FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a combined hydrotherapy spa and swimming pool, showing my new design;

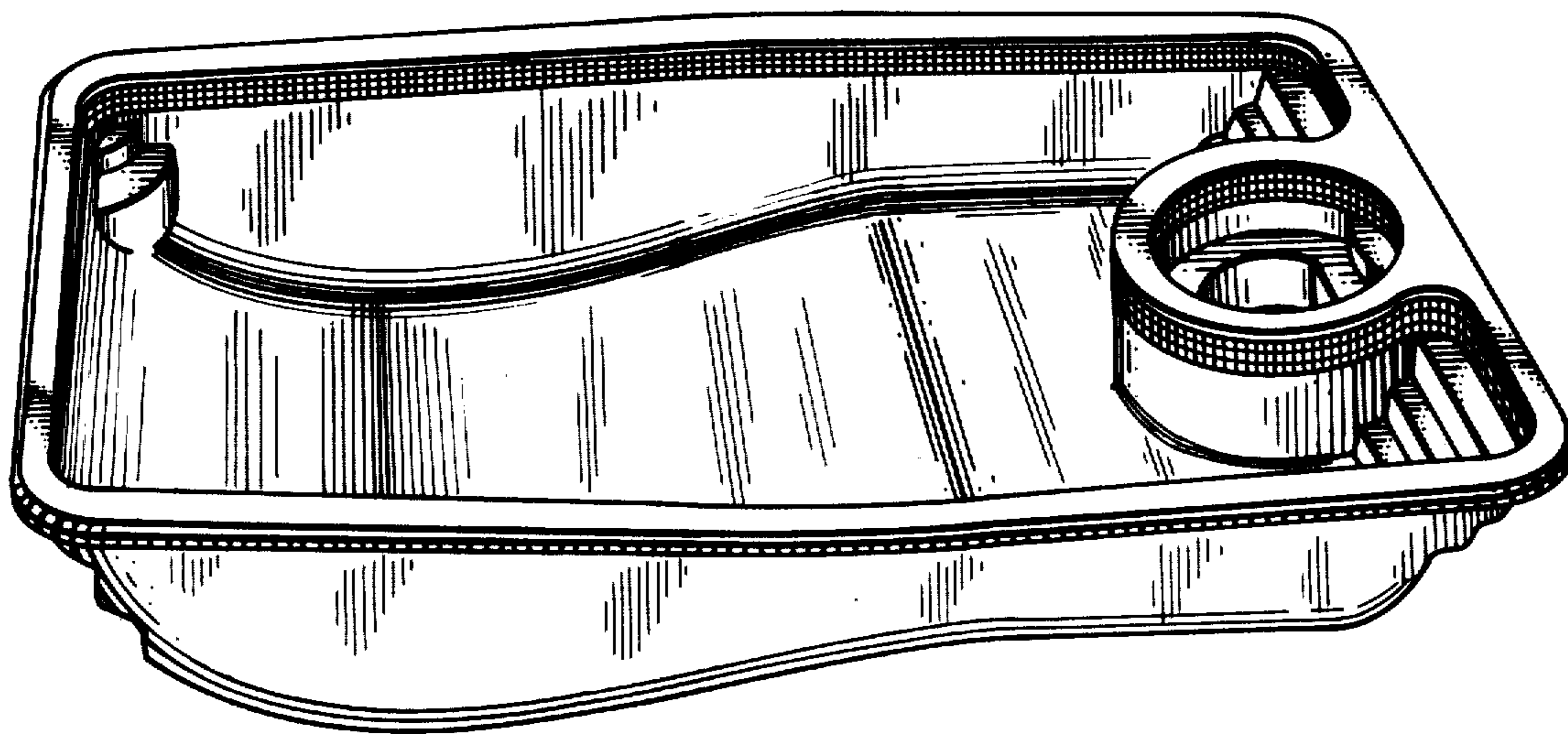
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an elevation of the end opposite FIG. 5.



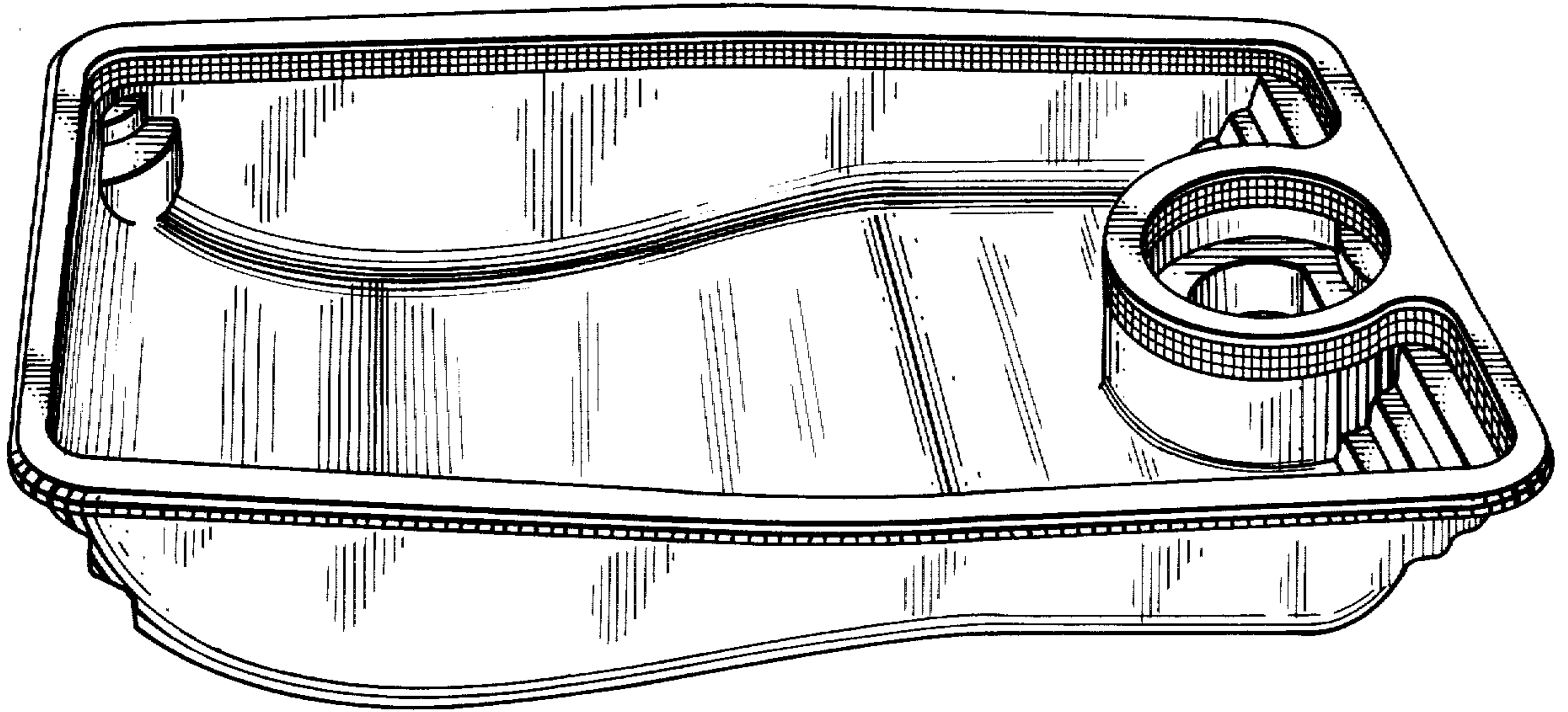

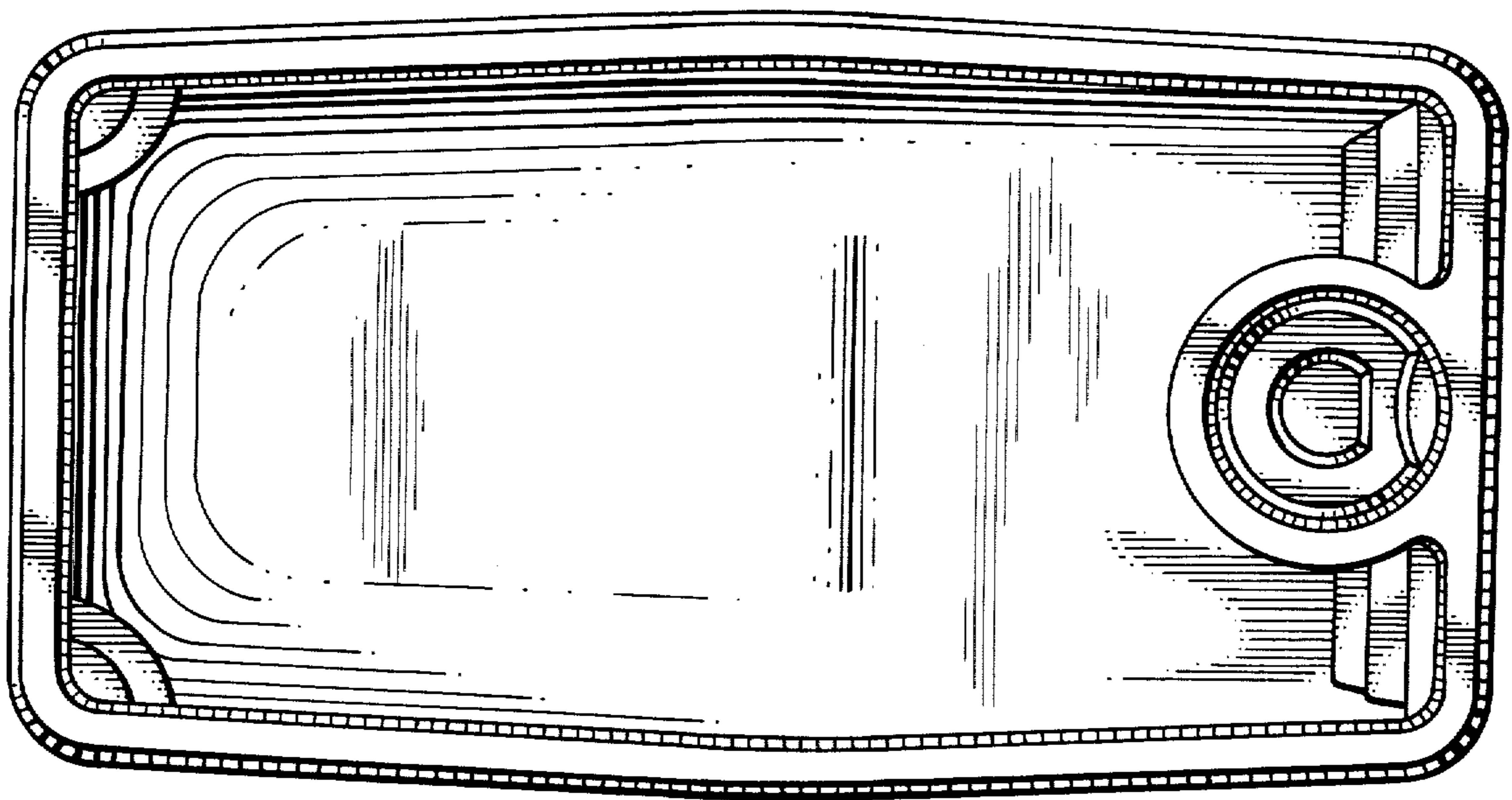

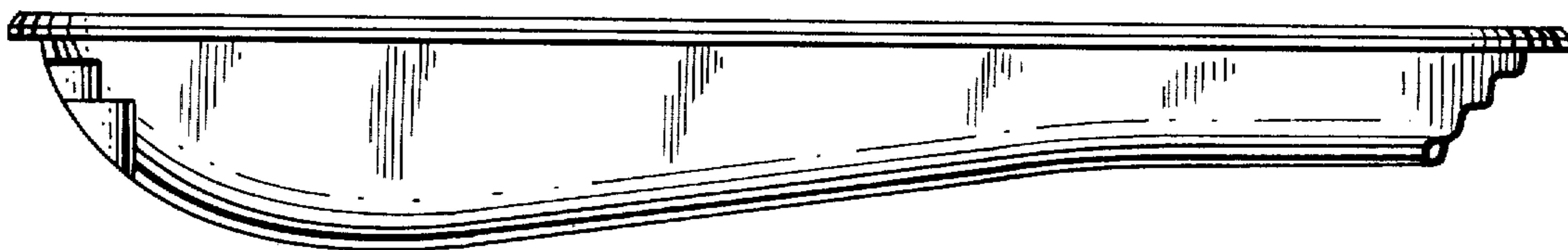

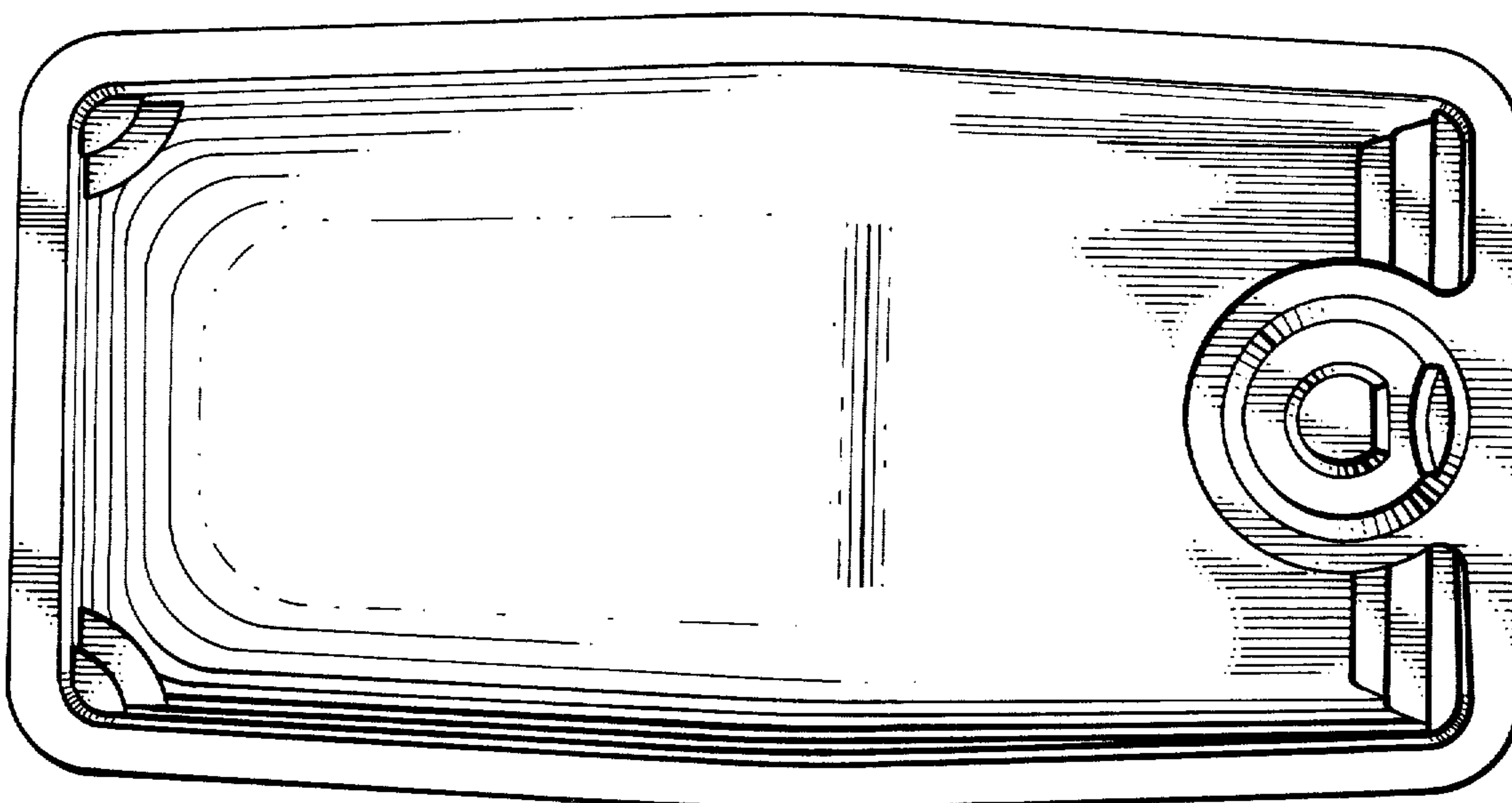

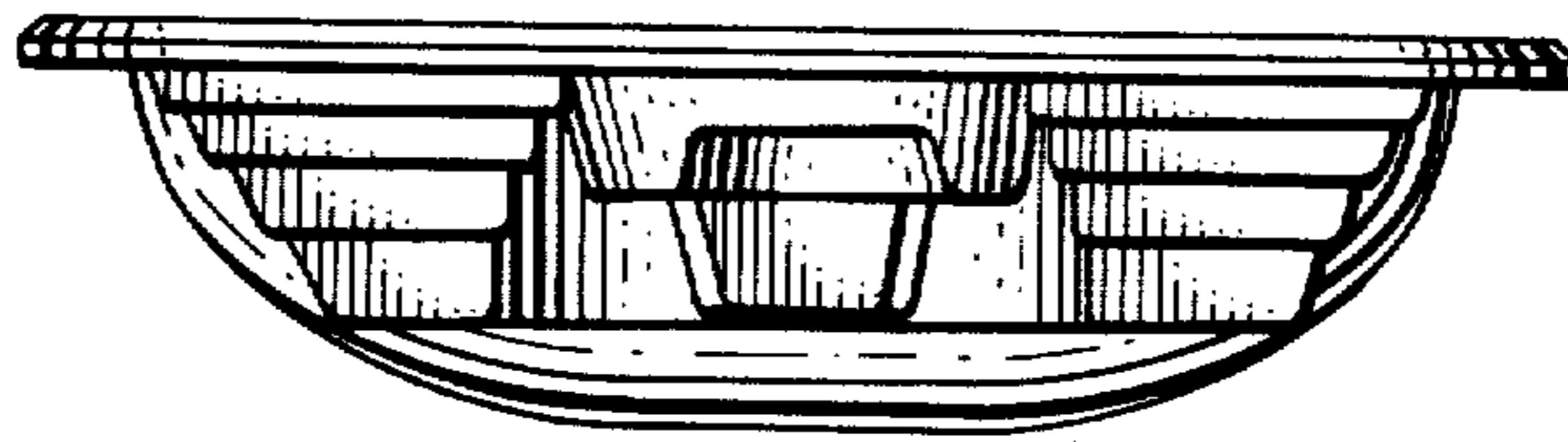

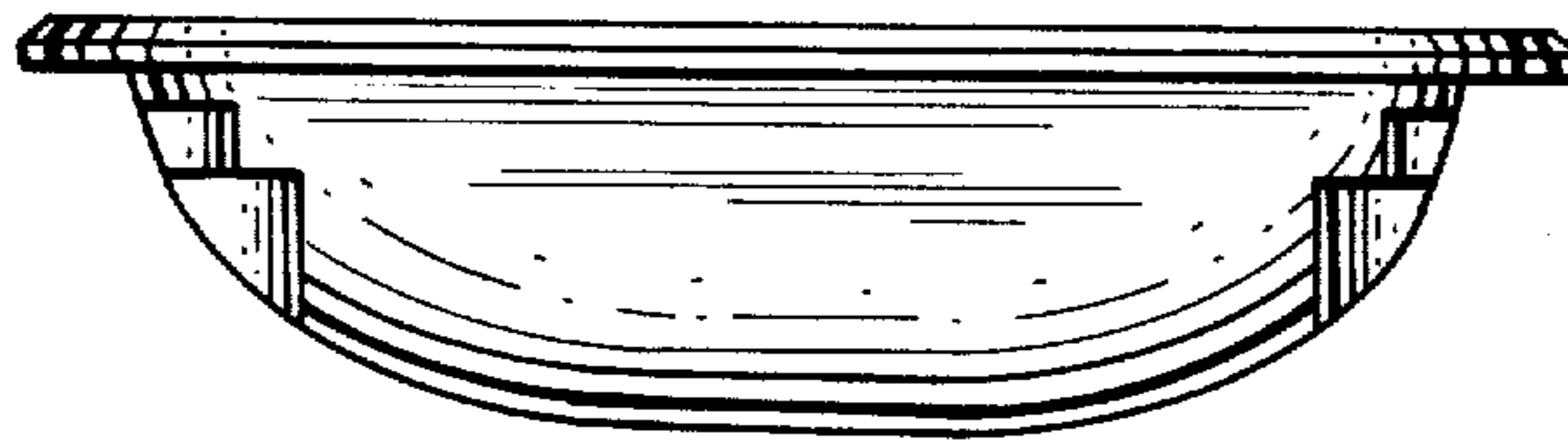
