FIG. 3 is an elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale.

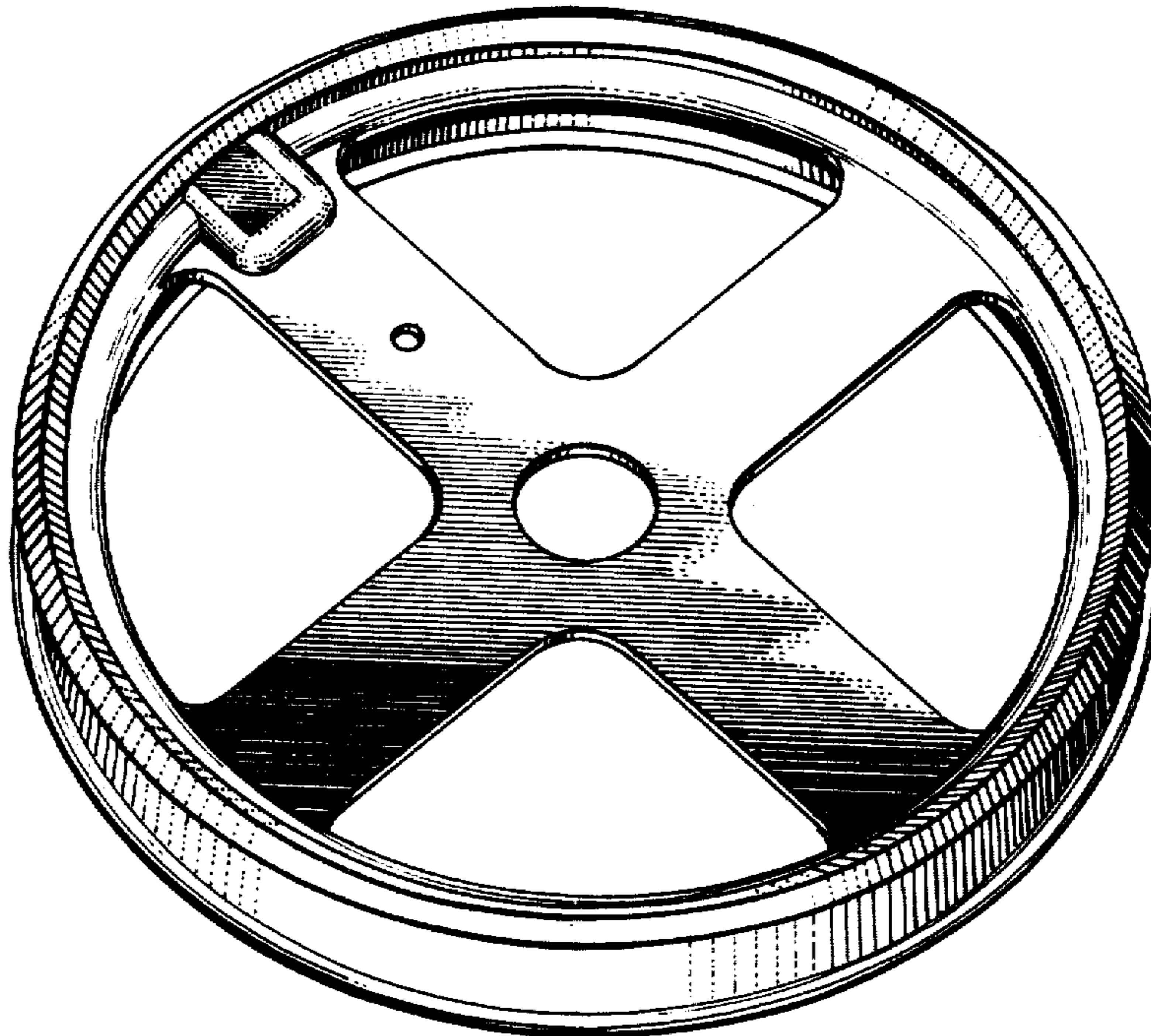

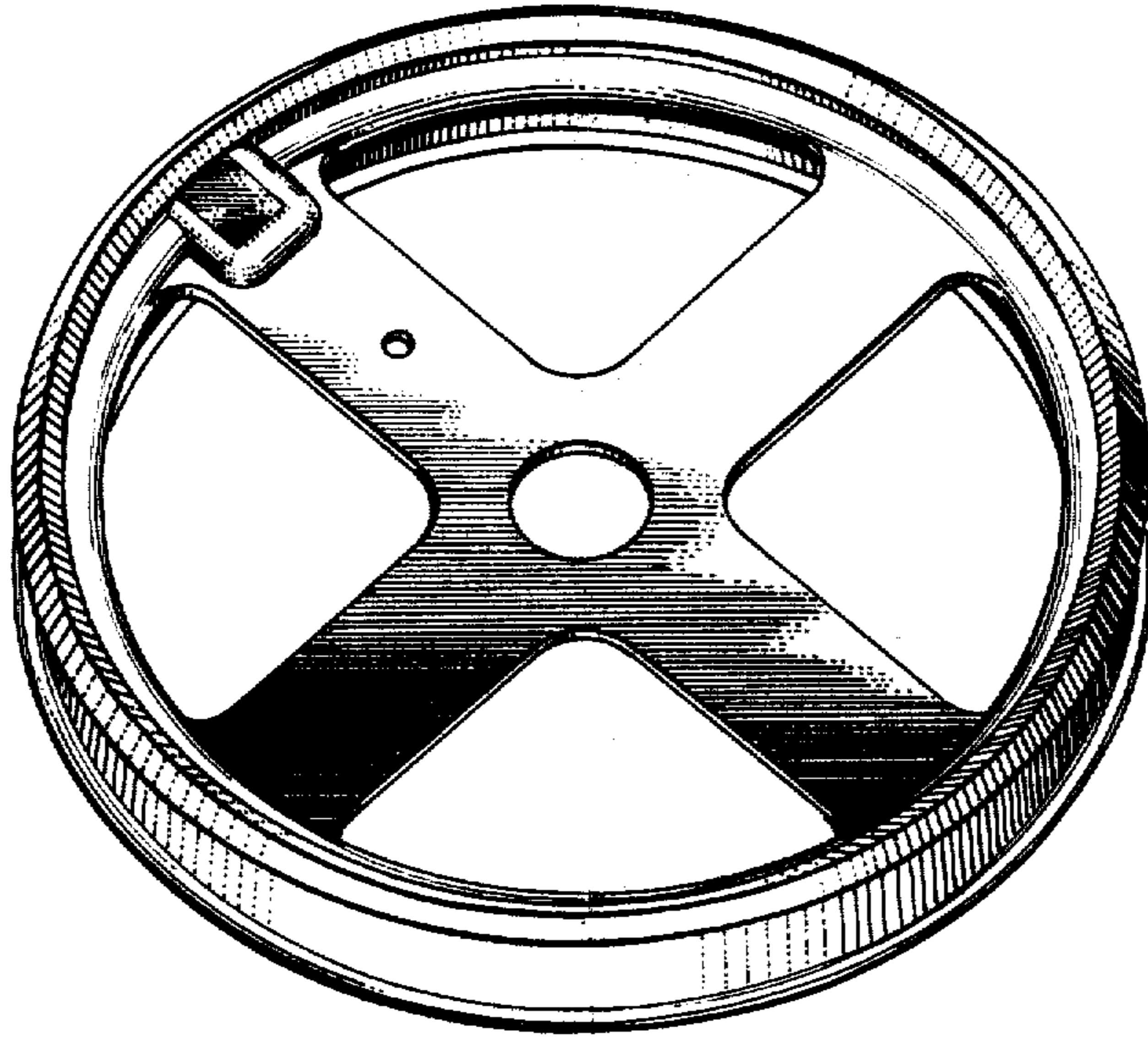

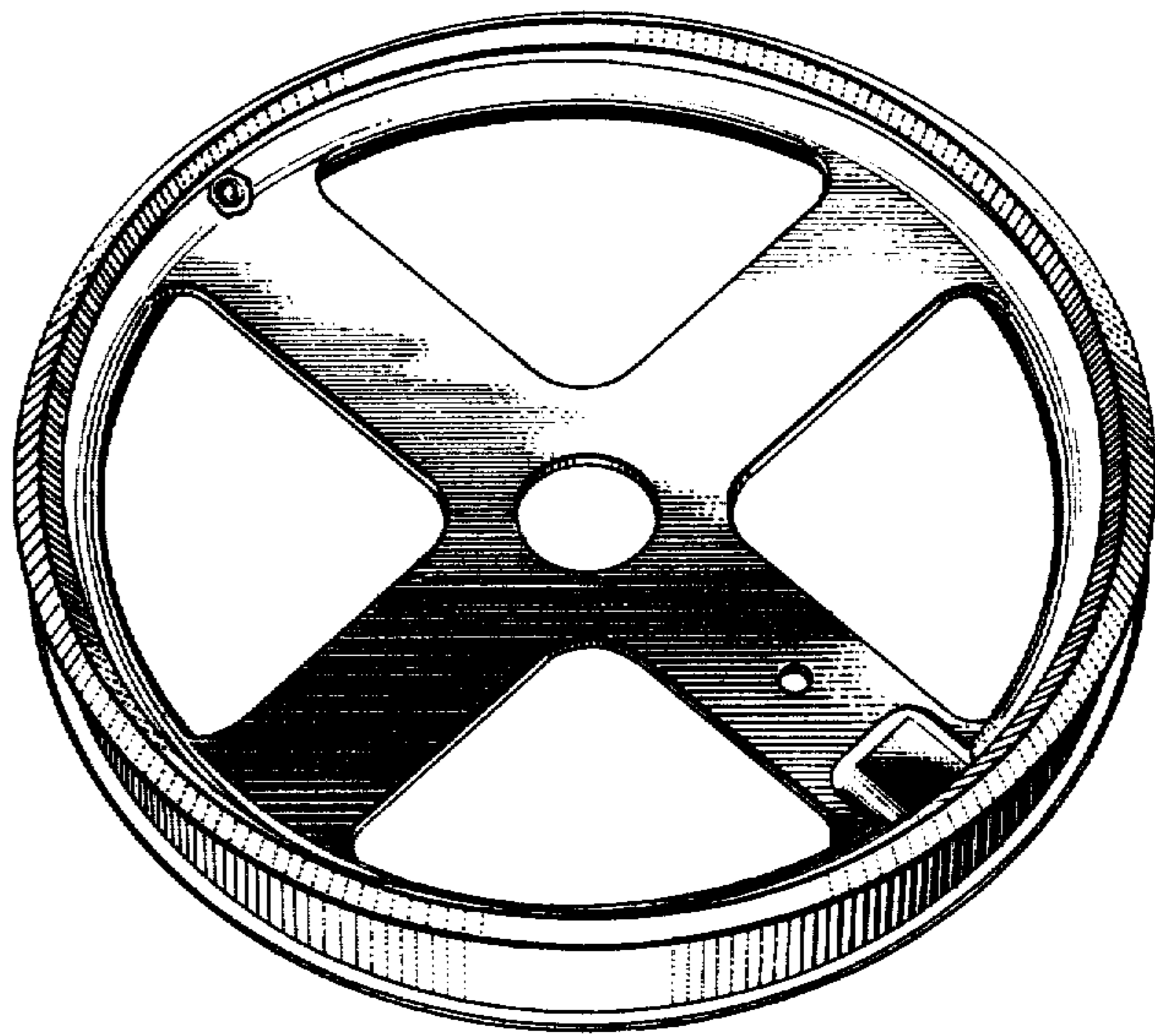
