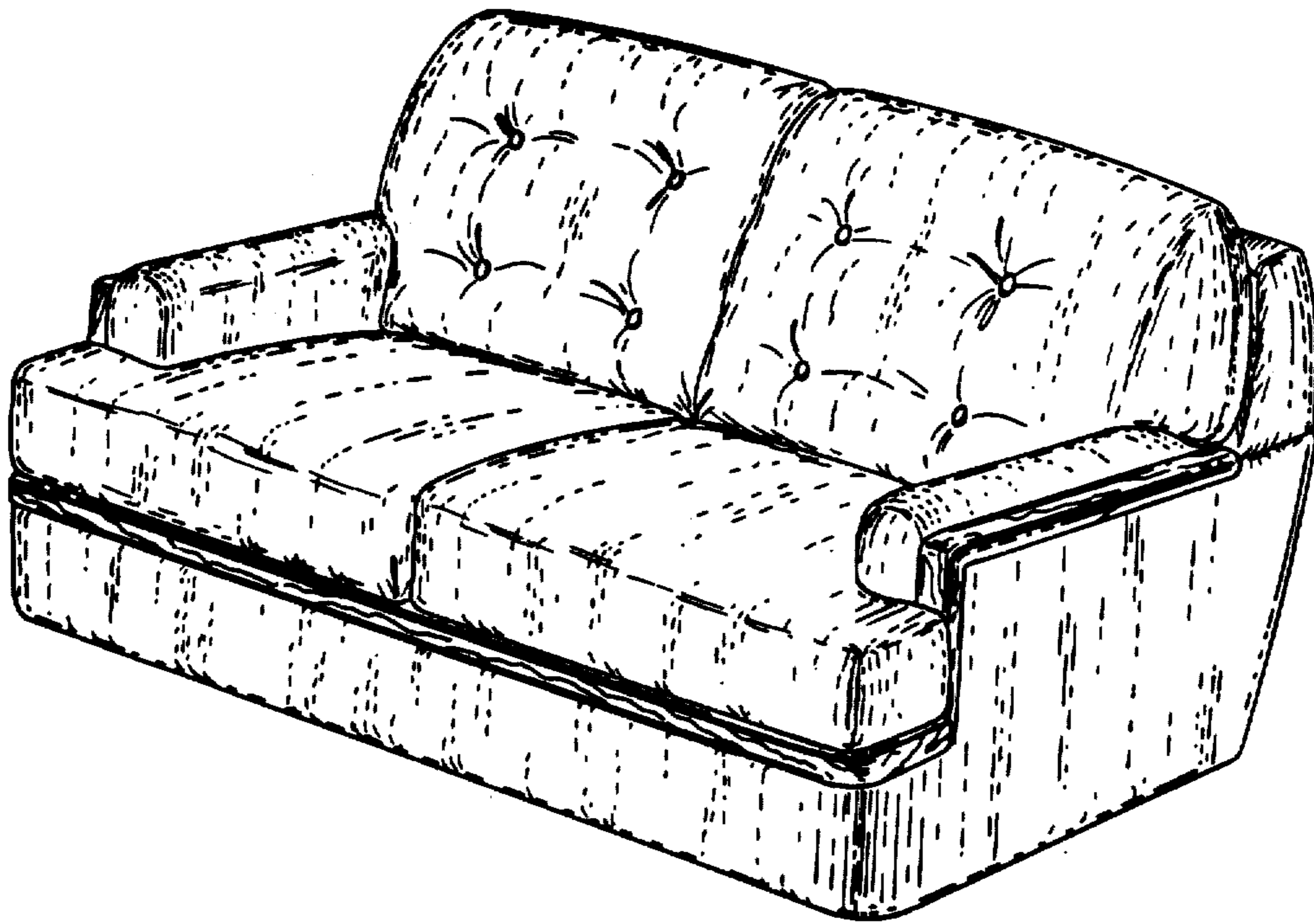

DESCRIPTION

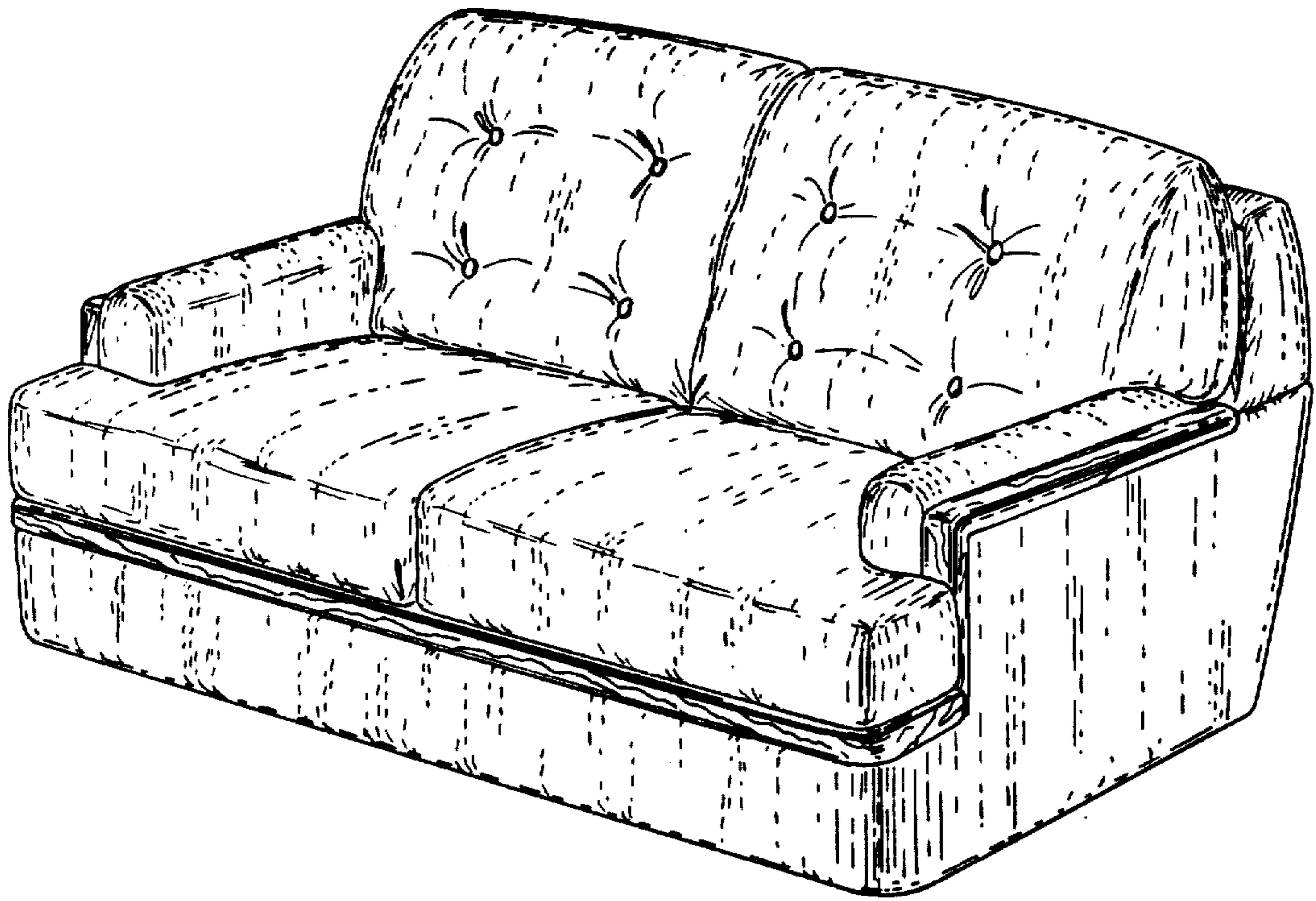
