The ornamental design for a symbolic pin, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a symbolic pin showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a symbolic pin showing a second embodiment of my new design;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a symbolic pin showing a third embodiment thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a symbolic pin showing a fourth embodiment thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a symbolic pin showing a fifth embodiment thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a symbolic pin showing a sixth embodiment thereof.

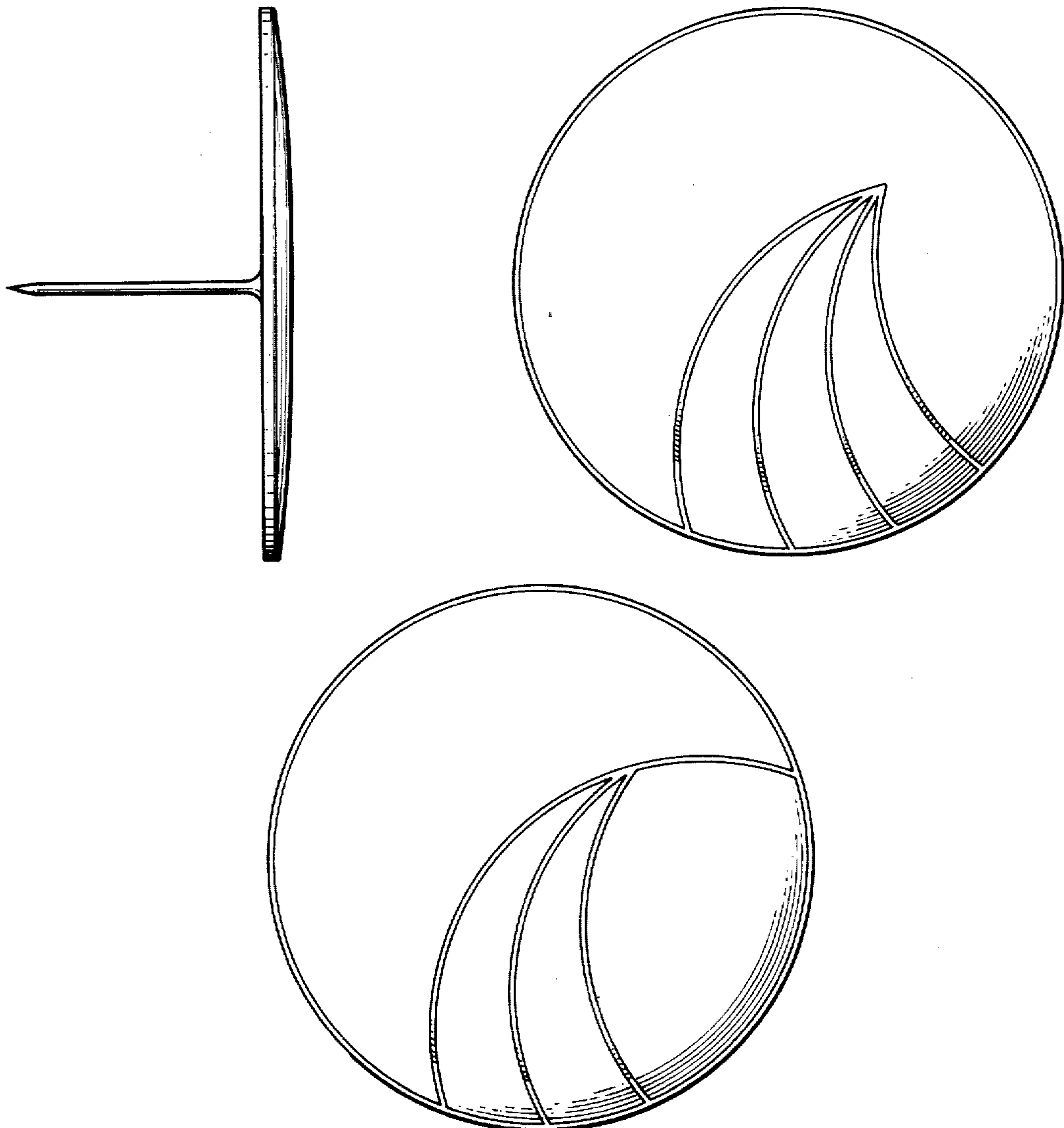

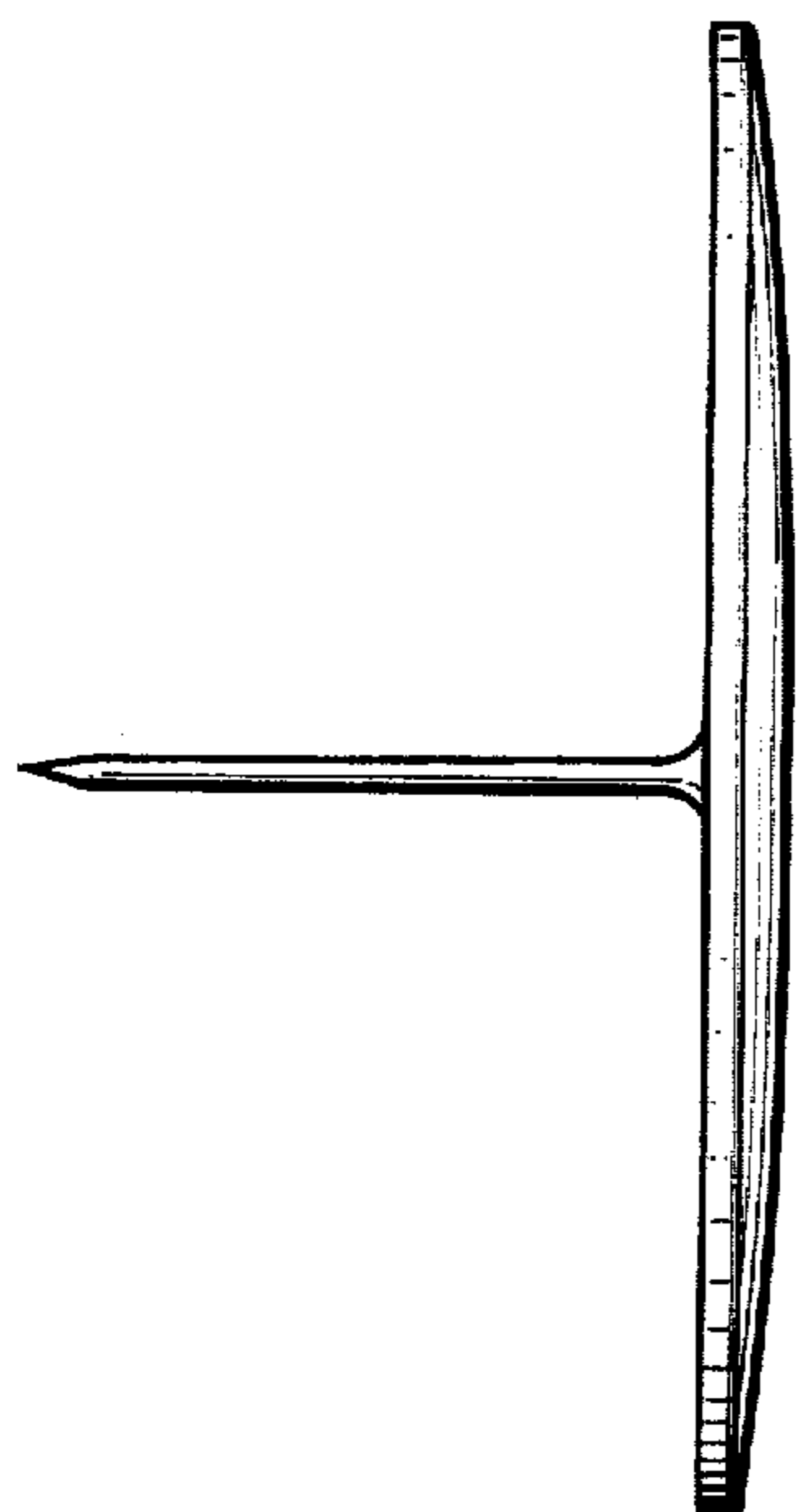

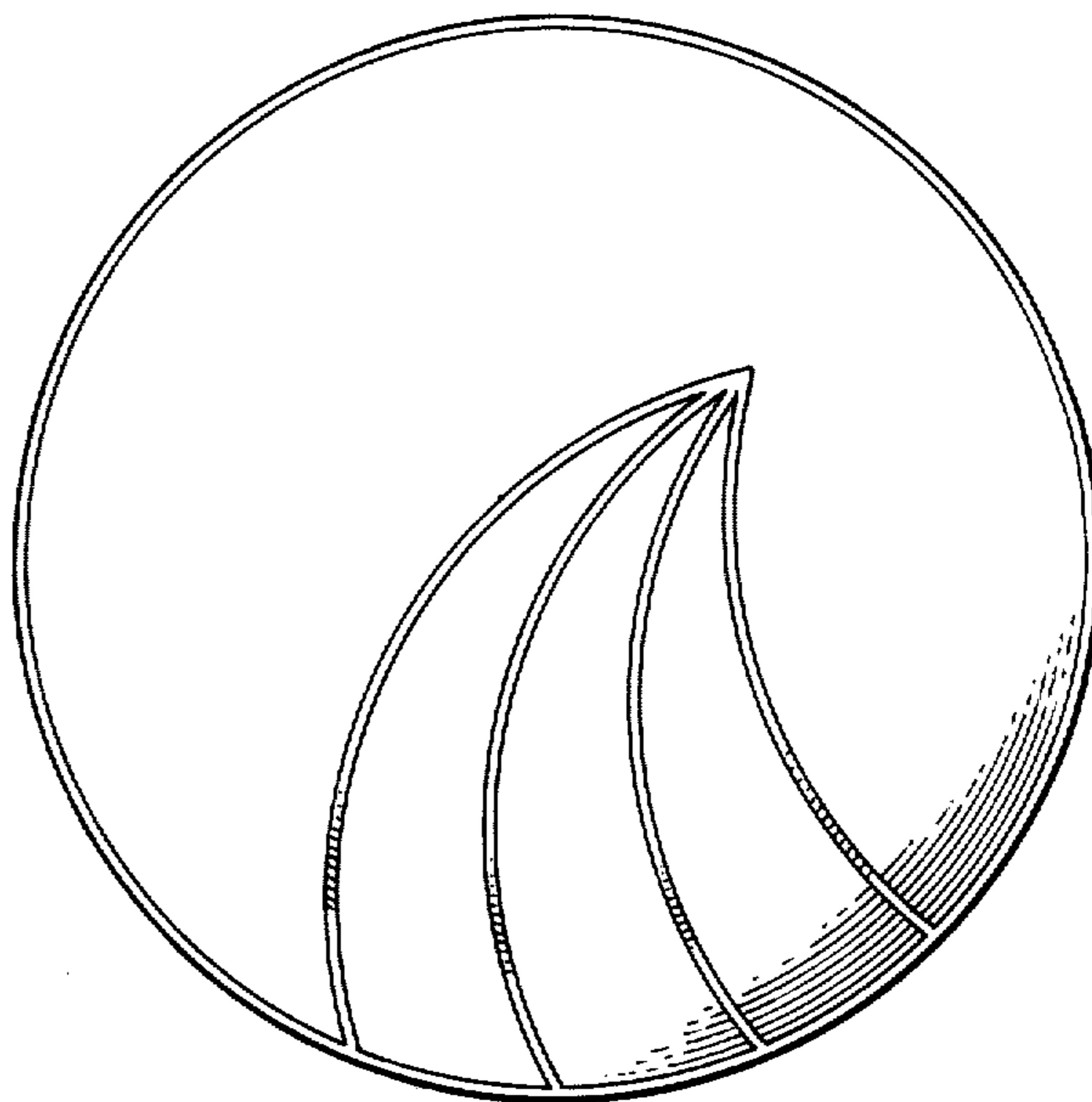

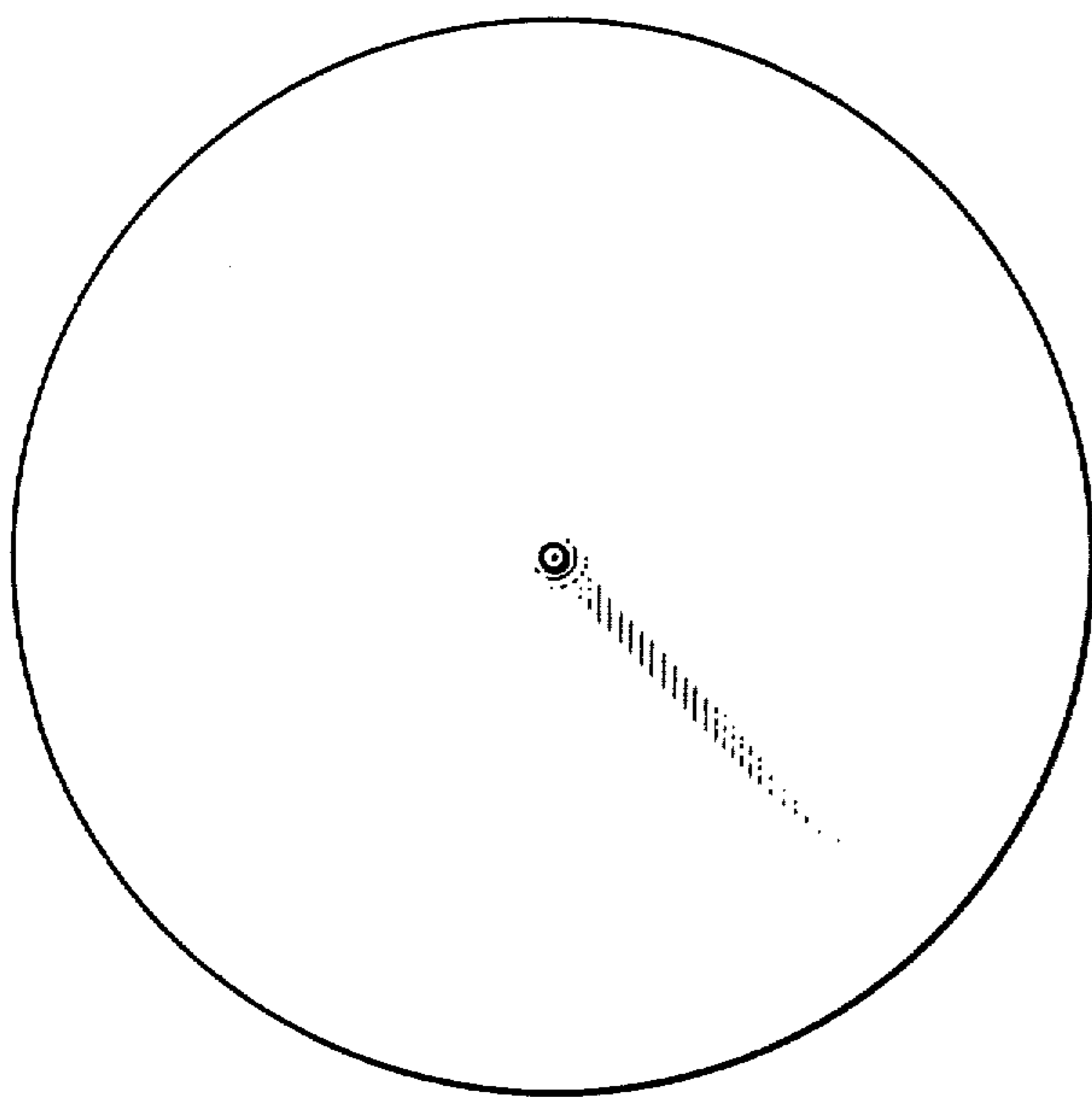

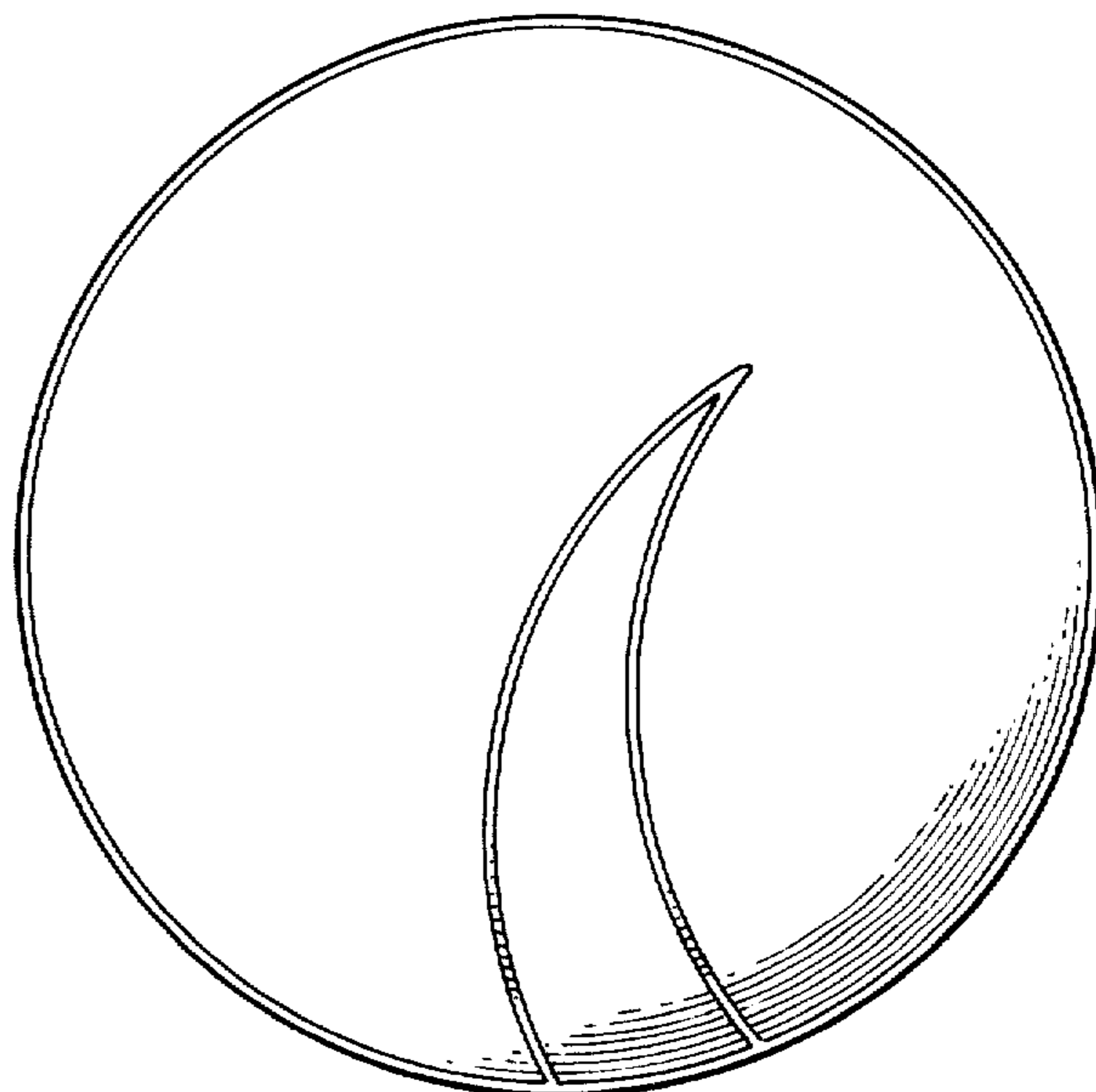

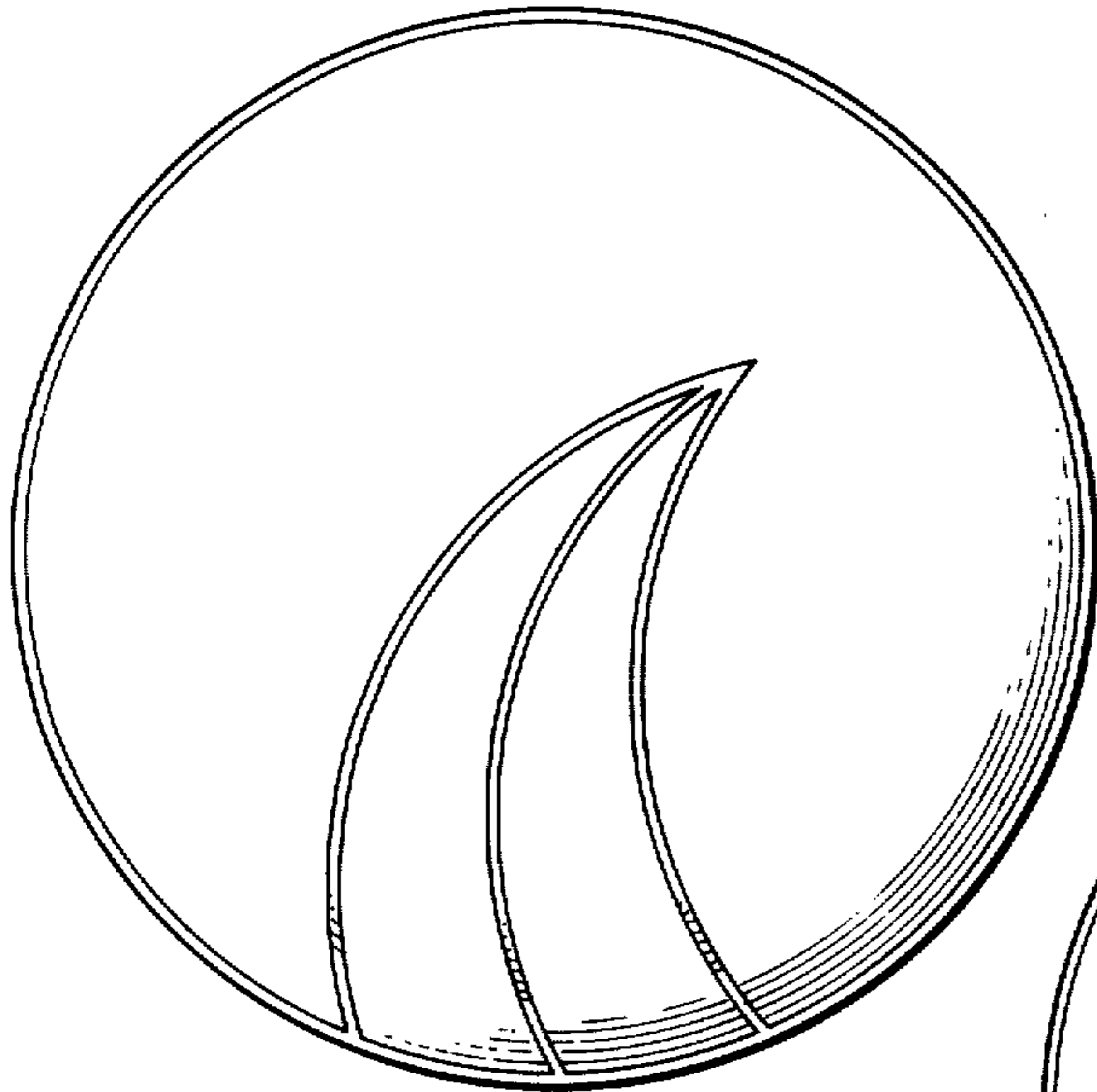

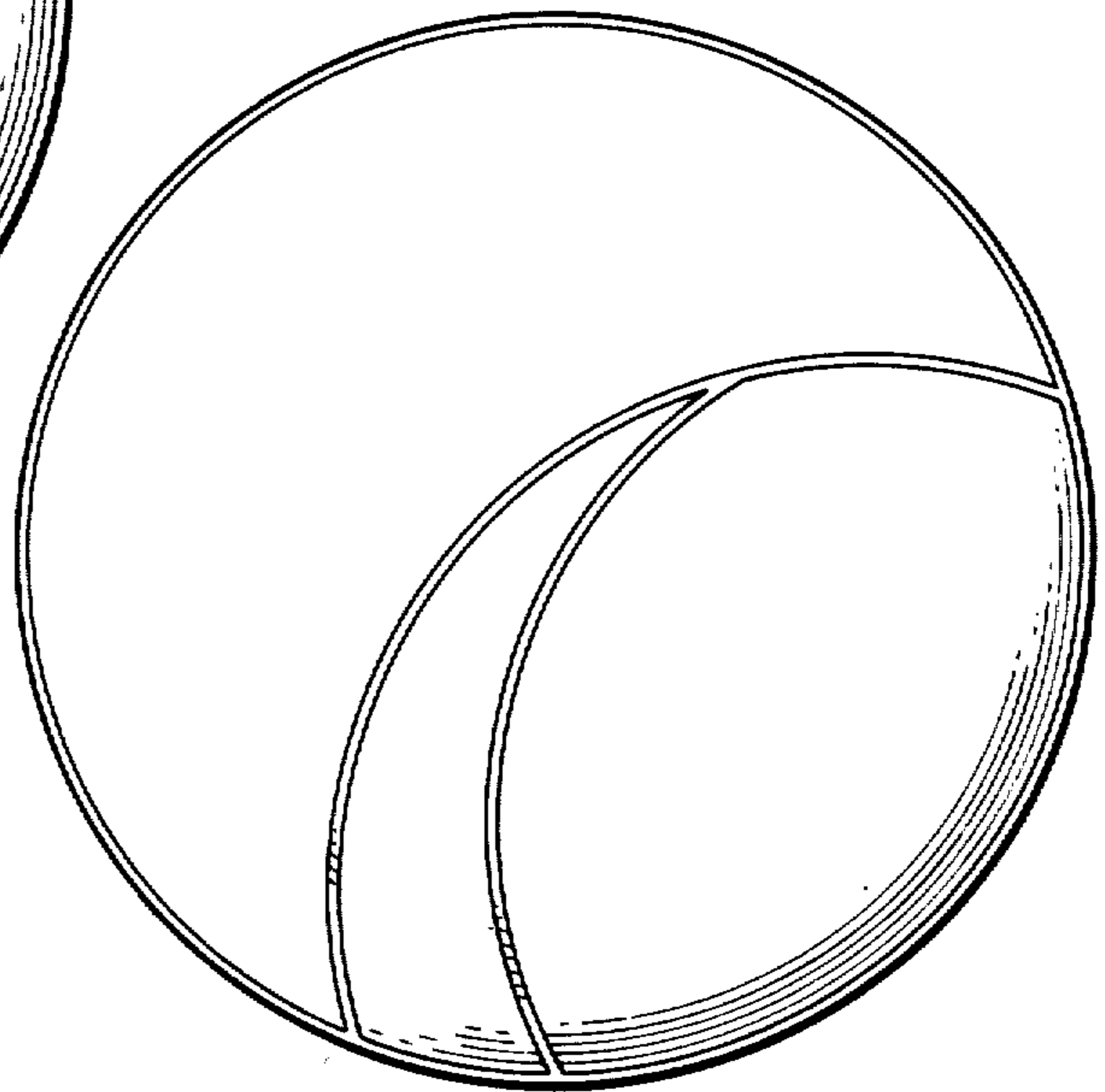

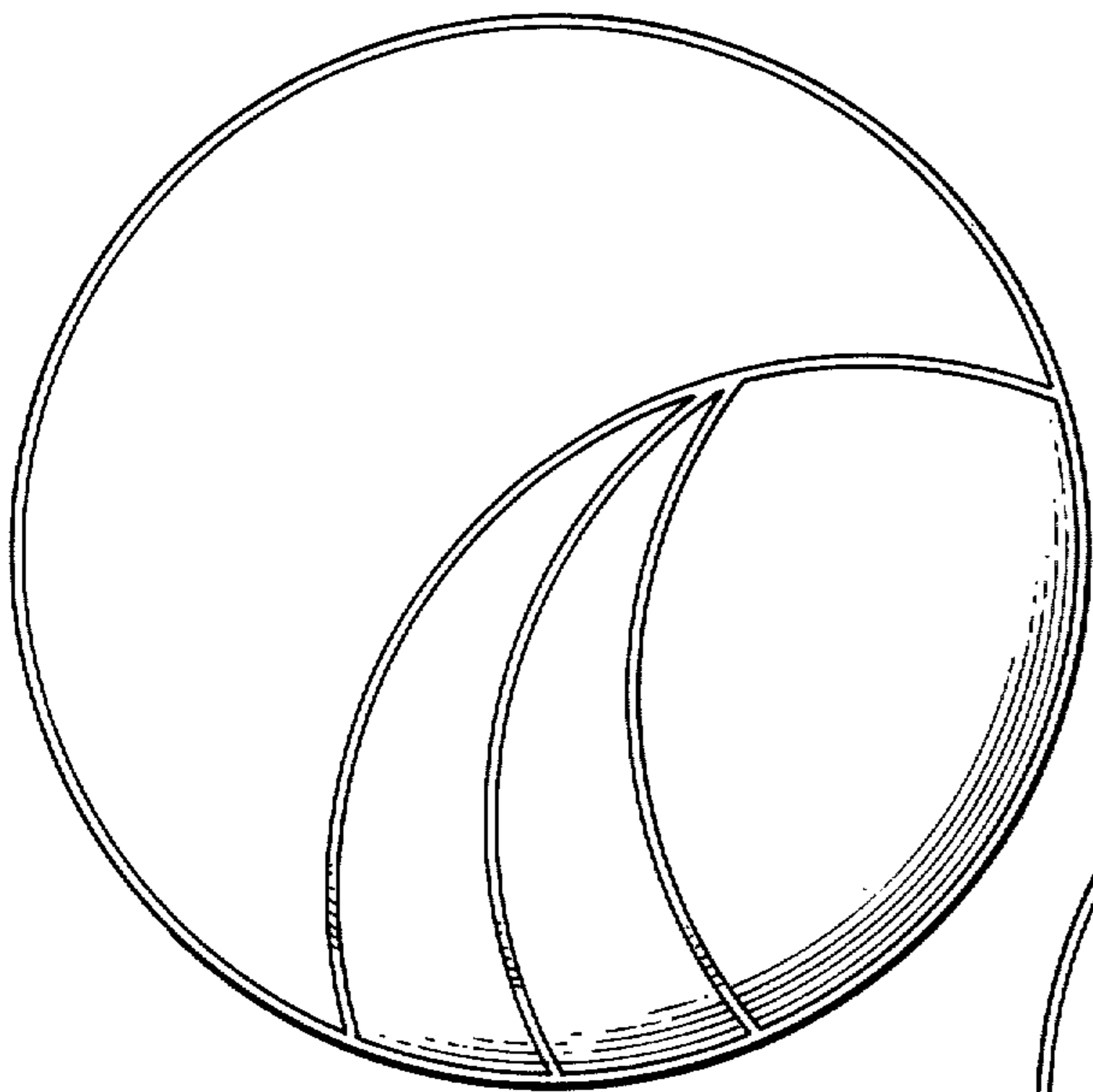
