

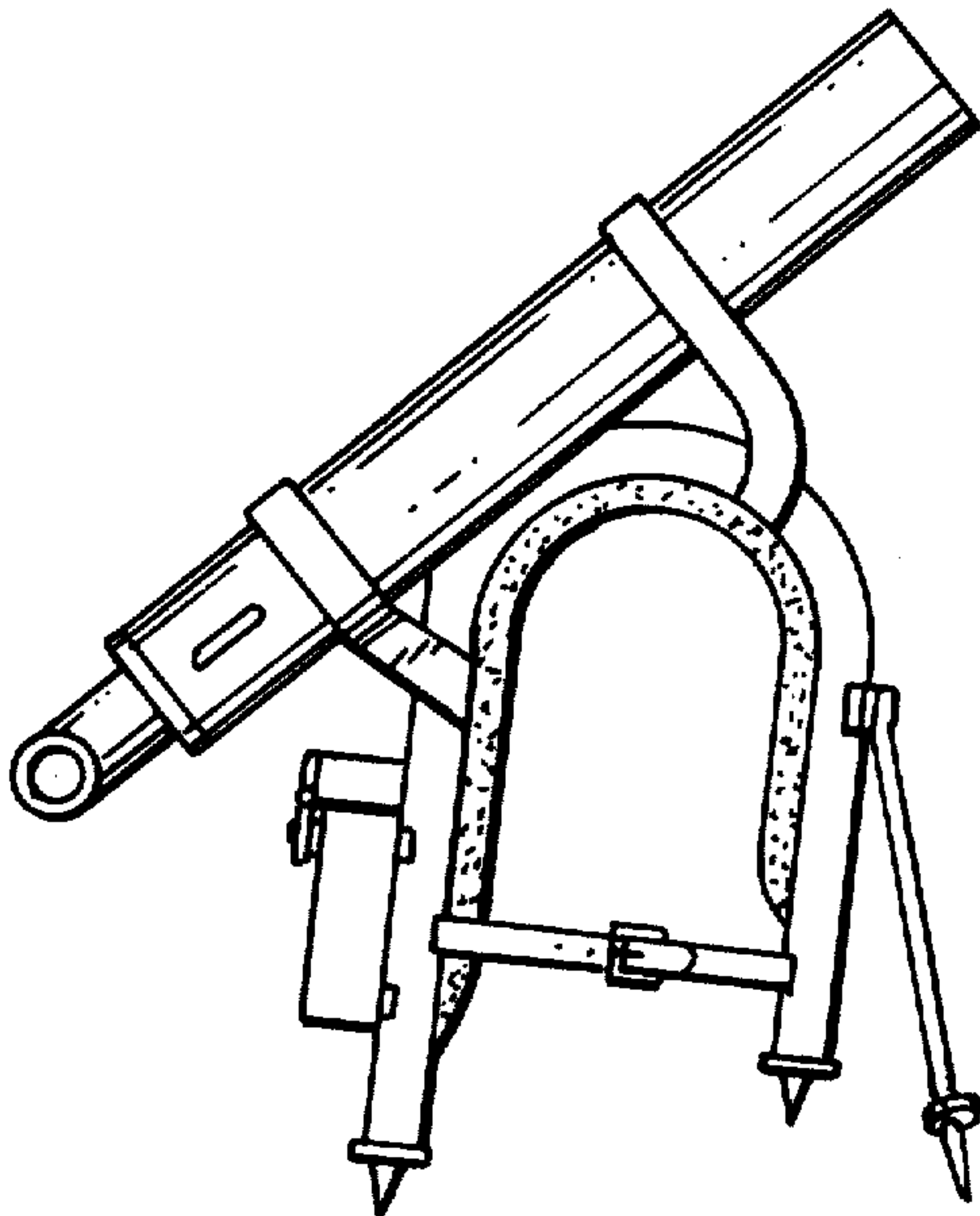

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the mortar illustrated in FIG. 1.



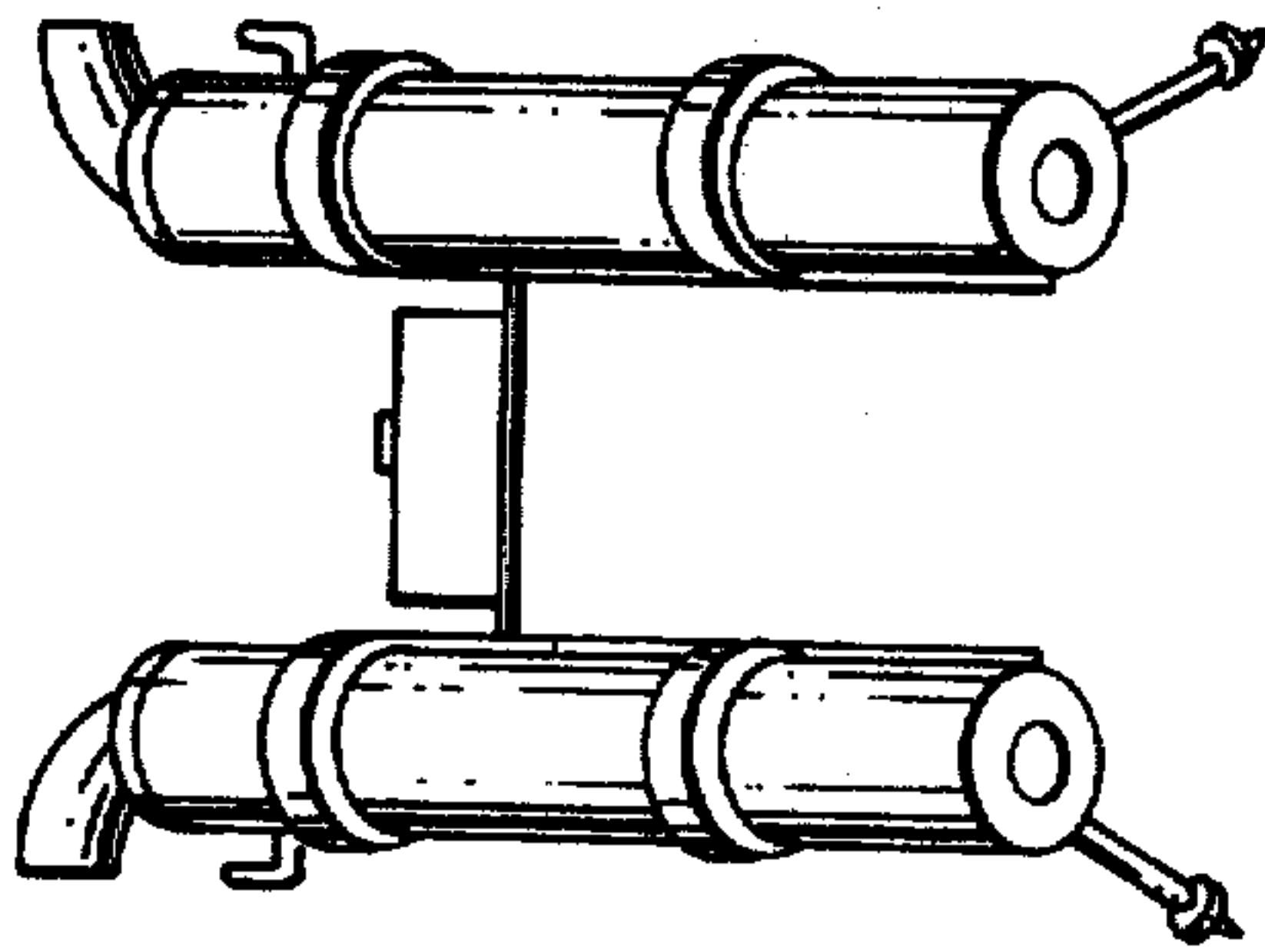

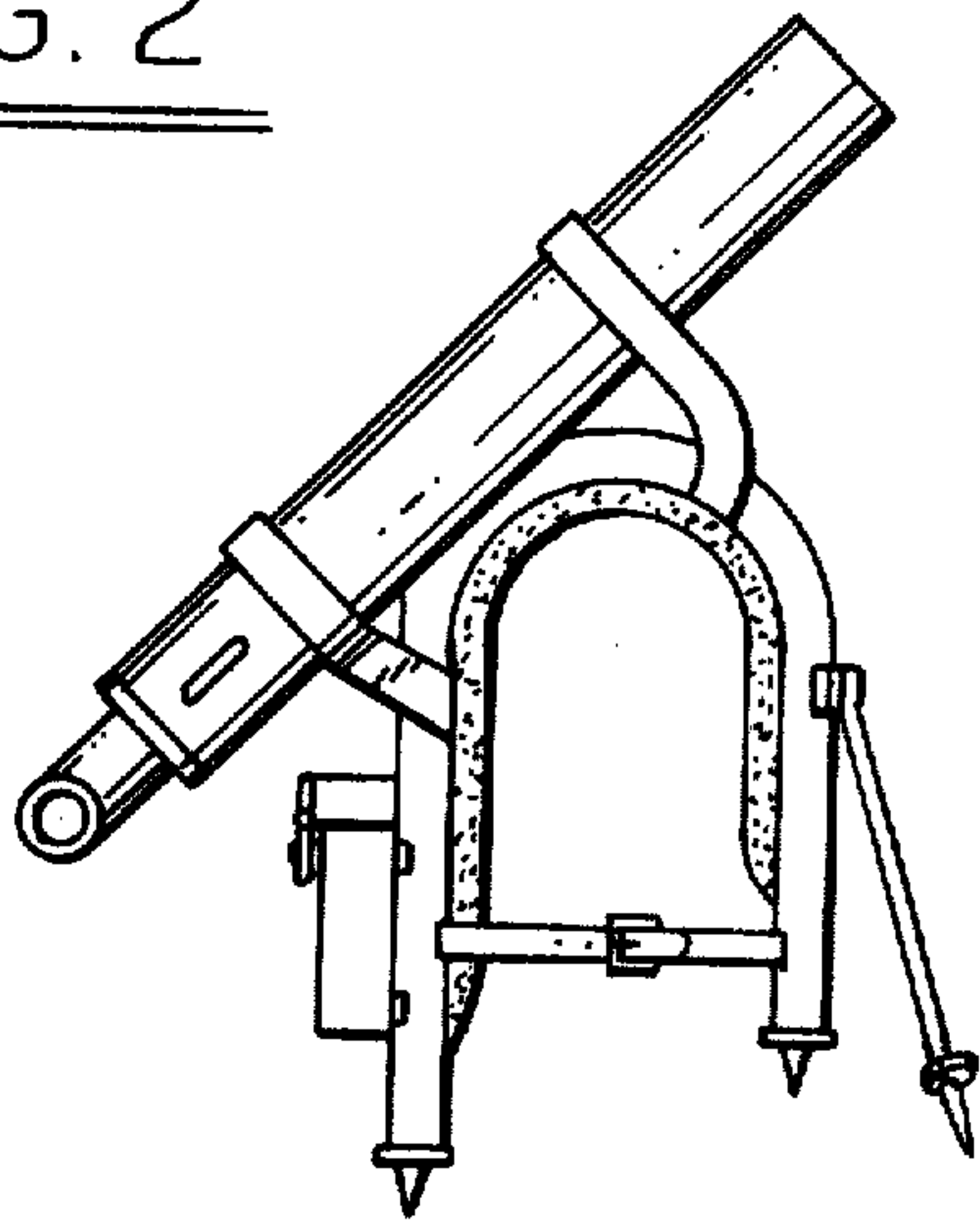

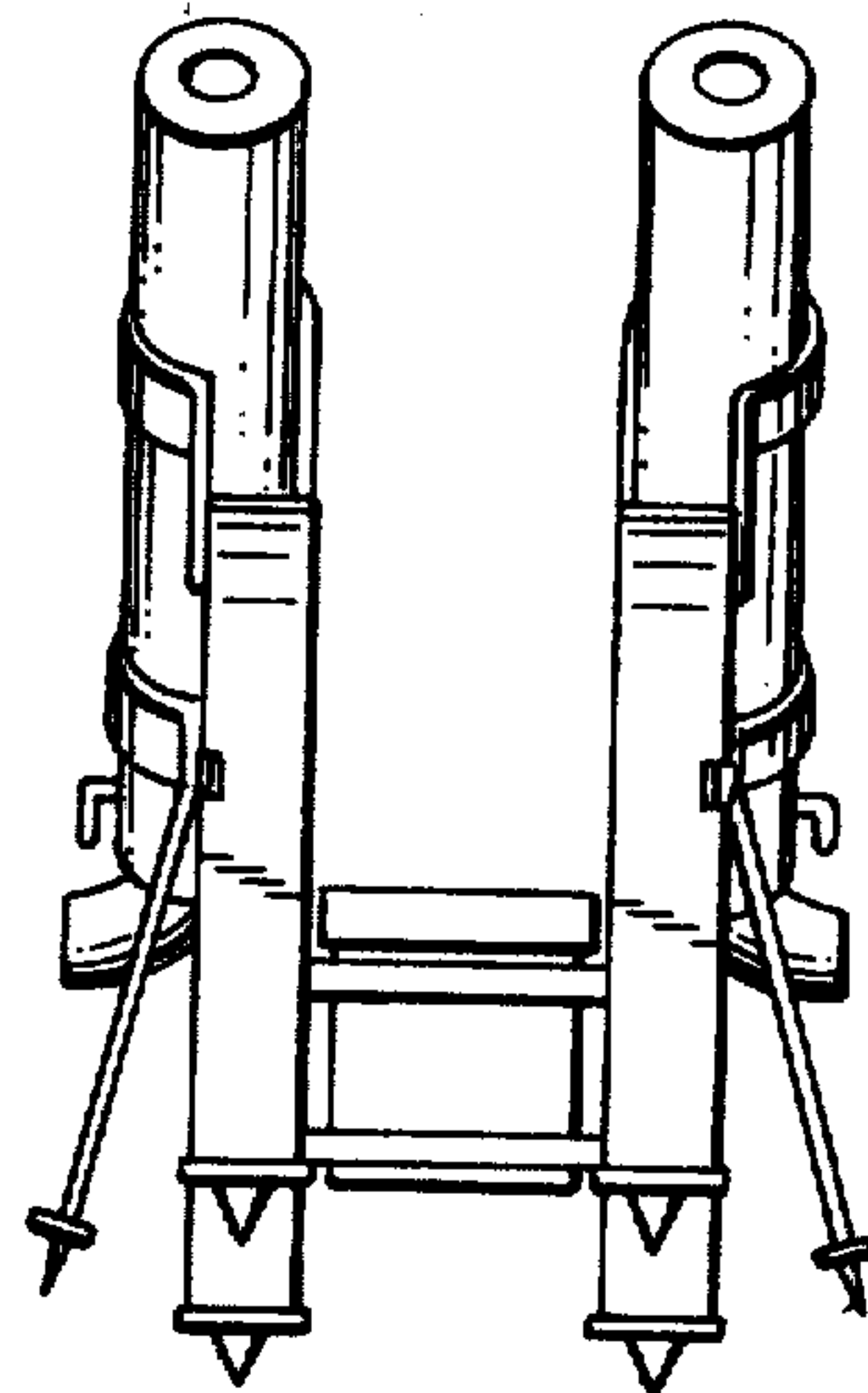

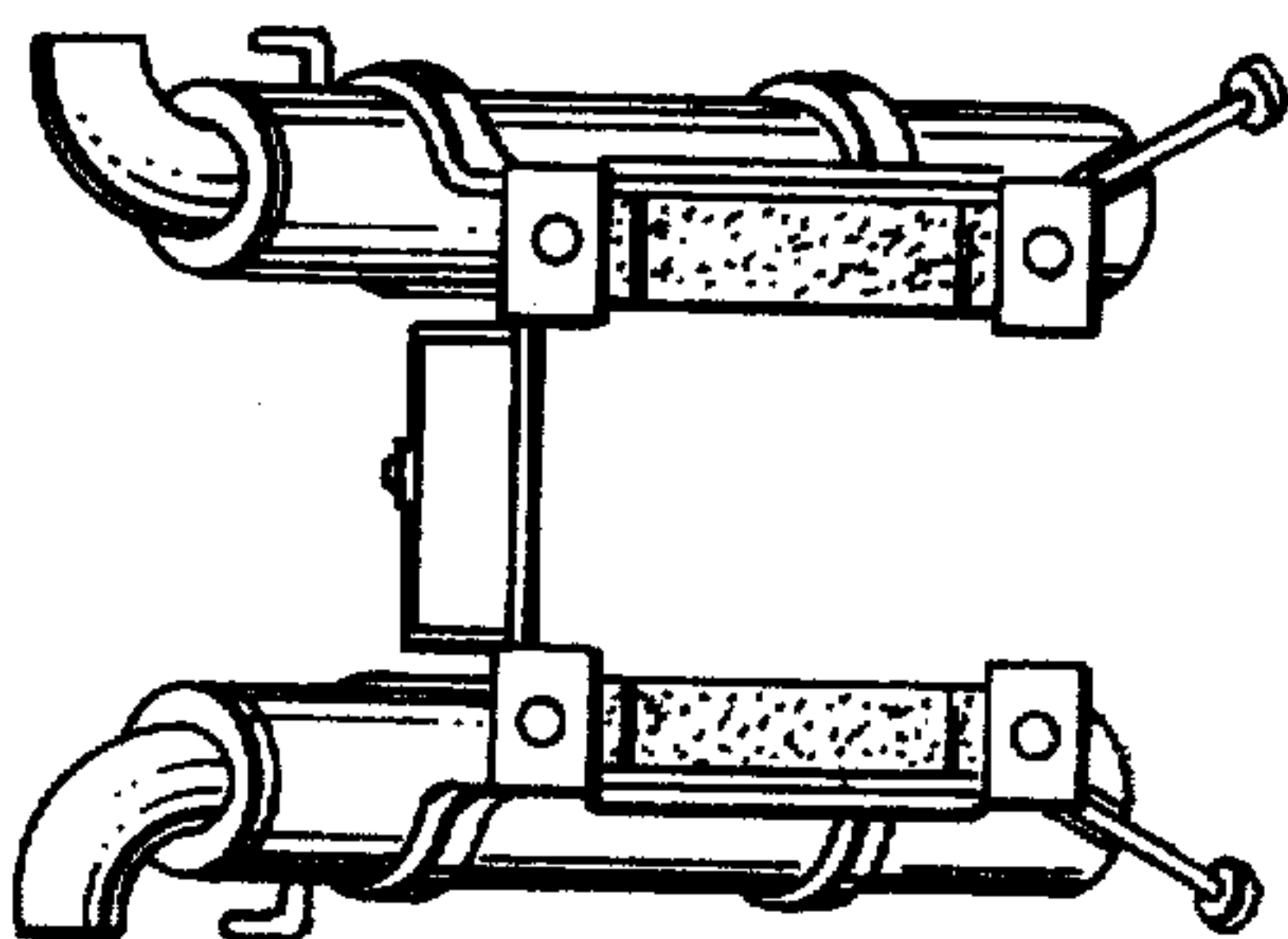

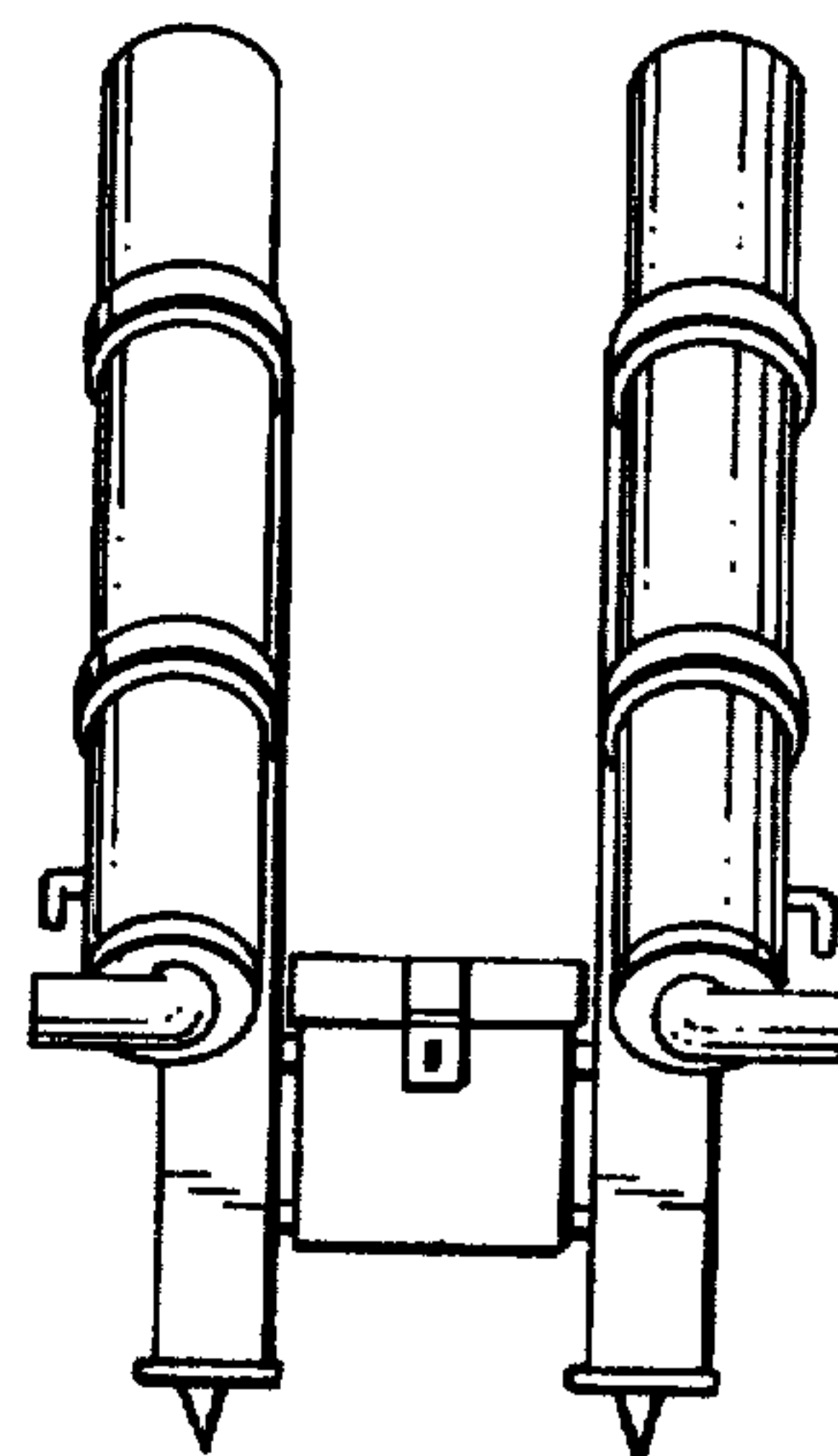
