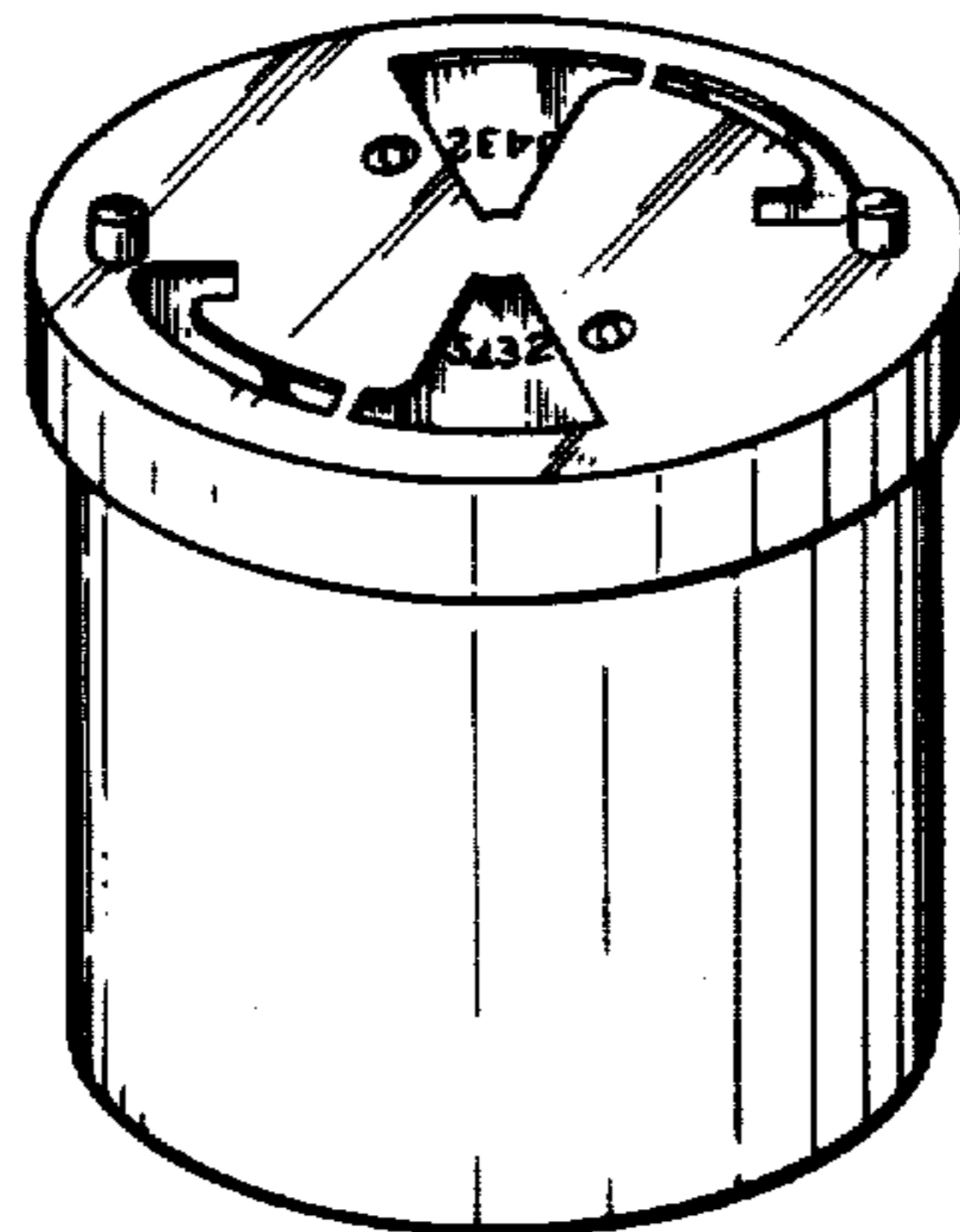
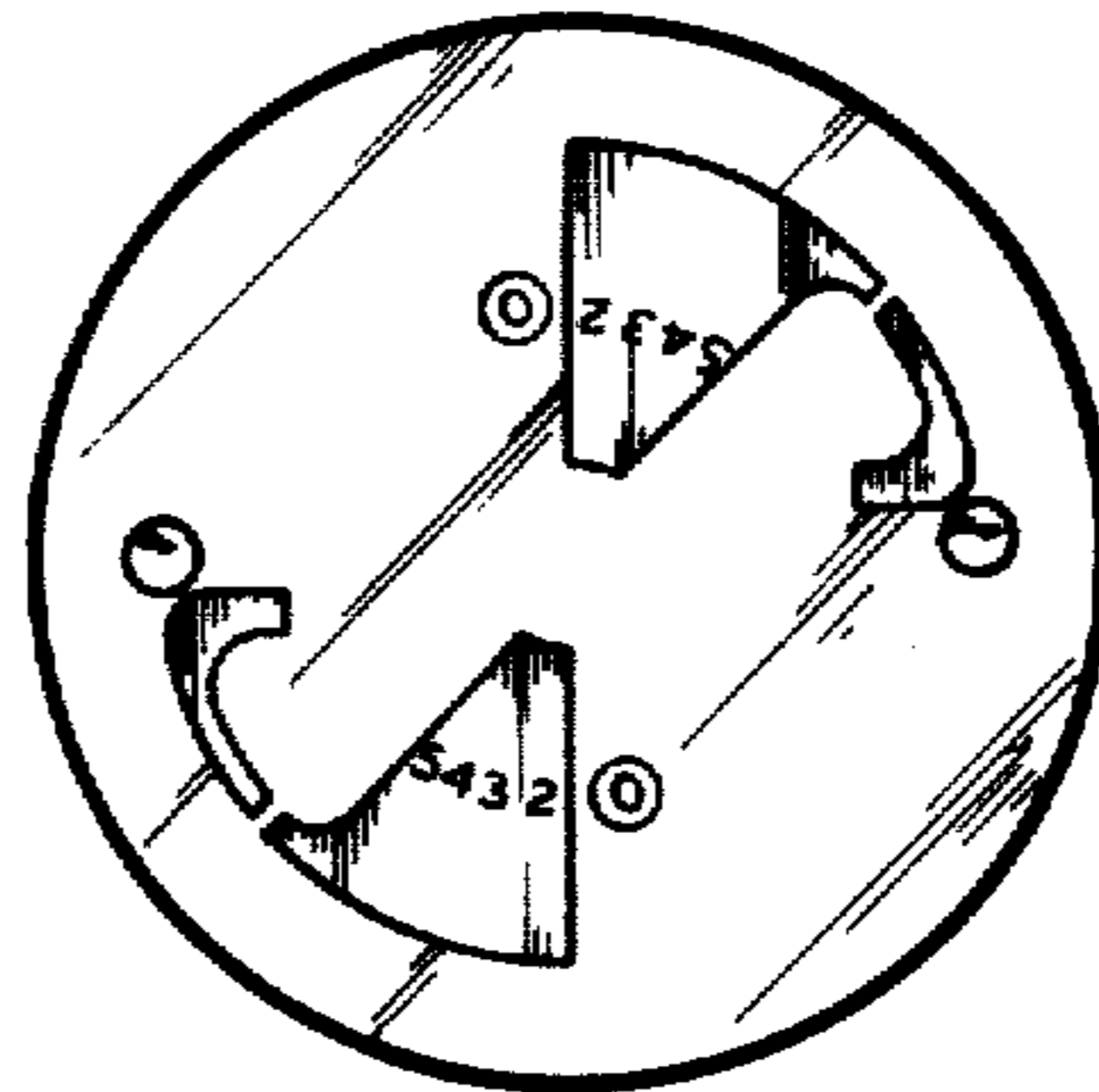

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a swimming pool chemical dispenser or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the dispenser with the dispenser cover in the fully closed position; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the dispenser with the dispenser cover in a partially opened position; FIG. 3 is a side perspective view with the dispenser cover in a partially opened position; FIG. 4 is a side perspective view with the dispenser cover in the fully opened position; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the dispenser container.



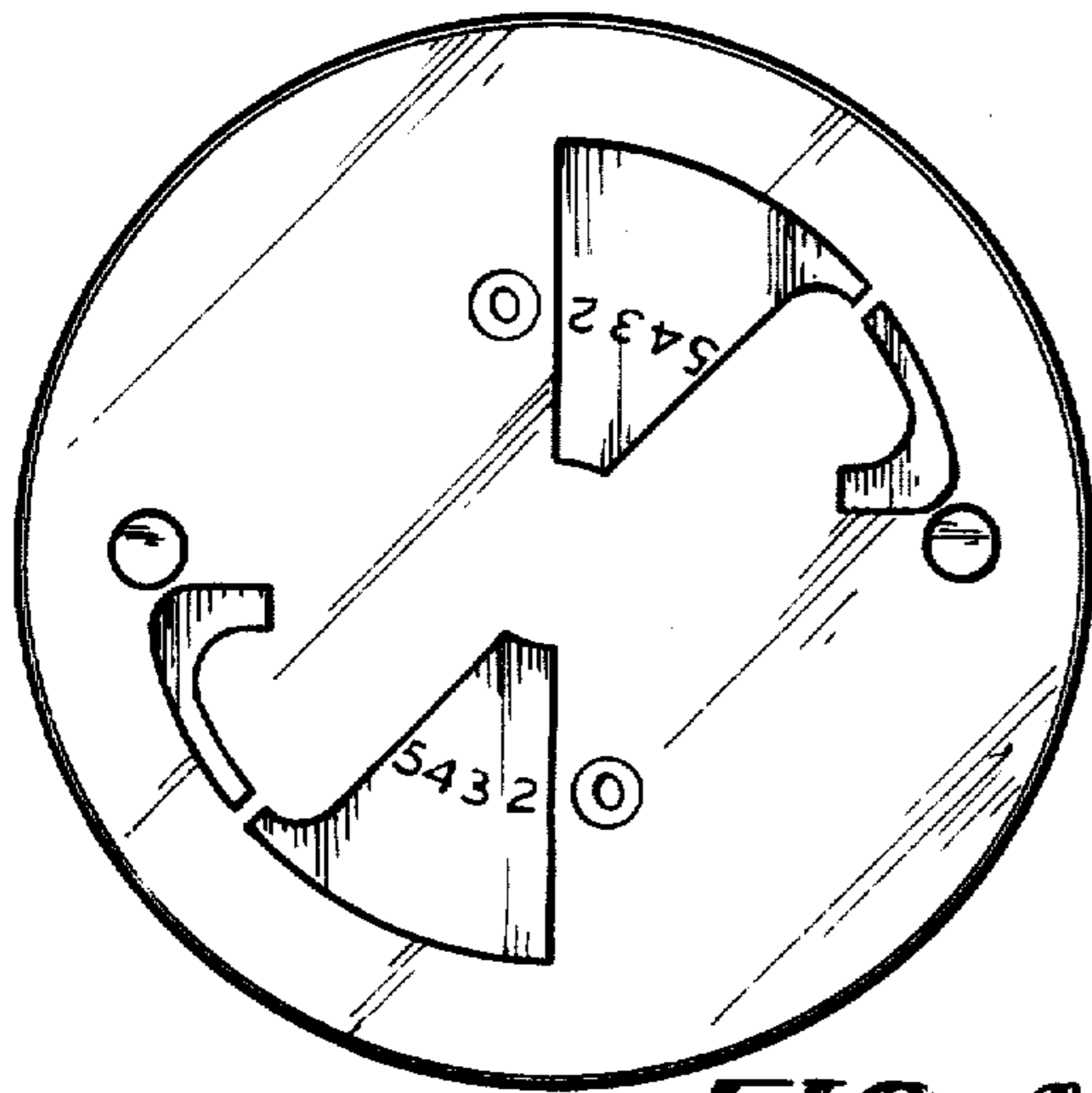

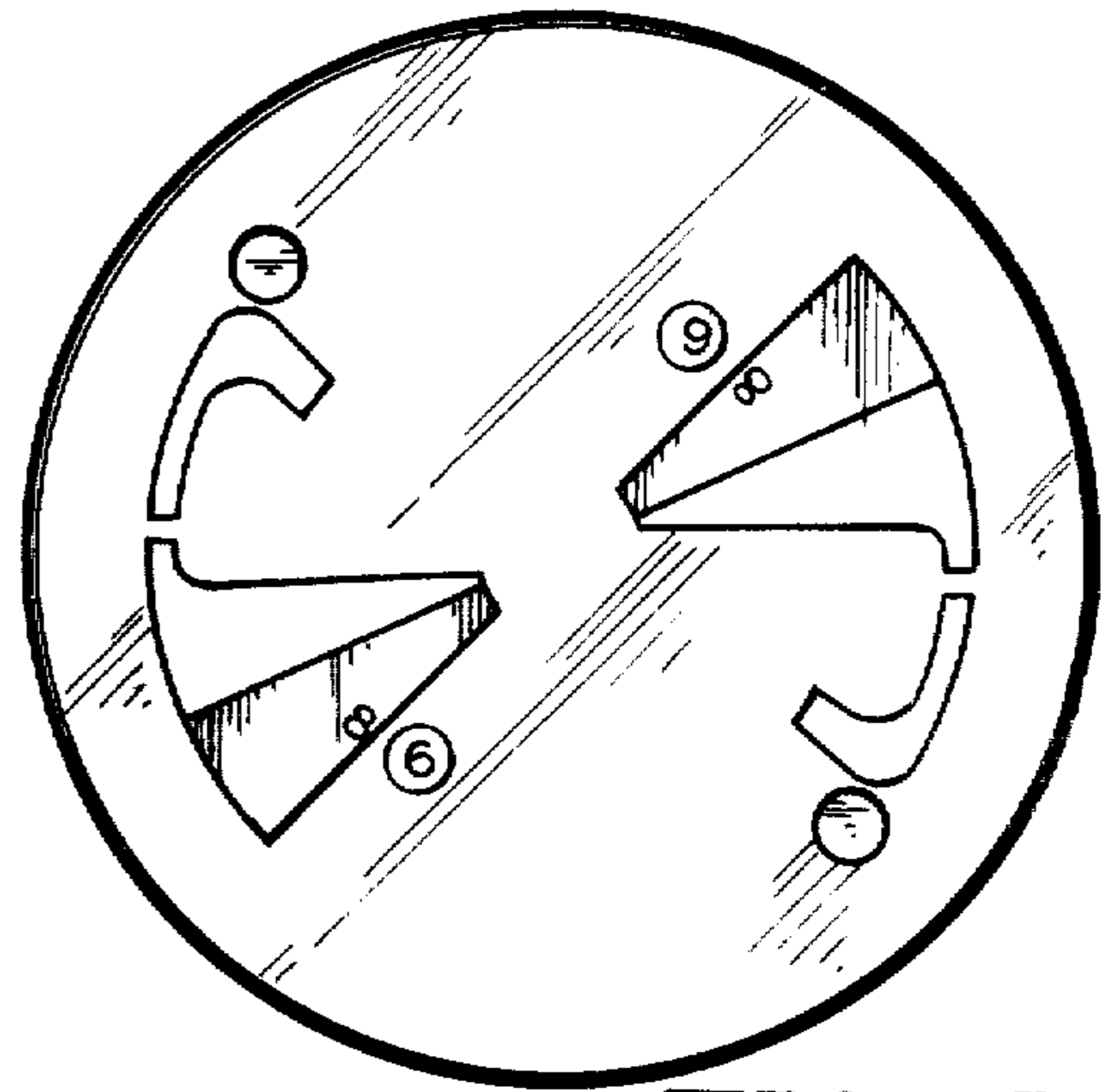

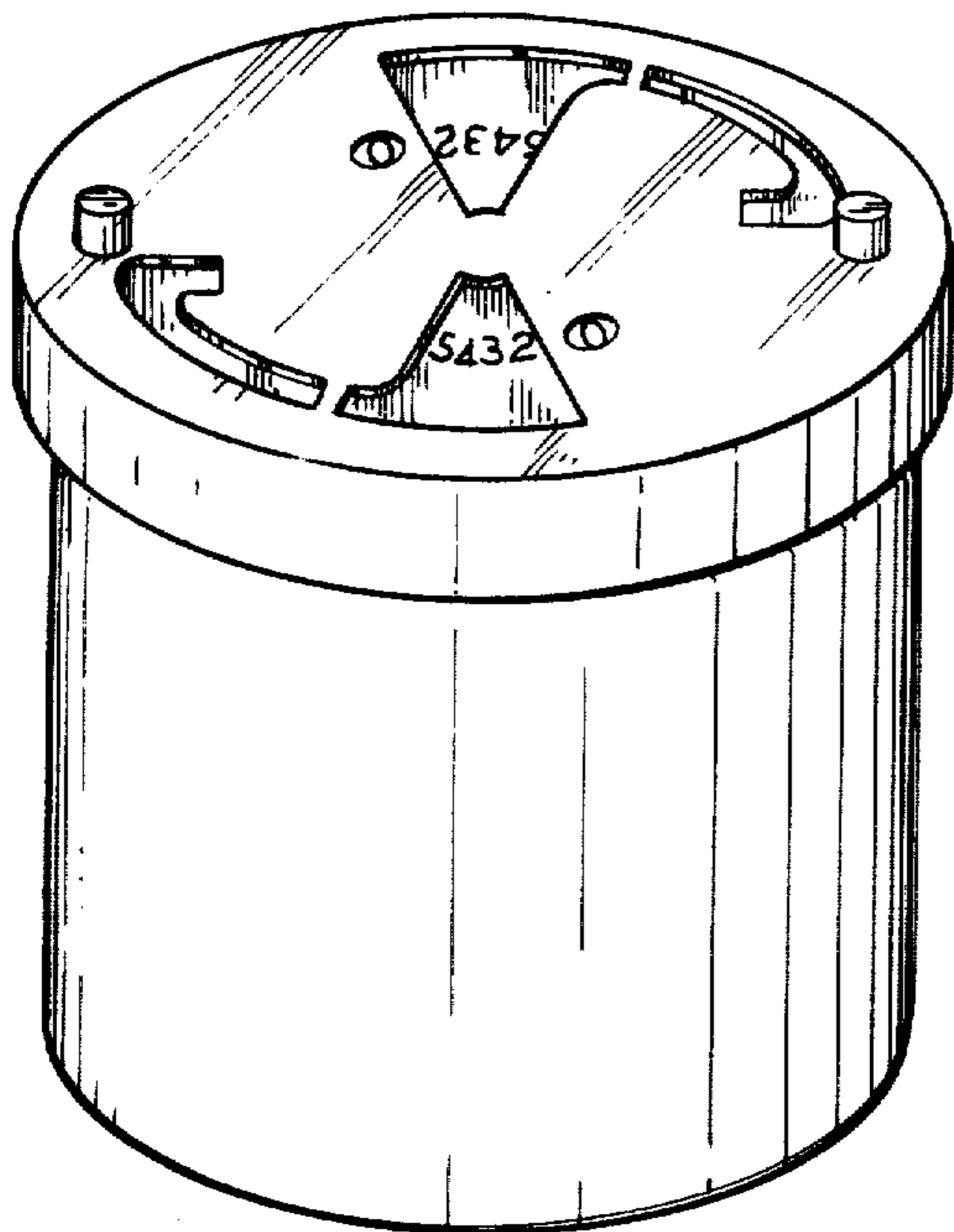

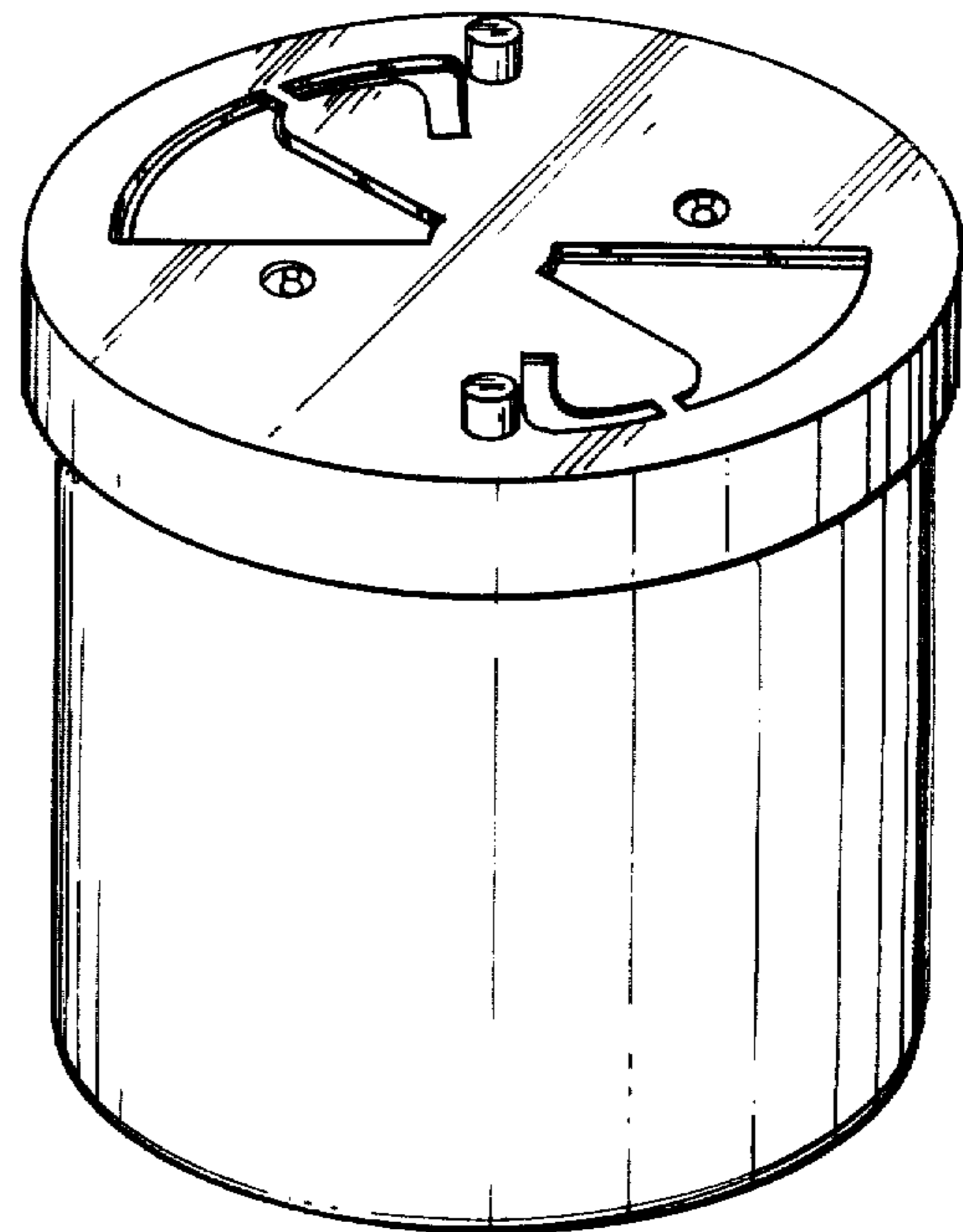

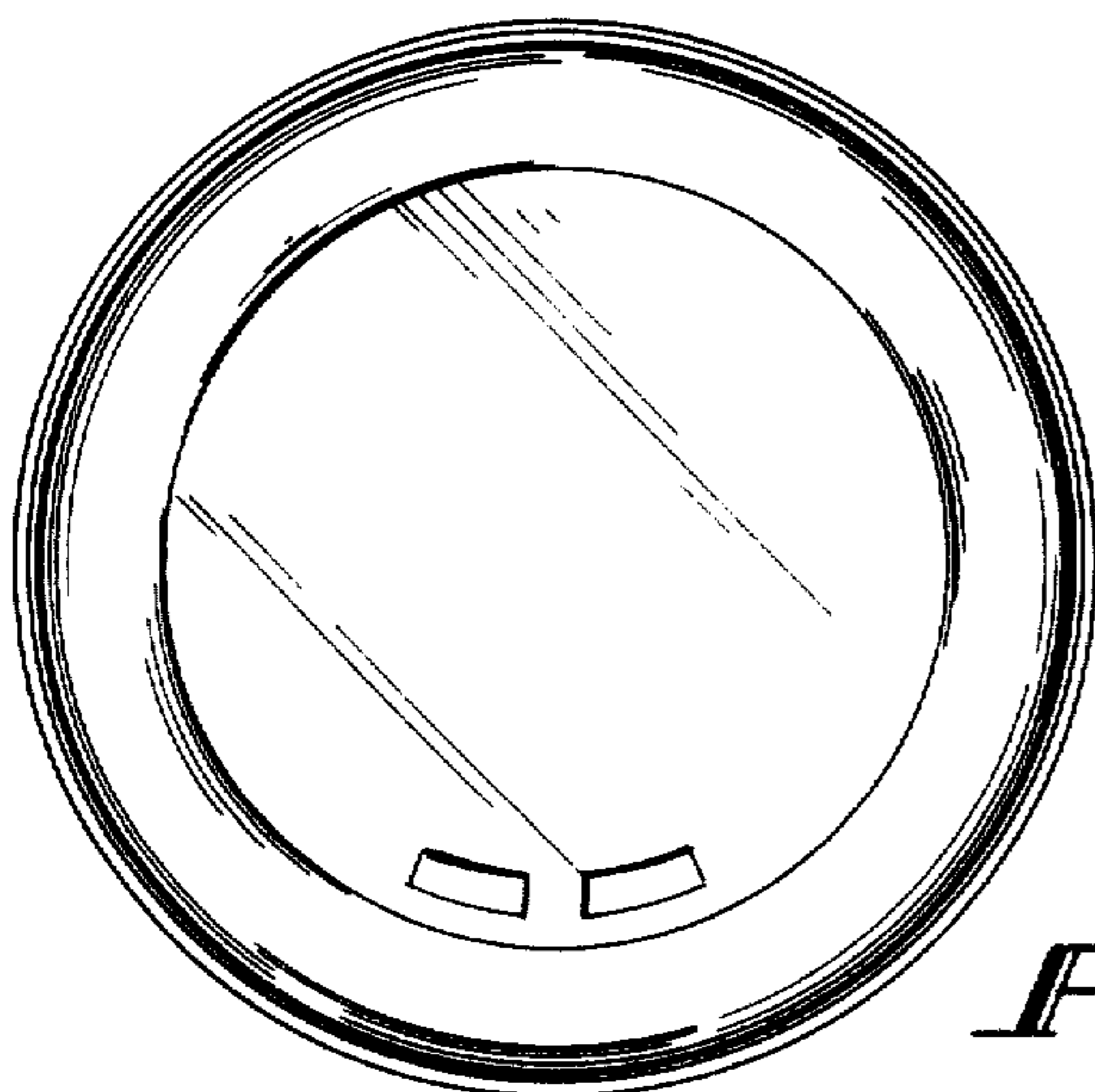
