[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a musical instrument stand, or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the musical instrument stand of the invention;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the stand of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the stand of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 4 is a top perspective view of the stand of FIG. 1, with the support legs extended.

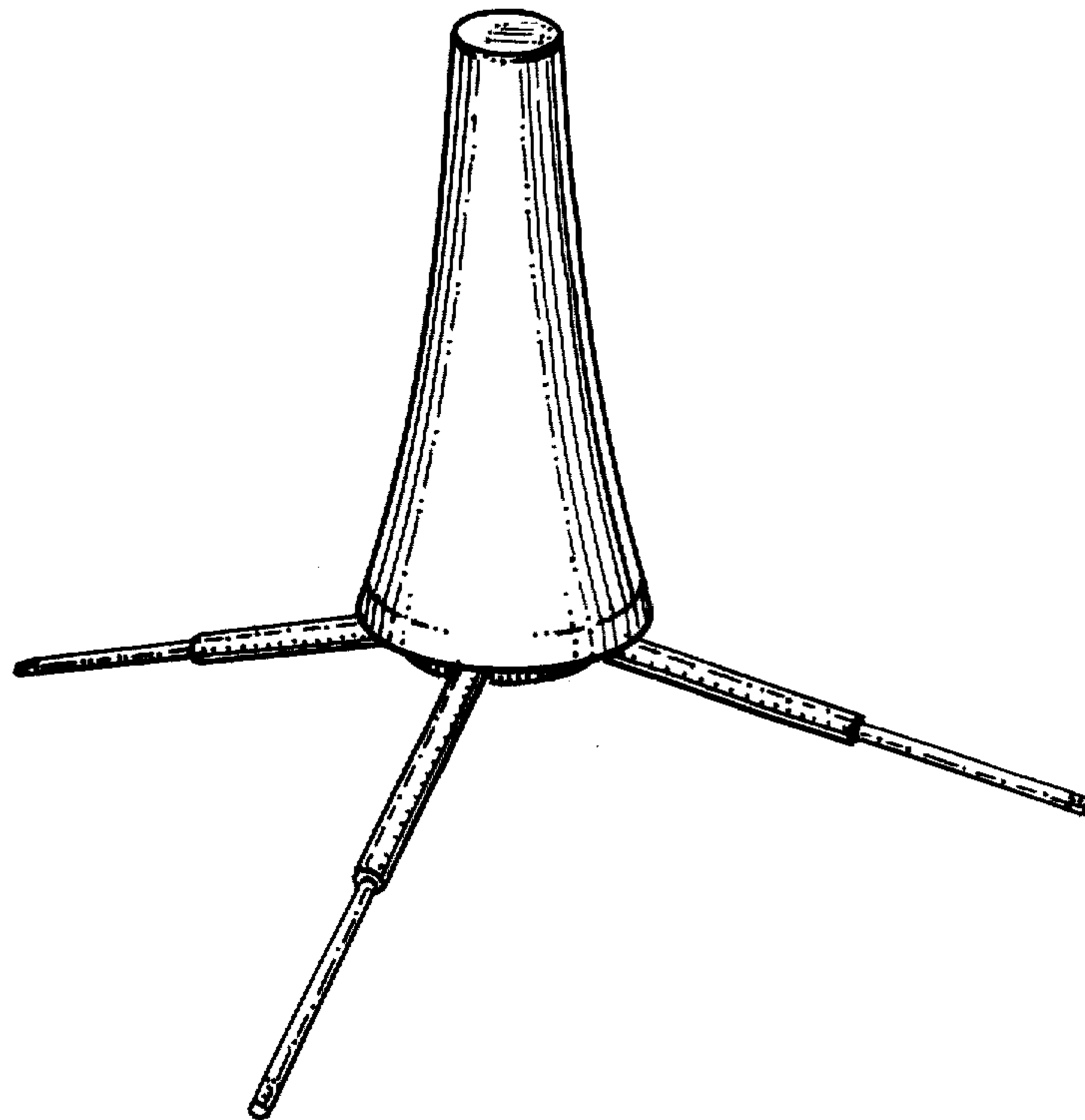

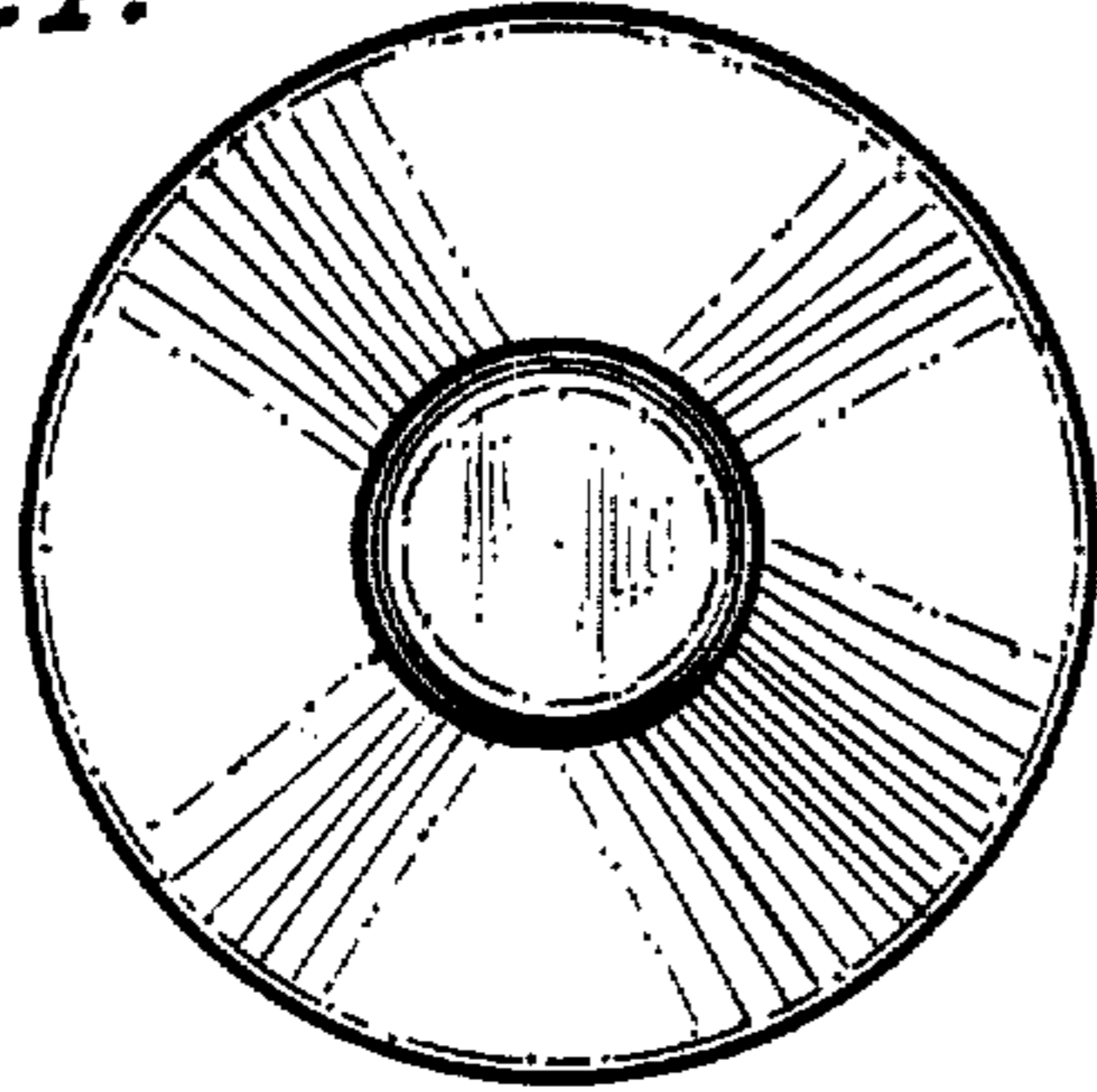

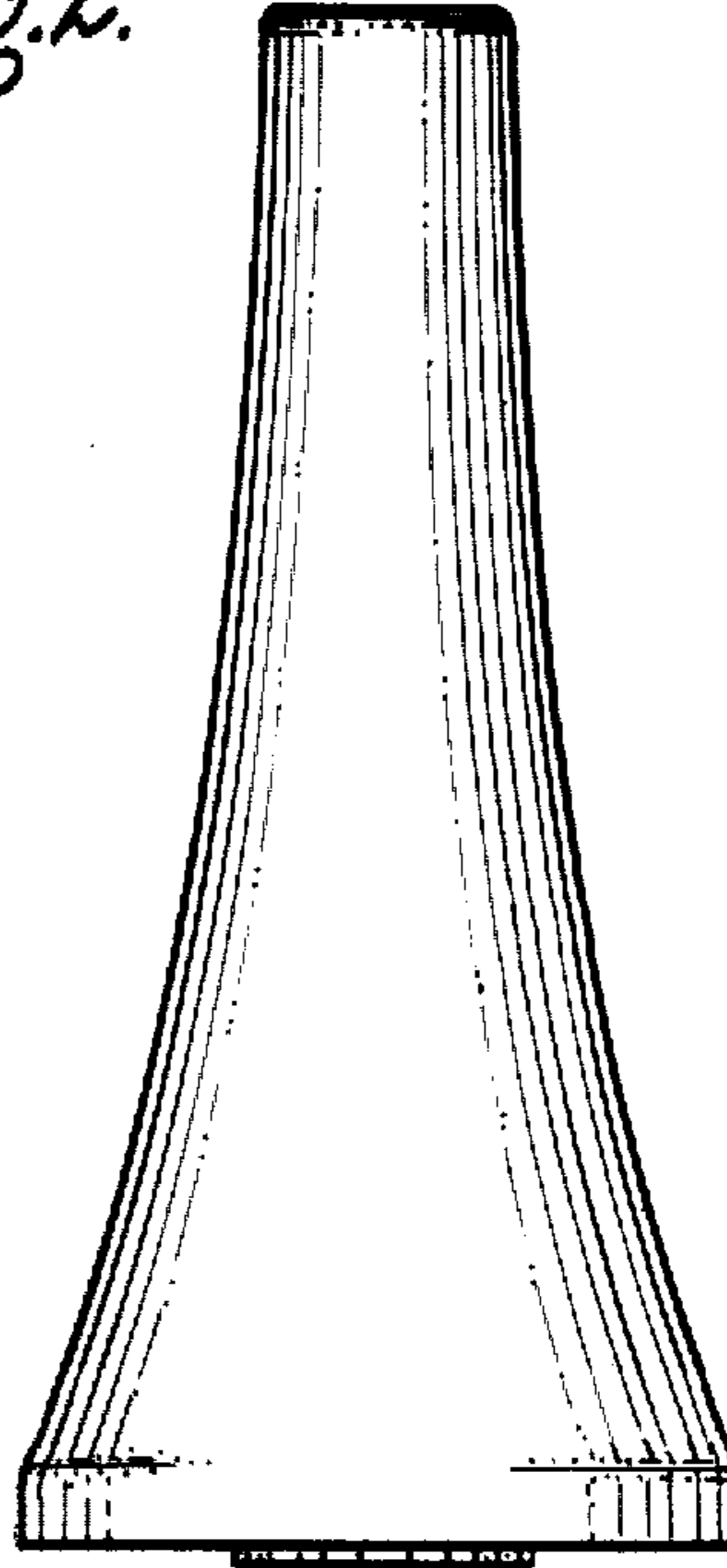

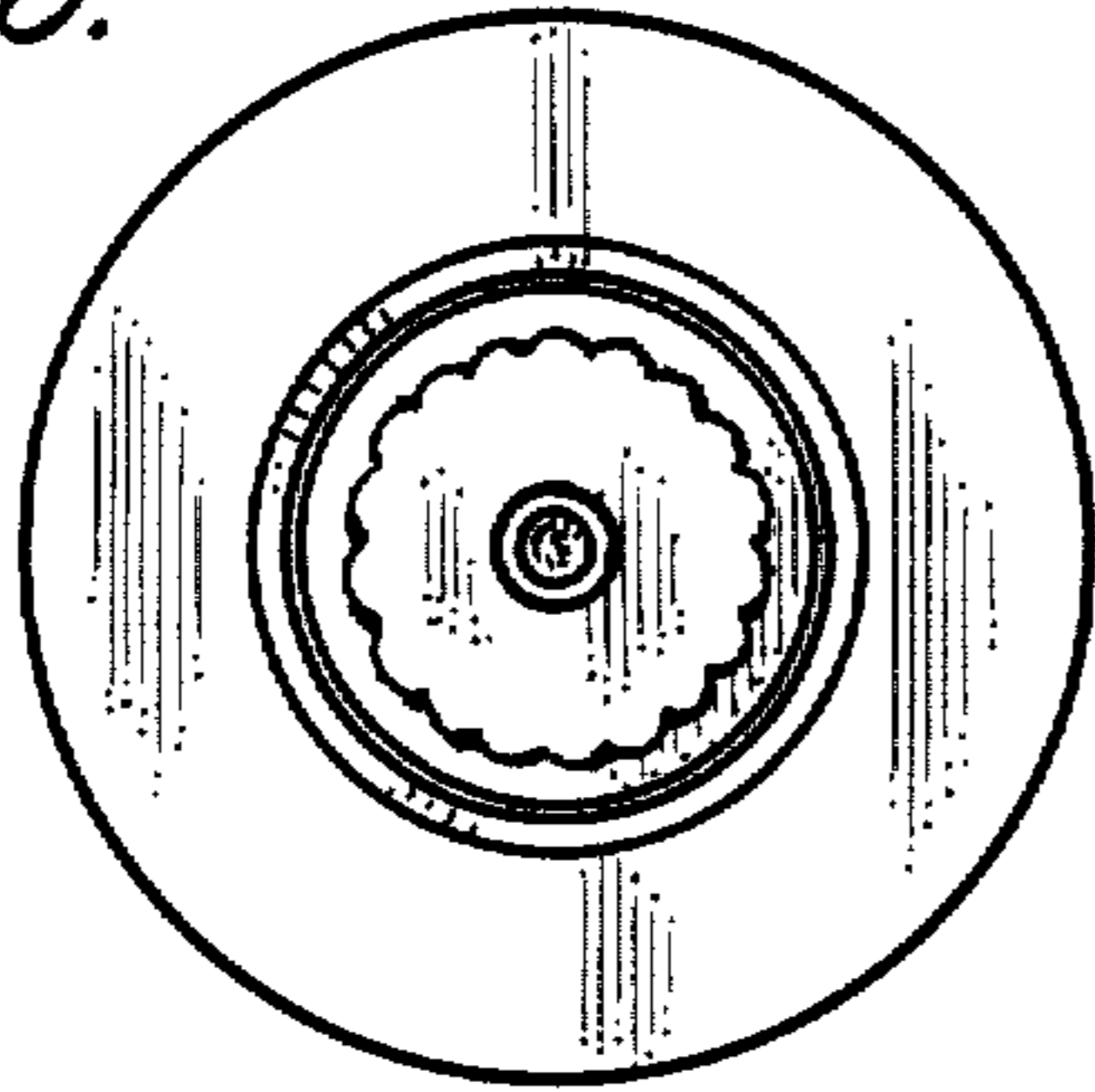
