DESCRIPTION

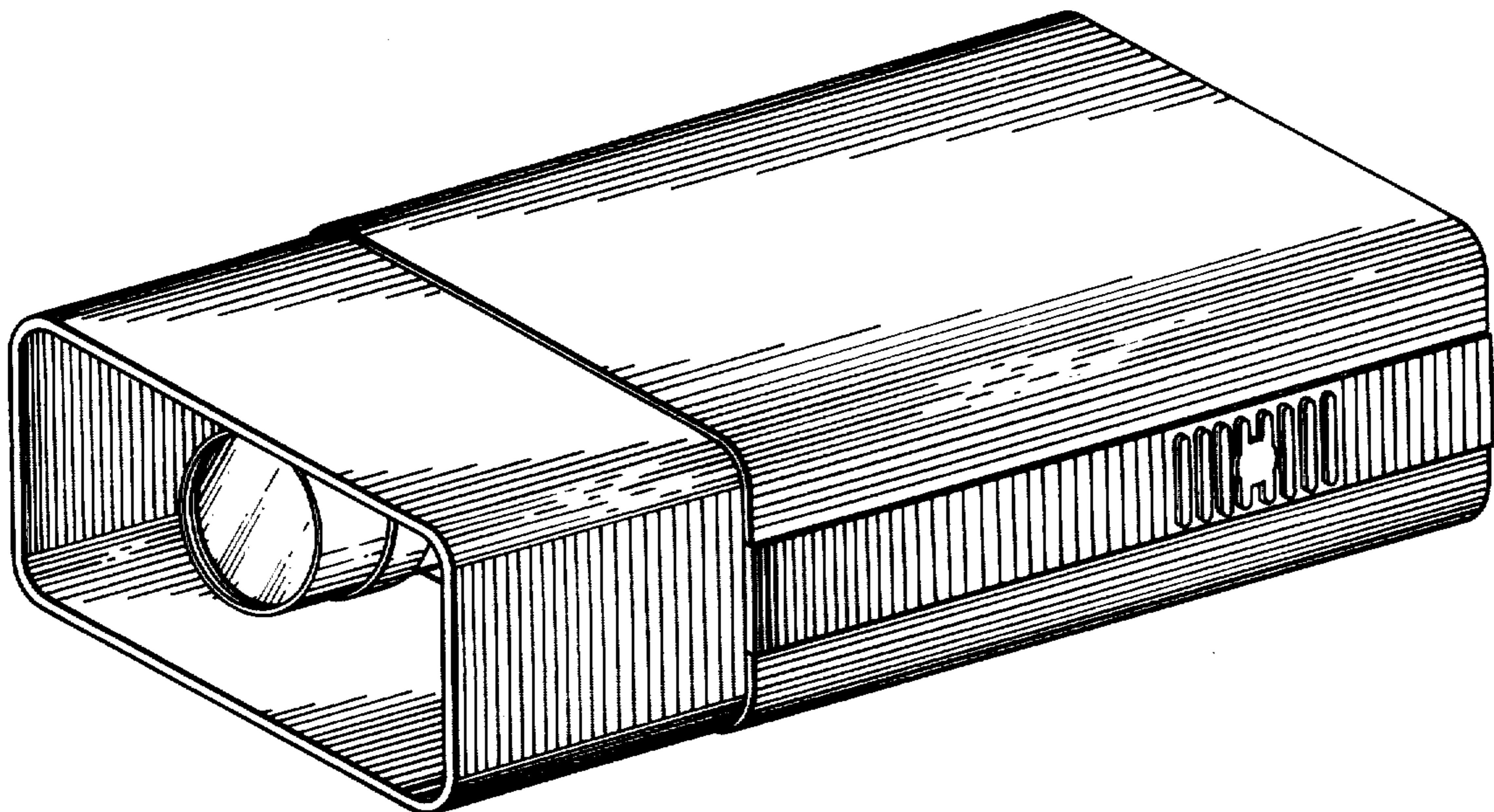
FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a television camera or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view.



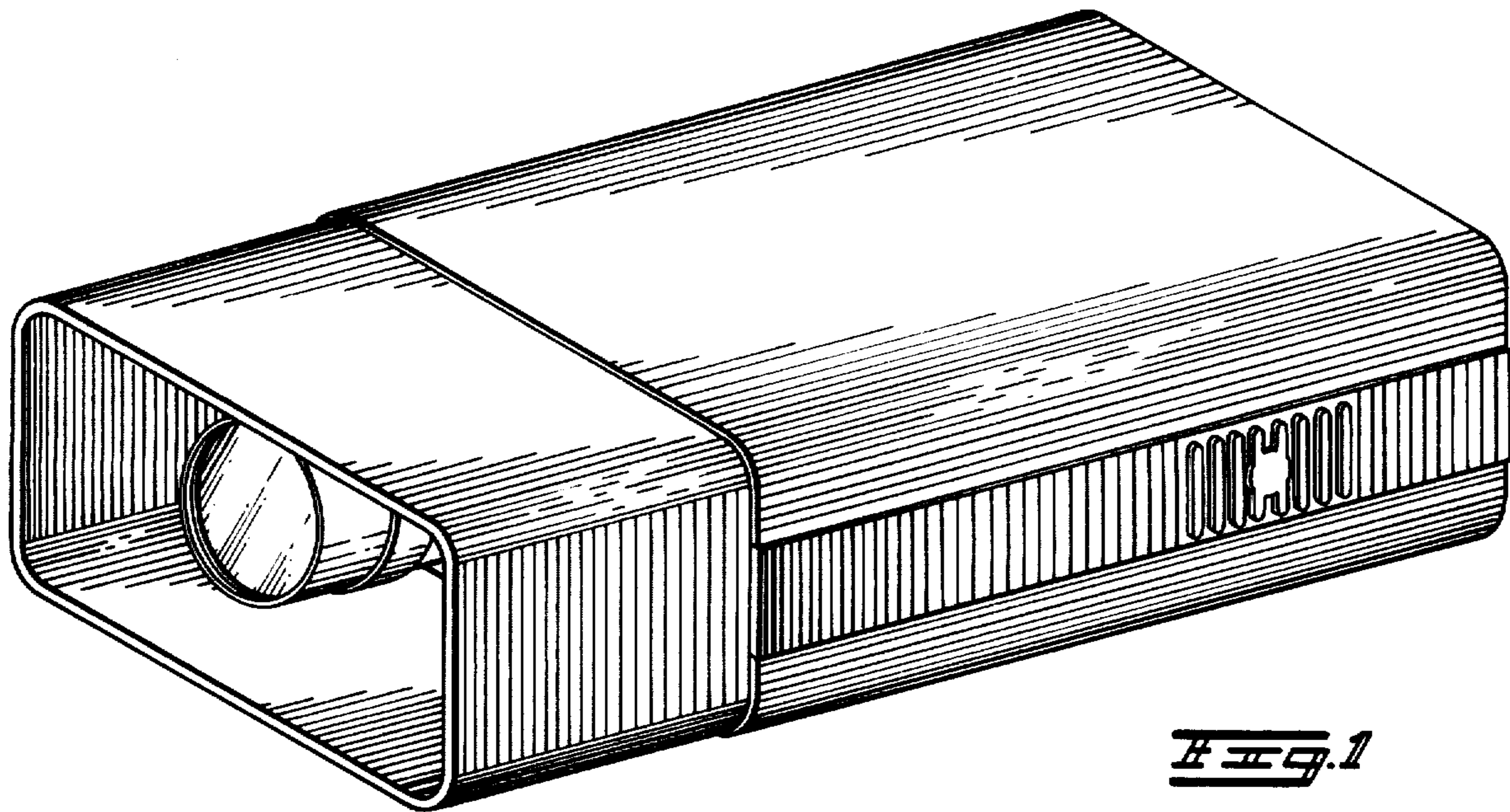

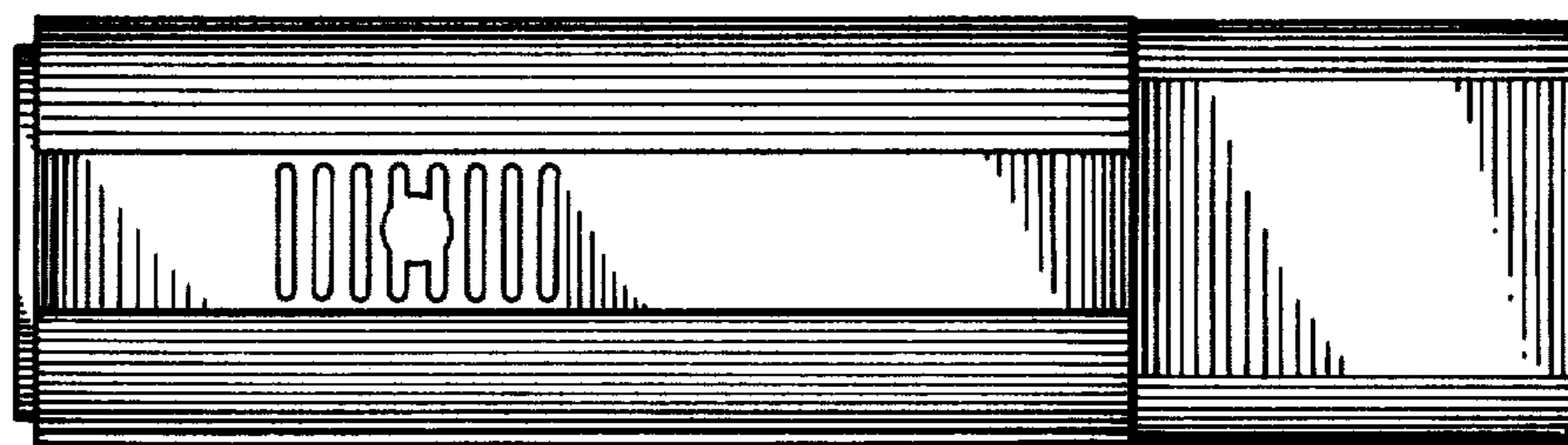

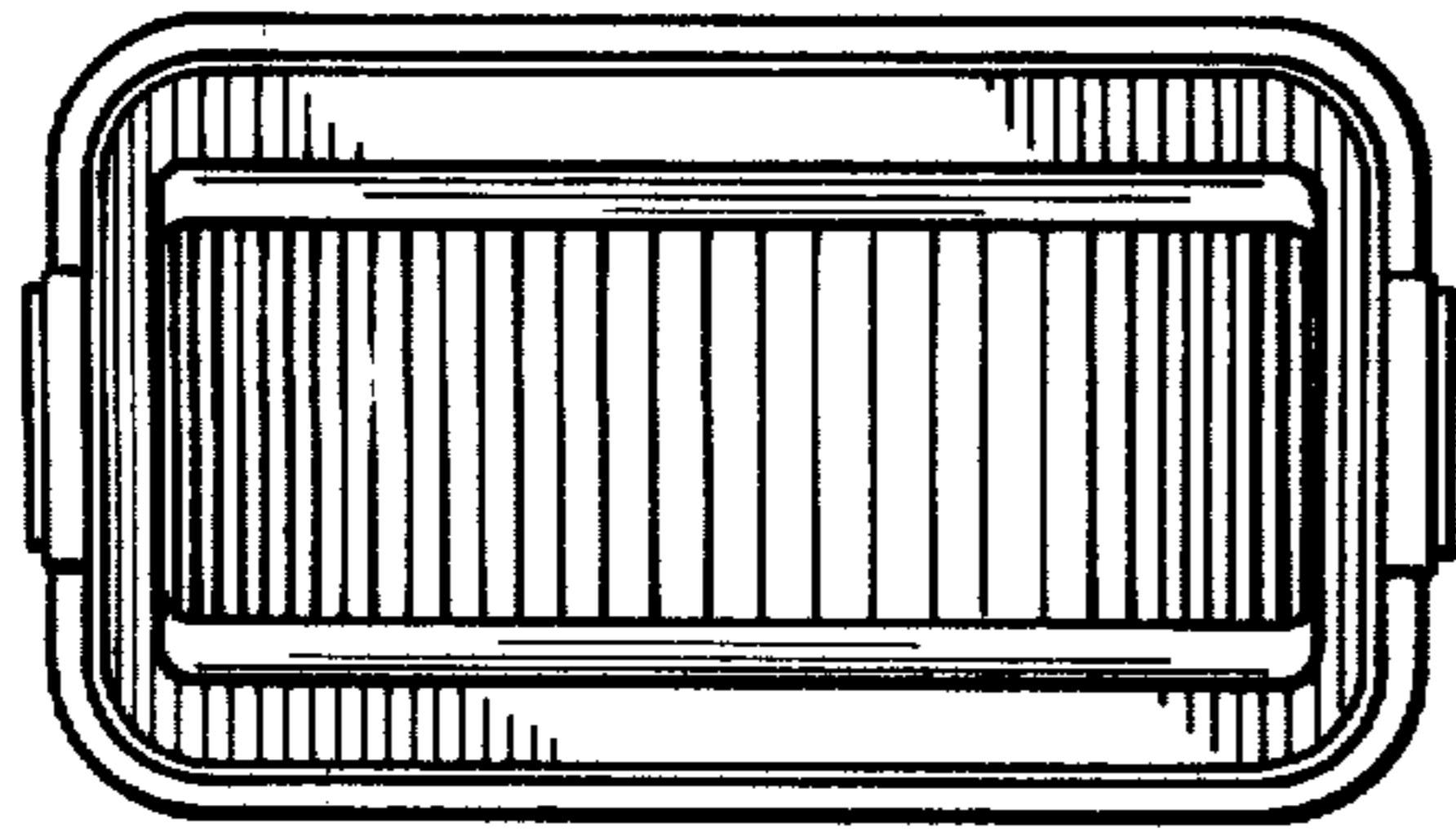

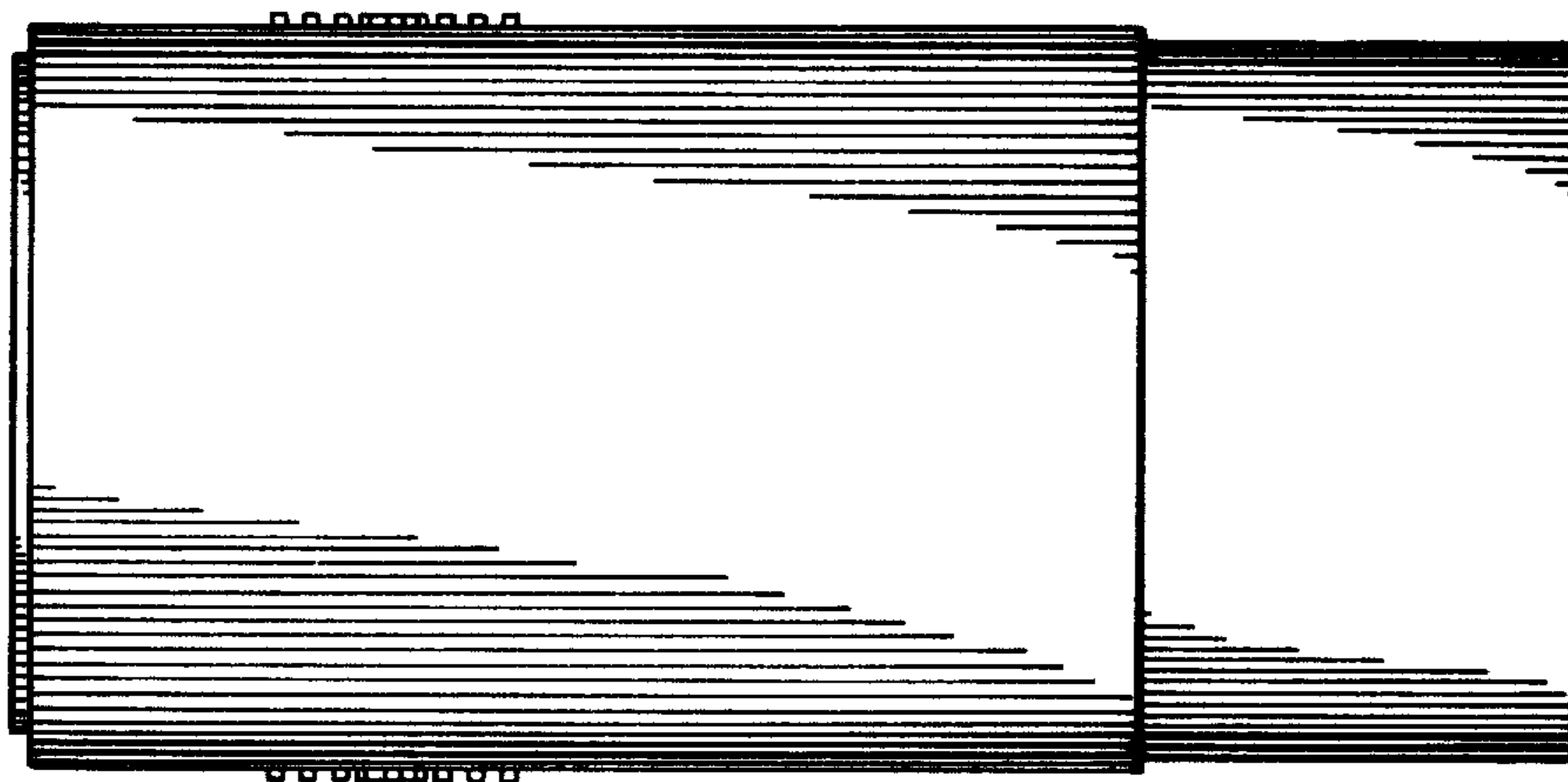
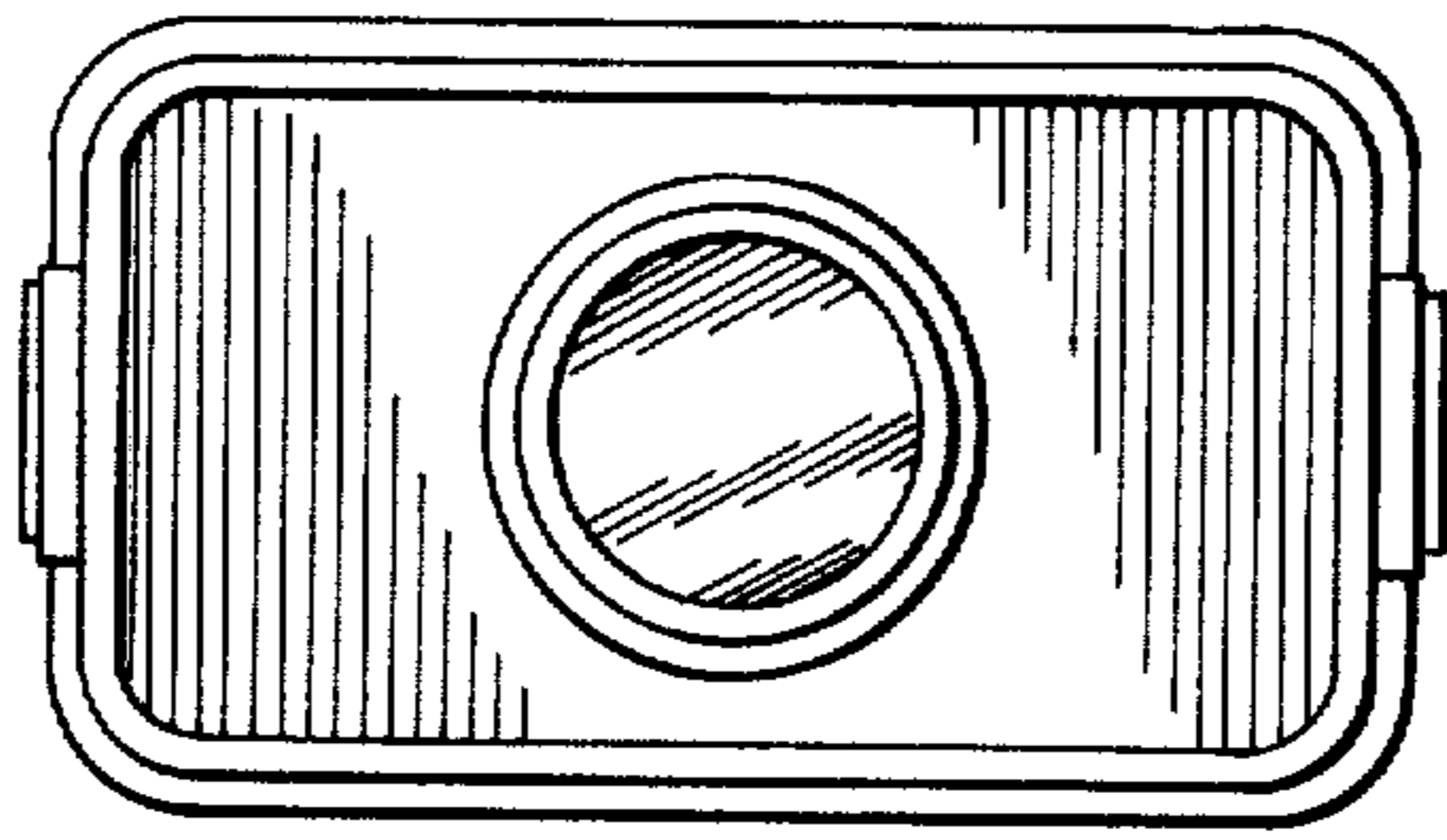
