The design is characterized by the specifically configured unitized seat and backrest unit as best illustrated in FIGS. 1, 2 and 5.

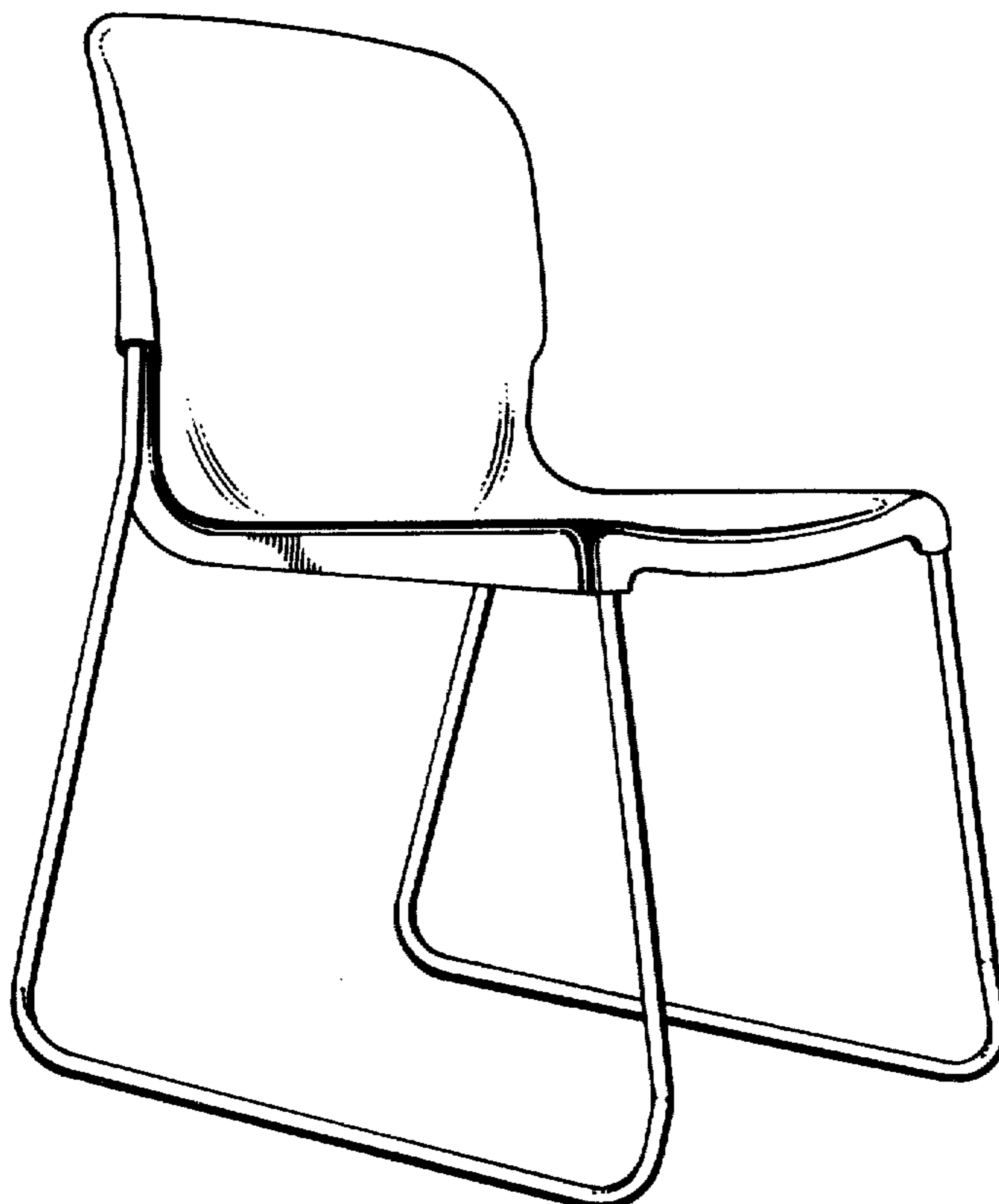

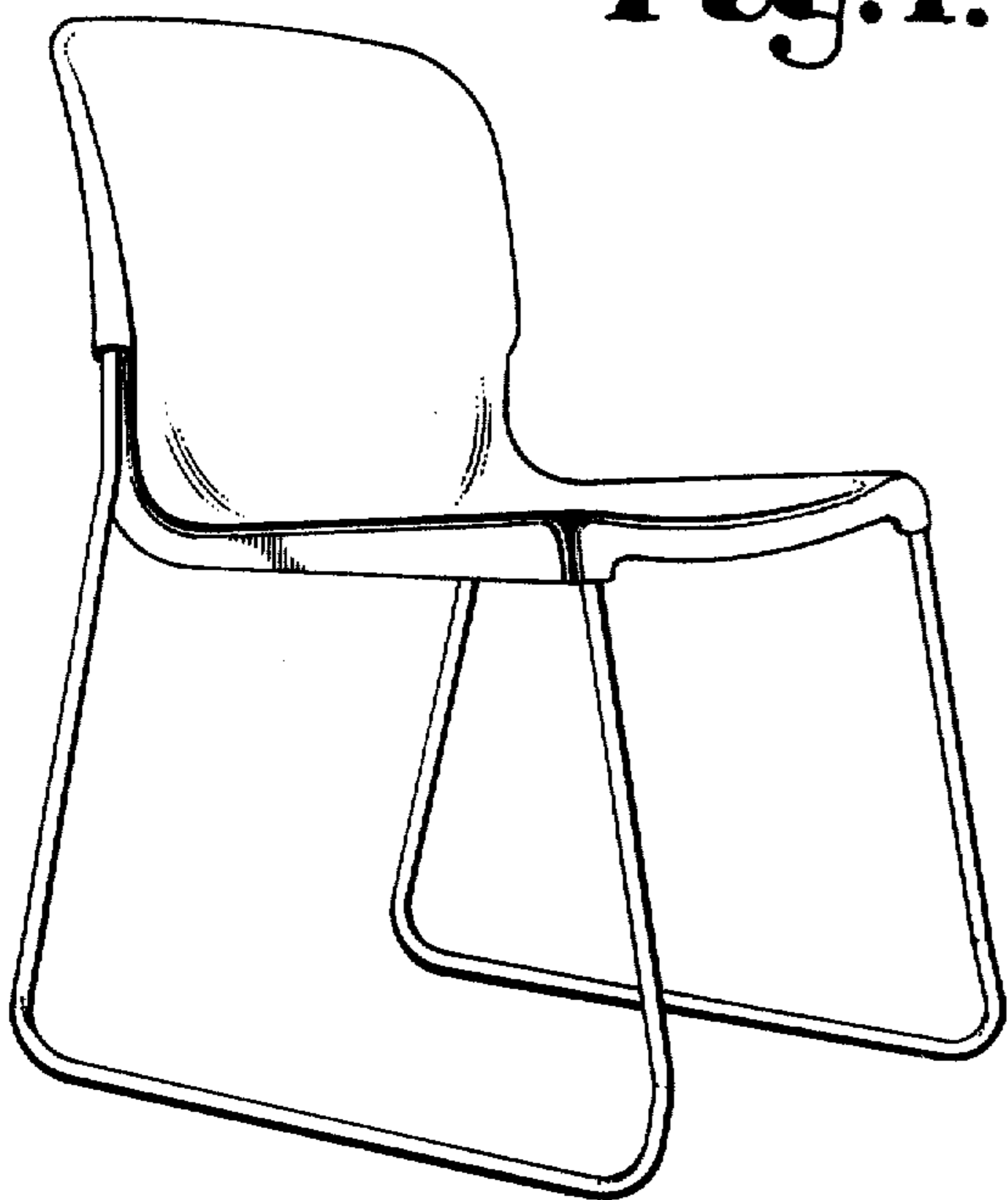

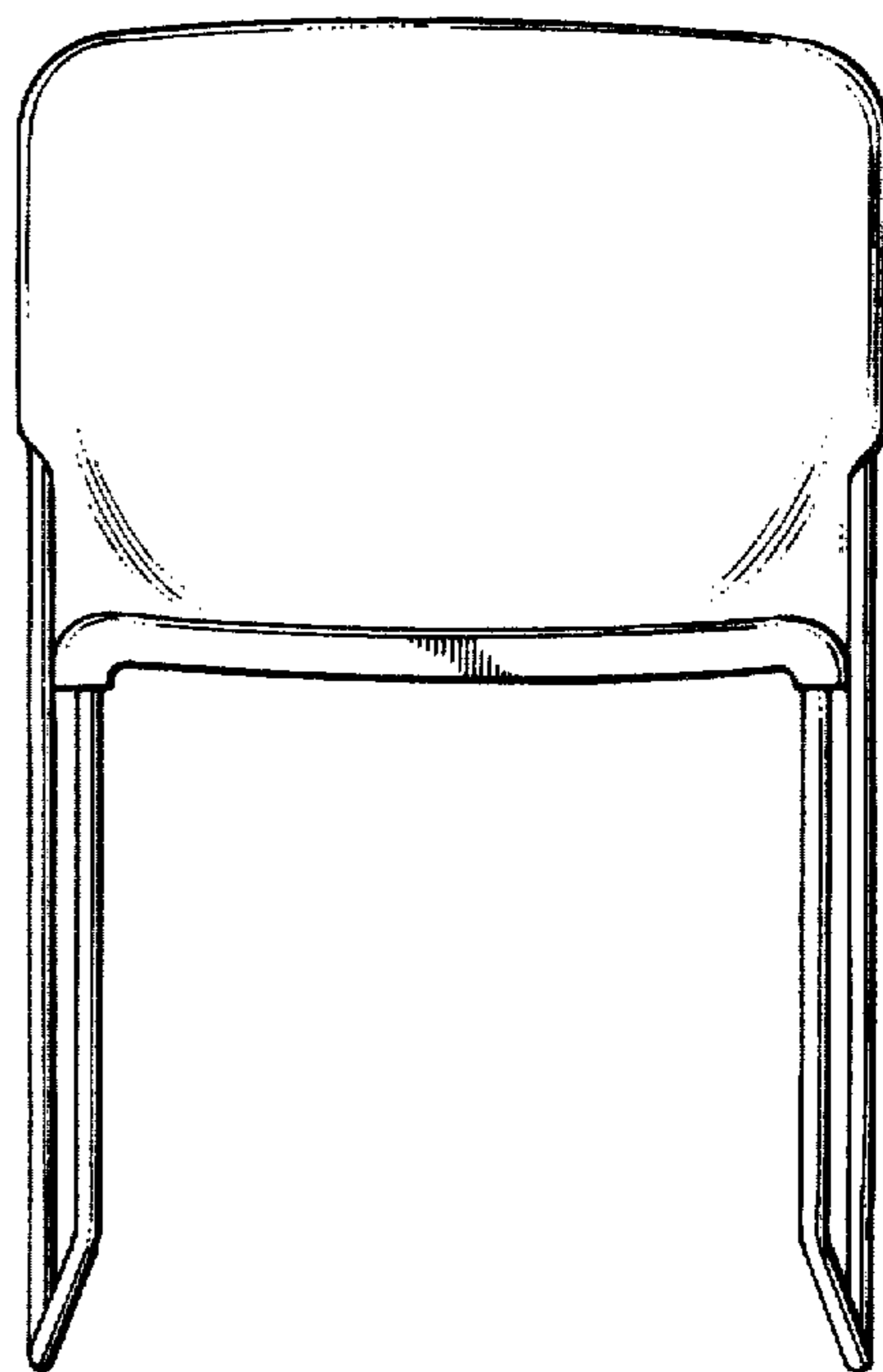

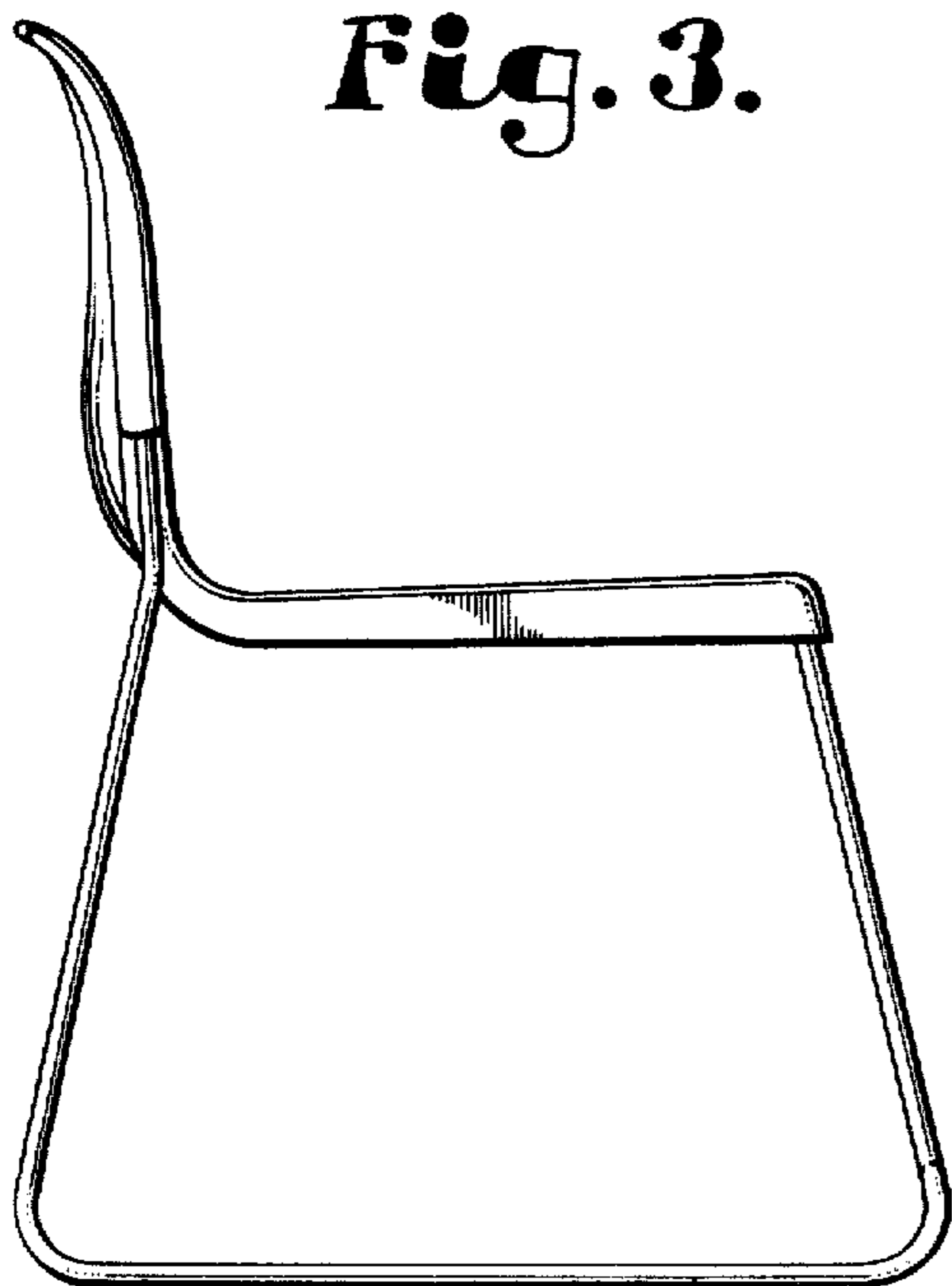

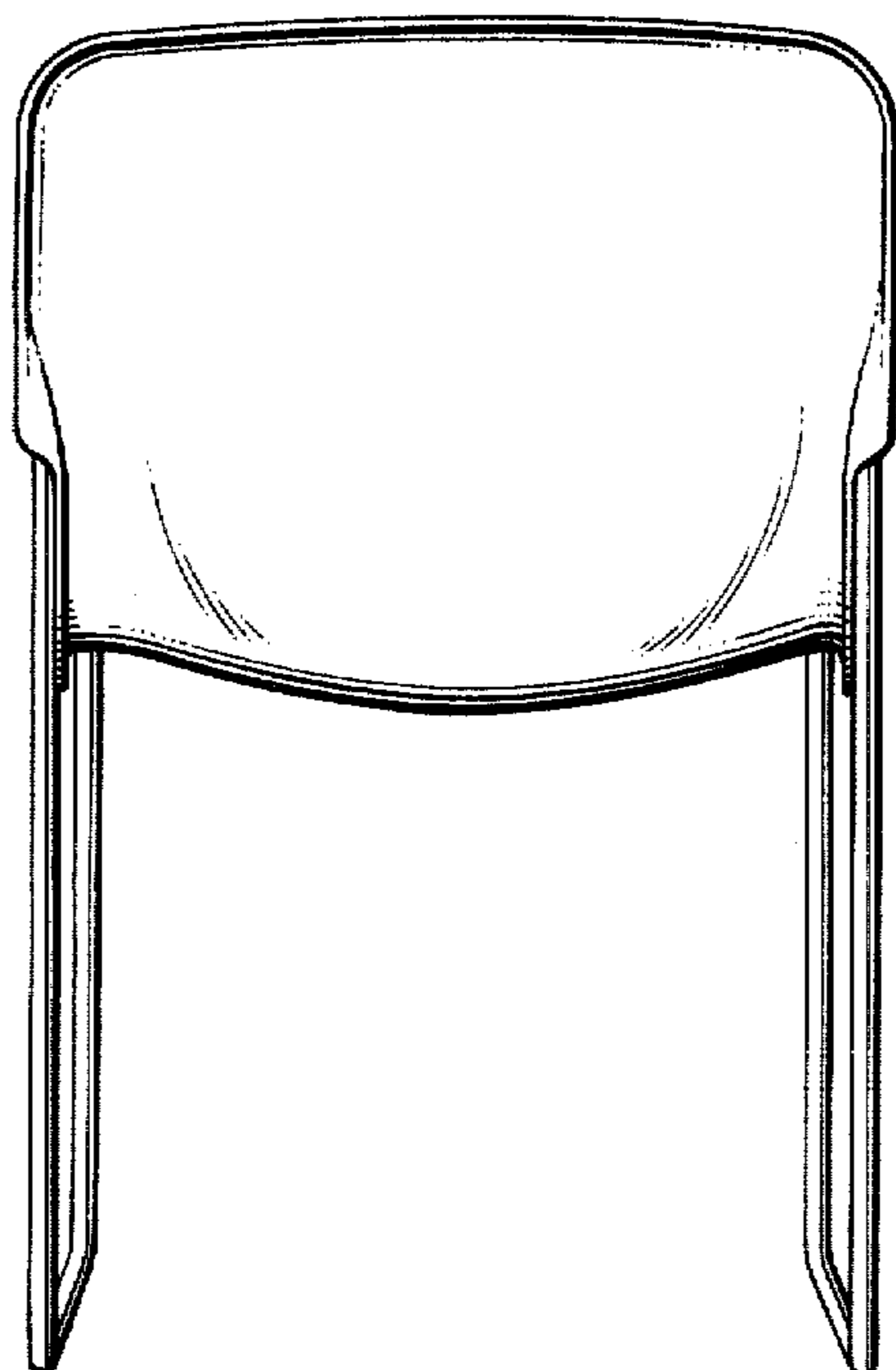
