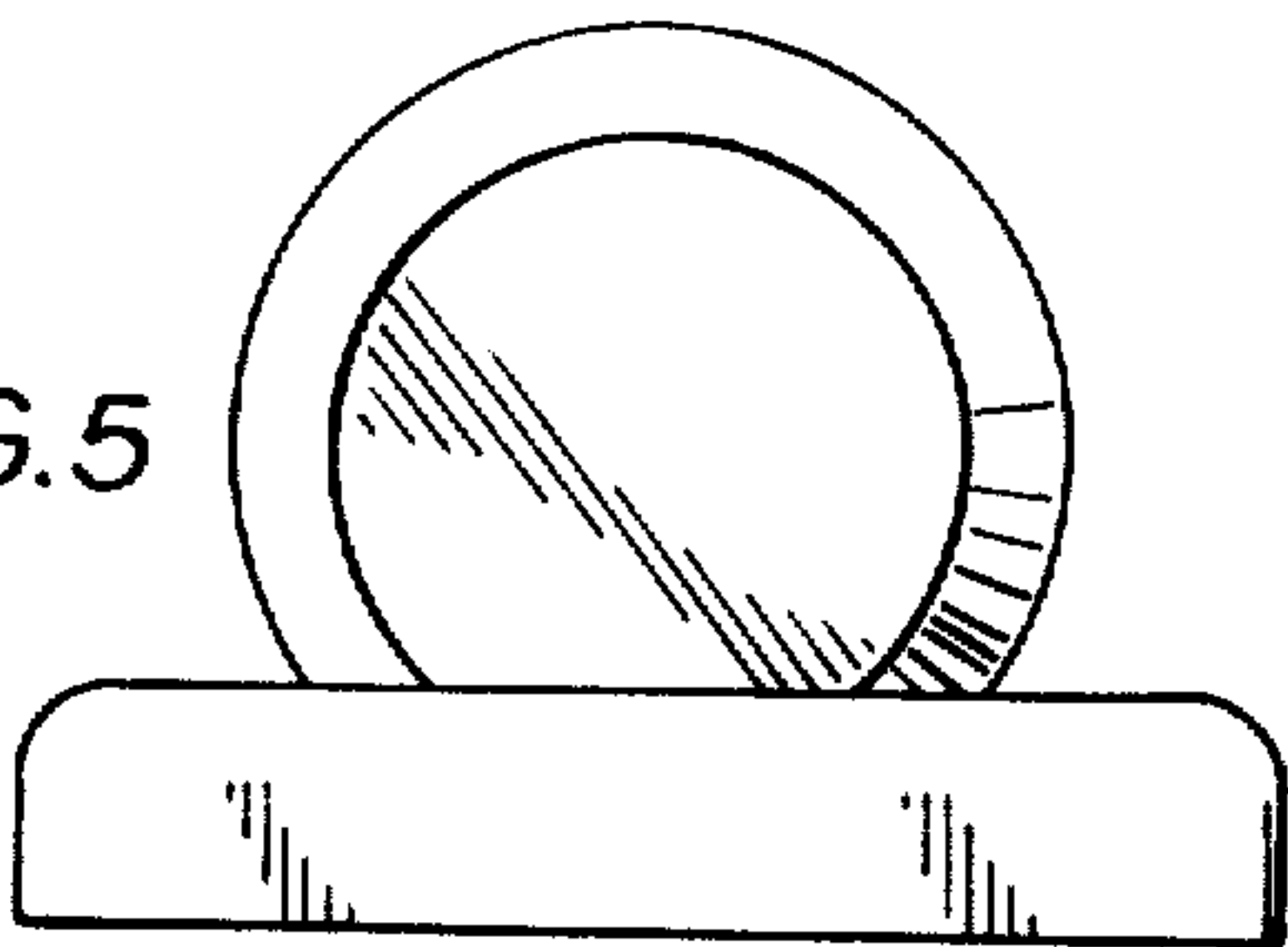

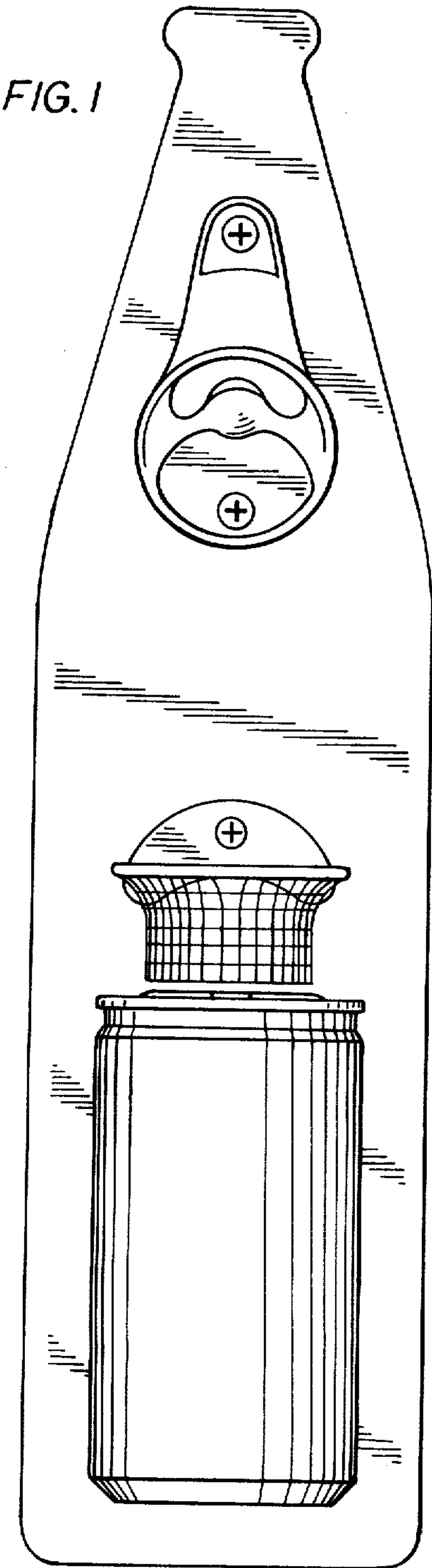

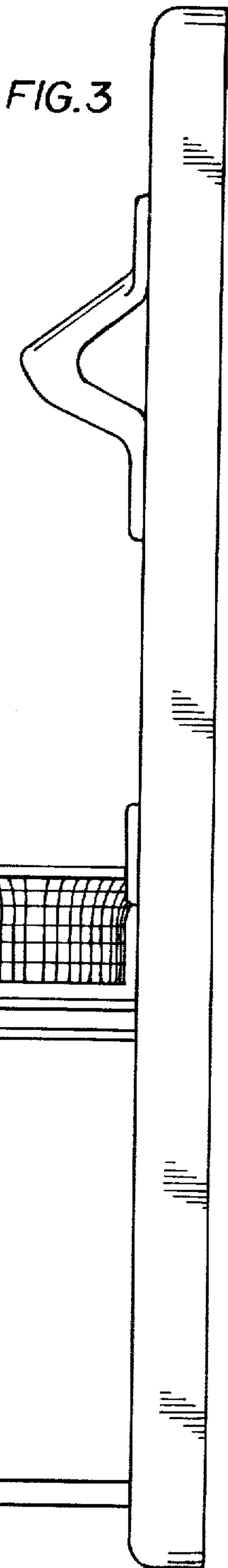

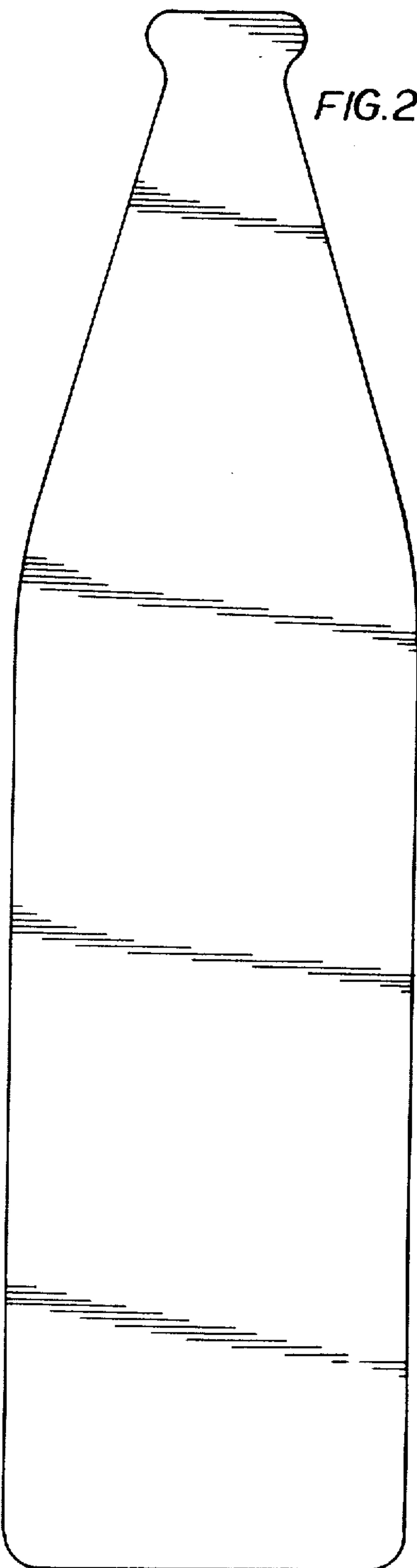
