DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a light fixture showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a frontal elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view on an enlarged scale taken from the right of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view on an enlarged scale taken from the left of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; and
