DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a epidural needle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



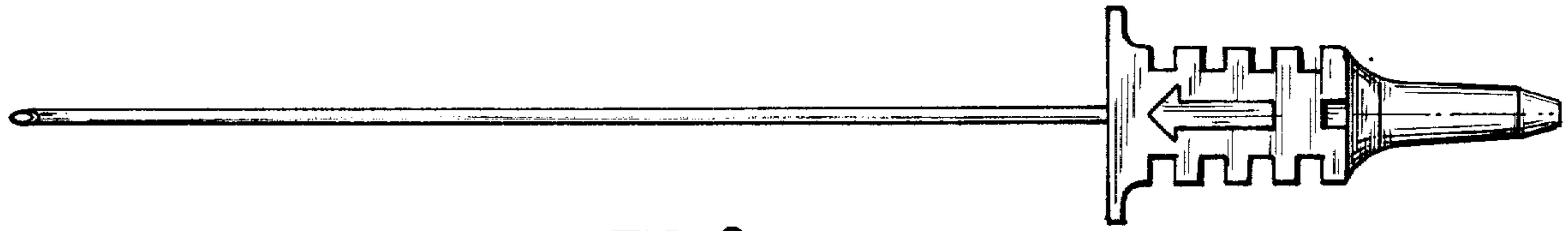

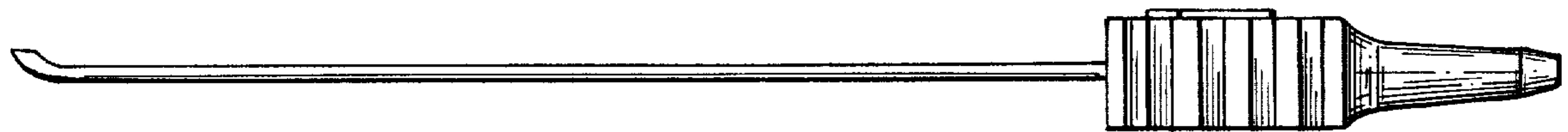

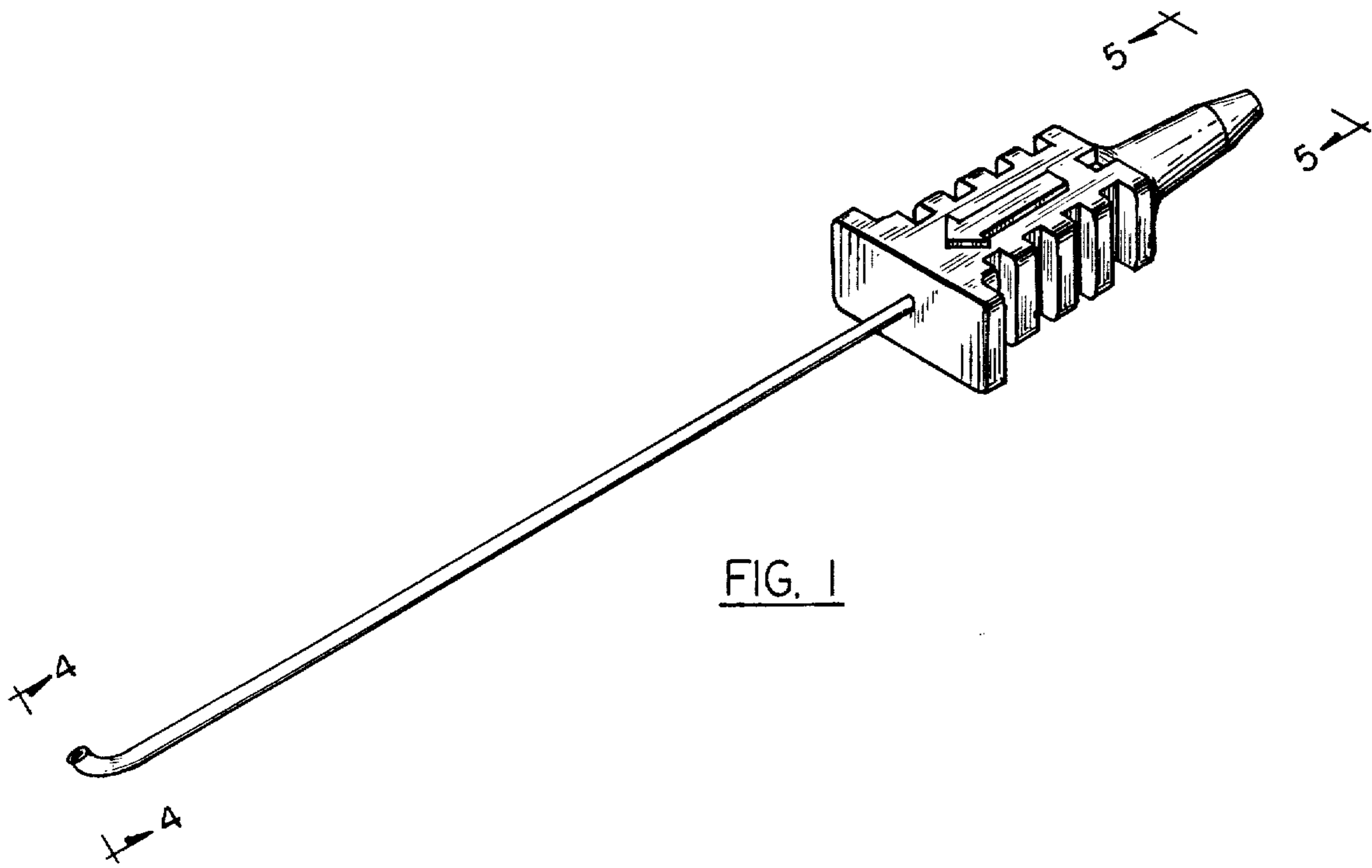

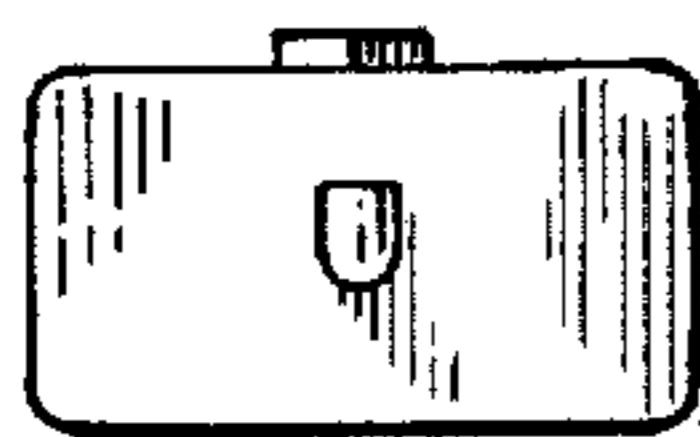

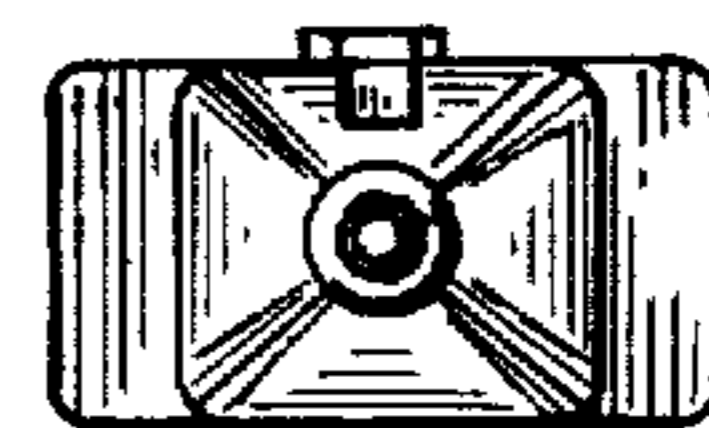
