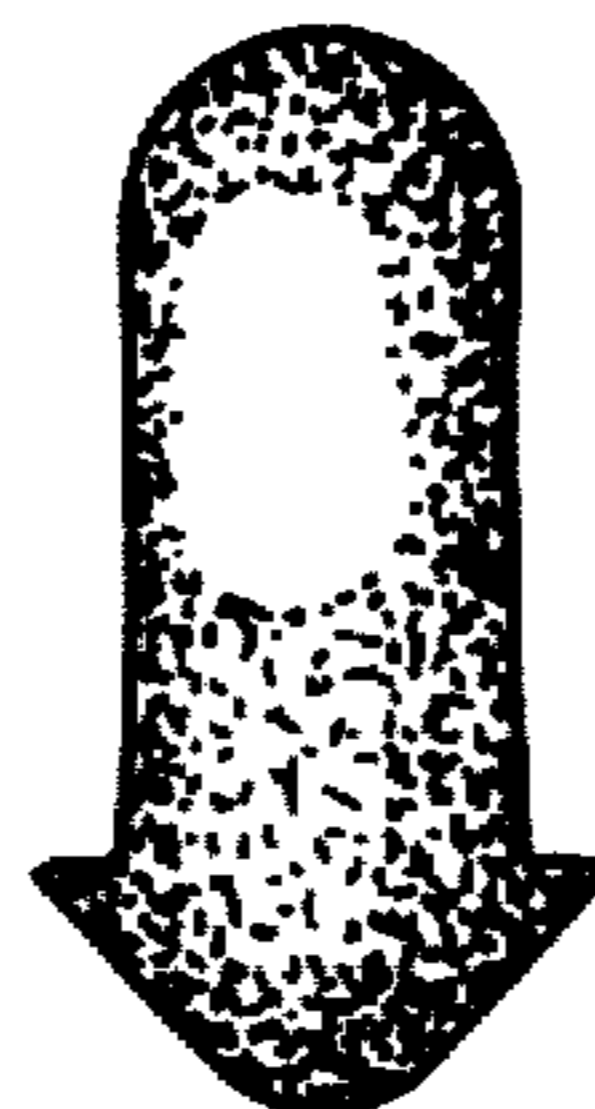
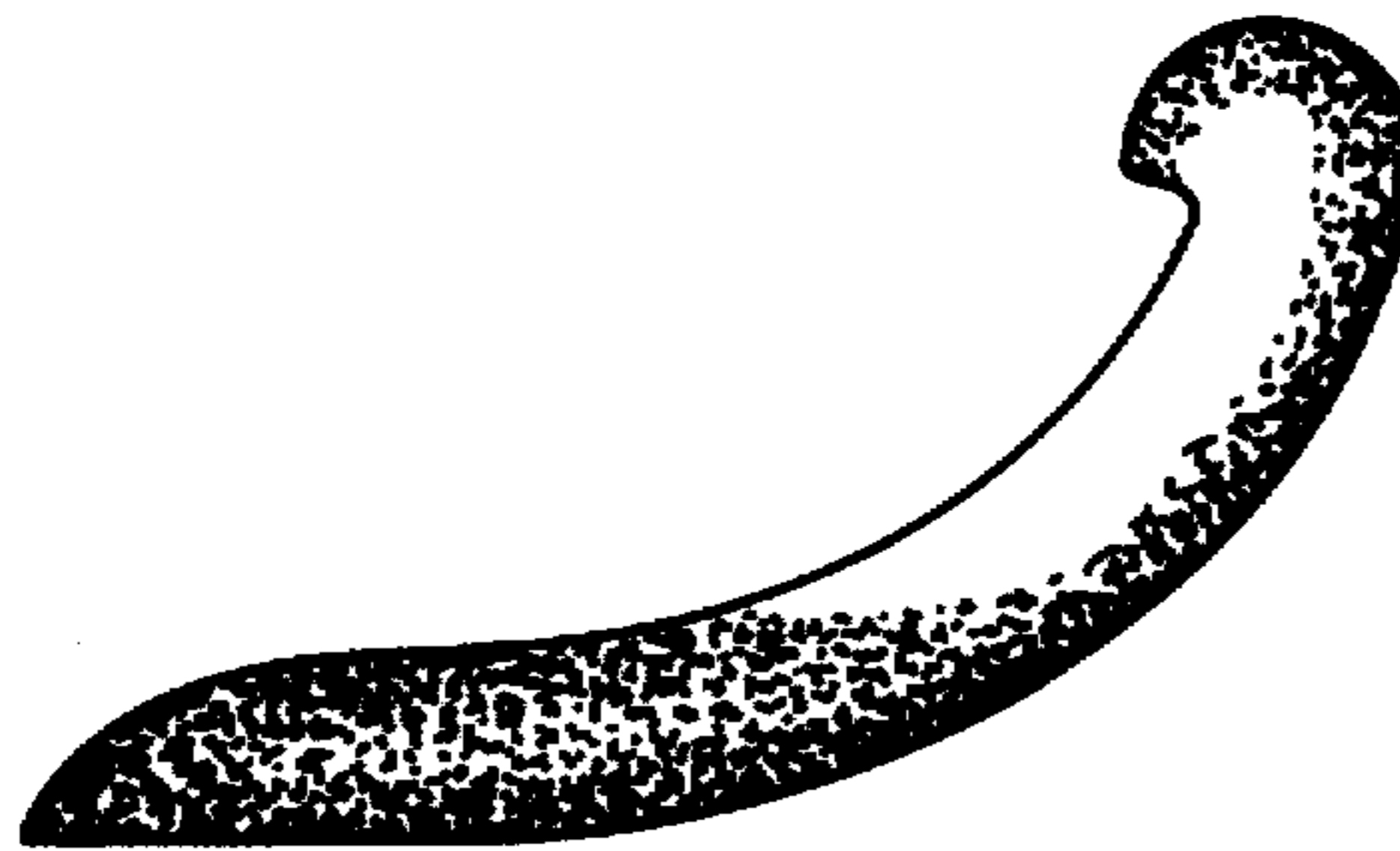

FIG. 6 is a tip end view of the device showing my new design.



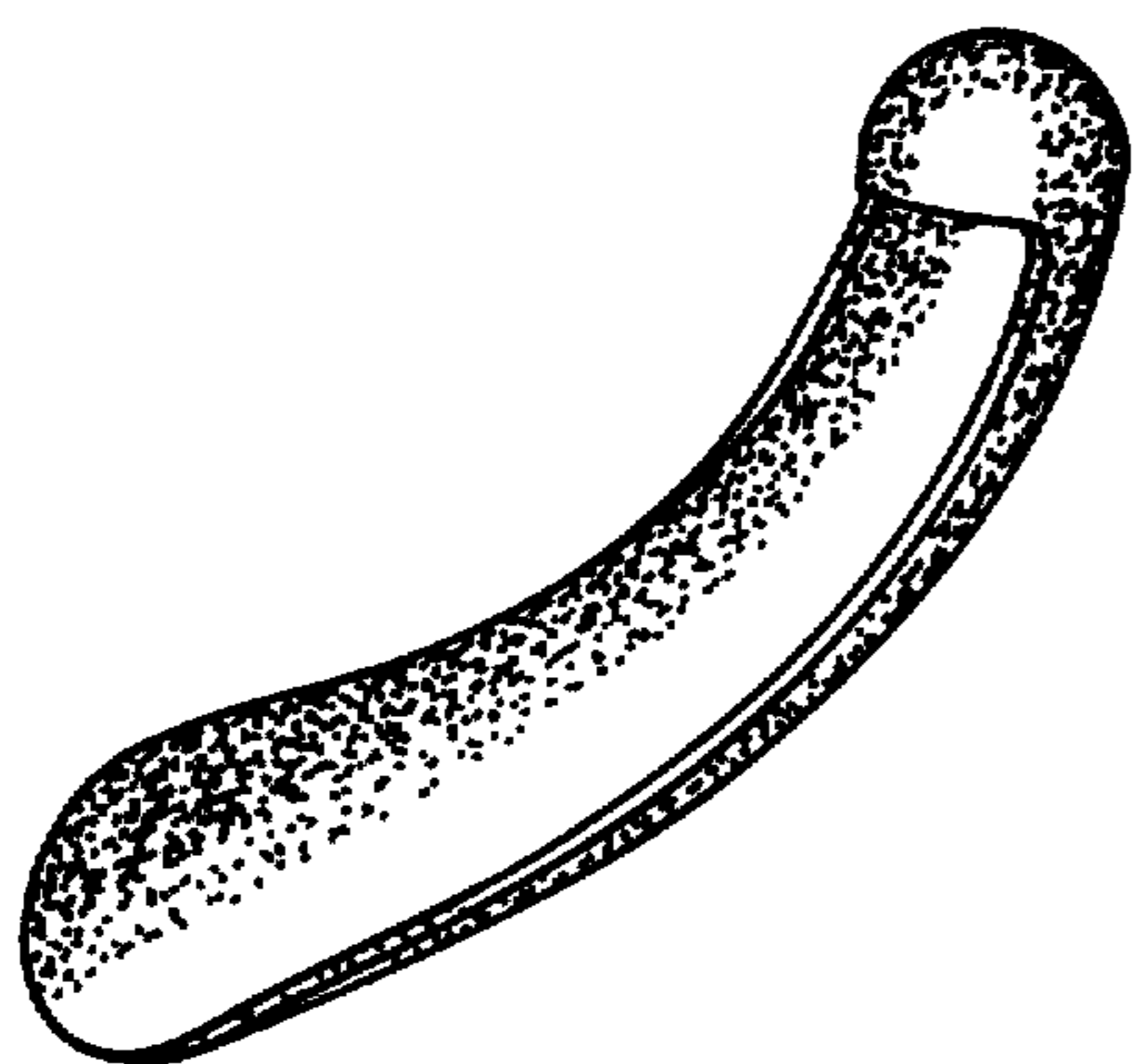

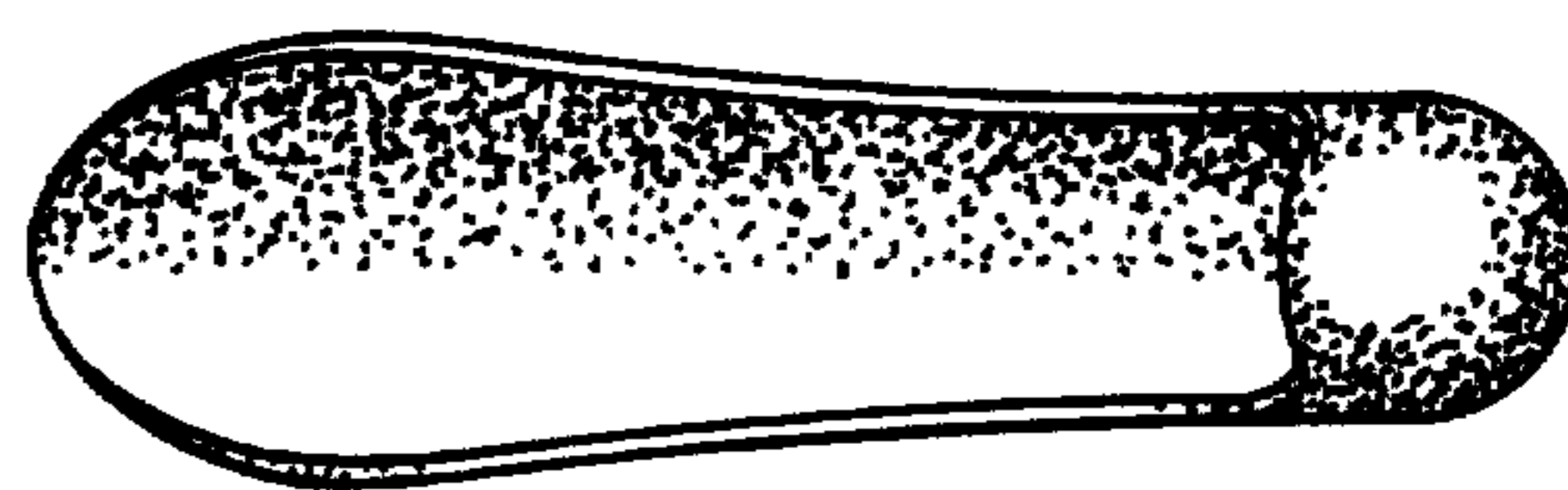

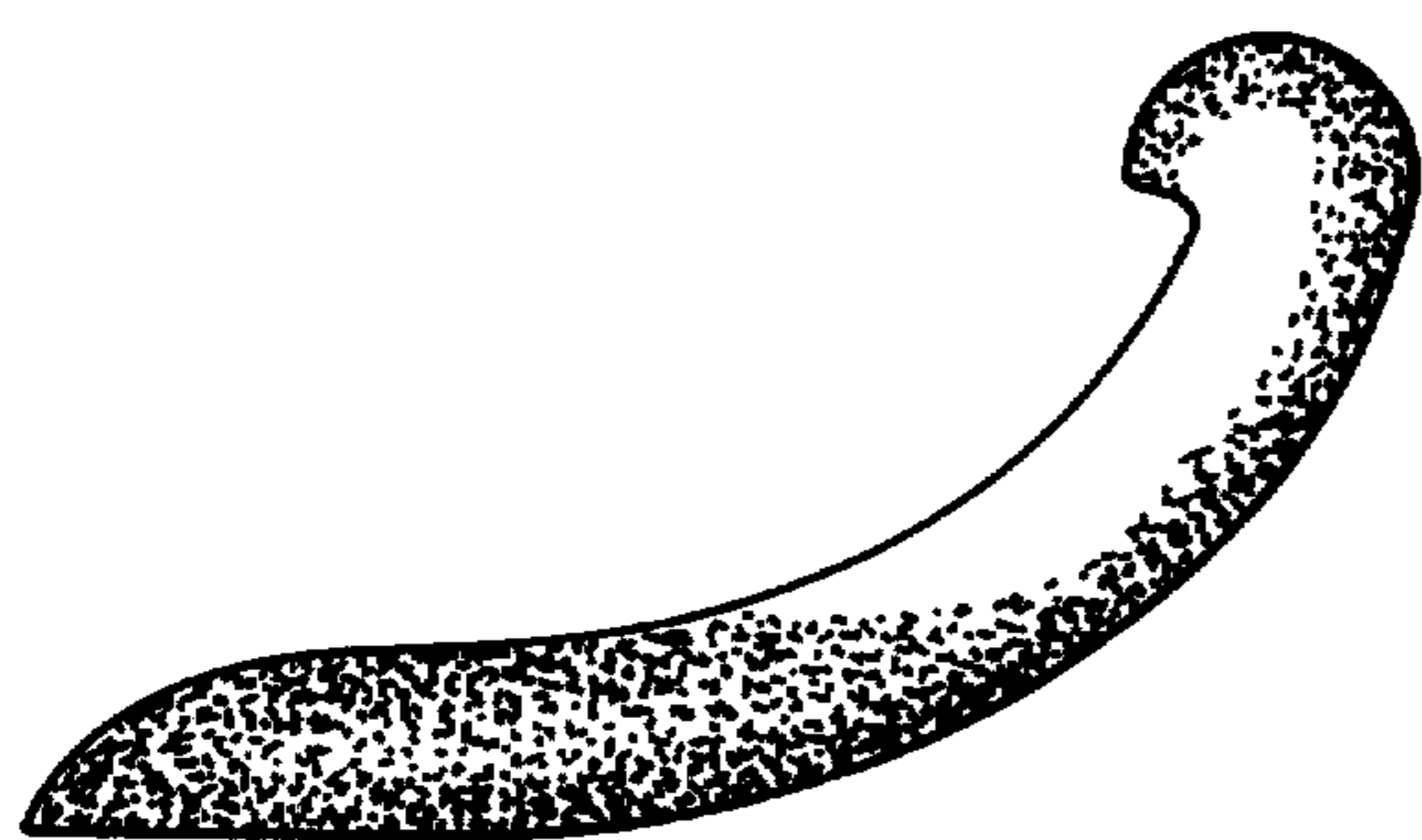

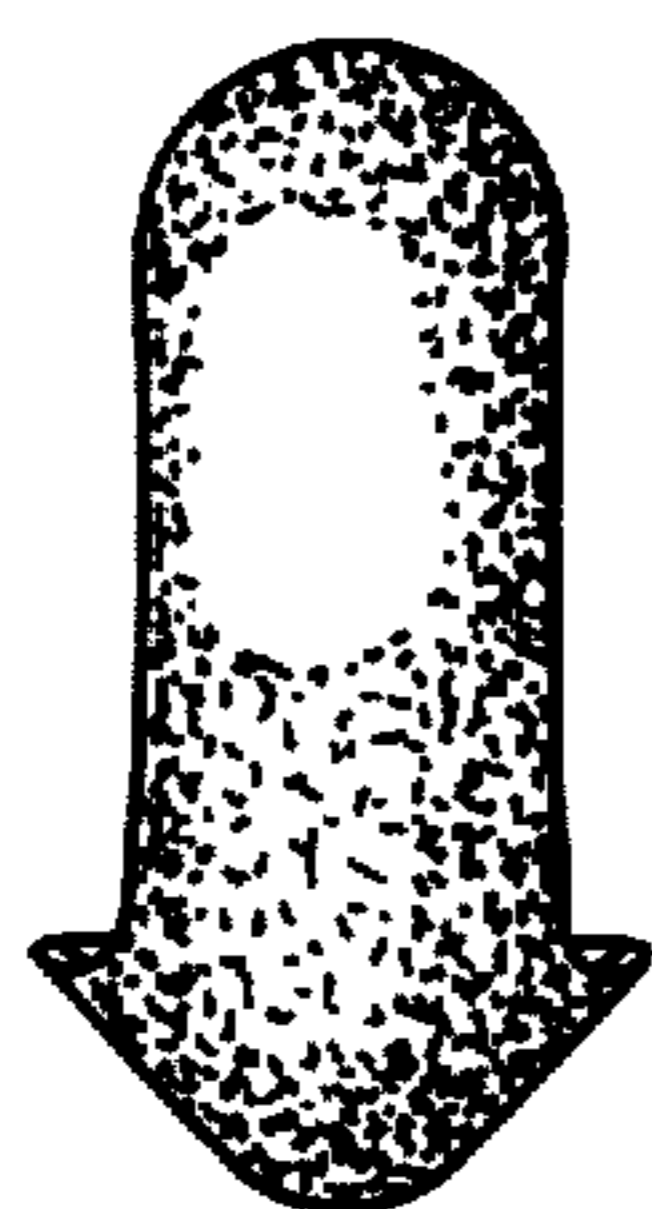

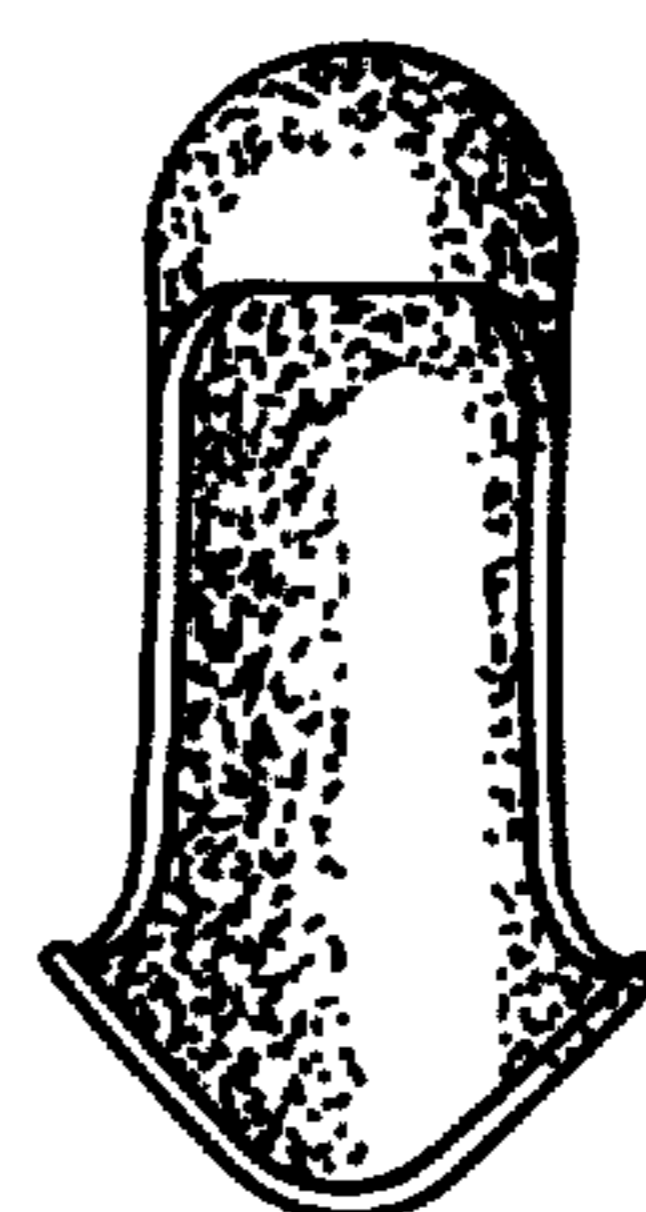
