The ornamental design for an electric guitar, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an electric guitar showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view of the guitar body;
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary front, bottom and left side perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary right side elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary left side elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the guitar.

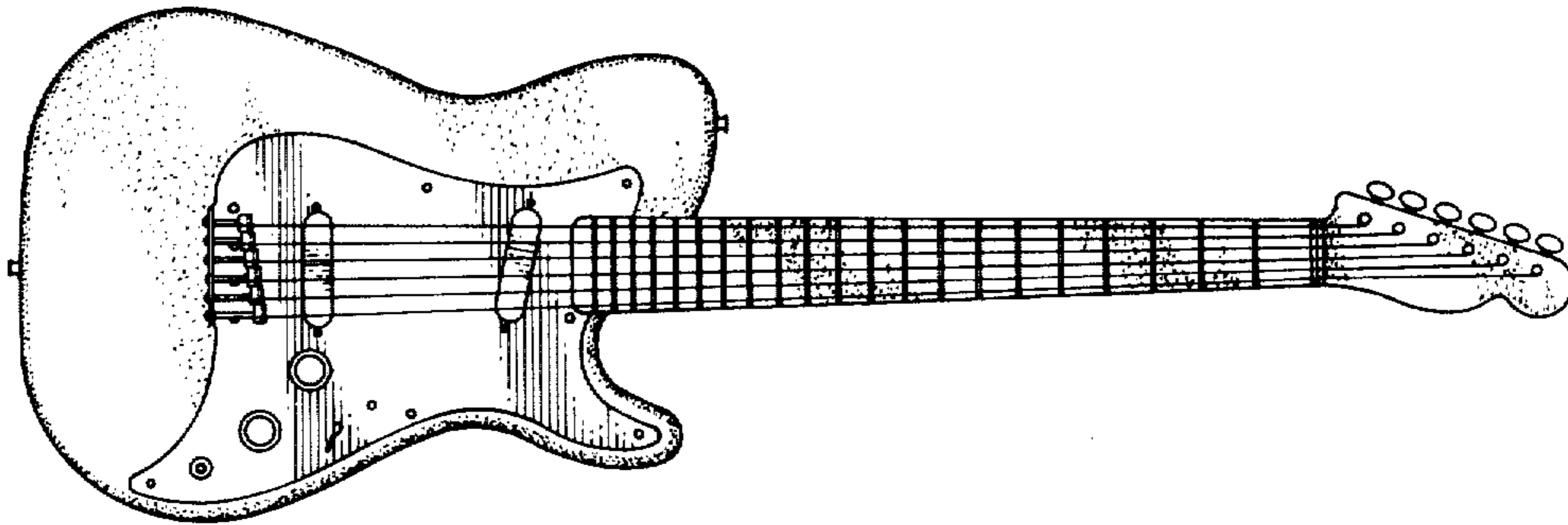

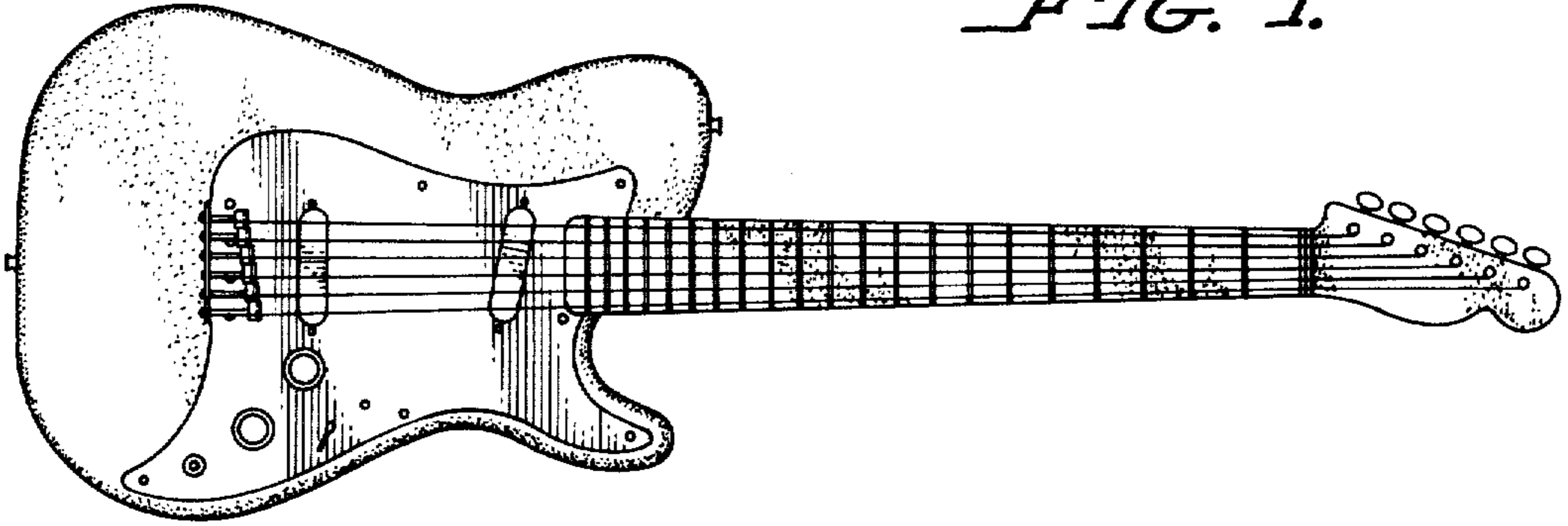

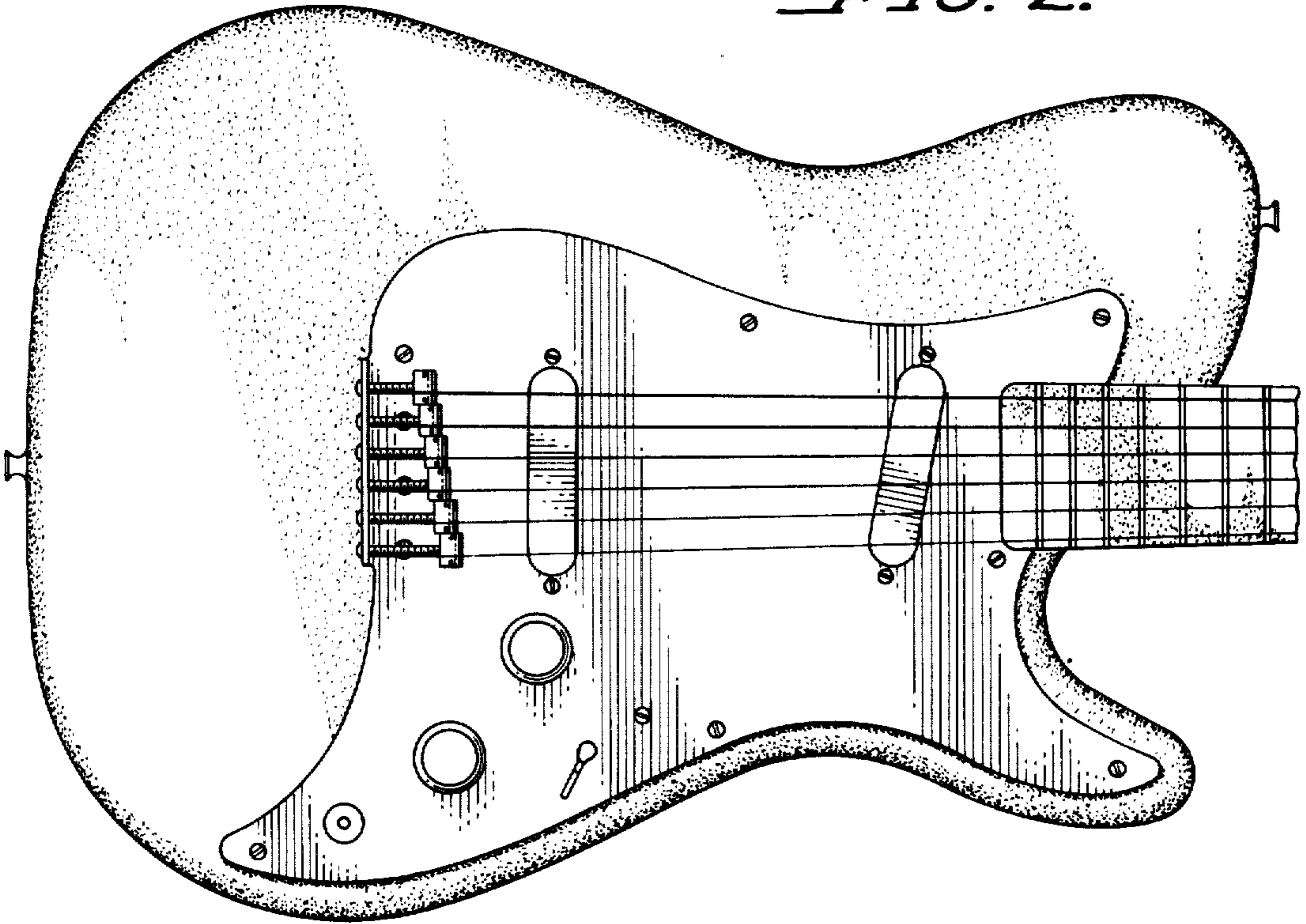

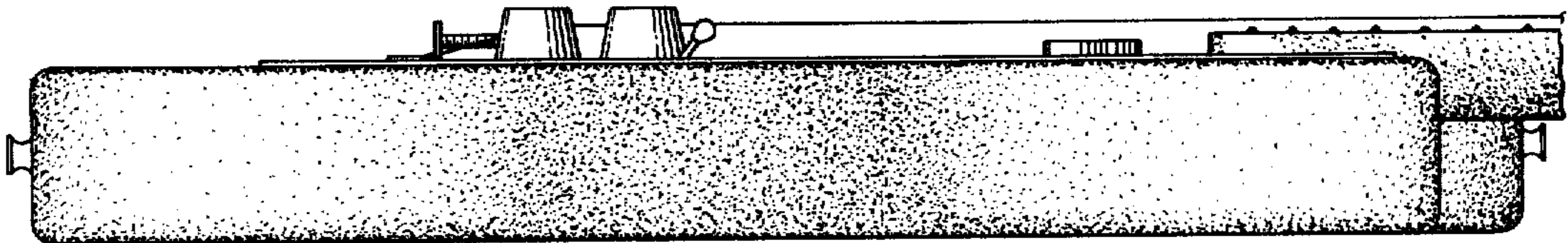

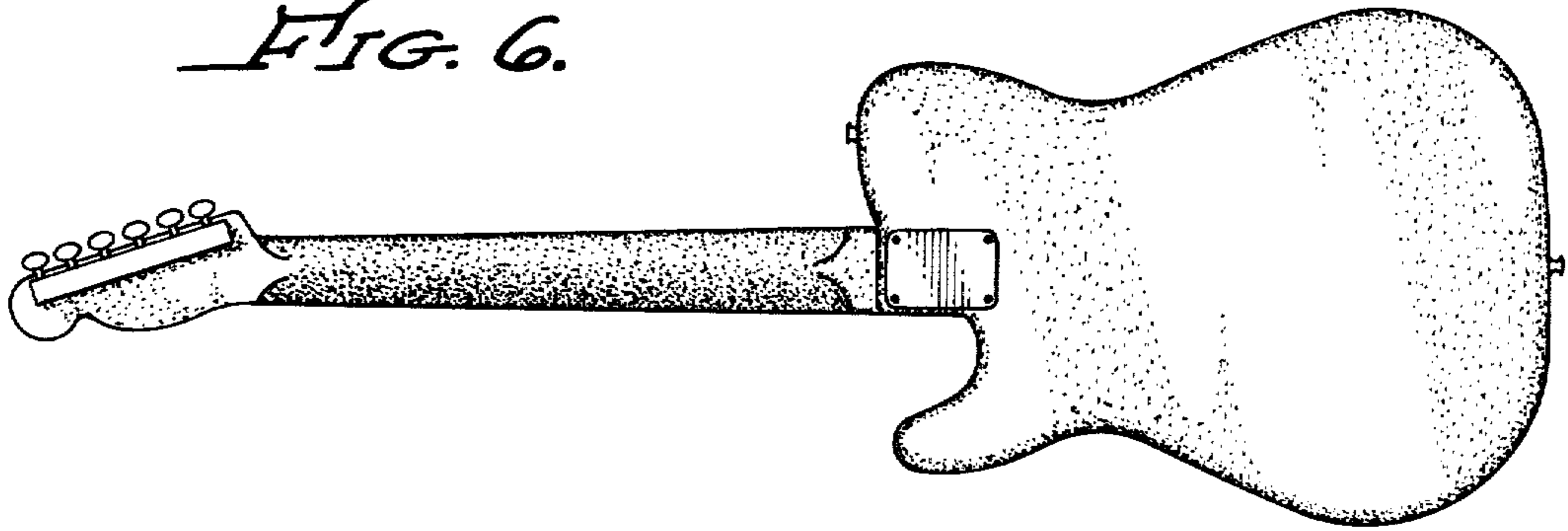

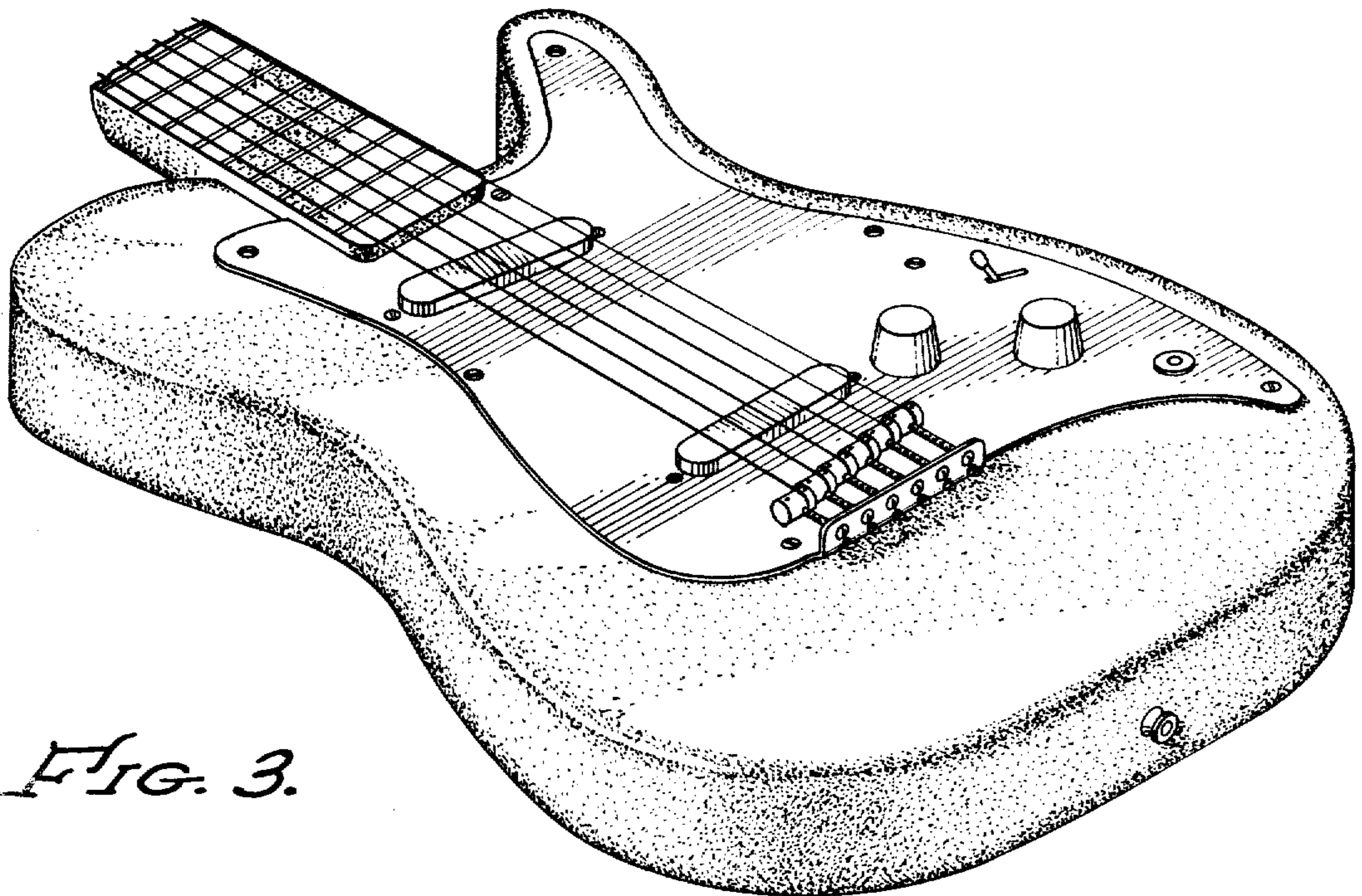
