DESCRIPTION

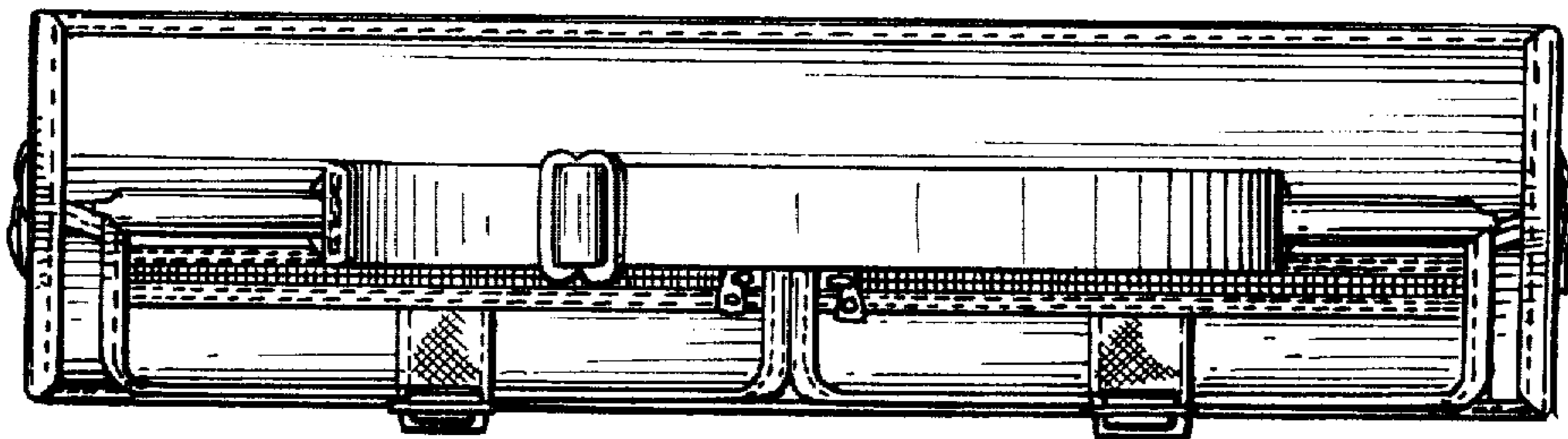
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of luggage showing

unfolded condition.



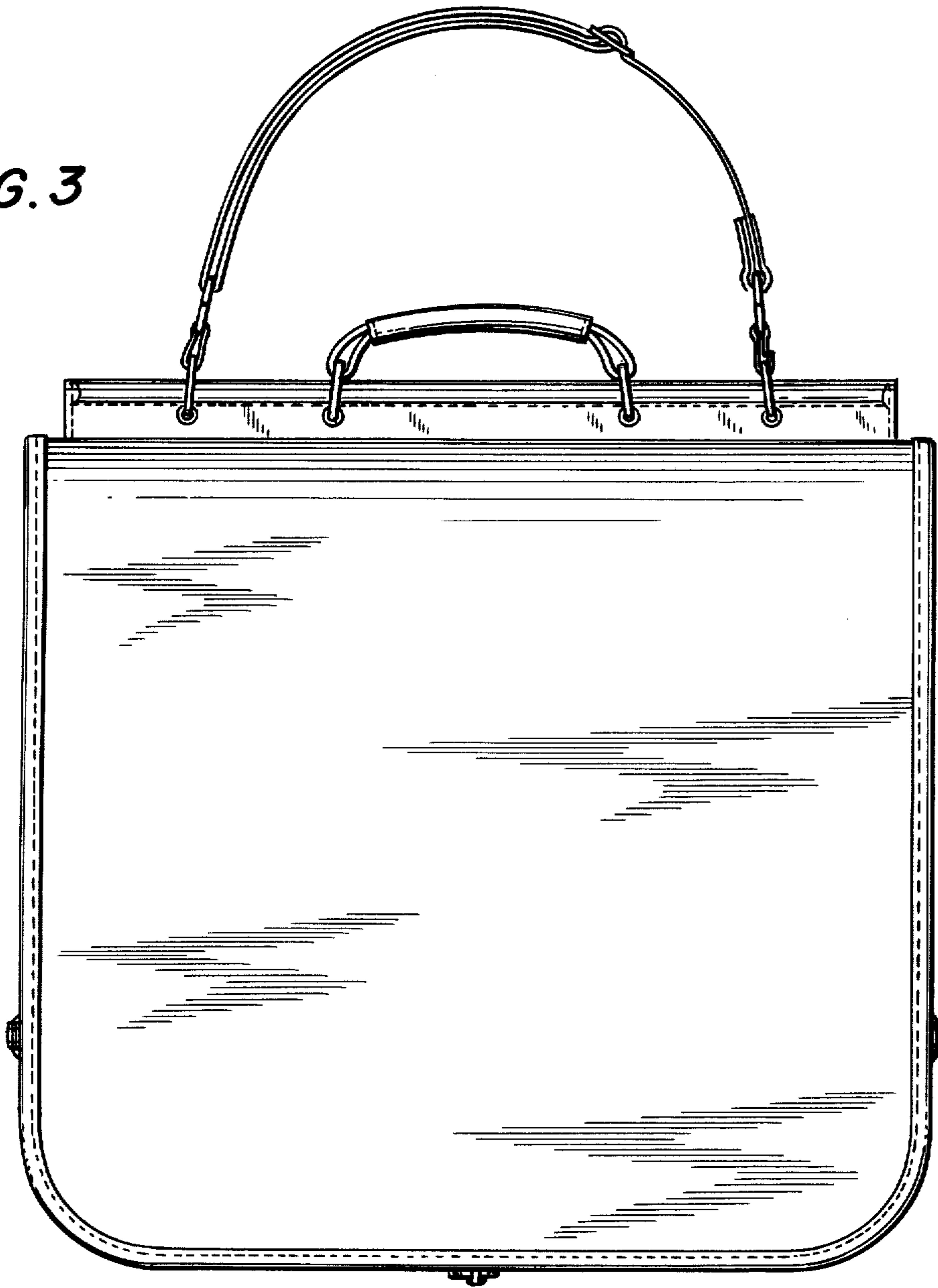

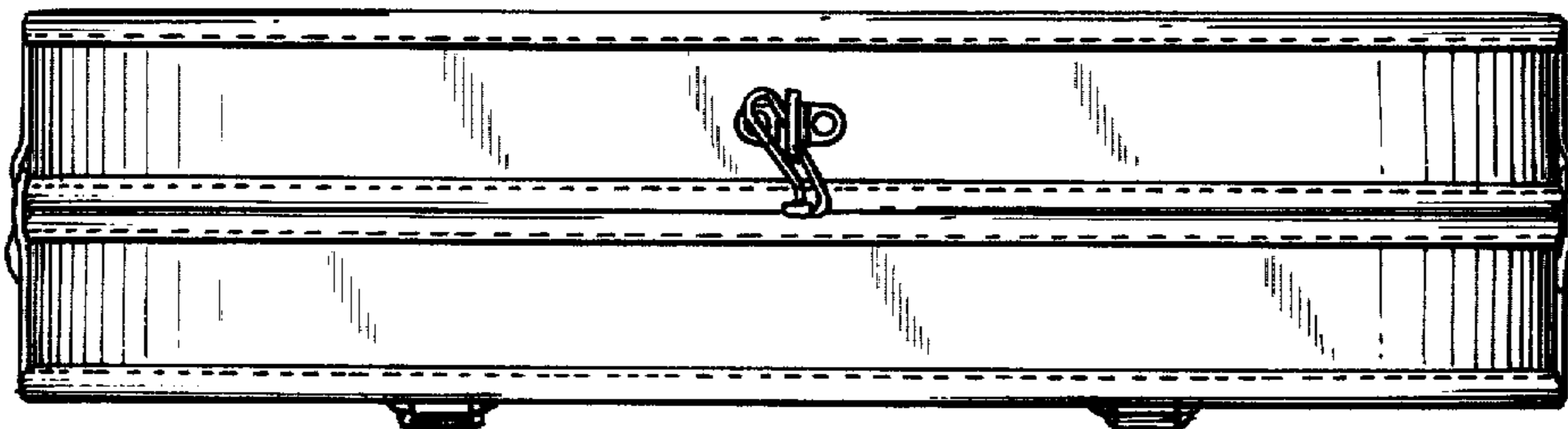

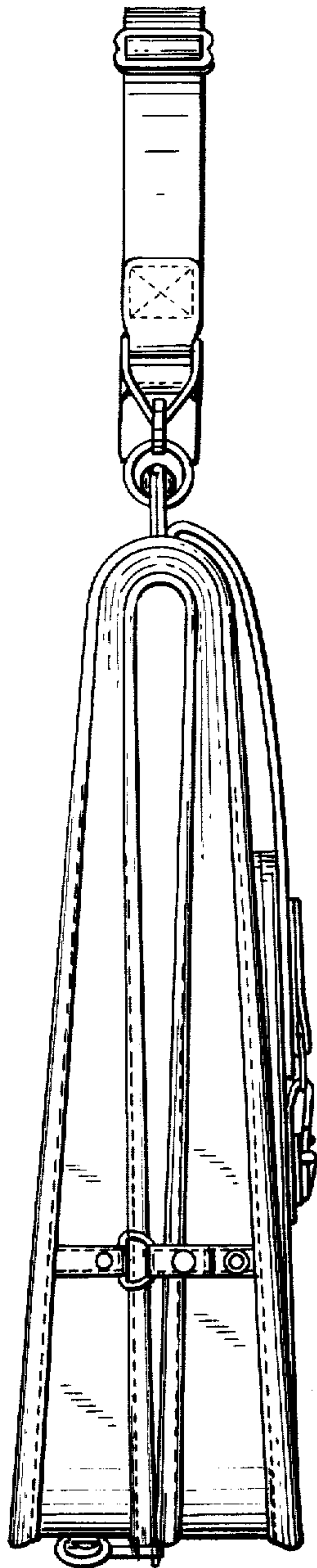
