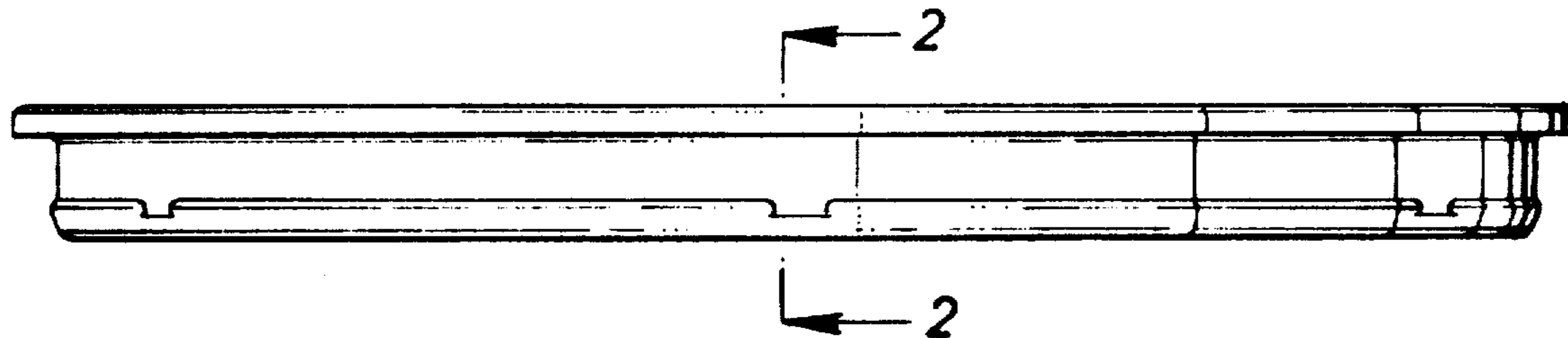

The ornamental design for a lid for a container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a lid for a container showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken on the line 2—2 of FIG. 4;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof.



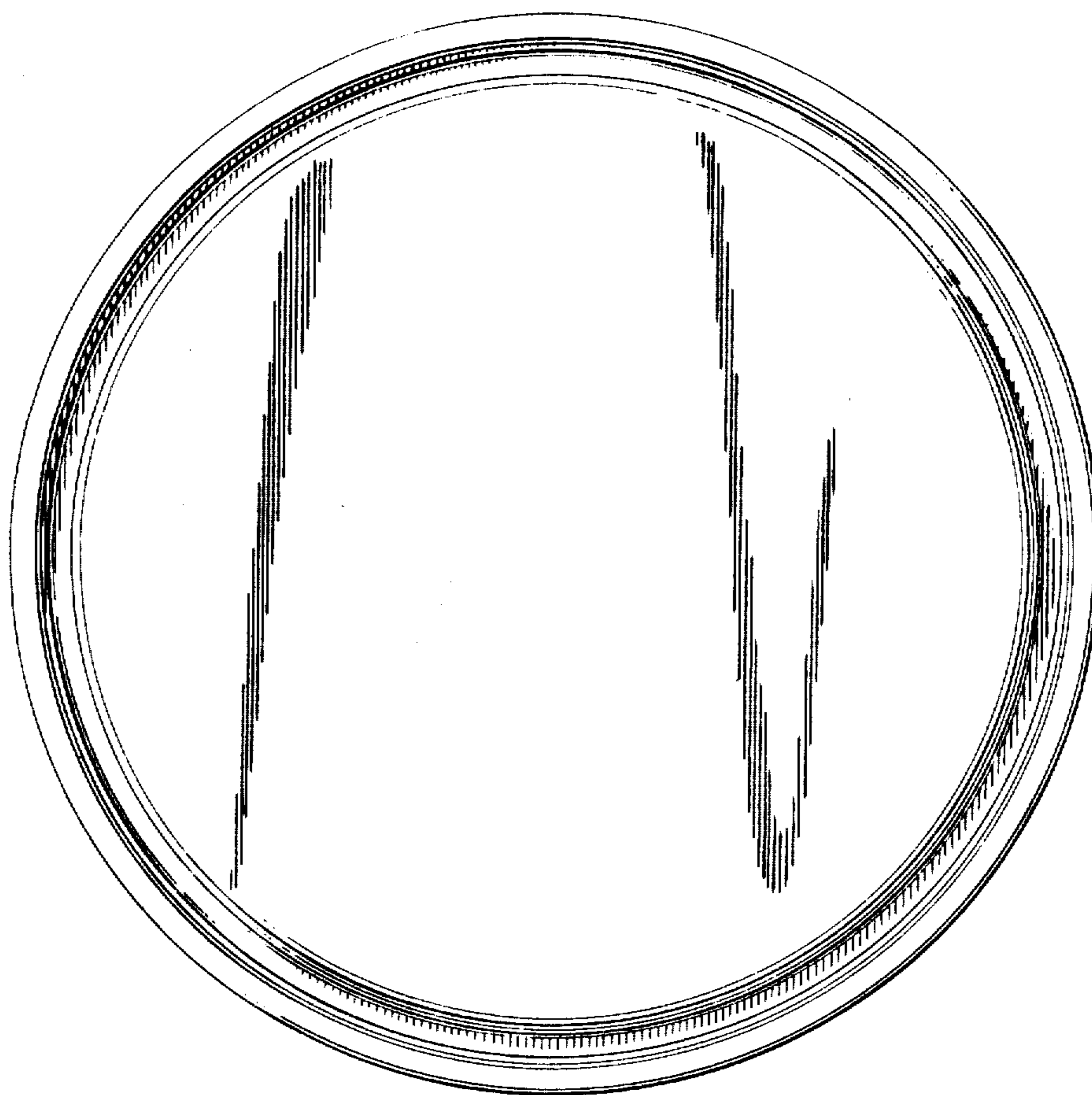

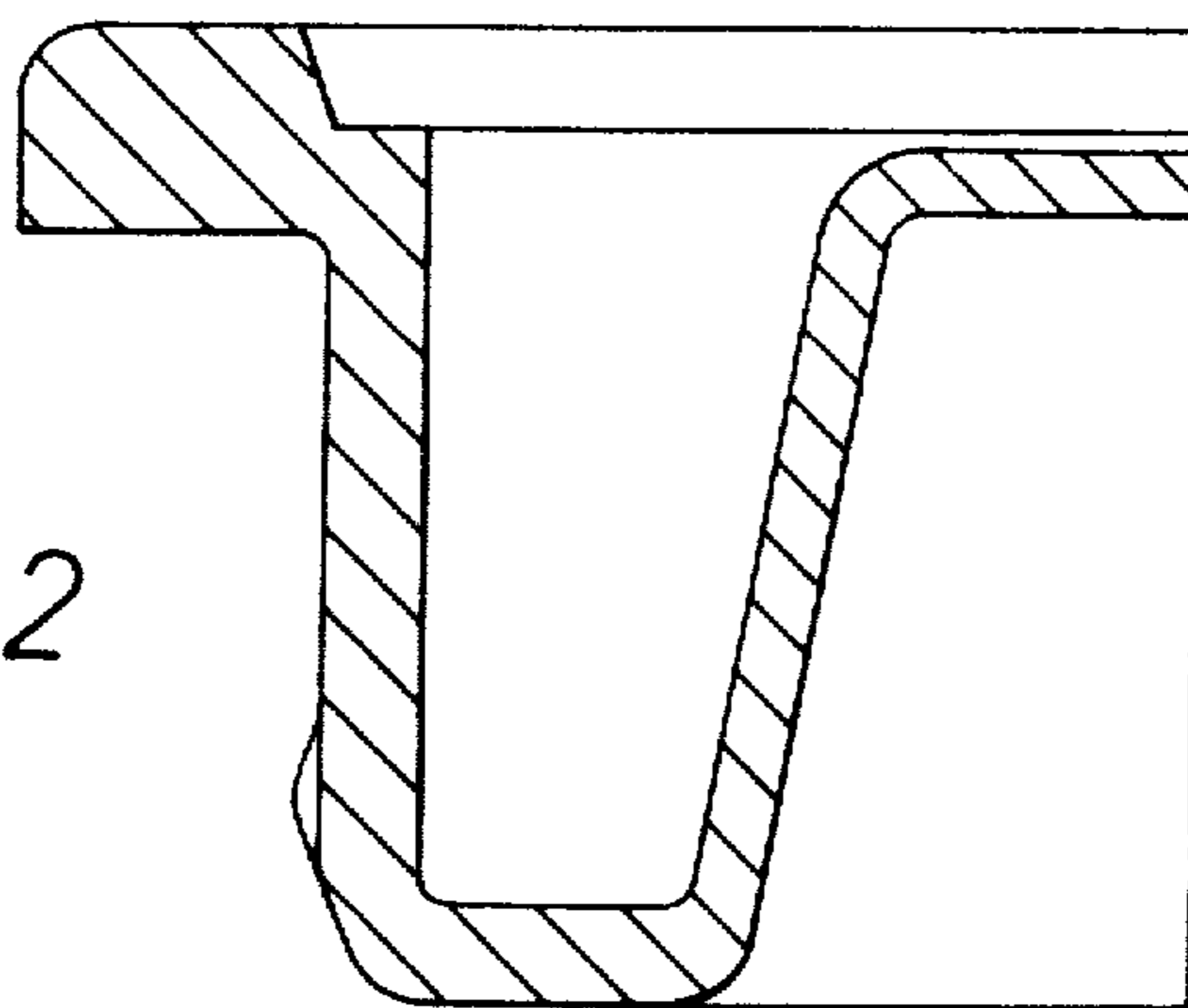

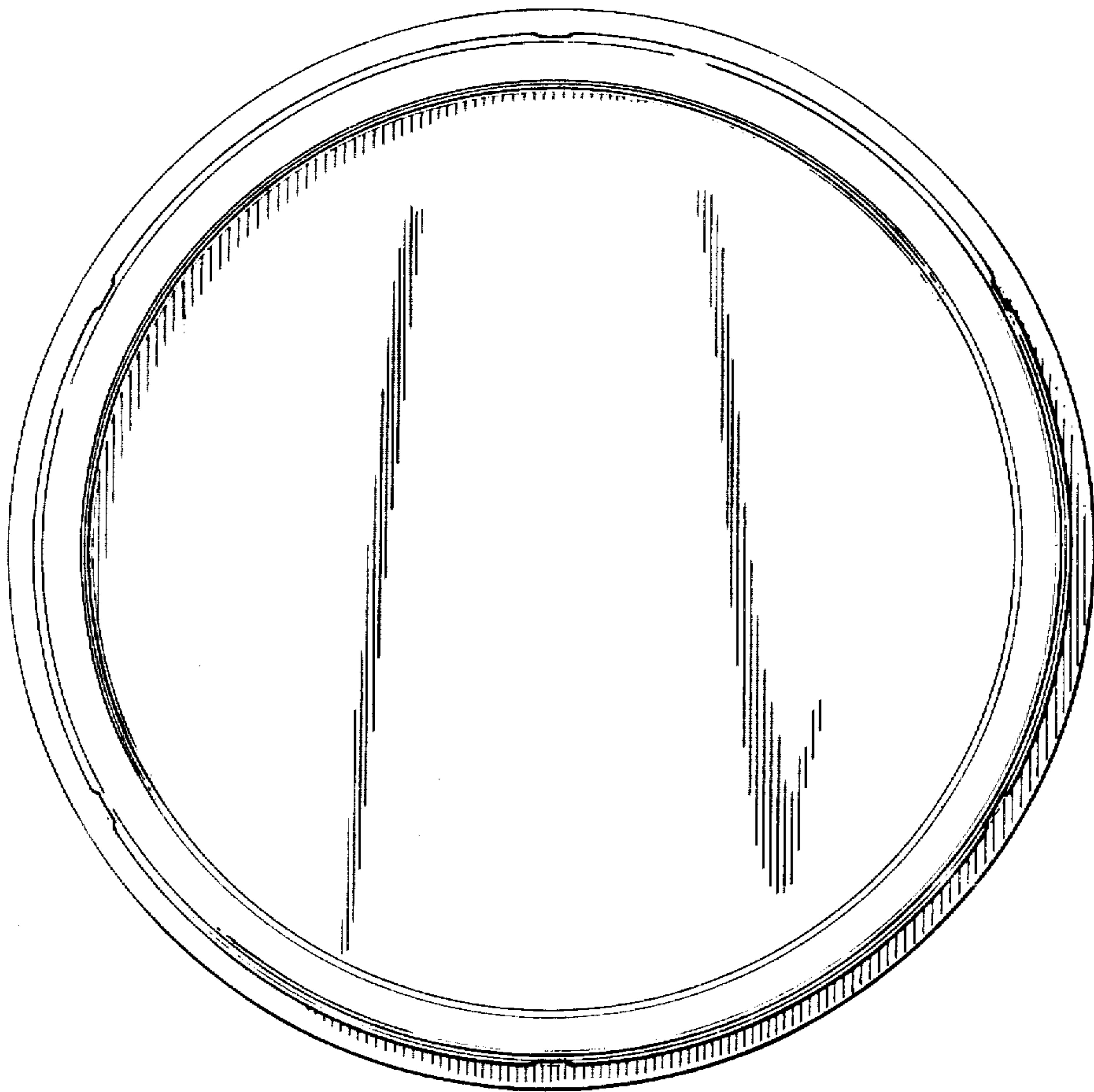

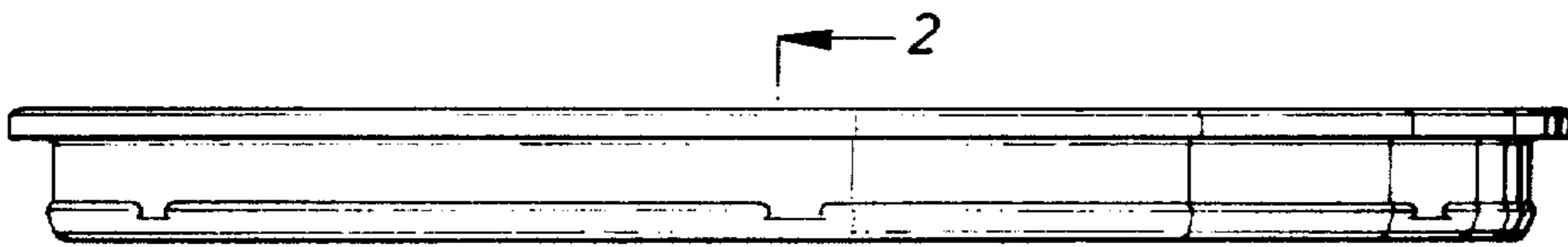
