[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a mold for confectionery or bakery product or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a mold for confectionery or bakery product or the like, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 3 is a top edge elevation; FIG. 4 is a bottom edge elevation; FIG. 5 is an elevation of the left-hand edge as appears in FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is an elevation of the right-hand edge as appears in FIG. 1; and, FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken on the line 7-7 in FIG. 1.

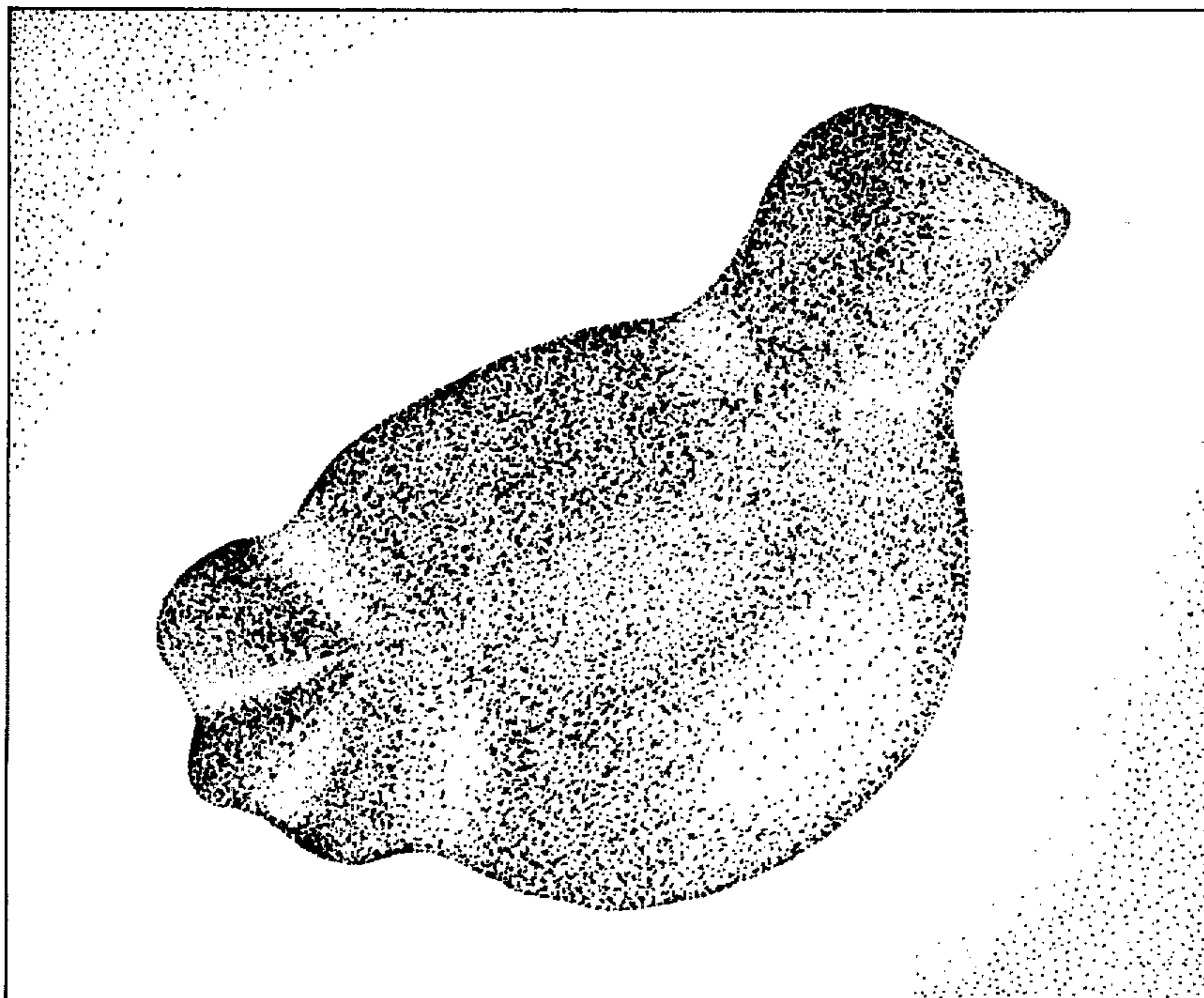

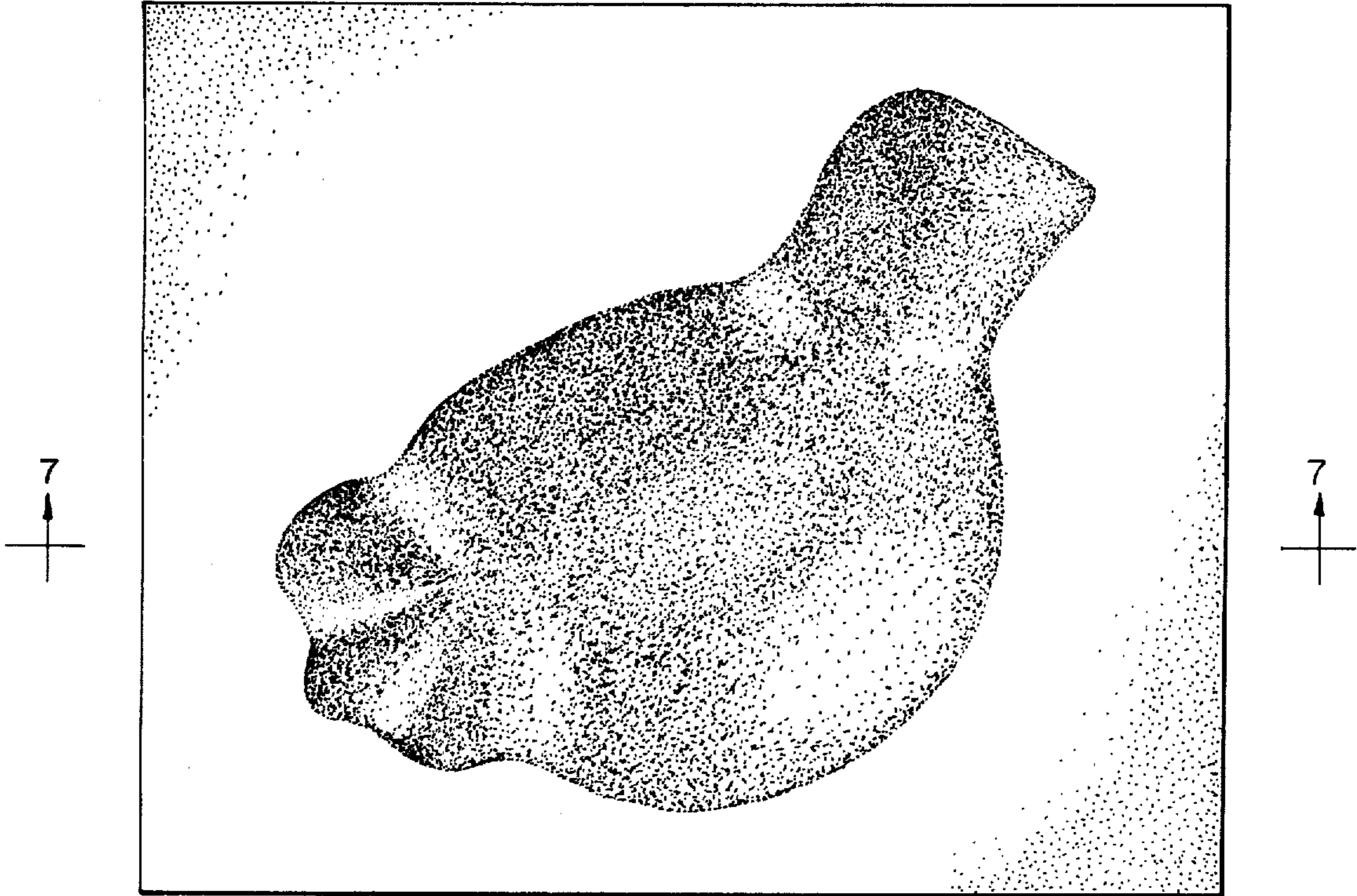

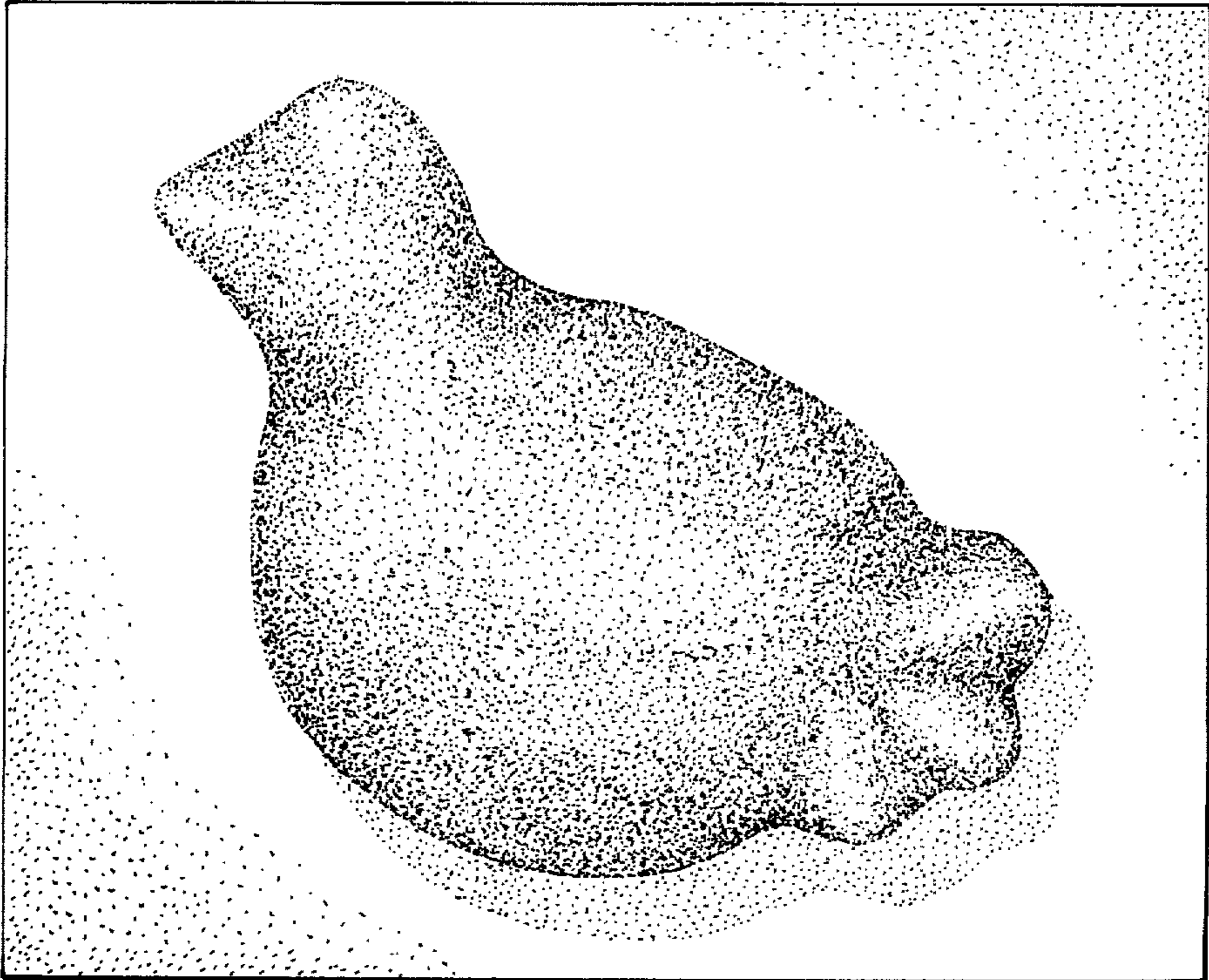

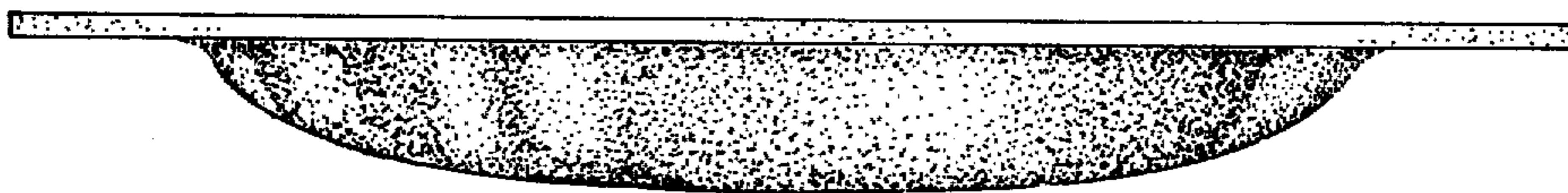
