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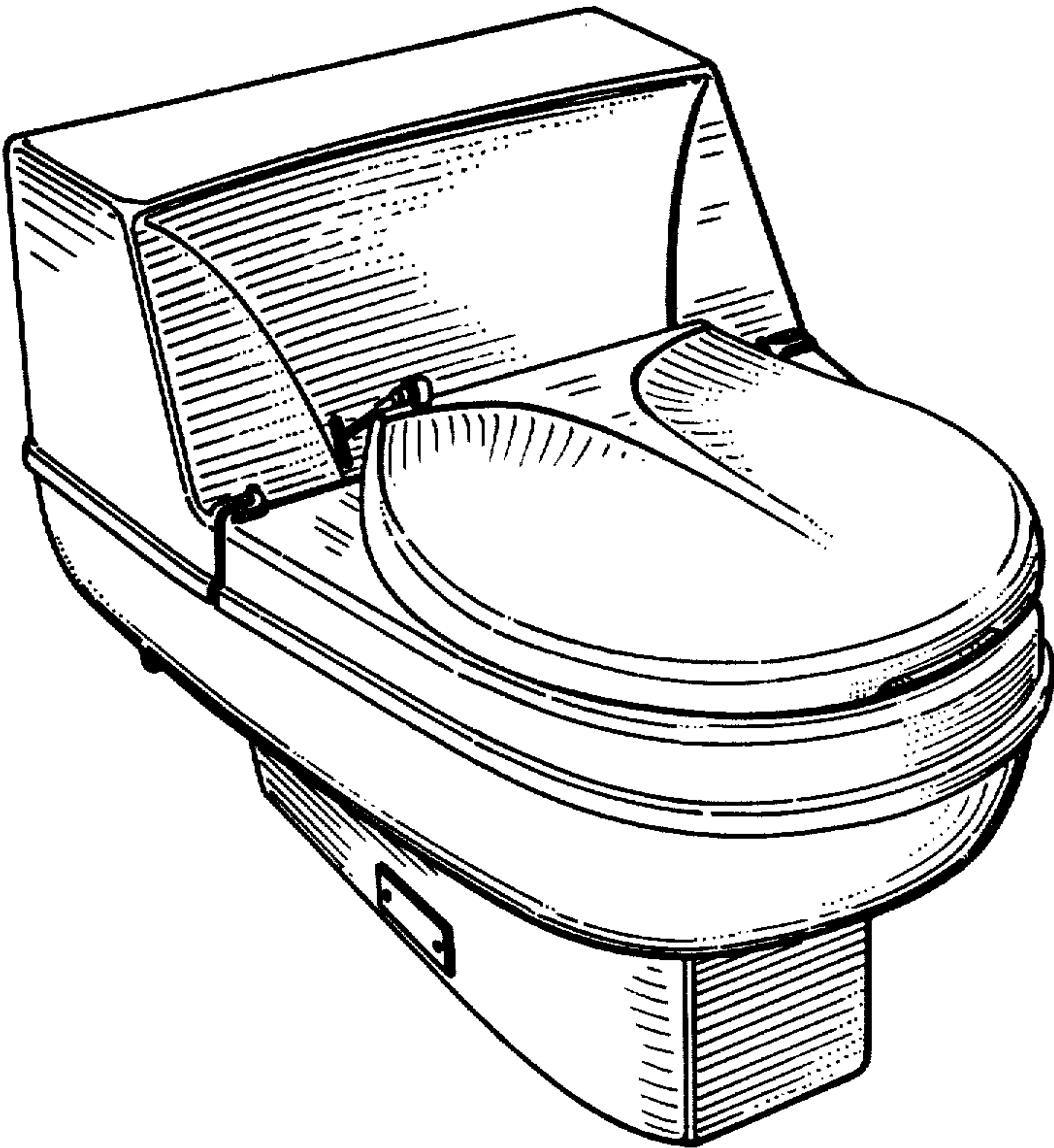

FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the bottom, rear and right side thereof.



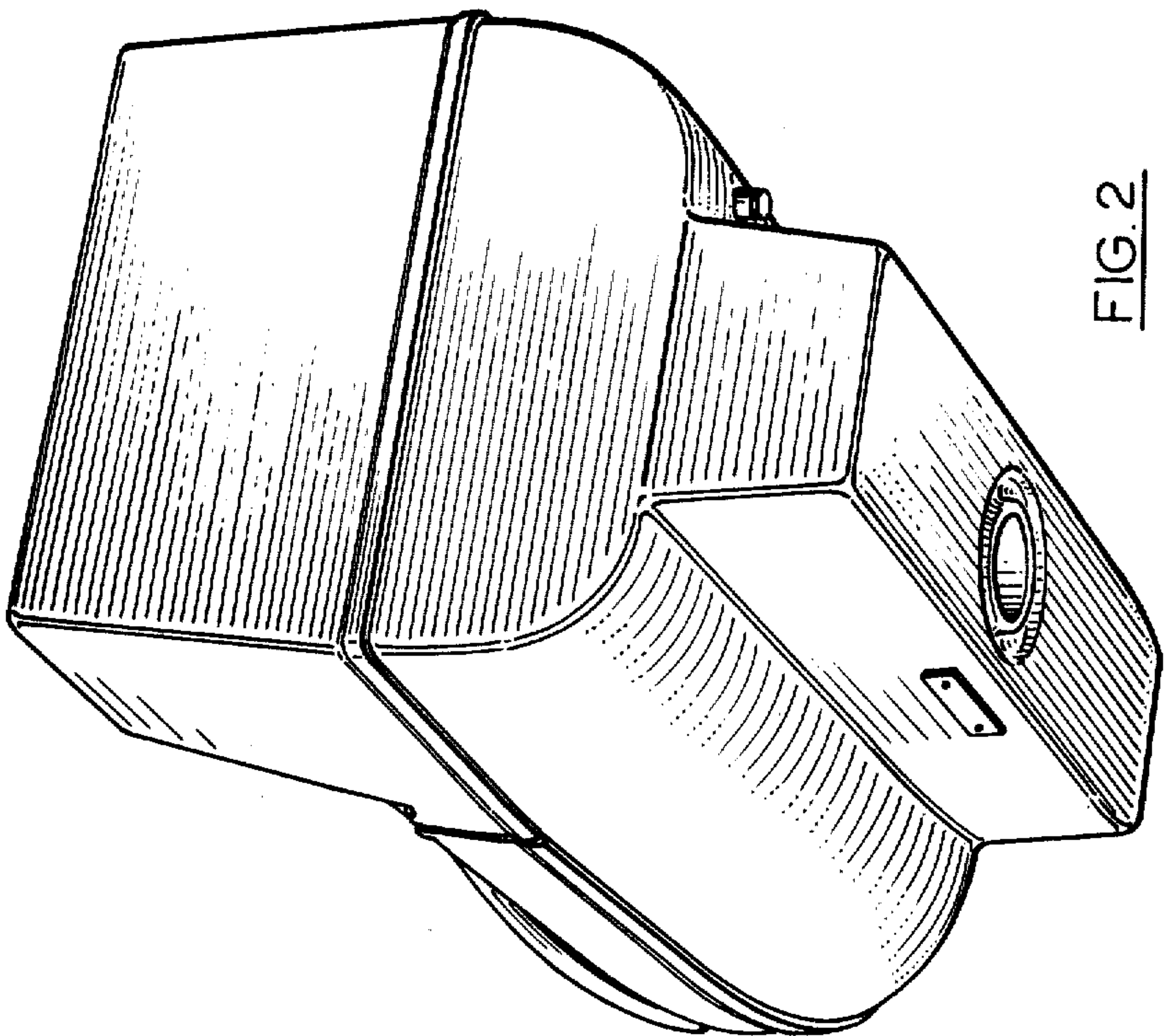

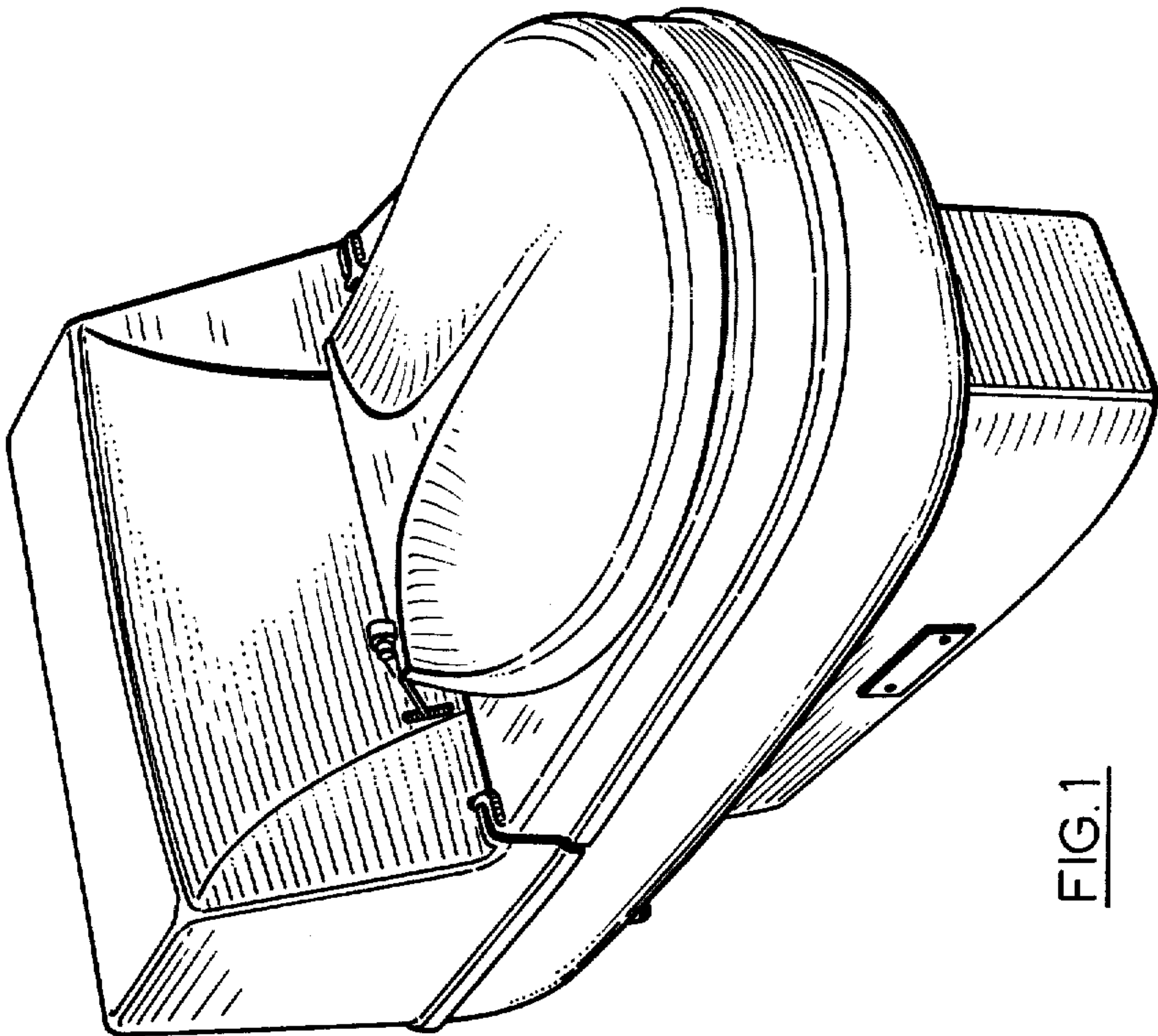
