The ornamental design for a decorative slat assembly for a suspended ceiling or the like, substantially as described and shown.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view from one side and above of the inventive decorative slat assembly for a suspended ceiling;


FIG. 2 is a rear elevation of a slat assembly for a suspended ceiling, illustrated in FIG. 1;
