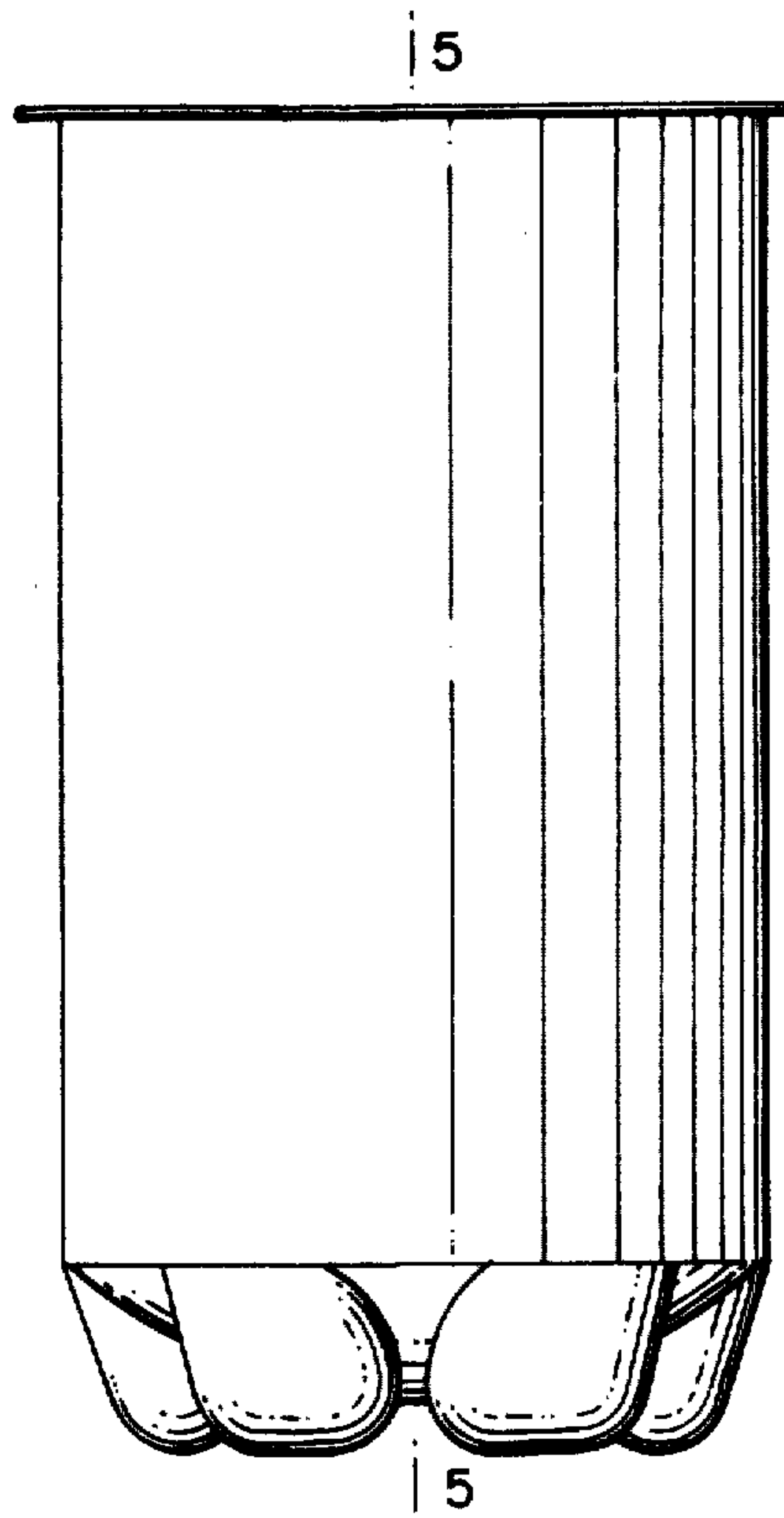

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a can or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-sectional view taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 1.



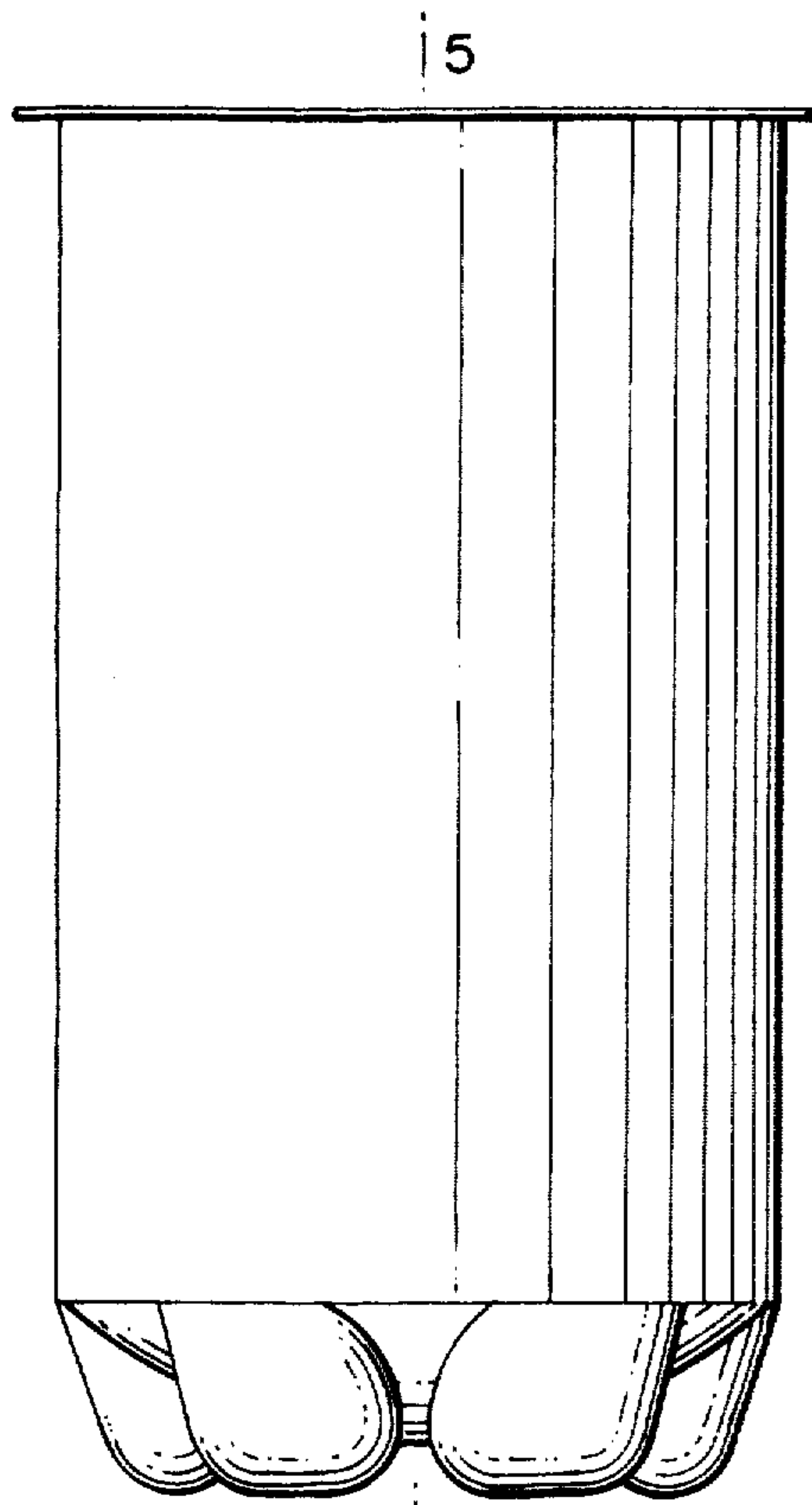

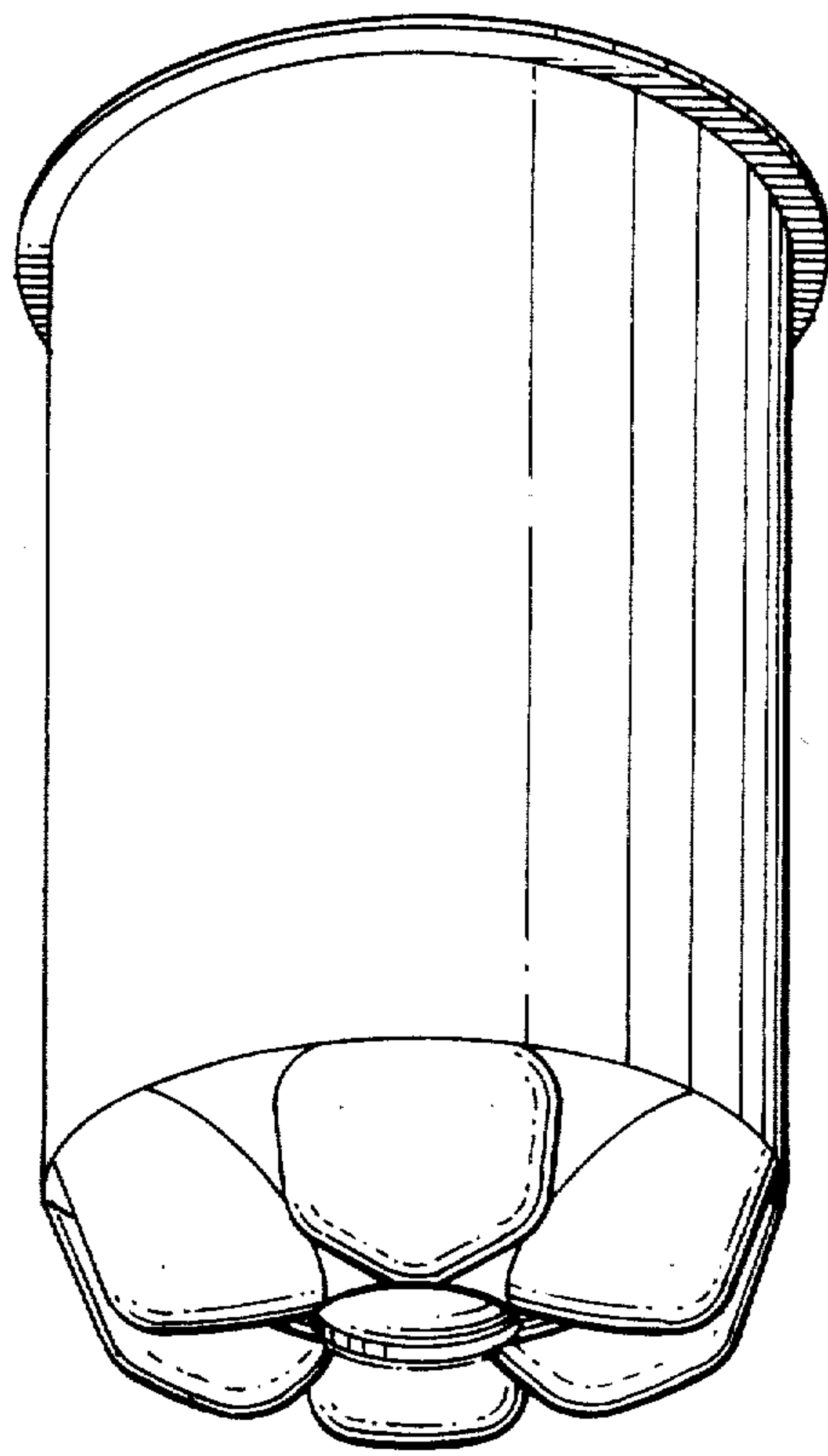

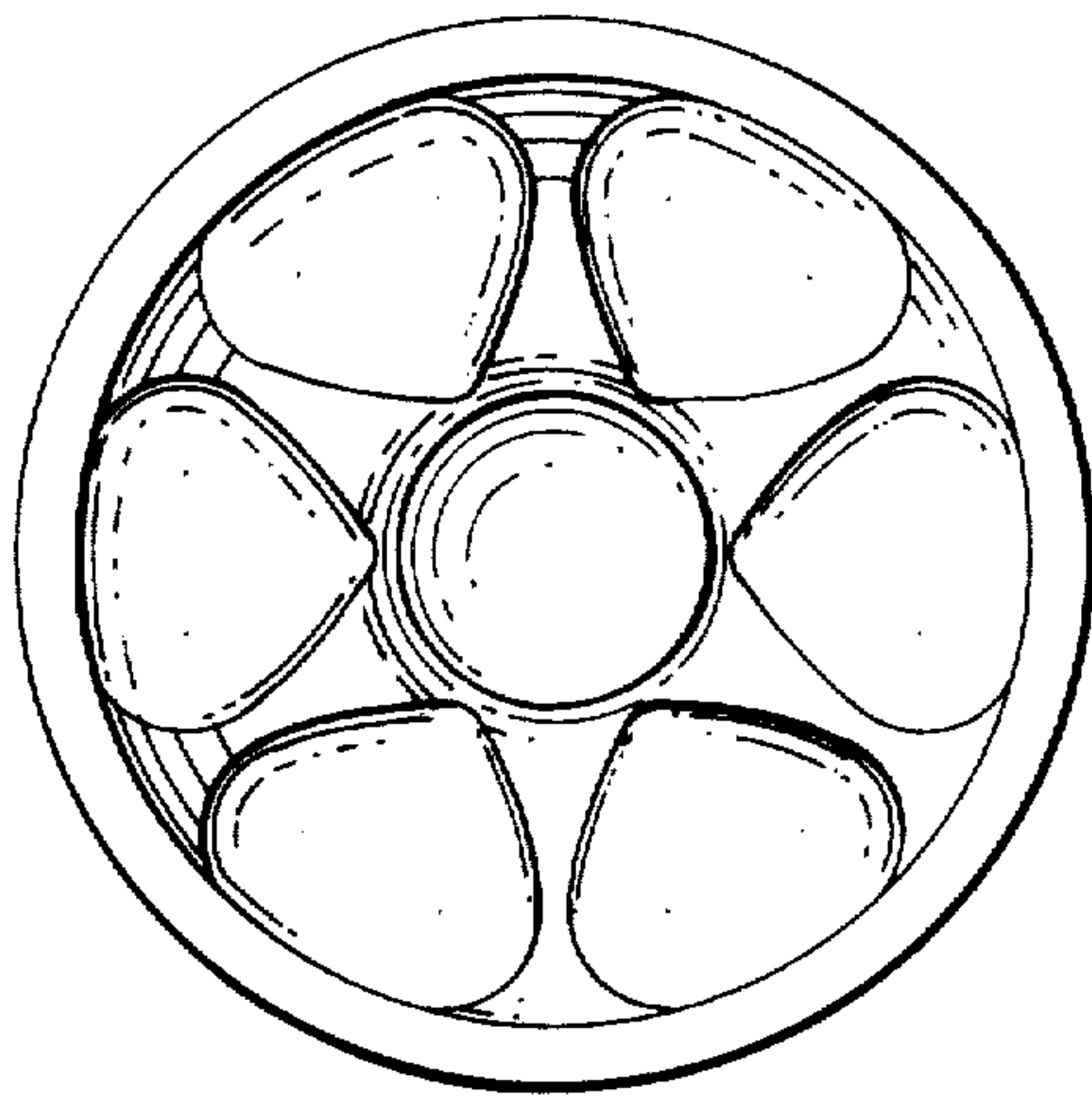

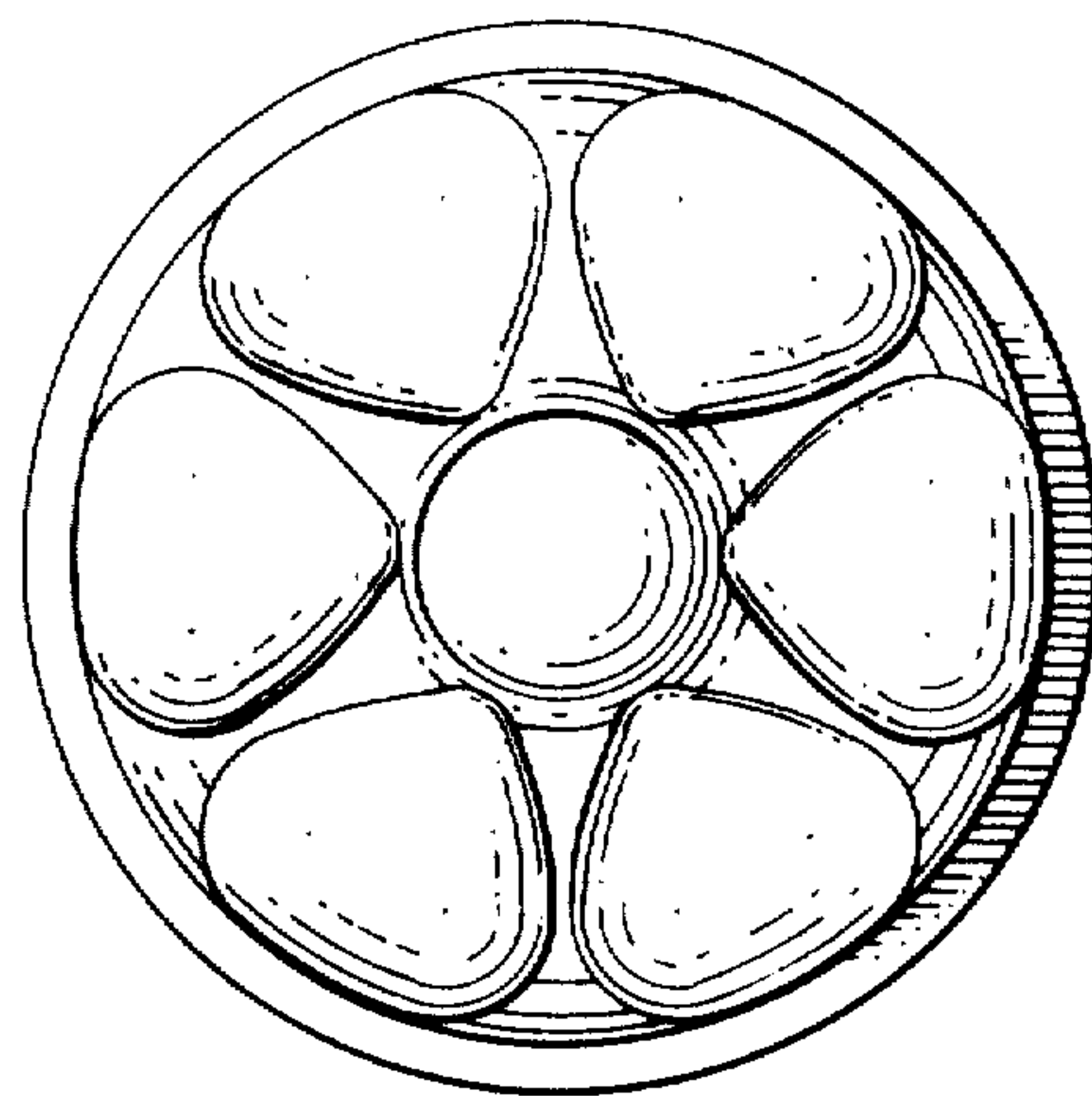

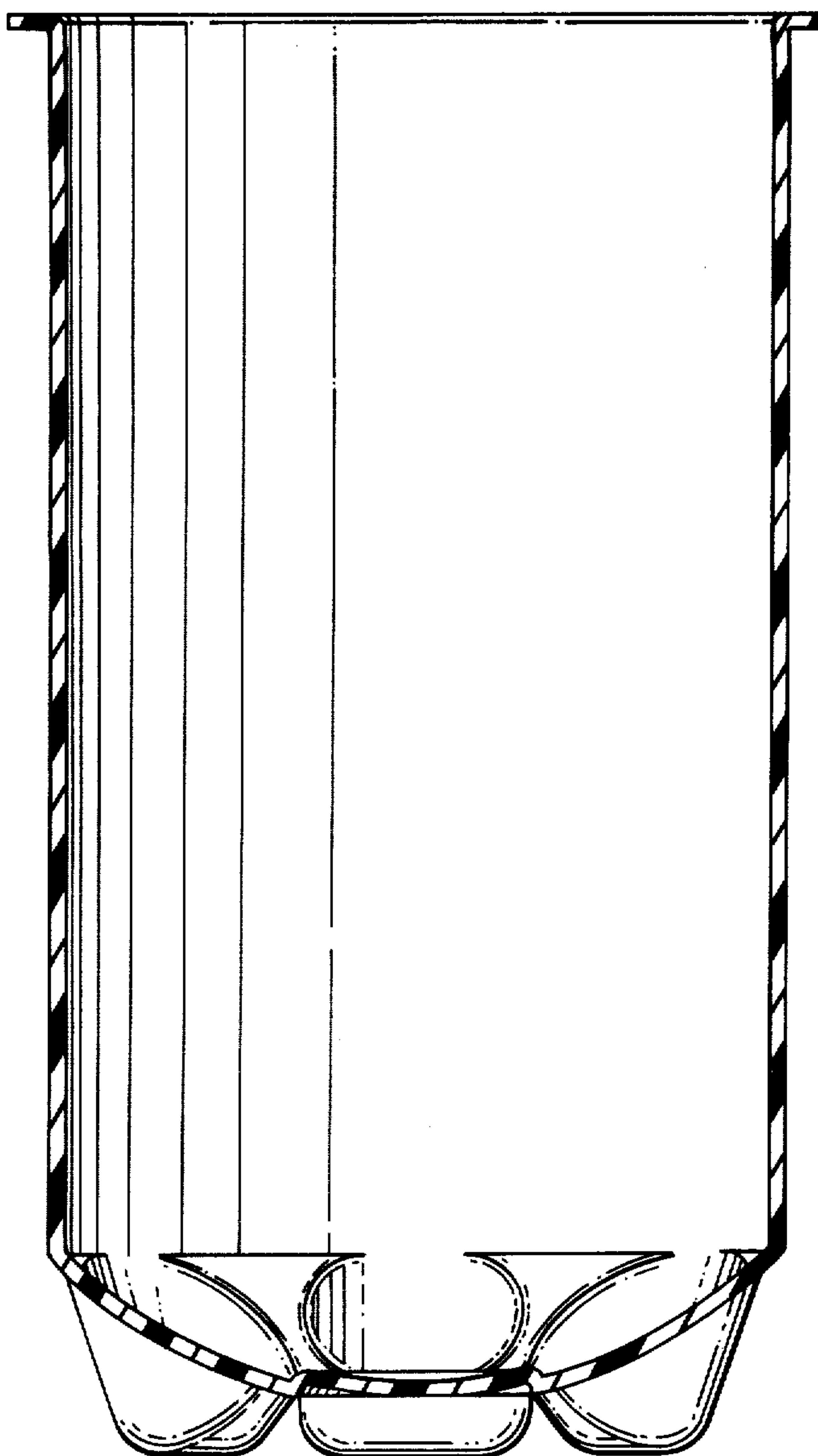
