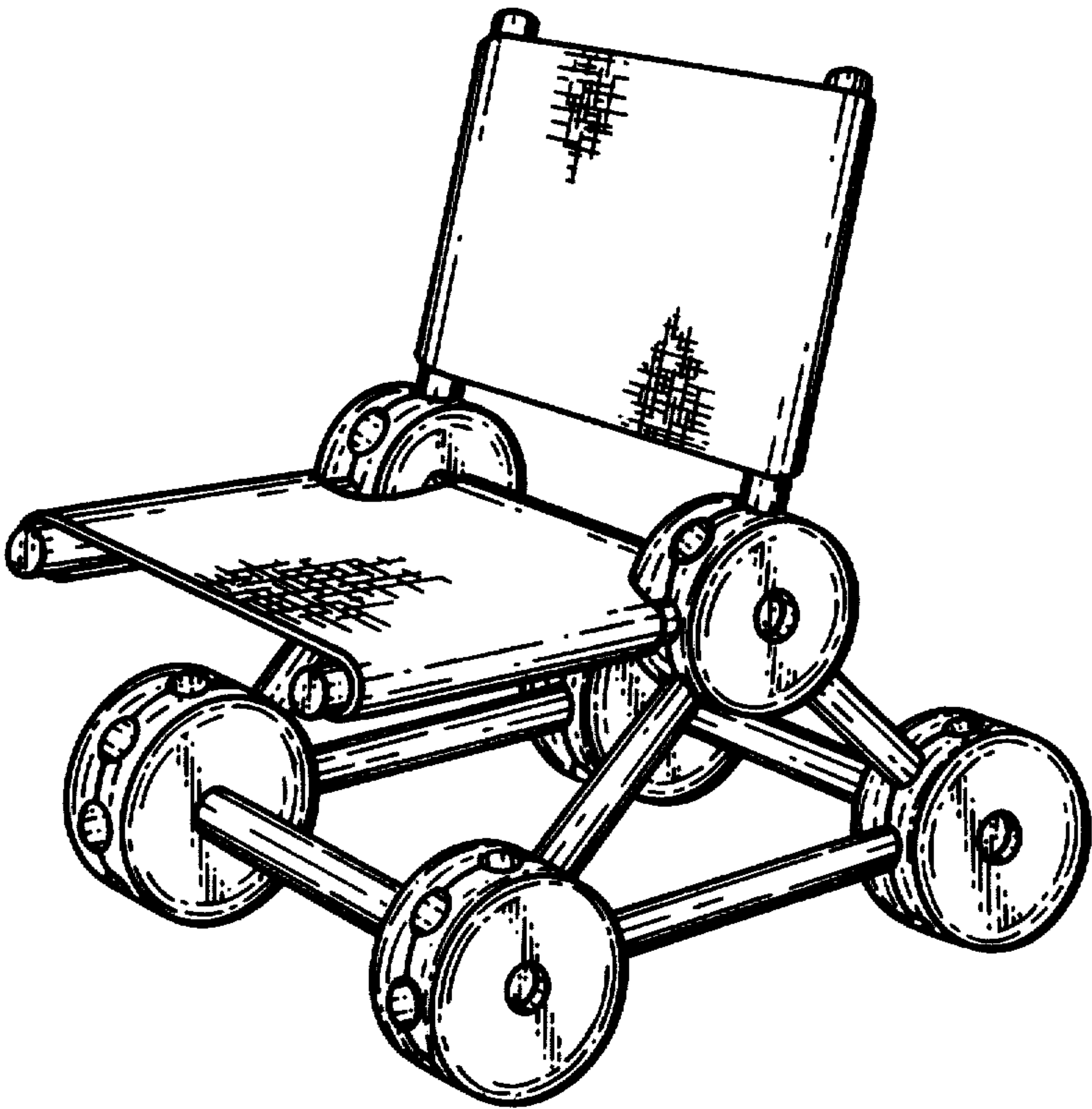

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a spool and spindle chair,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spool and spindle chair
in accord with my new design as taken from the front
and left side thereof,
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the design as taken
from the left side, the right side elevational view being
the mirror image thereof,
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, and
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the chair of my new
design.



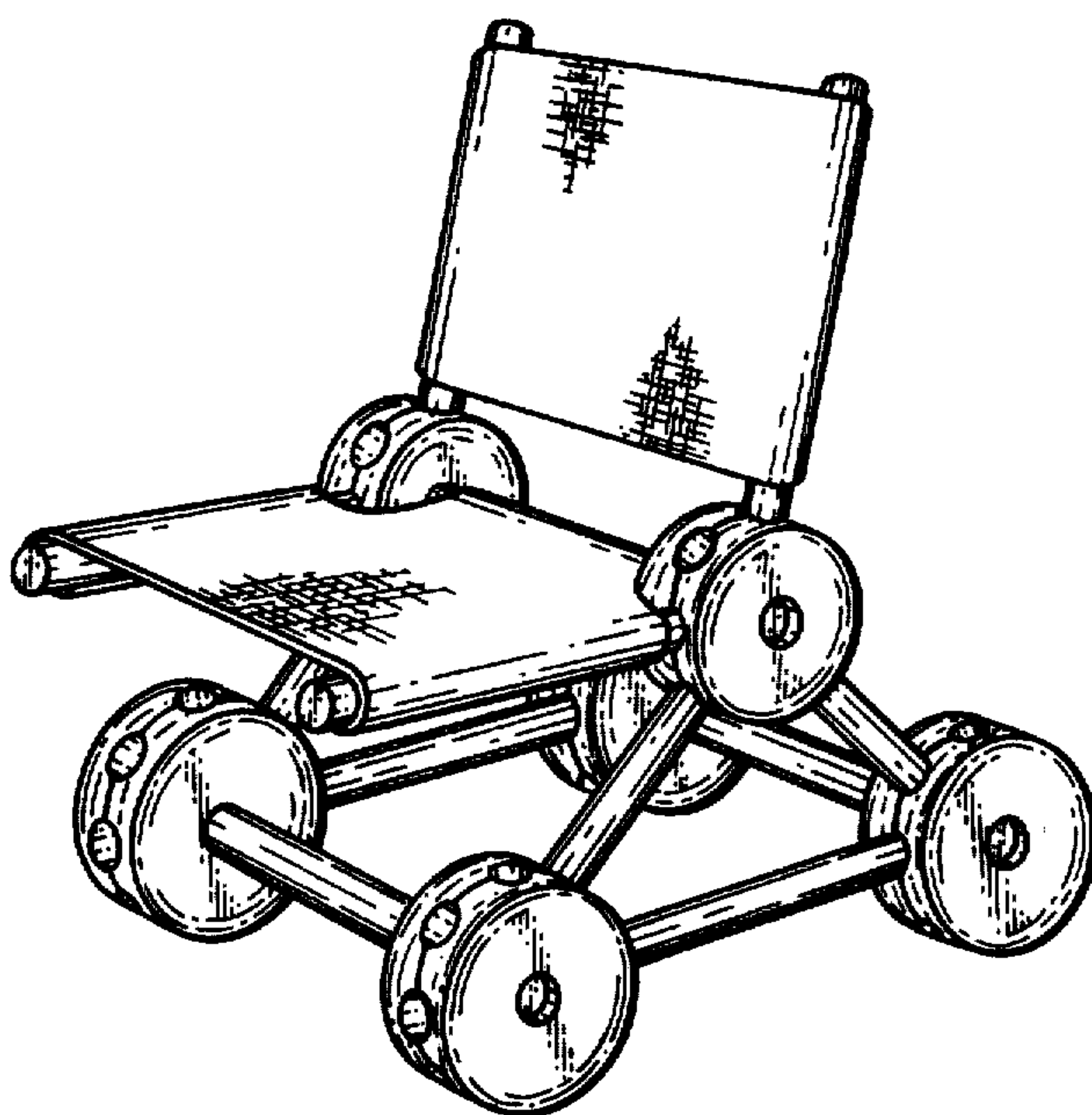

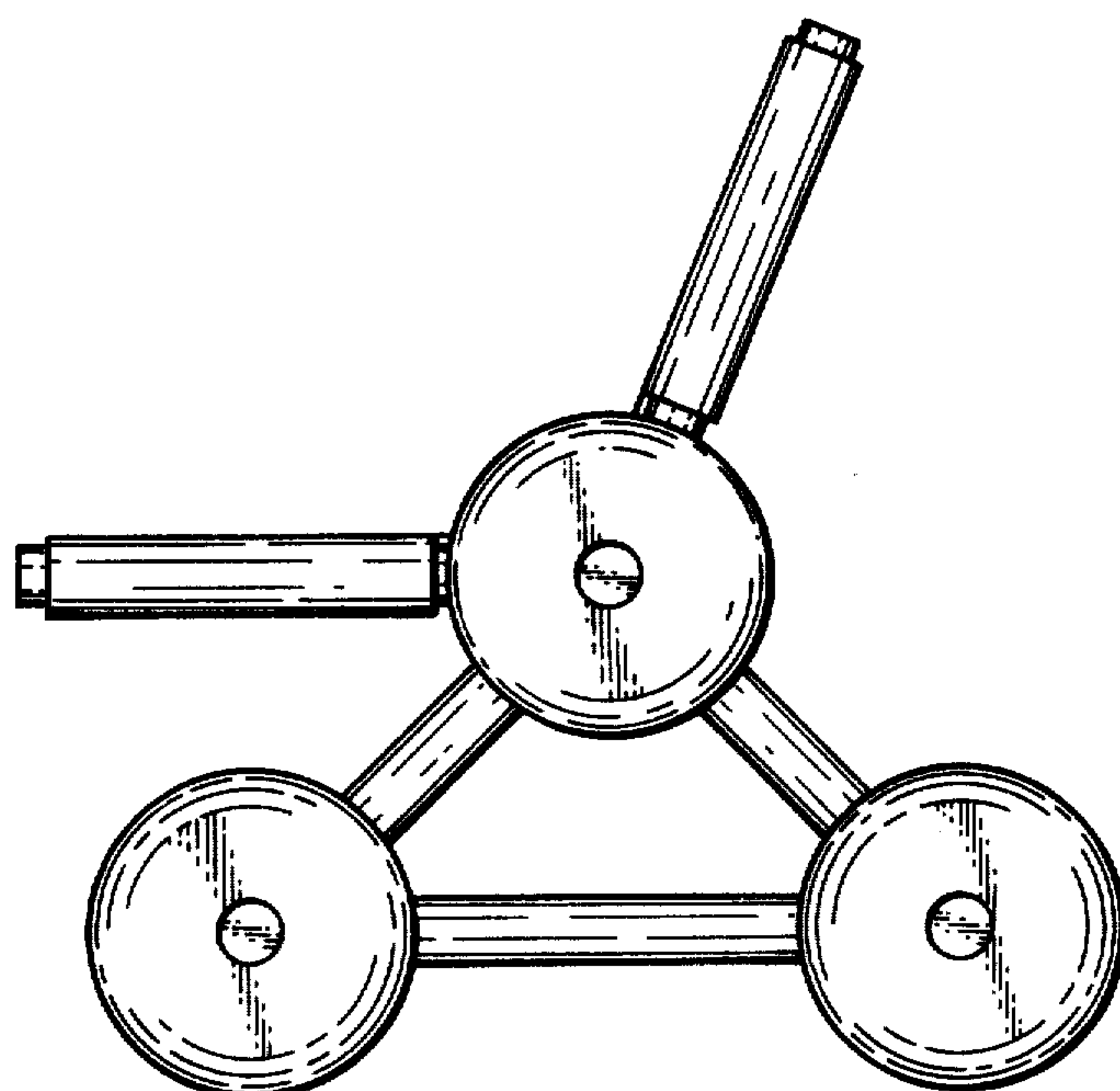

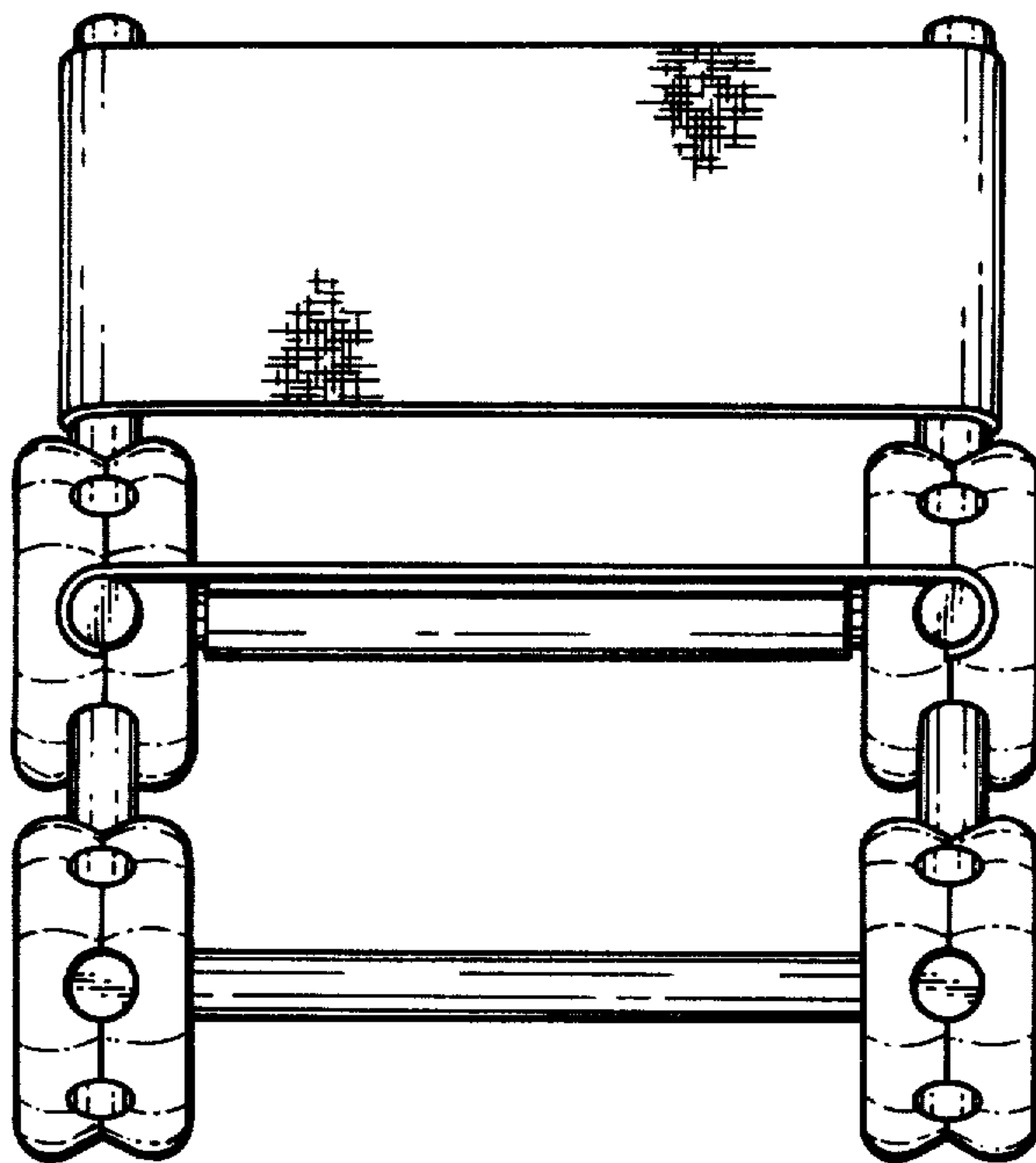

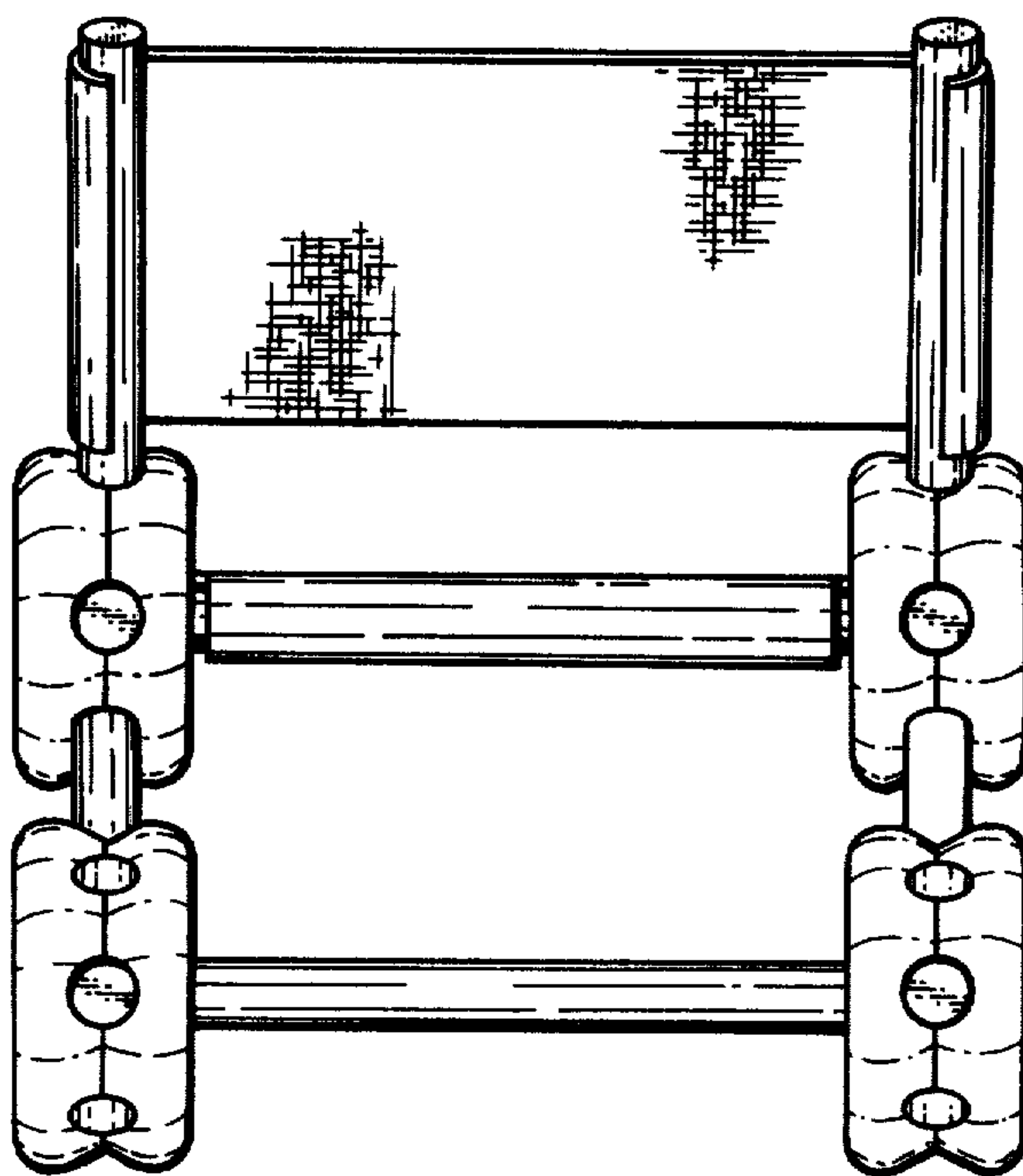
