The ornamental design for a jewelry display card, substantially as shown and described.

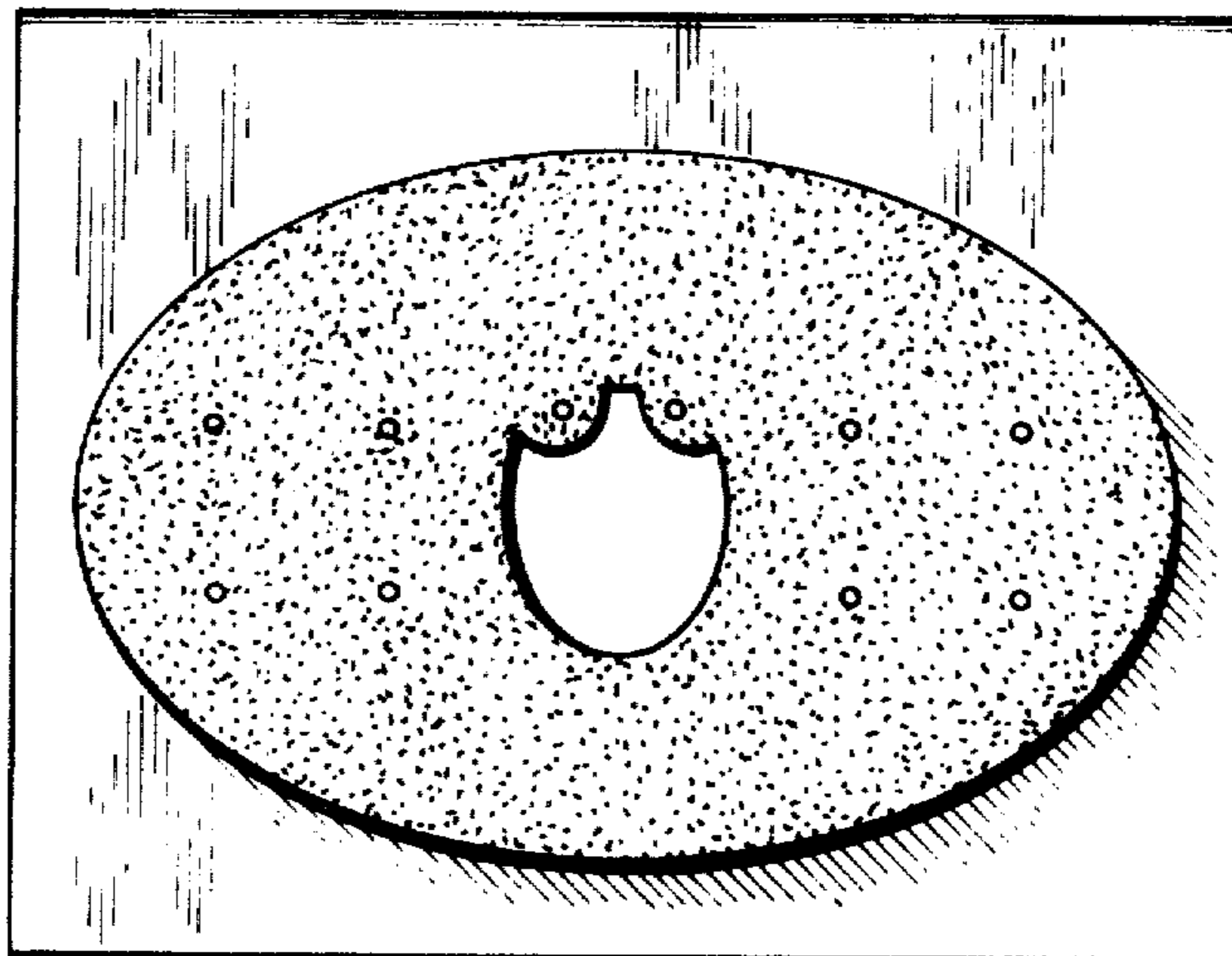
DESCRIPTION

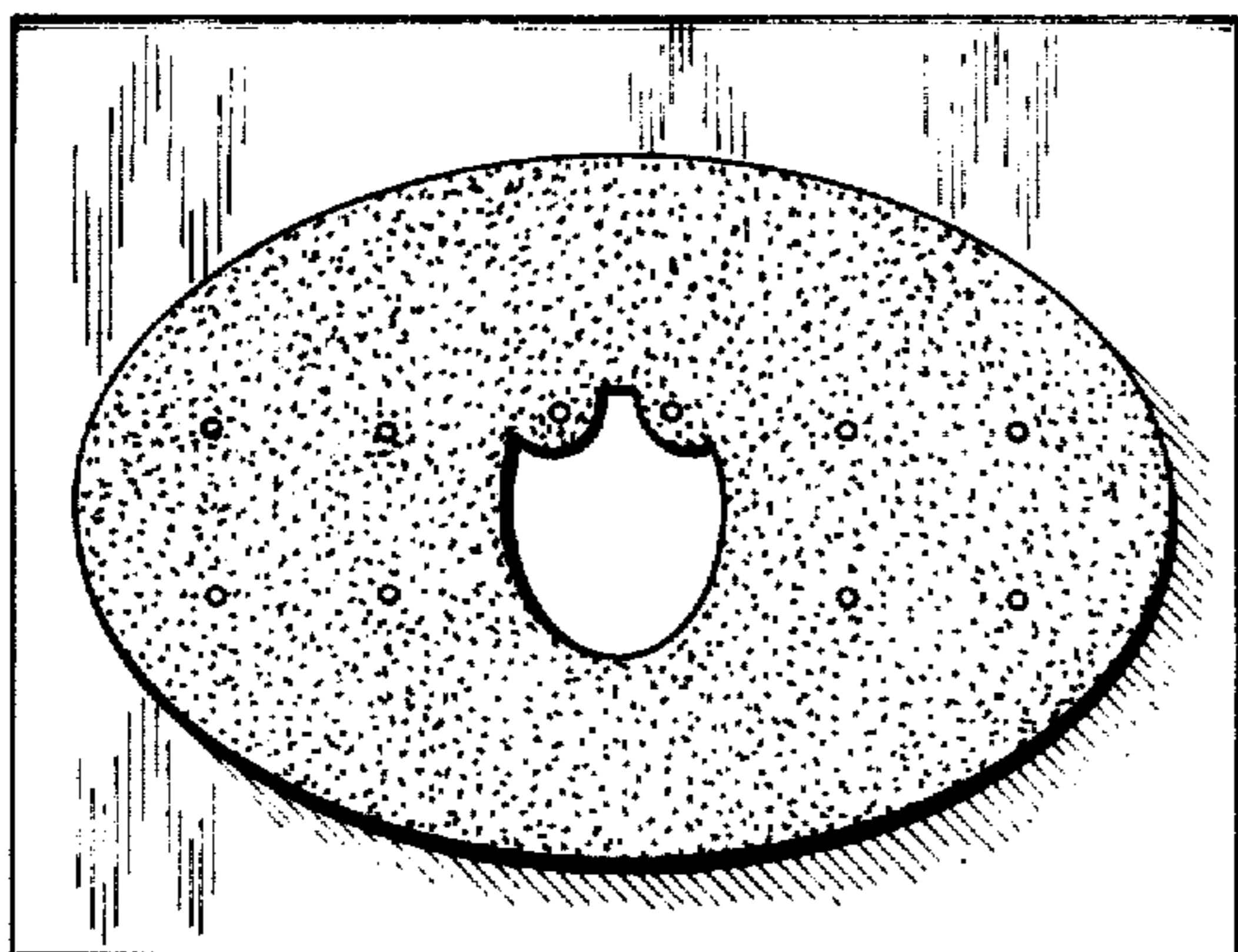

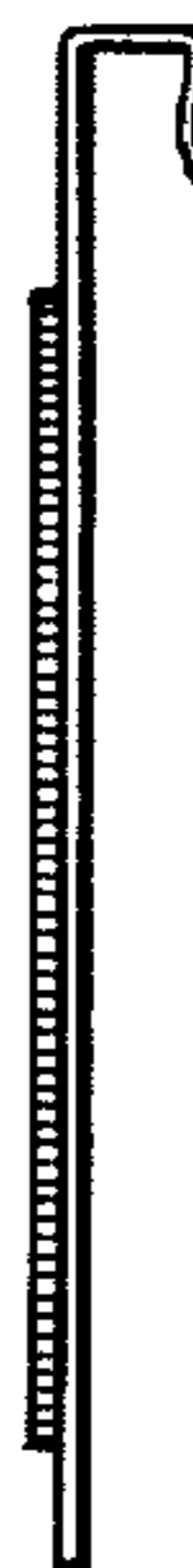

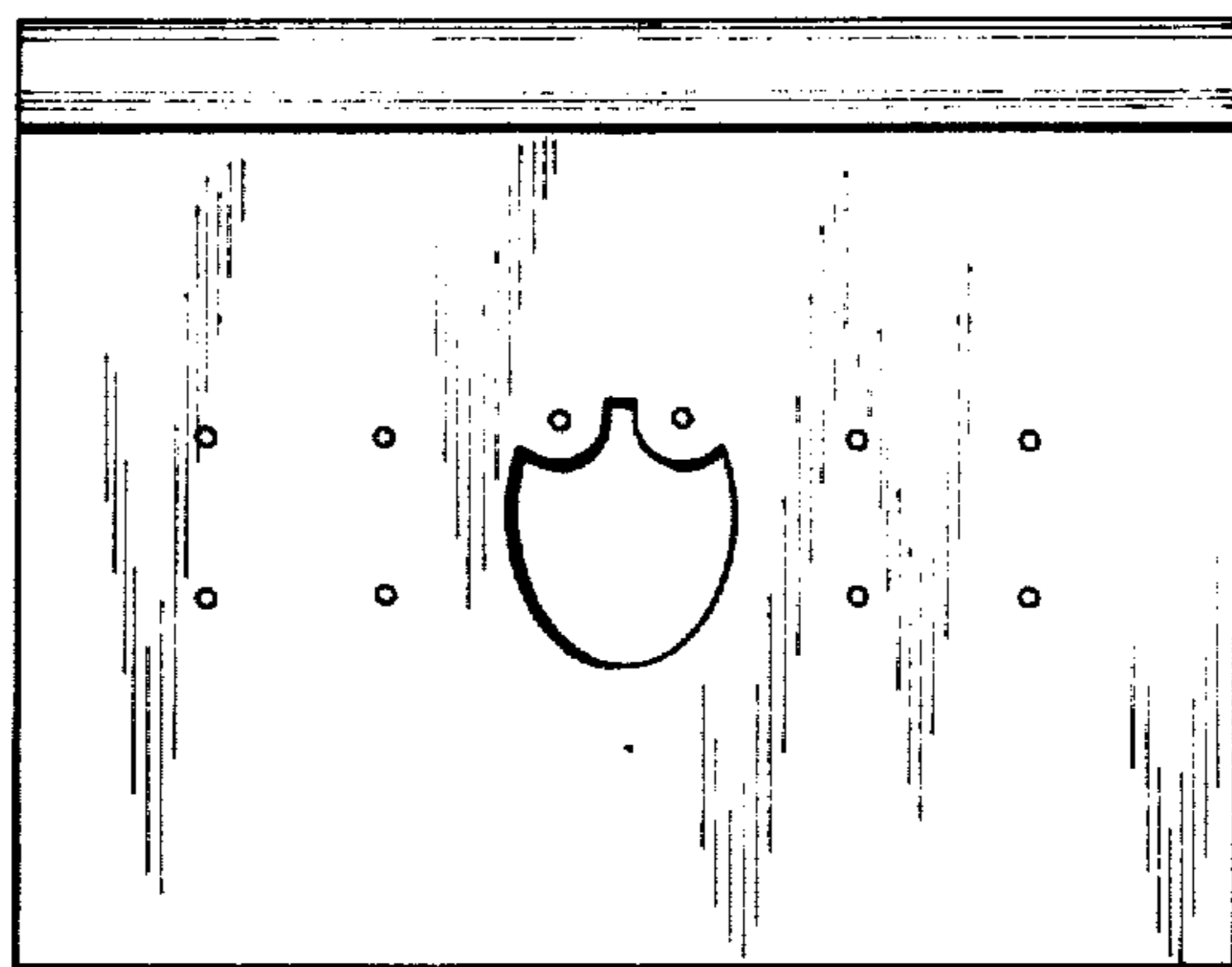

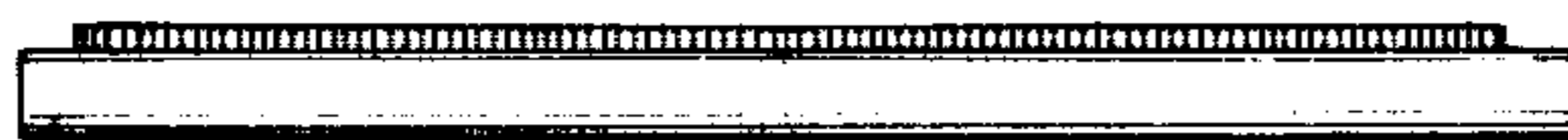
