[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a refrigerator cabinet suitable for use on railroads and in other vehicles subject to considerable vibration, substantially as shown.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a refrigerator cabinet suitable for use on railroads and in other vehicles subject to considerable vibration showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image of that shown;


FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof with the door in open condition.




