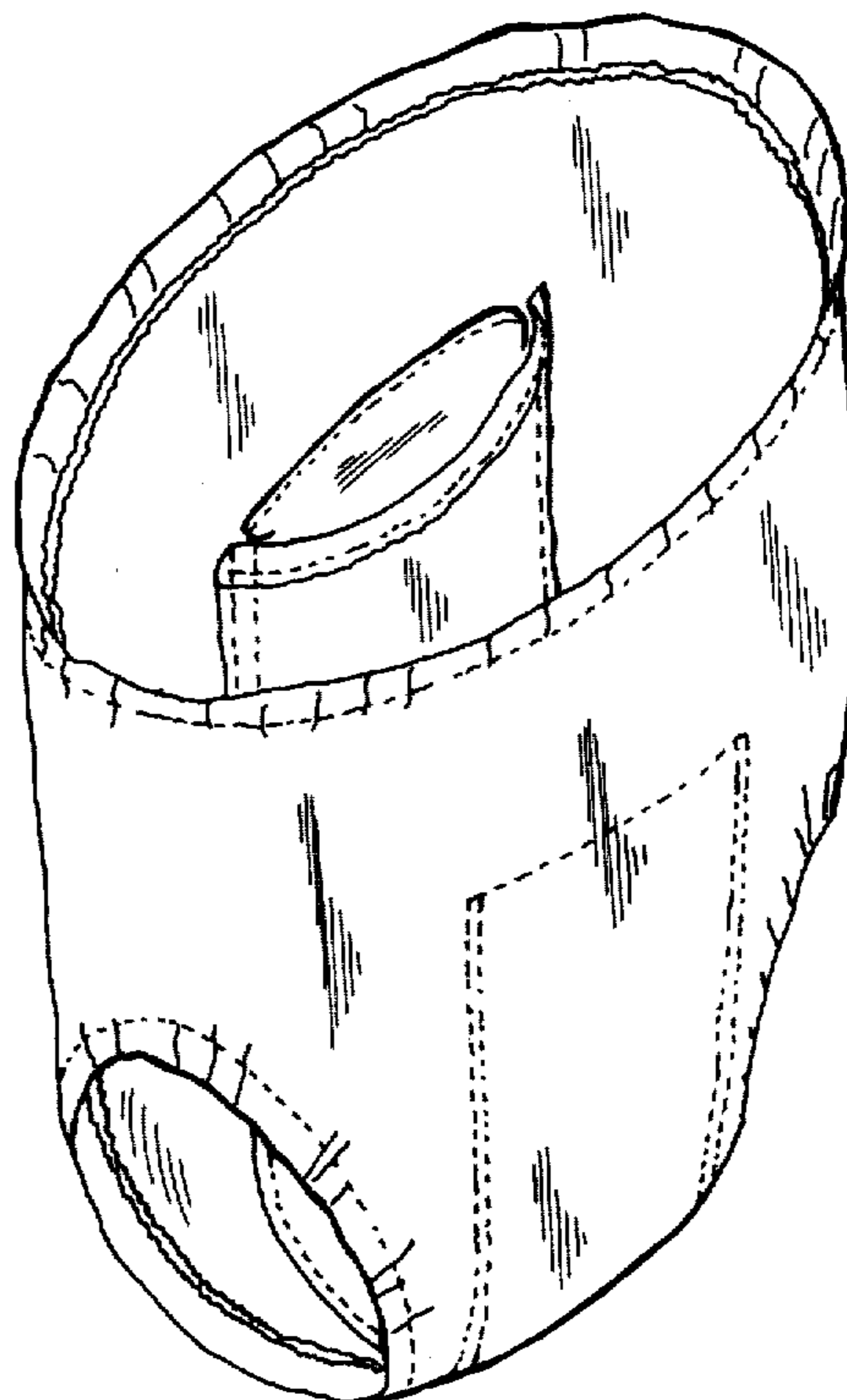

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an incontinence garment, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the top and rear of a preferred embodiment of my design for incontinence garment;
 FIG. 2 is a top view of my design for incontinence garment;
 FIG. 3 is a front view of my design for incontinence garment;
 FIG. 4 is a rear view of my design for incontinence garment;
 FIG. 5 is a side view of my design for incontinence garment;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view of my design for incontinence garment; and
 FIG. 7 is a greatly enlarged fragmentary view of the rib of the fabric of the incontinence garment, the fabric pattern being omitted from FIGS. 1–6 for convenience of illustration.



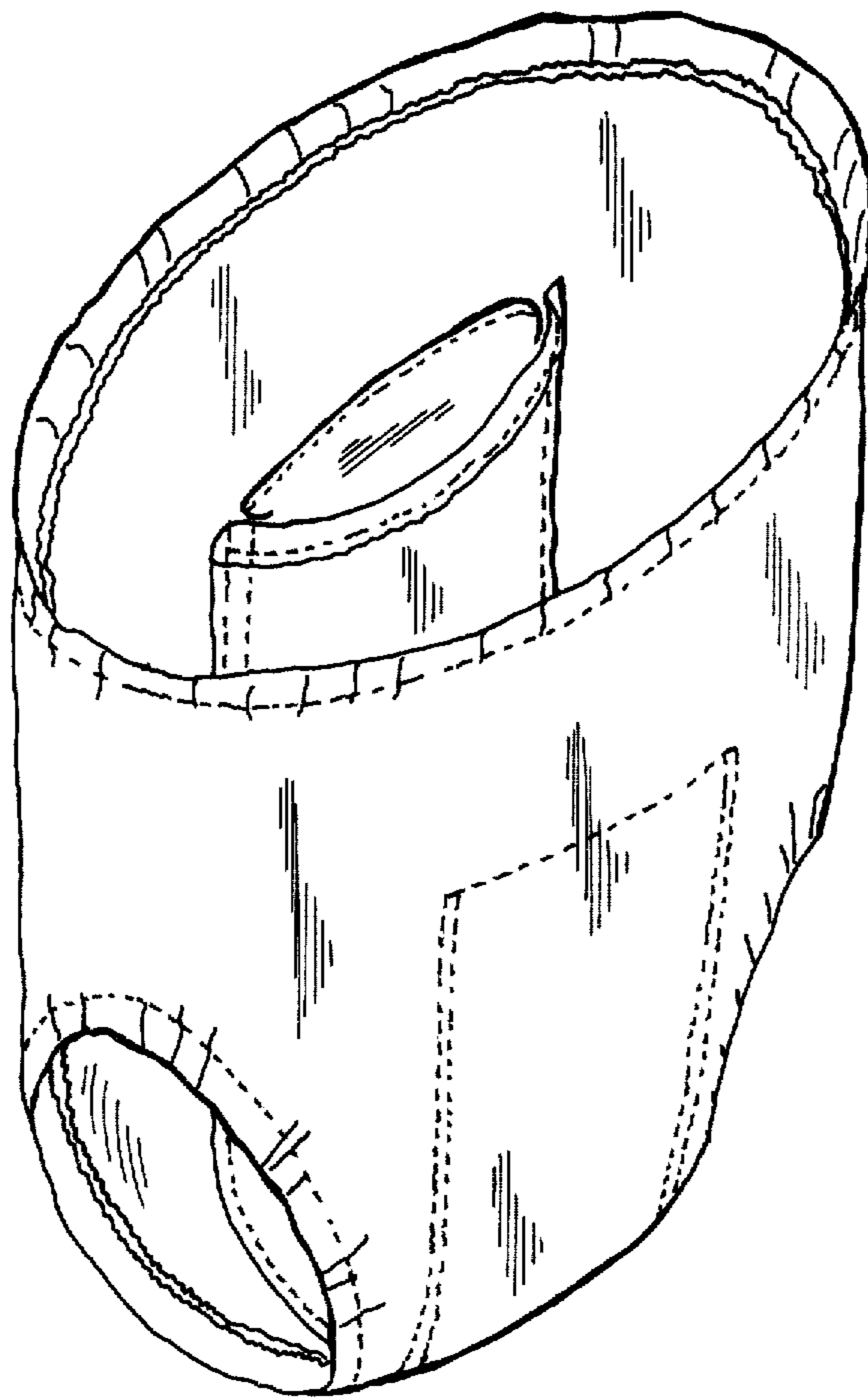

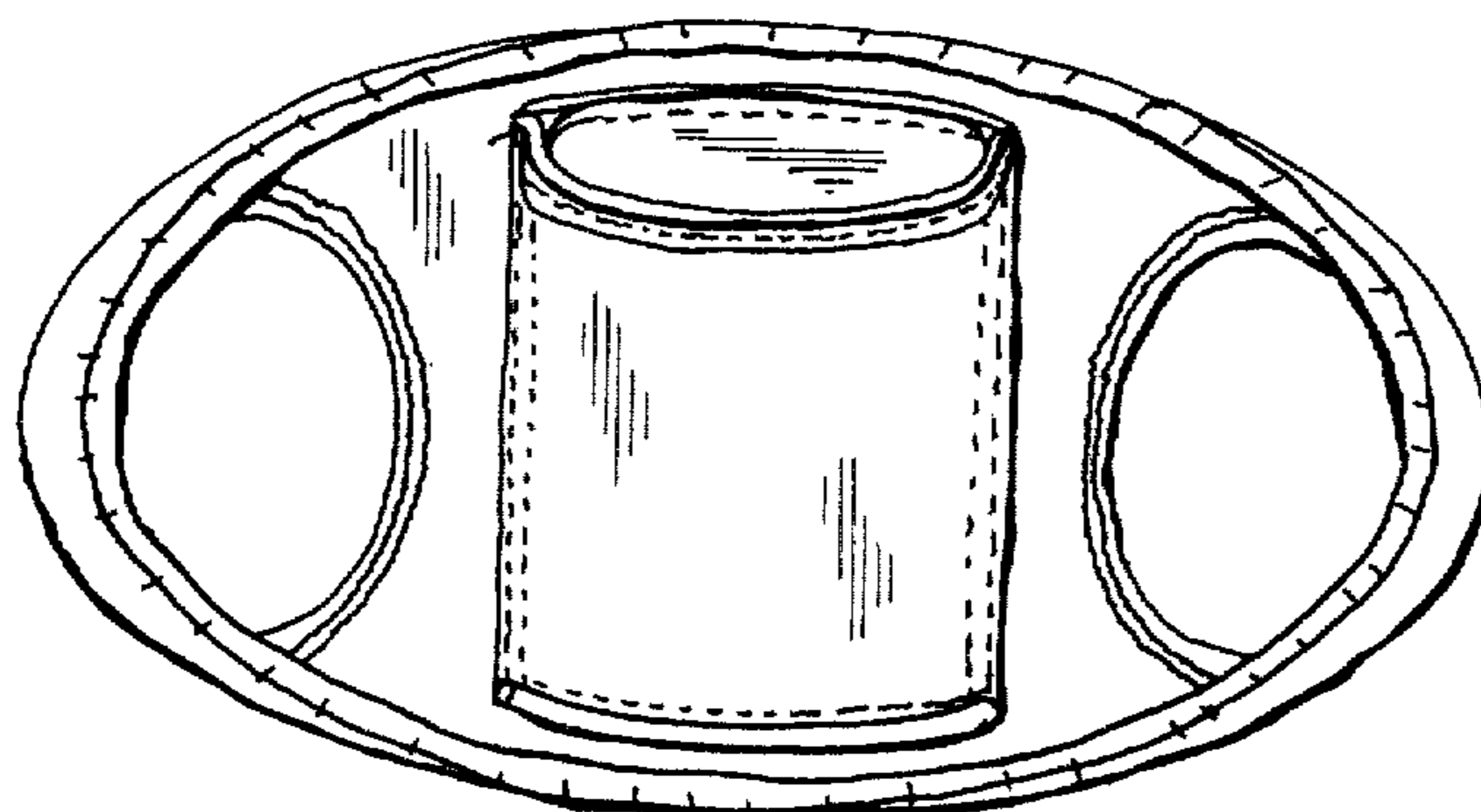

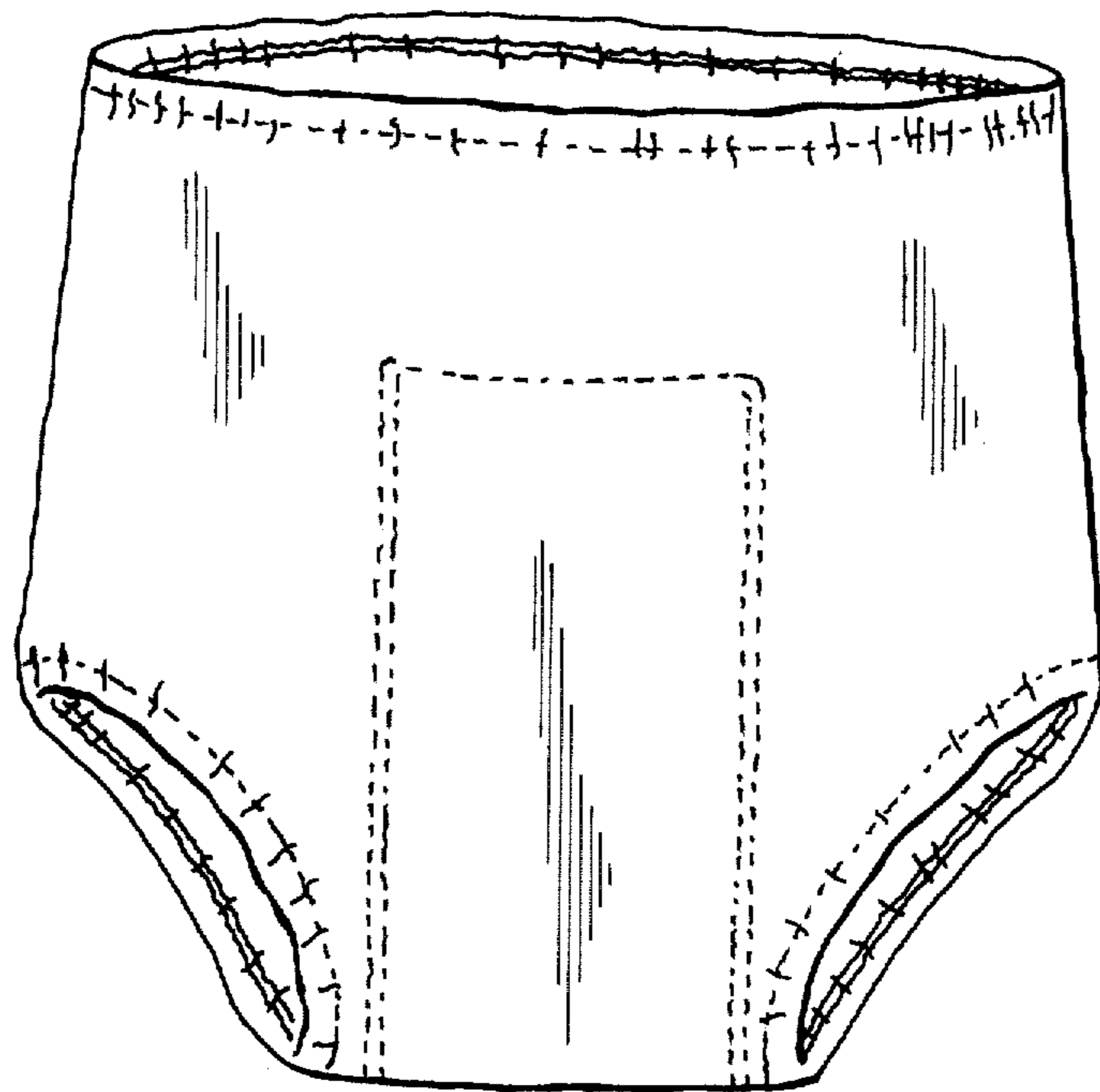

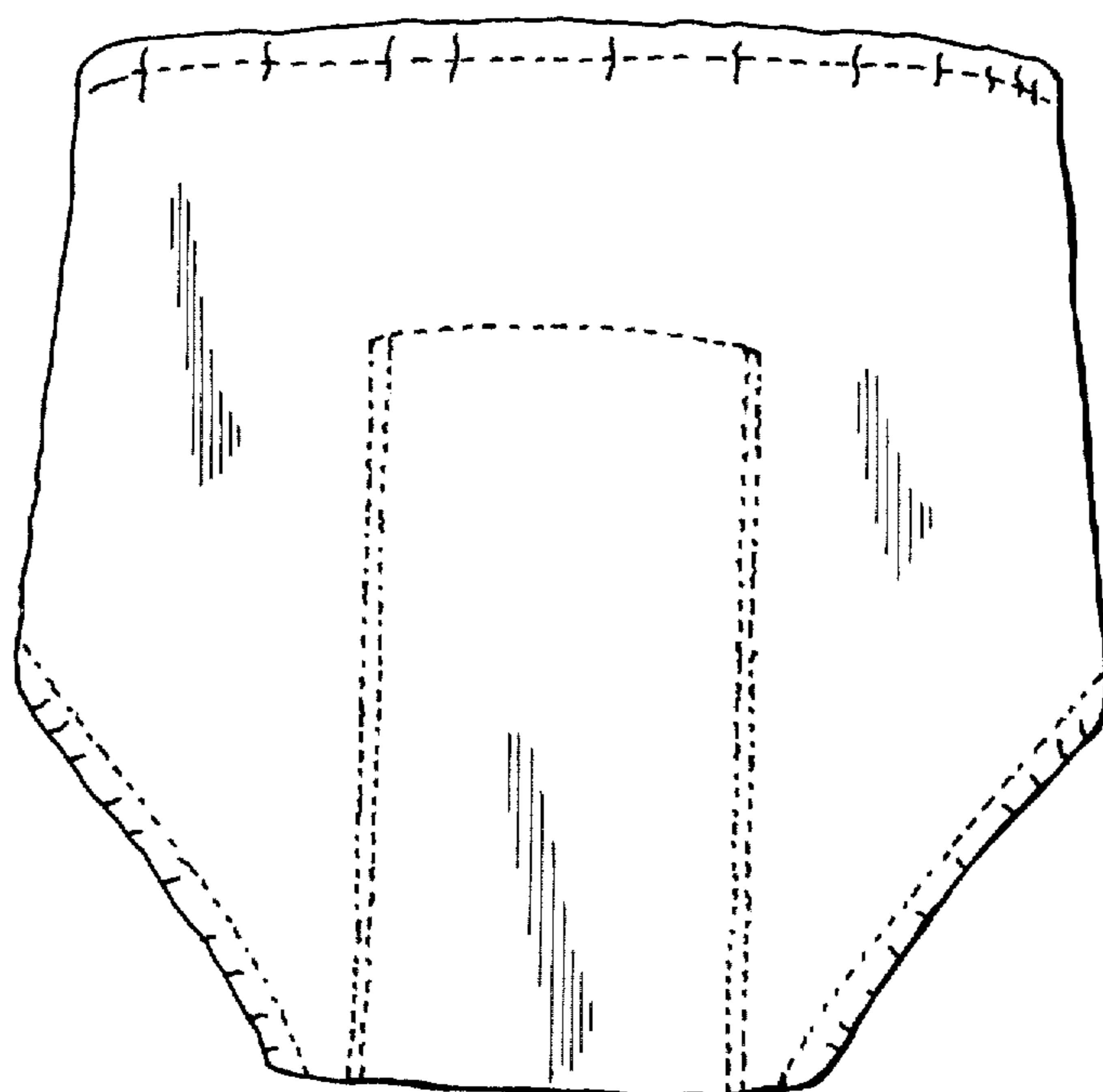

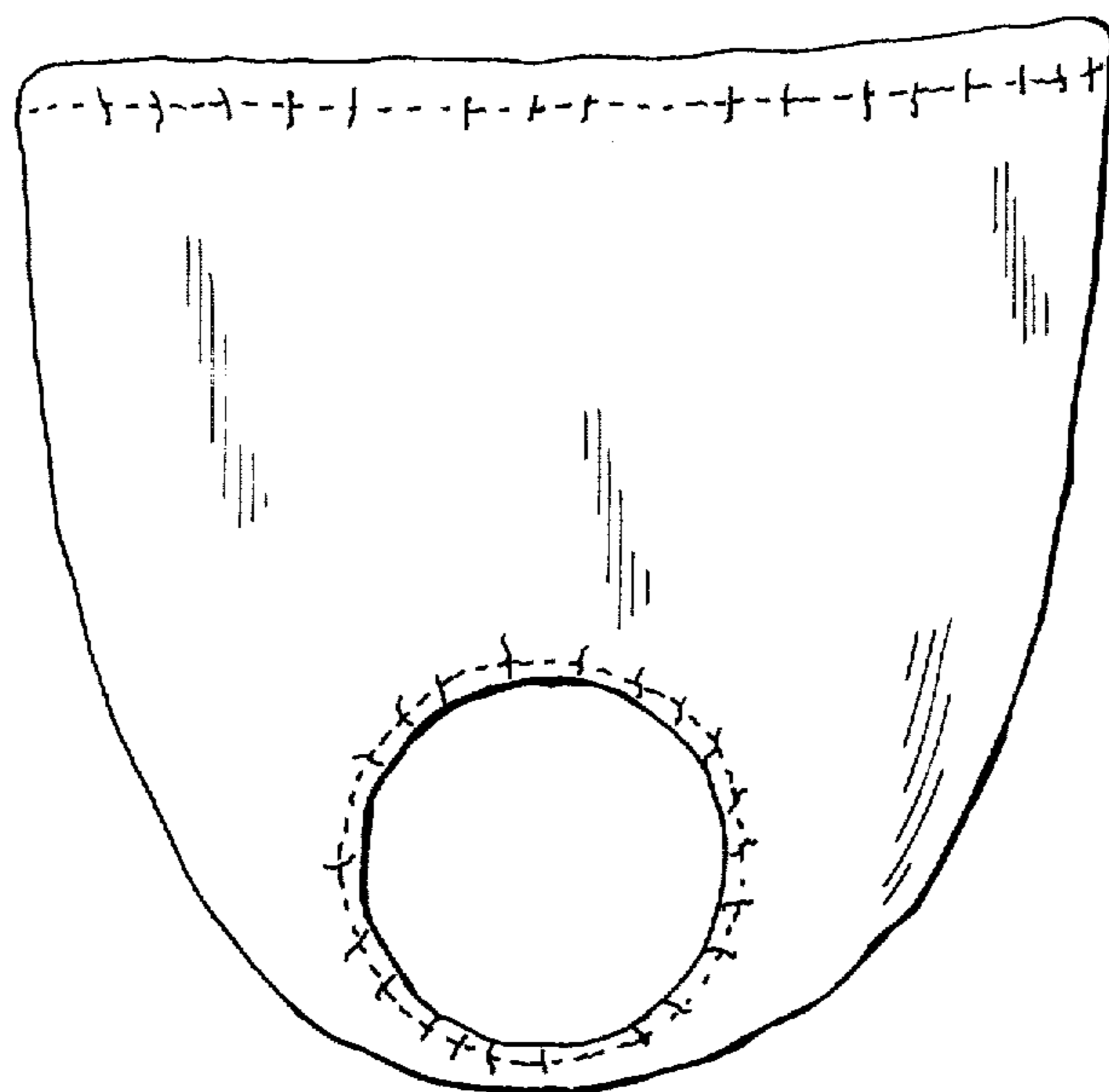

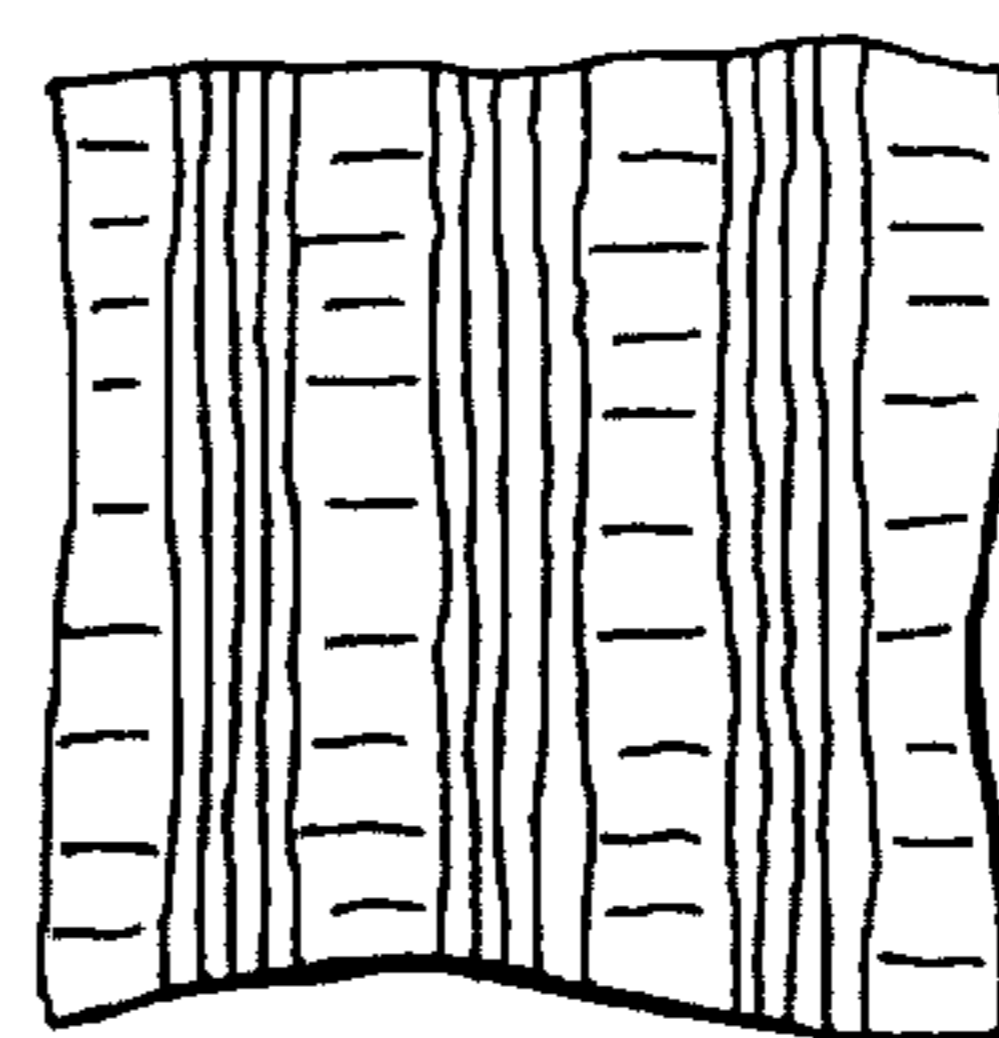
