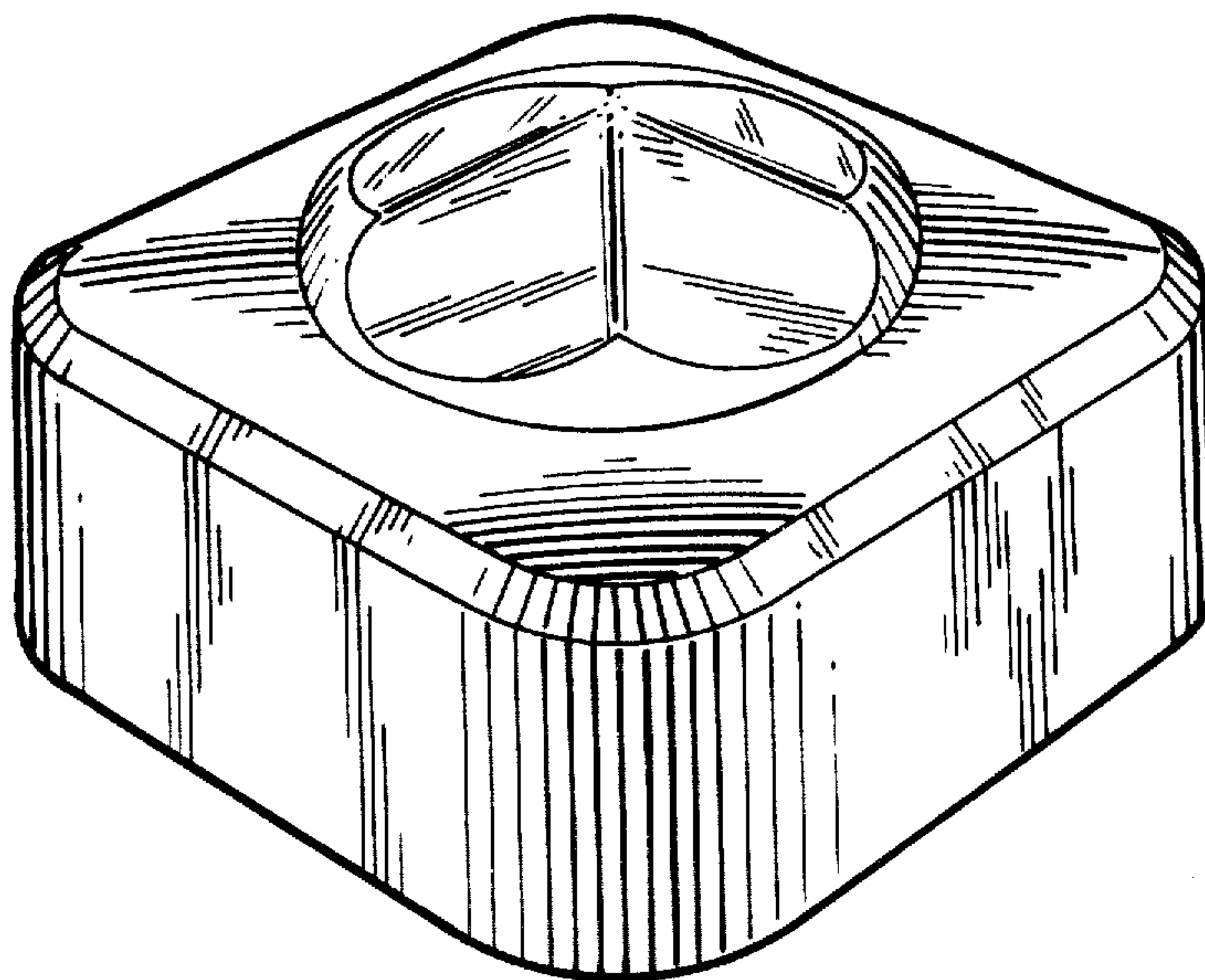
The ornamental design for a pharmaceutical tablet, as

that the remaining sides are identical to that shown.



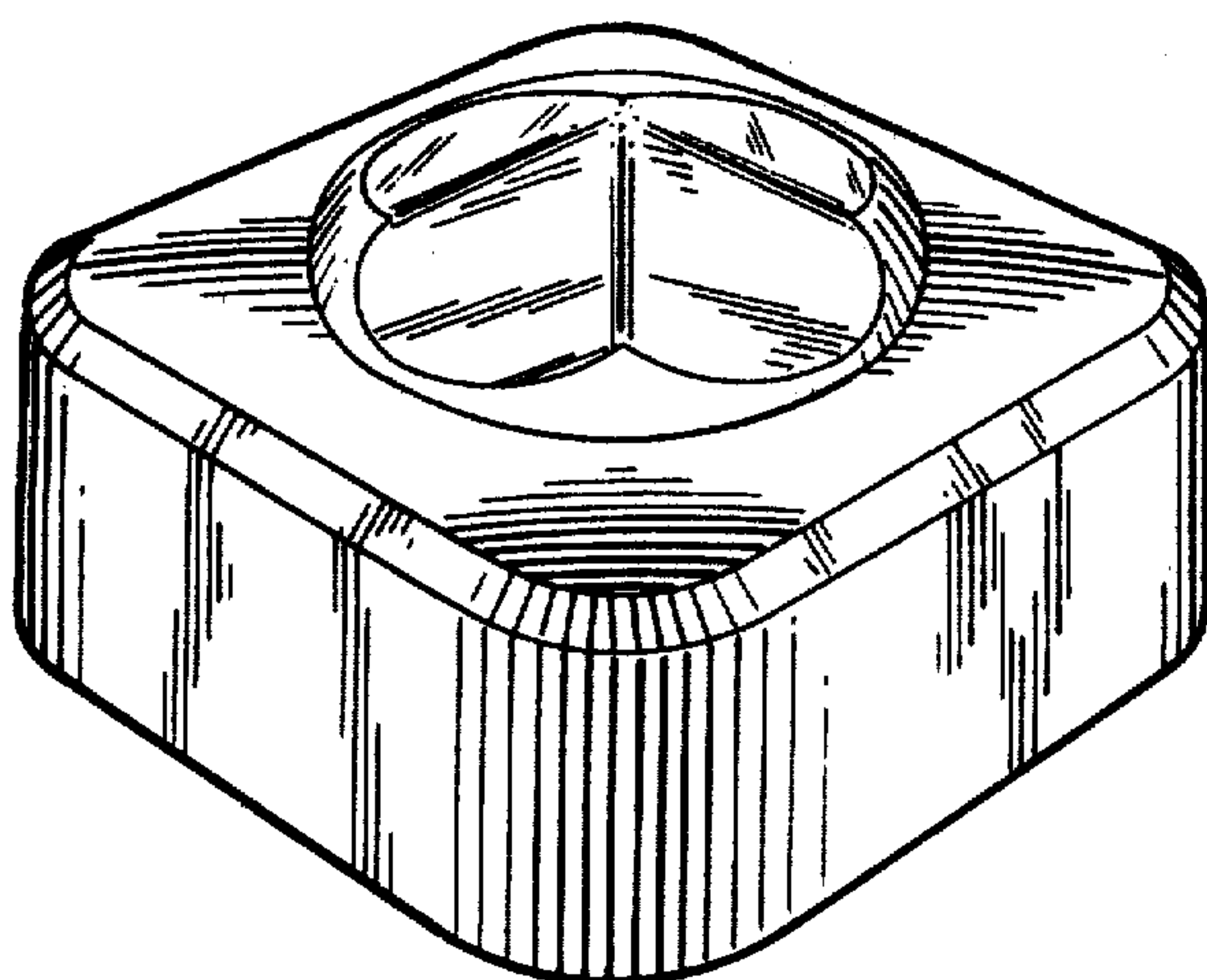

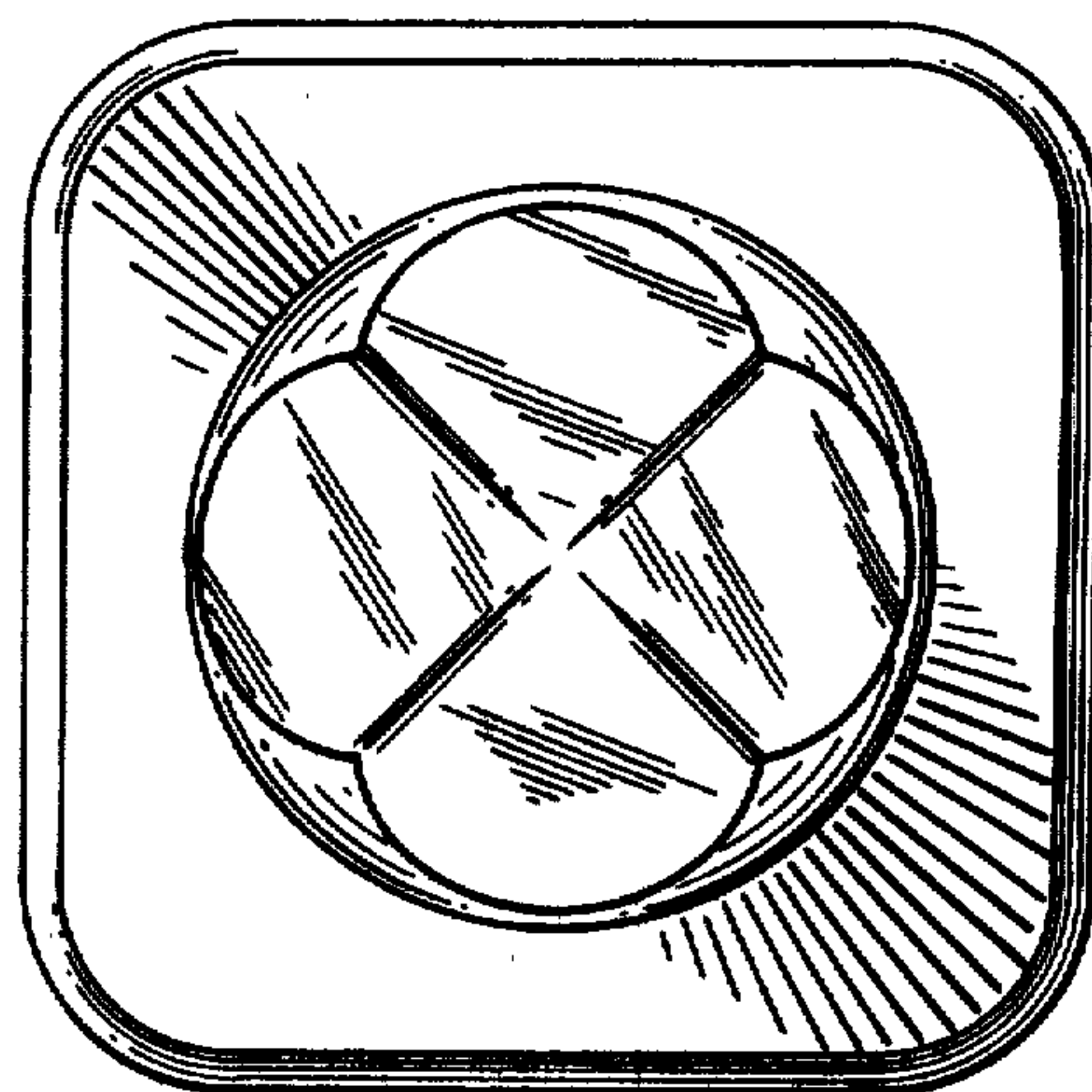

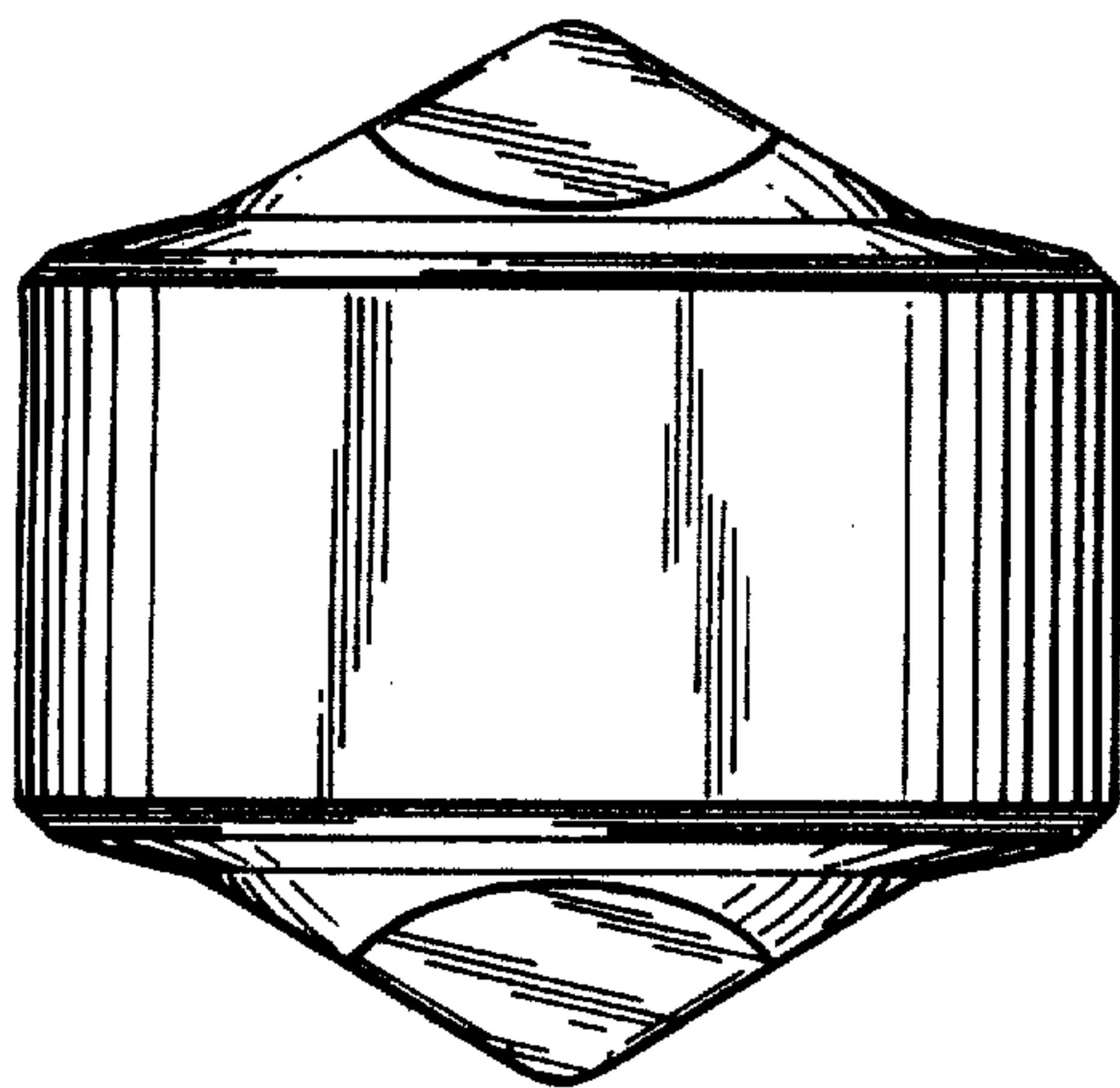
