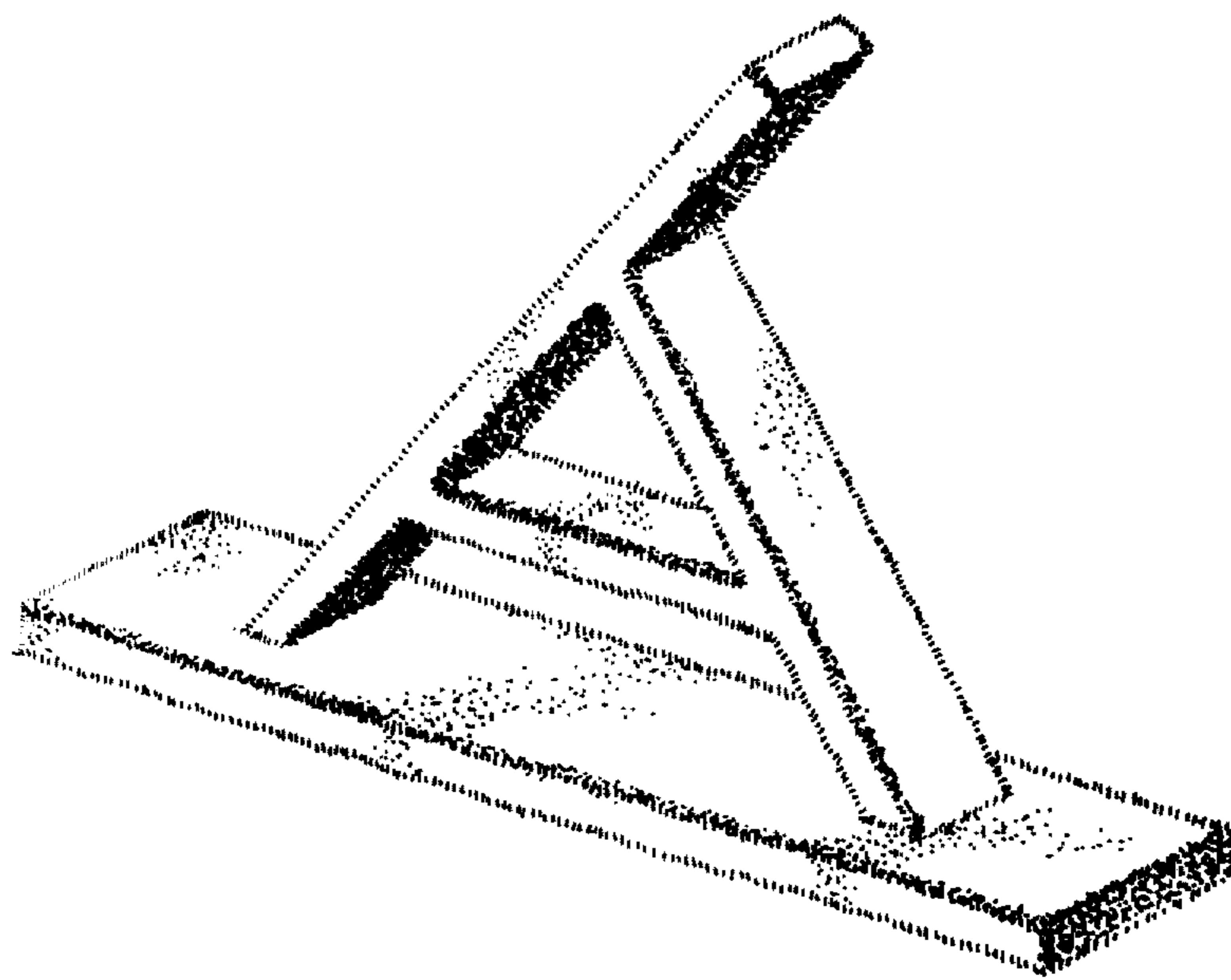

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined cat playground and exerciser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined cat playground and exerciser showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front shown.
FIG. 5 is a right end elevational view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



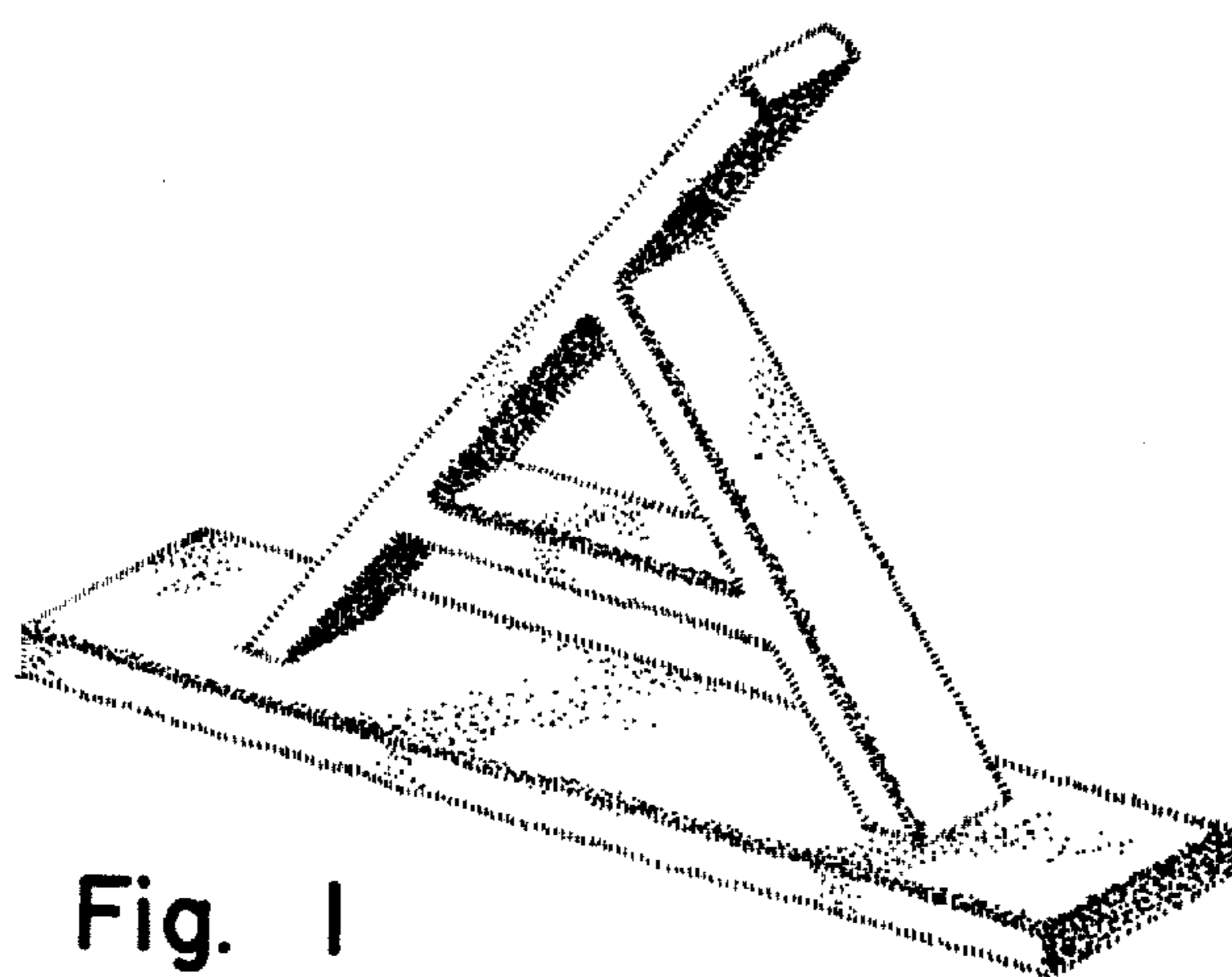

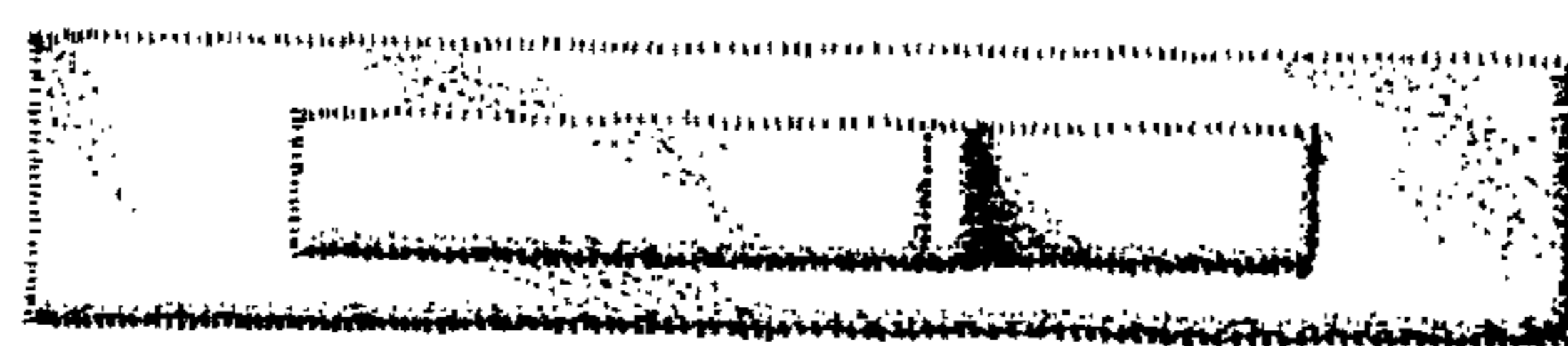

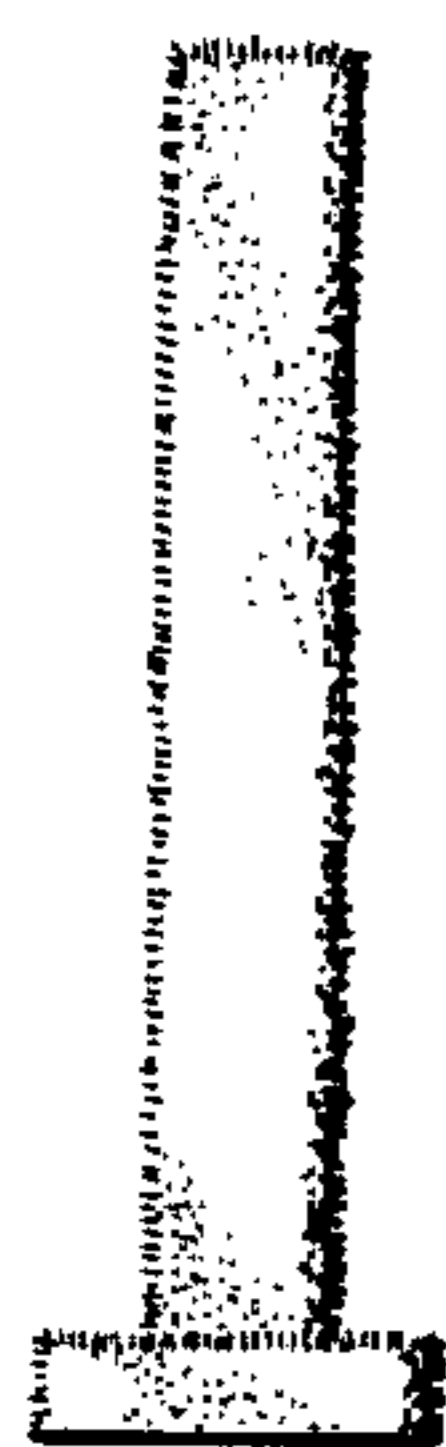

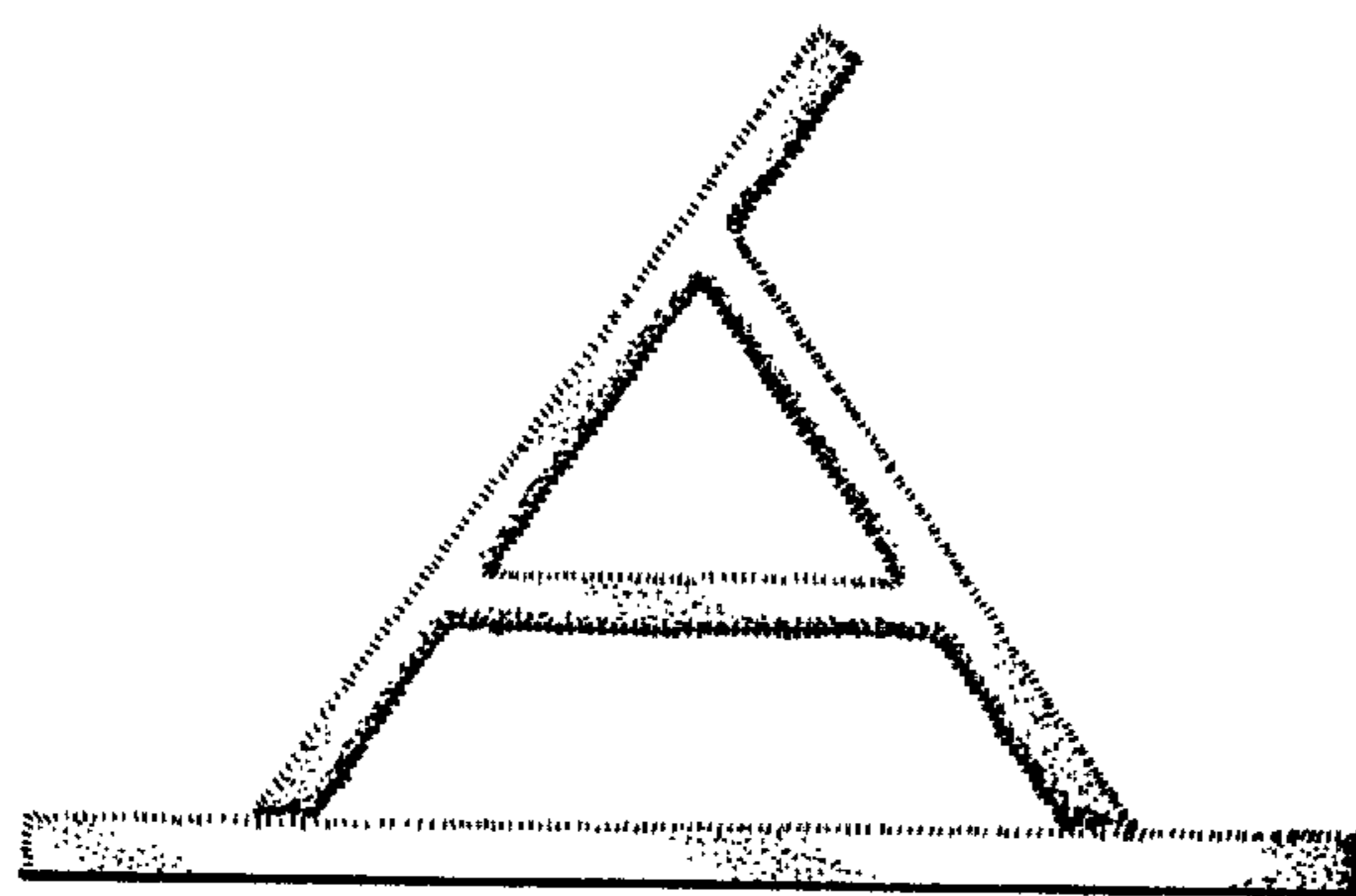

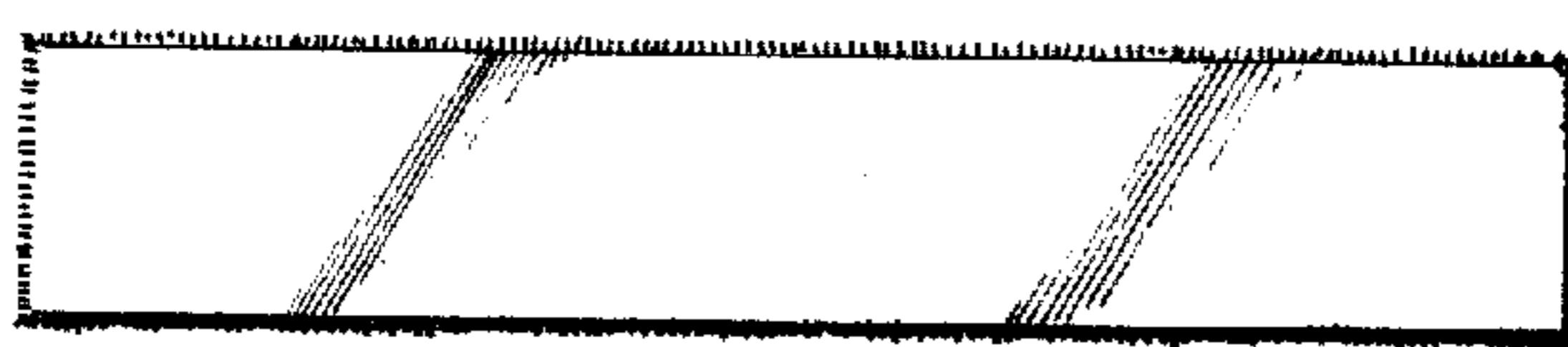
