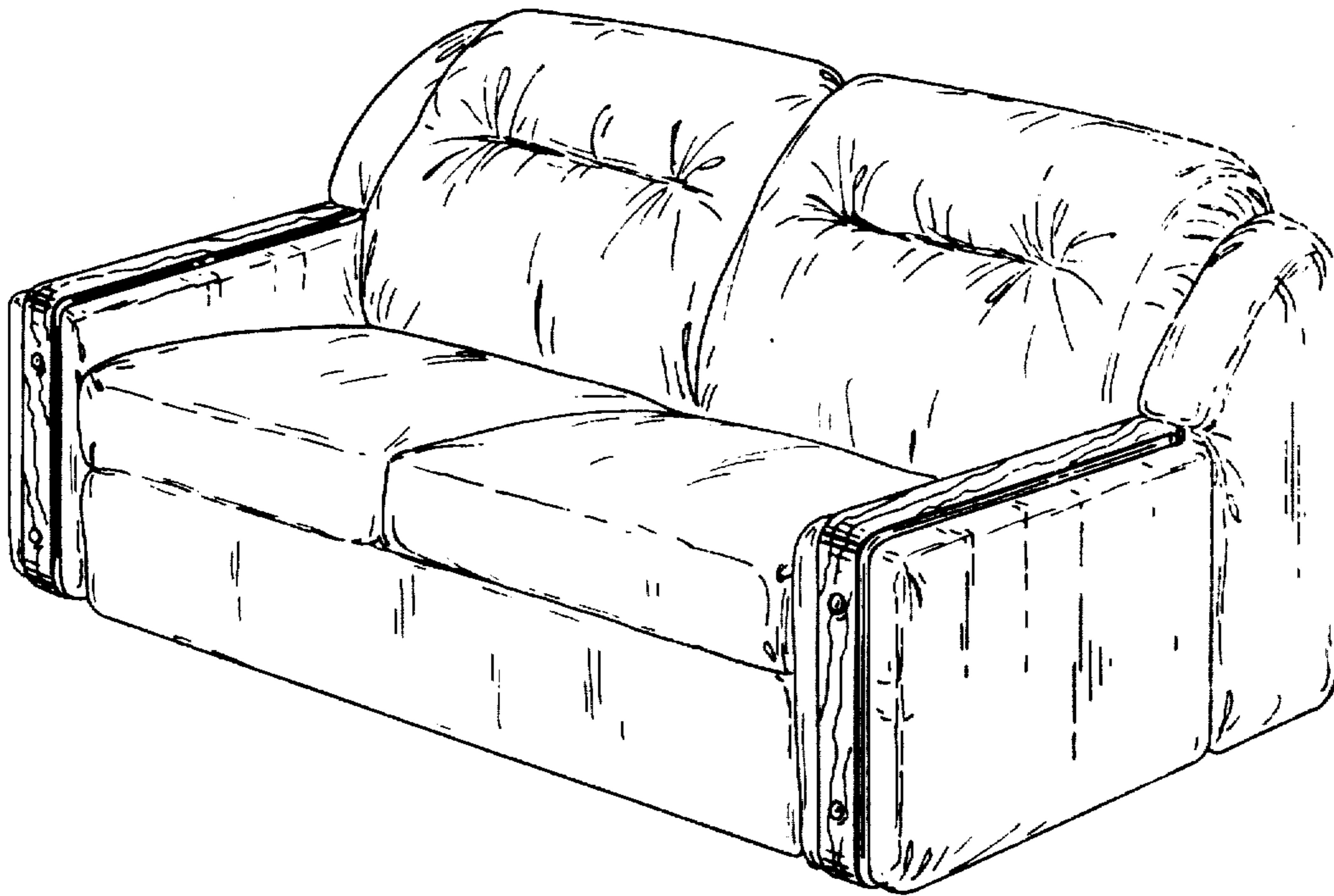
CLAIM
